fain flee out <u>18\_JOB\_27\_22</u> # For [God] shall cast upon him, and not spare: he would fain flee out of his hand.

fain have filled <u>42\_LUK\_15\_16</u># And he would fain have filled his belly with the husks that the swine did eat: and no man gave unto him.

faint all the <u>25\_LAM\_01\_13</u># From above hath he sent fire into my bones, and it prevaileth against them: he hath spread a net for my feet, he hath turned me back: he hath made me desolate [and] faint all the day.

faint and all <u>26\_EZE\_21\_07</u># And it shall be, when they say unto thee, Wherefore sighest thou? that thou shalt answer, For the tidings; because it cometh: and every heart shall melt, and all hands shall be feeble, and every spirit shall faint, and all knees shall be weak [as] water: behold, it cometh, and shall be brought to pass, saith the Lord GOD.

faint and be 23\_ISA\_40\_30 # Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall:

faint and every <u>23\_ISA\_13\_07</u> # Therefore shall all hands be faint, and every man's heart shall melt:

faint and his 23\_ISA\_29\_08 # It shall even be as when an hungry [man] dreameth, and, behold, he eateth; but he awaketh, and his soul is empty: or as when a thirsty man dreameth, and, behold, he drinketh; but he awaketh, and, behold, [he is] faint, and his soul hath appetite: so shall the multitude of all the nations be, that fight against mount Zion.

faint and I <u>07\_JUD\_08\_05</u> # And he said unto the men of Succoth, Give, I pray you, loaves of bread unto the people that follow me; for they [be] faint, and I am pursuing after Zebah and Zalmunna, kings of Midian.

faint and their <u>26\_EZE\_21\_15</u> # I have set the point of the sword against all their gates, that [their] heart may faint, and [their] ruins be multiplied: ah! [it is] made bright, [it is] wrapped up for the slaughter.

faint and to <u>23\_ISA\_40\_29</u> # He giveth power to the faint; and to [them that have] no might he increaseth strength.

faint and weary <u>05\_DEU\_25\_18</u> # How he met thee by the way, and smote the hindmost of thee, [even] all [that were] feeble behind thee, when thou [wast] faint and weary; and he feared not God.

faint and ye <u>24\_JER\_51\_46</u># And lest your heart faint, and ye fear for the rumour that shall be heard in the land; a rumour shall both come [one] year, and after that in [another] year [shall come] a rumour, and violence in the land, ruler against ruler.

faint as well <u>05\_DEU\_20\_08</u># And the officers shall speak further unto the people, and they shall say, What man [is there that is] fearful and fainthearted? let him go and return unto his house, lest his brethren's heart faint as well as his heart.

faint because of <u>06\_JOS\_02\_09</u># And she said unto the men, I know that the LORD hath given you the land, and that your terror is fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you.

faint because of <u>06\_JOS\_02\_24</u># And they said unto Joshua, Truly the LORD hath delivered into our

hands all the land; for even all the inhabitants of the country do faint because of us.

faint by the <u>41\_MAR\_08\_03</u> # And if I send them away fasting to their own houses, they will faint by the way: for divers of them came from far.

faint fear not <u>05\_DEU\_20\_03</u> # And shall say unto them, Hear, O Israel, ye approach this day unto battle against your enemies: let not your hearts faint, fear not, and do not tremble, neither be ye terrified because of them;

faint for hunger 25\_LAM\_02\_19 # Arise, cry out in the night: in the beginning of the watches pour out thine heart like water before the face of the Lord: lift up thy hands toward him for the life of thy young children, that faint for hunger in the top of every street.

faint for these <u>25\_LAM\_05\_17</u># For this our heart is faint; for these [things] our eyes are dim.

faint for thirst <u>30\_AMO\_08\_13</u> # In that day shall the fair virgins and young men faint for thirst.

faint in me 24\_JER\_08\_18 # [When] I would comfort myself against sorrow, my heart [is] faint in me.

faint in the <u>10\_2SA\_16\_02</u> # And the king said unto Ziba, What meanest thou by these? And Ziba said, The asses [be] for the king's household to ride on; and the bread and summer fruit for the young men to eat; and the wine, that such as be faint in the wilderness may drink.

faint in the <u>40\_MAT\_15\_32</u># Then Jesus called his disciples [unto him], and said, I have compassion on the multitude, because they continue with me now three days, and have nothing to eat: and I will not send them away fasting, lest they faint in the way.

faint in the <u>20\_PRO\_24\_10</u> # [If] thou faint in the day of adversity, thy strength [is] small.

faint in your <u>58\_HEB\_12\_03</u># For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.

faint not at <u>49\_EPH\_03\_13</u> # Wherefore I desire that ye faint not at my tribulations for you, which is your glory.

faint not but <u>47\_2CO\_04\_16</u> # For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward [man] is renewed day by day.

faint not <u>47\_2CO\_04\_01</u> # Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not;

faint not <u>48\_GAL\_06\_09</u> # And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

faint that they <u>09\_1SA\_30\_10</u># But David pursued, he and four hundred men: for two hundred abode behind, which were so faint that they could not go over the brook Besor.

faint that they <u>09\_1SA\_30\_21</u> # And David came to the two hundred men, which were so faint that they could not follow David, whom they had made also to abide at the brook Besor: and they went forth to meet David, and to meet the people that [were] with him: and when David came near to the people, he saluted them.

faint therefore was <u>01\_GEN\_25\_30</u># And Esau said to Jacob, Feed me, I pray thee, with that same red [pottage]; for I [am] faint: therefore was his name called Edom.

faint when thou <u>58\_HEB\_12\_05</u> # And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto

children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him:

faint yet pursuing <u>07\_JUD\_08\_04</u> # And Gideon came to Jordan, [and] passed over, he, and the three hundred men that [were] with him, faint, yet pursuing [them].

faint <u>09\_1SA\_14\_28</u> # Then answered one of the people, and said, Thy father straitly charged the people with an oath, saying, Cursed [be] the man that eateth [any] food this day. And the people were faint.

faint <u>09\_18A\_14\_31</u># And they smote the Philistines that day from Michmash to Aijalon: and the people were very faint.

faint <u>10\_2SA\_21\_15</u> # Moreover the Philistines had yet war again with Israel; and David went down, and his servants with him, and fought against the Philistines: and David waxed faint.

faint <u>01\_GEN\_25\_29</u># And Jacob sod pottage: and Esau came from the field, and he [was] faint:

faint <u>23\_ISA\_01\_05</u># Why should ye be stricken any more? ye will revolt more and more: the whole head is sick, and the whole heart faint.

faint 23 ISA 40 31 # But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew [their] strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; [and] they shall walk, and not faint.

faint 23\_ISA\_44\_12 # The smith with the tongs both worketh in the coals, and fashioneth it with hammers, and worketh it with the strength of his arms: yea, he is hungry, and his strength faileth: he drinketh no water, and is faint.

faint <u>25\_LAM\_01\_22</u> # Let all their wickedness come before thee; and do unto them, as thou hast done unto me for all my transgressions: for my sighs [are] many, and my heart [is] faint.

faint <u>42\_LUK\_18\_01</u> # And he spake a parable unto them [to this end], that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;

fainted and was <u>27\_DAN\_08\_27</u> # And I Daniel fainted, and was sick [certain] days; afterward I rose up, and did the king's business; and I was astonished at the vision, but none understood [it].

fainted and were <u>40\_MAT\_09\_36</u># But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.

fainted and wished <u>32\_JON\_04\_08</u># And it came to pass, when the sun did arise, that God prepared a vehement east wind; and the sun beat upon the head of Jonah, that he fainted, and wished in himself to die, and said, [It is] better for me to die than to live.

fainted by reason <u>01\_GEN\_47\_13</u> # And [there was] no bread in all the land; for the famine [was] very sore, so that the land of Egypt and [all] the land of Canaan fainted by reason of the famine.

fainted for he <u>01\_GEN\_45\_26</u># And told him, saying, Joseph [is] yet alive, and he [is] governor over all the land of Egypt. And Jacob's heart fainted, for he believed them not.

fainted for him <u>26\_EZE\_31\_15</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; In the day when he went down to the grave I caused a mourning: I covered the deep for him, and I restrained the floods thereof, and the great waters were stayed: and I caused Lebanon to mourn for him, and all the trees of the field fainted for him.

fainted in my <u>24\_JER\_45\_03</u># Thou didst say, Woe is me now! for the LORD hath added grief to my sorrow; I fainted in my sighing, and I find no rest.

fainted in them <u>19\_PSA\_107\_05</u> # Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them.

fainted they lie <u>23\_ISA\_51\_20</u> # Thy sons have fainted, they lie at the head of all the streets, as a wild bull in a net: they are full of the fury of the LORD, the rebuke of thy God.

fainted unless I <u>19\_PSA\_27\_13</u># [I had fainted], unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.

fainted within me <u>32\_JON\_02\_07</u> # When my soul fainted within me I remembered the LORD: and my prayer came in unto thee, into thine holy temple.

fainted <u>66\_REV\_02\_03</u># And hast borne, and hast patience, and for my name's sake hast laboured, and hast not fainted.

faintest it toucheth <u>18\_JOB\_04\_05</u># But now it is come upon thee, and thou faintest; it toucheth thee, and thou art troubled.

fainteth for the <u>19\_PSA\_84\_02</u># My soul longeth, yea, even fainteth for the courts of the LORD: my heart and my flesh crieth out for the living God.

fainteth for thy <u>19\_PSA\_119\_81</u># CAPH. My soul fainteth for thy salvation: [but] I hope in thy word.

fainteth not neither 23\_ISA\_40\_28 # Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, [that] the everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? [there is] no searching of his understanding.

fainteth <u>23 ISA 10 18</u> # And shall consume the glory of his forest, and of his fruitful field, both soul and body: and they shall be as when a standardbearer fainteth.

fainthearted for the <u>23\_ISA\_07\_04</u># And say unto him, Take heed, and be quiet; fear not, neither be fainthearted for the two tails of these smoking firebrands, for the fierce anger of Rezin with Syria, and of the son of Remaliah.

fainthearted let him <u>05\_DEU\_20\_08</u># And the officers shall speak further unto the people, and they shall say, What man [is there that is] fearful and fainthearted? let him go and return unto his house, lest his brethren's heart faint as well as his heart.

fainthearted there is <u>24\_JER\_49\_23</u> # Concerning Damascus. Hamath is confounded, and Arpad: for they have heard evil tidings: they are fainthearted; [there is] sorrow on the sea; it cannot be quiet.

faintness into their <u>03\_LEV\_26\_36</u> # And upon them that are left [alive] of you I will send a faintness into their hearts in the lands of their enemies; and the sound of a shaken leaf shall chase them; and they shall flee, as fleeing from a sword; and they shall fall when none pursueth.
