fainted and was 27_DAN_08_27 # And I Daniel fainted, and was sick [certain] days; afterward I rose up, and did the king's business; and I was astonished at the vision, but none understood [it].

fainted and were 40_MAT_09_36# But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.

fainted and wished <u>32_JON_04_08</u># And it came to pass, when the sun did arise, that God prepared a vehement east wind; and the sun beat upon the head of Jonah, that he fainted, and wished in himself to die, and said, [It is] better for me to die than to live.

fainted by reason <u>01_GEN_47_13</u># And [there was] no bread in all the land; for the famine [was] very sore, so that the land of Egypt and [all] the land of Canaan fainted by reason of the famine.

fainted for he <u>01_GEN_45_26</u># And told him, saying, Joseph [is] yet alive, and he [is] governor over all the land of Egypt. And Jacob's heart fainted, for he believed them not.

fainted for him <u>26_EZE_31_15</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; In the day when he went down to the grave I caused a mourning: I covered the deep for him, and I restrained the floods thereof, and the great waters were stayed: and I caused Lebanon to mourn for him, and all the trees of the field fainted for him.

fainted in my 24_JER_45_03 # Thou didst say, Woe is me now! for the LORD hath added grief to my sorrow; I fainted in my sighing, and I find no rest.

fainted in them 19_PSA_107_05 # Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them.

fainted they lie 23_ISA_51_20 # Thy sons have fainted, they lie at the head of all the streets, as a wild bull in a net: they are full of the fury of the LORD, the rebuke of thy God.

fainted unless I 19_PSA_27_13 # [I had fainted], unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.

fainted within me 32_JON_02_07 # When my soul fainted within me I remembered the LORD: and my prayer came in unto thee, into thine holy temple.

fainted <u>66_REV_02_03</u># And hast borne, and hast patience, and for my name's sake hast laboured, and hast not fainted.
