famous according as [19_PSA_74_05](#) # [A man] was famous according as he had lifted up axes upon the thick trees.

famous among women [26_EZE_23_10](#) # These discovered her nakedness: they took her sons and her daughters, and slew her with the sword: and she became famous among women; for they had executed judgment upon her.

famous in Bethlehem [08_RUT_04_11](#) # And all the people that [were] in the gate, and the elders, said, [We are] witnesses. The LORD make the woman that is come into thine house like Rachel and like Leah, which two did build the house of Israel: and do thou worthily in Ephratah, and be famous in Bethlehem:

famous in Israel [08_RUT_04_14](#) # And the women said unto Naomi, Blessed [be] the LORD, which hath not left thee this day without a kinsman, that his name may be famous in Israel.
