hedges there they <u>13\_1CH\_04\_23</u> # These [were] the potters, and those that dwelt among plants and hedges: there they dwelt with the king for his work.

hedges thou hast 19 PSA 89 40 # Thou hast broken down all his hedges; thou hast brought his strong holds to ruin.

knowledge able also <u>45\_ROM\_15\_14</u> # And I myself also am persuaded of you, my brethren, that ye also are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, able also to admonish one another.

knowledge after the <u>51\_COL\_03\_10</u># And have put on the new [man], which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:

knowledge among you <u>59\_JAM\_03\_13</u># Who [is] a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him show out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom.

knowledge and by <u>09\_1SA\_02\_03</u> # Talk no more so exceeding proudly; let [not] arrogancy come out of your mouth: for the LORD [is] a God of knowledge, and by him actions are weighed.

knowledge and having 16\_NEH\_10\_28 # And the rest of the people, the priests, the Levites, the porters, the singers, the Nethinims, and all they that had separated themselves from the people of the lands unto the law of God, their wives, their sons, and their daughters, every one having knowledge, and having understanding;

knowledge and he <u>20\_PRO\_22\_12</u># The eyes of the LORD preserve knowledge, and he overthroweth the words of the transgressor.

ledges thereof and 11 1KI 07 35 # And in the top of the base [was there] a round compass of half a cubit high: and on the top of the base the ledges thereof and the borders thereof [were] of the same.

ledges thereof and <u>11\_1KI\_07\_36</u># For on the plates of the ledges thereof, and on the borders thereof, he graved cherubims, lions, and palm trees, according to the proportion of every one, and additions round about.

pledge of the 18\_JOB\_24\_09 # They pluck the fatherless from the breast, and take a pledge of the poor.

pledge shall I <u>01\_GEN\_38\_18</u># And he said, What pledge shall I give thee? And she said, Thy signet, and thy bracelets, and thy staff that [is] in thine hand. And he gave [it] her, and came in unto her, and she conceived by him.

pledge thou shalt <u>02\_EXO\_22\_26</u># If thou at all take thy neighbour's raiment to pledge, thou shalt deliver it unto him by that the sun goeth down:

selvedge in the <u>02\_EXO\_26\_04</u># And thou shalt make loops of blue upon the edge of the one curtain from the selvedge in the coupling; and likewise shalt thou make in the uttermost edge of [another] curtain, in the coupling of the second.

selvedge in the 02\_EXO\_36\_11 # And he made loops of blue on the edge of one curtain from the selvedge in

the coupling: likewise he made in the uttermost side of [another] curtain, in the coupling of the second.

twoedged sword and <u>66\_REV\_01\_16</u># And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword: and his countenance [was] as the sun shineth in his strength.

twoedged sword in 19\_PSA\_149\_06 # [Let] the high [praises] of God [be] in their mouth, and a twoedged sword in their hand;

twoedged sword piercing <u>58\_HEB\_04\_12</u># For the word of God [is] quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and [is] a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

twoedged sword 20\_PRO\_05\_04 # But her end is bitter as wormwood, sharp as a twoedged sword.

wedge of gold <u>06\_JOS\_07\_21</u># When I saw among the spoils a goodly Babylonish garment, and two hundred shekels of silver, and a wedge of gold of fifty shekels weight, then I coveted them, and took them; and, behold, they [are] hid in the earth in the midst of my tent, and the silver under it.
