eight among the <u>13\_1CH\_24\_04</u> # And there were more chief men found of the sons of Eleazar than of the sons of Ithamar; and [thus] were they divided. Among the sons of Eleazar [there were] sixteen chief men of the house of [their] fathers, and eight among the sons of Ithamar according to the house of their fathers.

eight and their <u>16\_NEH\_11\_14</u># And their brethren, mighty men of valour, an hundred twenty and eight: and their overseer [was] Zabdiel, the son of [one of] the great men.

eight and twenty <u>02\_EXO\_26\_02</u># The length of one curtain [shall be] eight and twenty cubits, and the breadth of one curtain four cubits: and every one of the curtains shall have one measure.

eight boards and <u>02\_EXO\_26\_25</u> # And they shall be eight boards, and their sockets [of] silver, sixteen sockets; two sockets under one board, and two sockets under another board.

eight boards and <u>02\_EXO\_36\_30</u># And there were eight boards; and their sockets [were] sixteen sockets of silver, under every board two sockets.

eight bullocks two <u>04\_NUM\_29\_29</u> # And on the sixth day eight bullocks, two rams, [and] fourteen lambs of the first year without blemish:

eight cities them <u>04\_NUM\_35\_07</u># [So] all the cities which ye shall give to the Levites [shall be] forty and eight cities: them [shall ye give] with their suburbs.

eight cities with <u>06\_JOS\_21\_41</u># All the cities of the Levites within the possession of the children of Israel [were] forty and eight cities with their suburbs.

eight cubits and <u>02\_EXO\_36\_09</u># The length of one curtain [was] twenty and eight cubits, and the breadth of one curtain four cubits: the curtains [were] all of one size.

eight cubits and <u>26\_EZE\_40\_09</u># Then measured he the porch of the gate, eight cubits; and the posts thereof, two cubits; and the porch of the gate [was] inward.

eight cubits <u>11\_1KI\_07\_10</u># And the foundation [was of] costly stones, even great stones, stones of ten cubits, and stones of eight cubits.

eight for thou <u>21\_ECC\_11\_02</u># Give a portion to seven, and also to eight; for thou knowest not what evil shall be upon the earth.

eight hundred and <u>15\_EZR\_02\_06</u># The children of Pahathmoab, of the children of Jeshua [and] Joab, two thousand eight hundred and twelve.

eight hundred and <u>01\_GEN\_05\_07</u># And Seth lived after he begat Enos eight hundred and seven years, and begat sons and daughters:

eight hundred and <u>01\_GEN\_05\_10</u># And Enos lived after he begat Cainan eight hundred and fifteen years, and begat sons and daughters:

eight hundred and <u>01\_GEN\_05\_13</u># And Cainan lived after he begat Mahalaleel eight hundred and forty years, and begat sons and daughters:

eight hundred and <u>01\_GEN\_05\_16</u># And Mahalaleel lived after he begat Jared eight hundred and thirty years, and begat sons and daughters:

eight hundred and <u>16\_NEH\_07\_11</u># The children of Pahathmoab, of the children of Jeshua and Joab, two thousand and eight hundred [and] eighteen.

eight hundred forty <u>16\_NEH\_07\_13</u># The children of Zattu, eight hundred forty and five.

eight hundred mighty <u>13\_1CH\_12\_30</u> # And of the children of Ephraim twenty thousand and eight hundred, mighty men of valour, famous throughout the house of their fathers.

eight hundred ninety <u>01\_GEN\_05\_17</u># And all the days of Mahalaleel were eight hundred ninety and five years: and he died.

eight hundred ready <u>13\_1CH\_12\_24</u> # The children of Judah that bare shield and spear [were] six thousand and eight hundred, ready armed to the war.

eight hundred thirty <u>24\_JER\_52\_29</u># In the eighteenth year of Nebuchadrezzar he carried away captive from Jerusalem eight hundred thirty and two persons:

eight hundred thousand <u>14\_2CH\_13\_03</u> # And Abijah set the battle in array with an army of valiant men of war, [even] four hundred thousand chosen men: Jeroboam also set the battle in array against him with eight hundred thousand chosen men, [being] mighty men of valour.

eight hundred thousand <u>10\_28A\_24\_09</u># And Joab gave up the sum of the number of the people unto the king: and there were in Israel eight hundred thousand valiant men that drew the sword; and the men of Judah [were] five hundred thousand men.

eight hundred twenty <u>16\_NEH\_11\_12</u># And their brethren that did the work of the house [were] eight hundred twenty and two: and Adaiah the son of Jeroham, the son of Pelaliah, the son of Amzi, the son of Zechariah, the son of Pashur, the son of Malchiah,

eight hundred whom <u>10\_2SA\_23\_08</u># These [be] the names of the mighty men whom David had: The Tachmonite that sat in the seat, chief among the captains; the same [was] Adino the Eznite: [he lift up his

spear] against eight hundred, whom he slew at one time.

eight hundred years <u>01\_GEN\_05\_04</u> # And the days of Adam after he had begotten Seth were eight hundred years: and he begat sons and daughters:

eight hundred years <u>01\_GEN\_05\_19</u># And Jared lived after he begat Enoch eight hundred years, and begat sons and daughters:

eight males <u>15\_EZR\_08\_11</u># And of the sons of Bebai; Zechariah the son of Bebai, and with him twenty and eight males.

eight men and <u>24\_JER\_41\_15</u># But Ishmael the son of Nethaniah escaped from Johanan with eight men, and went to the Ammonites.

eight Milcah did <u>01\_GEN\_22\_23</u># And Bethuel begat Rebekah: these eight Milcah did bear to Nahor, Abraham's brother.

eight Obededom also <u>13\_1CH\_16\_38</u> # And Obededom with their brethren, threescore and eight; Obededom also the son of Jeduthun and Hosah [to be] porters:

eight oxen he <u>04\_NUM\_07\_08</u># And four wagons and eight oxen he gave unto the sons of Merari, according unto their service, under the hand of Ithamar the son of Aaron the priest.

eight principal men <u>33\_MIC\_05\_05</u> # And this [man] shall be the peace, when the Assyrian shall come into our land: and when he shall tread in our palaces, then shall we raise against him seven shepherds, and eight principal men.

eight sons and <u>09\_1SA\_17\_12</u> # Now David [was] the son of that Ephrathite of Bethlehemjudah, whose name [was] Jesse; and he had eight sons: and the man went among men [for] an old man in the days of Saul.

eight sons and <u>14\_2CH\_11\_21</u># And Rehoboam loved Maachah the daughter of Absalom above all his wives and his concubines: [for he took eighteen wives, and threescore concubines; and begat twenty and eight sons, and threescore daughters.]

eight souls were <u>60\_1PE\_03\_20</u> # Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water.

eight steps <u>26\_EZE\_40\_31</u> # And the arches thereof [were] toward the utter court; and palm trees [were] upon the posts thereof: and the going up to it [had] eight steps.

eight steps <u>26\_EZE\_40\_34</u> # And the arches thereof [were] toward the outward court; and palm trees [were] upon the posts thereof, on this side, and on that side: and the going up to it [had] eight steps.

eight steps <u>26\_EZE\_40\_37</u> # And the posts thereof [were] toward the utter court; and palm trees [were] upon the posts thereof, on this side, and on that side: and the going up to it [had] eight steps.

eight tables whereupon <u>26\_EZE\_40\_41</u> # Four tables [were] on this side, and four tables on that side, by the side of the gate; eight tables, whereupon they slew [their sacrifices].

eight thousand and <u>13\_1CH\_12\_35</u># And of the Danites expert in war twenty and eight thousand and six hundred.

eight thousand and <u>04\_NUM\_02\_24</u> # All that were numbered of the camp of Ephraim [were] an hundred

thousand and eight thousand and an hundred, throughout their armies. And they shall go forward in the third rank.

eight thousand and <u>04\_NUM\_03\_28</u># In the number of all the males, from a month old and upward, [were] eight thousand and six hundred, keeping the charge of the sanctuary.

eight thousand and <u>04\_NUM\_04\_48</u># Even those that were numbered of them, were eight thousand and five hundred and fourscore.

eight thousand <u>13\_1CH\_23\_03</u> # Now the Levites were numbered from the age of thirty years and upward: and their number by their polls, man by man, was thirty and eight thousand.

eight valiant men <u>16\_NEH\_11\_06</u># All the sons of Perez that dwelt at Jerusalem [were] four hundred threescore and eight valiant men.

eight years and <u>14\_2CH\_21\_20</u># Thirty and two years old was he when he began to reign, and he reigned in Jerusalem eight years, and departed without being desired. Howbeit they buried him in the city of David, but not in the sepulchres of the kings.

eight years and <u>44\_ACT\_09\_33</u> # And there he found a certain man named AEneas, which had kept his bed eight years, and was sick of the palsy.

eight years in <u>14\_2CH\_21\_05</u> # Jehoram [was] thirty and two years old when he began to reign, and he reigned eight years in Jerusalem.

eight years in <u>12\_2KI\_08\_17</u># Thirty and two years old was he when he began to reign; and he reigned eight years in Jerusalem.

eight years old <u>09\_1SA\_04\_15</u># Now Eli was ninety and eight years old; and his eyes were dim, that he could not see.

eight years old <u>14\_2CH\_34\_01</u> # Josiah [was] eight years old when he began to reign, and he reigned in Jerusalem one and thirty years.

eight years old <u>14\_2CH\_36\_09</u> # Jehoiachin [was] eight years old when he began to reign, and he reigned three months and ten days in Jerusalem: and he did [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD.

eight years old <u>12\_2KI\_22\_01</u> # Josiah [was] eight years old when he began to reign, and he reigned thirty and one years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Jedidah, the daughter of Adaiah of Boscath.

eight years until <u>05\_DEU\_02\_14</u> # And the space in which we came from Kadeshbarnea, until we were come over the brook Zered, [was] thirty and eight years; until all the generation of the men of war were wasted out from among the host, as the LORD sware unto them.

eight years <u>12\_2KI\_10\_36</u># And the time that Jehu reigned over Israel in Samaria [was] twenty and eight years.

eight years <u>43\_JOH\_05\_05</u> # And a certain man was there, which had an infirmity thirty and eight years.

eight years <u>07\_JUD\_03\_08</u> # Therefore the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he sold them into the hand of Chushanrishathaim king of Mesopotamia: and the children of Israel served Chushanrishathaim eight years.

eight years <u>07\_JUD\_12\_14</u> # And he had forty sons and thirty nephews, that rode on threescore and ten ass colts: and he judged Israel eight years.

eight <u>15\_EZR\_02\_23</u> # The men of Anathoth, an hundred twenty and eight.

eight <u>15\_EZR\_02\_41</u># The singers: the children of Asaph, an hundred twenty and eight.

eight <u>16\_NEH\_07\_15</u># The children of Binnui, six hundred forty and eight.

eight <u>16\_NEH\_07\_16</u># The children of Bebai, six hundred twenty and eight.

eight <u>16\_NEH\_07\_21</u> # The children of Ater of Hezekiah, ninety and eight.

eight <u>16\_NEH\_07\_22</u># The children of Hashum, three hundred twenty and eight.

eight <u>16\_NEH\_07\_26</u># The men of Bethlehem and Netophah, an hundred fourscore and eight.

eight <u>16\_NEH\_07\_27</u># The men of Anathoth, an hundred twenty and eight.

eight <u>16\_NEH\_07\_44</u> # The singers: the children of Asaph, an hundred forty and eight.

eight <u>16\_NEH\_07\_45</u># The porters: the children of Shallum, the children of Ater, the children of Talmon, the children of Akkub, the children of Hatita, the children of Shobai, an hundred thirty and eight.

eight <u>16\_NEH\_11\_08</u># And after him Gabbai, Sallai, nine hundred twenty and eight.

eighteen and pursued <u>01\_GEN\_14\_14</u># And when Abram heard that his brother was taken captive, he armed his trained [servants], born in his own house, three hundred and eighteen, and pursued [them] unto Dan.

eighteen cubits and <u>12\_2KI\_25\_17</u> # The height of the one pillar [was] eighteen cubits, and the chapiter upon it [was] brass: and the height of the chapiter three cubits; and the wreathen work, and pomegranates upon the chapiter round about, all of brass: and like unto these had the second pillar with wreathen work.

eighteen cubits and <u>24\_JER\_52\_21</u># And [concerning] the pillars, the height of one pillar [was] eighteen cubits; and a fillet of twelve cubits did compass it; and the thickness thereof [was] four fingers: [it was] hollow.

eighteen cubits high <u>11\_1KI\_07\_15</u># For he cast two pillars of brass, of eighteen cubits high apiece: and a line of twelve cubits did compass either of them about.

eighteen males <u>15\_EZR\_08\_09</u> # Of the sons of Joab; Obadiah the son of Jehiel, and with him two hundred and eighteen males.

eighteen thousand measures <u>26 EZE 48 35</u> # [It was] round about eighteen thousand [measures]: and the name of the city from [that] day [shall be], The LORD [is] there.

eighteen thousand men <u>10\_2SA\_08\_13</u> # And David gat [him] a name when he returned from smiting of the Syrians in the valley of salt, [being] eighteen thousand [men].

eighteen thousand men <u>07\_JUD\_20\_25</u> # And Benjamin went forth against them out of Gibeah the second day, and destroyed down to the ground of the children of Israel again eighteen thousand men; all these

eighteen thousand men <u>07\_JUD\_20\_44</u> # And there fell of Benjamin eighteen thousand men; all these [were] men of valour.

eighteen thousand talents <u>13\_1CH\_29\_07</u> # And gave for the service of the house of God of gold five thousand talents and ten thousand drams, and of silver ten thousand talents, and of brass eighteen thousand talents, and one hundred thousand talents of iron.

eighteen thousand which <u>13\_1CH\_12\_31</u> # And of the half tribe of Manasseh eighteen thousand, which were expressed by name, to come and make David king.

eighteen thousand <u>13\_1CH\_18\_12</u># Moreover Abishai the son of Zeruiah slew of the Edomites in the valley of salt eighteen thousand.

eighteen upon whom <u>42\_LUK\_13\_04</u> # Or those eighteen, upon whom the tower in Siloam fell, and slew them, think ye that they were sinners above all men that dwelt in Jerusalem?

eighteen wives and <u>14\_2CH\_11\_21</u># And Rehoboam loved Maachah the daughter of Absalom above all his wives and his concubines: [for he took eighteen wives, and threescore concubines; and begat twenty and eight sons, and threescore daughters.]

eighteen years all <u>07\_JUD\_10\_08</u># And that year they vexed and oppressed the children of Israel: eighteen years, all the children of Israel that [were] on the other side Jordan in the land of the Amorites, which [is] in Gilead.

eighteen years and <u>42\_LUK\_13\_11</u># And, behold, there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up [herself].

eighteen years be <u>42\_LUK\_13\_16</u> # And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?

eighteen years old <u>12\_2KI\_24\_08</u> # Jehoiachin [was] eighteen years old when he began to reign, and he reigned in Jerusalem three months. And his mother's name [was] Nehushta, the daughter of Elnathan of Jerusalem.

eighteen years <u>07\_JUD\_03\_14</u># So the children of Israel served Eglon the king of Moab eighteen years.

eighteen <u>13\_1CH\_26\_09</u> # And Meshelemiah had sons and brethren, strong men, eighteen.

eighteen <u>15\_EZR\_08\_18</u># And by the good hand of our God upon us they brought us a man of understanding, of the sons of Mahli, the son of Levi, the son of Israel; and Sherebiah, with his sons and his brethren, eighteen;

eighteen <u>16\_NEH\_07\_11</u># The children of Pahathmoab, of the children of Jeshua and Joab, two thousand and eight hundred [and] eighteen.

eighteenth to Aphses <u>13\_1CH\_24\_15</u> # The seventeenth to Hezir, the eighteenth to Aphses,

eighteenth to Hanani <u>13\_1CH\_25\_25</u># The eighteenth to Hanani, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:

eighteenth year of <u>11\_1KI\_15\_01</u># Now in the eighteenth year of king Jeroboam the son of Nebat reigned Abijam over Judah.

eighteenth year of <u>14\_2CH\_13\_01</u> # Now in the eighteenth year of king Jeroboam began Abijah to reign over Judah.

eighteenth year of <u>14\_2CH\_34\_08</u> # Now in the eighteenth year of his reign, when he had purged the land, and the house, he sent Shaphan the son of Azaliah, and Maaseiah the governor of the city, and Joah the son of Joahaz the recorder, to repair the house of the LORD his God.

eighteenth year of <u>14\_2CH\_35\_19</u># In the eighteenth year of the reign of Josiah was this passover kept.

eighteenth year of <u>12\_2KI\_03\_01</u> # Now Jehoram the son of Ahab began to reign over Israel in Samaria the eighteenth year of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, and reigned twelve years.

eighteenth year of <u>12\_2KI\_22\_03</u> # And it came to pass in the eighteenth year of king Josiah, [that] the king sent Shaphan the son of Azaliah, the son of Meshullam, the scribe, to the house of the LORD, saying,

eighteenth year of <u>12\_2KI\_23\_23</u># But in the eighteenth year of king Josiah, [wherein] this passover was holden to the LORD in Jerusalem.

eighteenth year of <u>24\_JER\_32\_01</u> # The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD in the tenth year of Zedekiah king of Judah, which [was] the eighteenth year of Nebuchadrezzar.

eighteenth year of <u>24\_JER\_52\_29</u> # In the eighteenth year of Nebuchadrezzar he carried away captive from Jerusalem eight hundred thirty and two persons:

eighth and is <u>66\_REV\_17\_11</u># And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition.

eighth beryl the <u>66\_REV\_21\_20</u> # The fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolyte; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, a topaz; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the eleventh, a jacinth; the twelfth, an amethyst.

eighth captain for <u>13\_1CH\_27\_11</u># The eighth [captain] for the eighth month [was] Sibbecai the Hushathite, of the Zarhites: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

eighth day and <u>44\_ACT\_07\_08</u># And he gave him the covenant of circumcision: and so [Abraham] begat Isaac, and circumcised him the eighth day; and Isaac [begat] Jacob; and Jacob [begat] the twelve patriarchs.

eighth day and <u>26\_EZE\_43\_27</u> # And when these days are expired, it shall be, [that] upon the eighth day, and [so] forward, the priests shall make your burnt offerings upon the altar, and your peace offerings; and I will accept you, saith the Lord GOD.

eighth day and <u>03\_LEV\_22\_27</u> # When a bullock, or a sheep, or a goat, is brought forth, then it shall be seven days under the dam; and from the eighth day and thenceforth it shall be accepted for an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

eighth day for <u>03\_LEV\_14\_23</u> # And he shall bring them on the eighth day for his cleansing unto the priest, unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, before the LORD.

eighth day he <u>11\_1KI\_08\_66</u># On the eighth day he sent the people away: and they blessed the king, and went unto their tents joyful and glad of heart for all the goodness that the LORD had done for David his servant, and for Israel his people.

eighth day he <u>03\_LEV\_14\_10</u> # And on the eighth day he shall take two he lambs without blemish, and one ewe lamb of the first year without blemish, and three tenth deals of fine flour [for] a meat offering, mingled with oil, and one log of oil.

eighth day offered <u>04\_NUM\_07\_54</u># On the eighth day [offered] Gamaliel the son of Pedahzur, prince of the children of Manasseh:

eighth day shall <u>03\_LEV\_23\_36</u># Seven days ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: on the eighth day shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: it [is] a solemn assembly; [and] ye shall do no servile work [therein].

eighth day shall <u>03\_LEV\_23\_39</u># Also in the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when ye have gathered in the fruit of the land, ye shall keep a feast unto the LORD seven days: on the first day [shall be] a sabbath, and on the eighth day [shall be] a sabbath.

eighth day she <u>03\_LEV\_15\_29</u># And on the eighth day she shall take unto her two turtles, or two young pigeons, and bring them unto the priest, to the door of the tabernacle of the congregation.

eighth day that <u>03\_LEV\_09\_01</u># And it came to pass on the eighth day, [that] Moses called Aaron and his sons, and the elders of Israel;

eighth day the <u>03\_LEV\_12\_03</u># And in the eighth day the flesh of his foreskin shall be circumcised.

eighth day they <u>14\_2CH\_07\_09</u># And in the eighth day they made a solemn assembly: for they kept the dedication of the altar seven days, and the feast seven days.

eighth day they <u>42\_LUK\_01\_59</u> # And it came to pass, that on the eighth day they came to circumcise the child; and they called him Zacharias, after the name of his father.

eighth day thou <u>02\_EXO\_22\_30</u># Likewise shalt thou do with thine oxen, [and] with thy sheep: seven days it shall be with his dam; on the eighth day thou shalt give it me.

eighth day was <u>16\_NEH\_08\_18</u> # Also day by day, from the first day unto the last day, he read in the book of the law of God. And they kept the feast seven days; and on the eighth day [was] a solemn assembly, according unto the manner.

eighth day ye <u>04\_NUM\_29\_35</u># On the eighth day ye shall have a solemn assembly: ye shall do no servile work [therein]:

eighth Elzabad the <u>13\_1CH\_12\_12</u># Johanan the eighth, Elzabad the ninth,

eighth for God <u>13\_1CH\_26\_05</u> # Ammiel the sixth, Issachar the seventh, Peulthai the eighth: for God blessed him.

eighth month even <u>11\_1KI\_12\_33</u># So he offered upon the altar which he had made in Bethel the fifteenth day of the eighth month, [even] in the month which he had devised of his own heart; and ordained a feast unto the children of Israel: and he offered upon the altar, and burnt incense.
