evidence and sealed <u>24_JER_32_10</u># And I subscribed the evidence, and sealed [it], and took witnesses, and weighed [him] the money in the balances.

evidence of the <u>24_JER_32_11</u># So I took the evidence of the purchase, [both] that which was sealed [according] to the law and custom, and that which was open:

evidence of the <u>24_JER_32_12</u> # And I gave the evidence of the purchase unto Baruch the son of Neriah, the son of Maaseiah, in the sight of Hanameel mine uncle's [son], and in the presence of the witnesses that subscribed the book of the purchase, before all the Jews that sat in the court of the prison.
