renewest the face [19 PSA 104 30](#) # Thou sendest forth thy spirit, they are created: and thou renewest the face of the earth.

renewest thy witnesses [18 JOB 10 17](#) # Thou renewest thy witnesses against me, and increasest thine indignation upon me; changes and war [are] against me.

sewed fig leaves [01 GEN 03 07](#) # And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they [were] naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.

sewed sackcloth upon [18 JOB 16 15](#) # I have sewed sackcloth upon my skin, and defiled my horn in the dust.
