affairs and how 49\_EPH\_06\_21 # But that ye also may know my affairs, [and] how I do, Tychicus, a beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, shall make known to you all things:

affairs and that 49\_EPH\_06\_22 # Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that ye might know our affairs, and [that] he might comfort your hearts.

affairs of the 13\_1CH\_26\_32 # And his brethren, men of valour, [were] two thousand and seven hundred chief fathers, whom king David made rulers over the Reubenites, the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, for every matter pertaining to God, and affairs of the king.

affairs of the <u>27\_DAN\_02\_49</u># Then Daniel requested of the king, and he set Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, over the affairs of the province of Babylon: but Daniel [sat] in the gate of the king.

fair speeches deceive <u>45\_ROM\_16\_18</u># For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple.

fair to look <u>01\_GEN\_26\_07</u># And the men of the place asked [him] of his wife; and he said, She [is] my sister: for he feared to say, [She is] my wife; lest, [said he], the men of the place should kill me for Rebekah; because she [was] fair to look upon.

fair virgins and 30\_AMO\_08\_13 # In that day shall the fair virgins and young men faint for thirst.

Fair weather cometh 18\_JOB\_37\_22 # Fair weather cometh out of the north: with God [is] terrible majesty.

fair weather for 40\_MAT\_16\_02 # He answered and said unto them, When it is evening, ye say, [It will be] fair weather: for the sky is red.

fair without inhabitant 23\_ISA\_05\_09 # In mine ears [said] the LORD of hosts, Of a truth many houses shall be desolate, [even] great and fair, without inhabitant.

fair woman to <u>01\_GEN\_12\_11</u># And it came to pass, when he was come near to enter into Egypt, that he said unto Sarai his wife, Behold now, I know that thou [art] a fair woman to look upon:

fair woman which 20 PRO 11 22 # [As] a jewel of gold in a swine's snout, [so is] a fair woman which is without discretion.

fair words unto 24\_JER\_12\_06 # For even thy brethren, and the house of thy father, even they have dealt treacherously with thee; yea, they have called a multitude after thee: believe them not, though they speak fair words unto thee.

fairest among women <u>22\_SON\_06\_01</u> # Whither is thy beloved gone, O thou fairest among women? whither is thy beloved turned aside? that we may seek him with thee.

fairs bright iron <u>26\_EZE\_27\_19</u> # Dan also and Javan going to and fro occupied in thy fairs: bright iron, cassia, and calamus, were in thy market.

fairs thy merchandise 26\_EZE\_27\_27 # Thy riches, and thy fairs, thy merchandise, thy mariners, and thy

pilots, thy calkers, and the occupiers of thy merchandise, and all thy men of war, that [are] in thee, and in all thy company which [is] in the midst of thee, shall fall into the midst of the seas in the day of thy ruin.

fairs with chief <u>26\_EZE\_27\_22</u> # The merchants of Sheba and Raamah, they [were] thy merchants: they occupied in thy fairs with chief of all spices, and with all precious stones, and gold.

fairs with emeralds <u>26\_EZE\_27\_16</u># Syria [was] thy merchant by reason of the multitude of the wares of thy making: they occupied in thy fairs with emeralds, purple, and broidered work, and fine linen, and coral, and agate.

fairs with horses <u>26\_EZE\_27\_14</u> # They of the house of Togarmah traded in thy fairs with horses and horsemen and mules.

fairs <u>26\_EZE\_27\_12</u> # Tarshish [was] thy merchant by reason of the multitude of all [kind of] riches; with silver, iron, tin, and lead, they traded in thy fairs.
