Felix came with 44_ACT_24_24 # And after certain days, when Felix came with his wife Drusilla, which was a Jewess, he sent for Paul, and heard him concerning the faith in Christ.

Felix heard these <u>44_ACT_24_22</u># And when Felix heard these things, having more perfect knowledge of [that] way, he deferred them, and said, When Lysias the chief captain shall come down, I will know the uttermost of your matter.

Felix room and 44_ACT_24_27 # But after two years Porcius Festus came into Felix' room: and Felix, willing to show the Jews a pleasure, left Paul bound.

Felix sendeth greeting 44_ACT_23_26 # Claudius Lysias unto the most excellent governor Felix [sendeth] greeting.
