expired at the 10\_2SA\_11\_01# And it came to pass, after the year was expired, at the time when kings go forth [to battle], that David sent Joab, and his servants with him, and all Israel; and they destroyed the children of Ammon, and besieged Rabbah. But David tarried still at Jerusalem.

expired it shall <u>26\_EZE\_43\_27</u># And when these days are expired, it shall be, [that] upon the eighth day, and [so] forward, the priests shall make your burnt offerings upon the altar, and your peace offerings; and I will accept you, saith the Lord GOD.

expired king Nebuchadnezzar <u>14\_2CH\_36\_10</u># And when the year was expired, king Nebuchadnezzar sent, and brought him to Babylon, with the goodly vessels of the house of the LORD, and made Zedekiah his brother king over Judah and Jerusalem.

expired Satan shall <u>66\_REV\_20\_07</u># And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison,
