

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

epistle be read <u>52\_1TH\_05\_27</u> # I charge you by the Lord that this epistle be read unto all the holy brethren.

epistle beloved I <u>61\_2PE\_03\_01</u> # This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in [both] which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance:

epistle from Laodicea <u>51\_COL\_04\_16</u># And when this epistle is read among you, cause that it be read also in the church of the Laodiceans; and that ye likewise read the [epistle] from Laodicea.

epistle hath made <u>47\_2CO\_07\_08</u> # For though I made you sorry with a letter, I do not repent, though I did repent: for I perceive that the same epistle hath made you sorry, though [it were] but for a season.

epistle is read <u>51\_COL\_04\_16</u># And when this epistle is read among you, cause that it be read also in the church of the Laodiceans; and that ye likewise read the [epistle] from Laodicea.

epistle not to <u>46\_1CO\_05\_09</u># I wrote unto you in an epistle not to company with fornicators:

epistle note that <u>53\_2TH\_03\_14</u> # And if any man obey not our word by this epistle, note that man, and have no company with him, that he may be ashamed.

epistle of Christ <u>47\_2CO\_03\_03</u> # [Forasmuch as ye are] manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tables of stone, but in fleshly tables of the heart.

epistle salute you <u>45\_ROM\_16\_22</u> # I Tertius, who wrote [this] epistle, salute you in the Lord.

epistle so I <u>53\_2TH\_03\_17</u> # The salutation of Paul with mine own hand, which is the token in every epistle: so I write.

epistle to the <u>44\_ACT\_23\_33</u> # Who, when they came to Caesarea, and delivered the epistle to the governor, presented Paul also before him.

epistle written in <u>47\_2CO\_03\_02</u> # Ye are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read of all men:

epistle <u>53\_2TH\_02\_15</u># Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which ye have been taught, whether by word, or our epistle.

epistle <u>44\_ACT\_15\_30</u> # So when they were dismissed, they came to Antioch: and when they had gathered the multitude together, they delivered the epistle:

epistles of commendation <u>47\_2CO\_03\_01</u> # Do we begin again to commend ourselves? or need we, as some [others], epistles of commendation to you, or [letters] of commendation from you?

epistles speaking in <u>61\_2PE\_03\_16</u># As also in all [his] epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be understood, which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest, as [they do] also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction.
