afar and thy 24\_JER\_30\_10 # Therefore fear thou not, O my servant Jacob, saith the LORD; neither be dismayed, O Israel: for, lo, I will save thee from afar, and thy seed from the land of their captivity; and Jacob shall return, and shall be in rest, and be quiet, and none shall make [him] afraid.

afar and will <u>18\_JOB\_36\_03</u># I will fetch my knowledge from afar, and will ascribe righteousness to my Maker.

afar off a <u>09\_1SA\_26\_13</u># Then David went over to the other side, and stood on the top of an hill afar off; a great space [being] between them:

afar off among 41\_MAR\_15\_40 # There were also women looking on afar off: among whom was Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James the less and of Joses, and Salome;

afar off and 12 2KI 02 07 # And fifty men of the sons of the prophets went, and stood to view afar off: and they two stood by Jordan.

afar off and 61\_2PE\_01\_09 # But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

afar off and 49\_EPH\_02\_17 # And came and preached peace to you which were afar off, and to them that were nigh.

afar off and <u>02\_EXO\_20\_21</u># And the people stood afar off, and Moses drew near unto the thick darkness where God [was].

afar off and <u>58\_HEB\_11\_13</u># These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of [them], and embraced [them], and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.

afar off and 24\_JER\_31\_10 # Hear the word of the LORD, O ye nations, and declare [it] in the isles afar off, and say, He that scattered Israel will gather him, and keep him, as a shepherd [doth] his flock.

afar off and 24\_JER\_46\_27# But fear not thou, O my servant Jacob, and be not dismayed, O Israel: for, behold, I will save thee from afar off, and thy seed from the land of their captivity; and Jacob shall return, and be in rest and at ease, and none shall make [him] afraid.

afar off and 24\_JER\_51\_50 # Ye that have escaped the sword, go away, stand not still: remember the LORD afar off, and let Jerusalem come into your mind.

afar off even 41\_MAR\_14\_54 # And Peter followed him afar off, even into the palace of the high priest: and he sat with the servants, and warmed himself at the fire.

afar off for 23 ISA 59 14 # And judgment is turned away backward, and justice standeth afar off: for truth is fallen in the street, and equity cannot enter.

afar off for <u>66\_REV\_18\_10</u># Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas that great city Babylon, that mighty city! for in one hour is thy judgment come.

afar off for 66\_REV\_18\_15 # The merchants of these things, which were made rich by her, shall stand afar off for the fear of her torment, weeping and wailing,

afar off upon 19\_PSA\_65\_05 # [By] terrible things in righteousness wilt thou answer us, O God of our salvation; [who art] the confidence of all the ends of the earth, and of them that are afar off [upon] the sea:

afar off which <u>40\_MAT\_27\_55</u># And many women were there beholding afar off, which followed Jesus from Galilee, ministering unto him:

afar off would <u>42\_LUK\_18\_13</u># And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as [his] eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner.

afar off yet <u>04\_NUM\_09\_10</u># Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, If any man of you or of your posterity shall be unclean by reason of a dead body, or [be] in a journey afar off, yet he shall keep the passover unto the LORD.

afar off <u>02\_EXO\_20\_18</u> # And all the people saw the thunderings, and the lightnings, and the noise of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking: and when the people saw [it], they removed, and stood afar off.

afar 20\_PRO\_31\_14 # She is like the merchants' ships; she bringeth her food from afar.

Far above all <u>49\_EPH\_01\_21</u># Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

far above all <u>49\_EPH\_04\_10</u> # He that descended is the same also that ascended up far above all heavens, that he might fill all things.]

far above all <u>19\_PSA\_97\_09</u># For thou, LORD, [art] high above all the earth: thou art exalted far above all gods.

far above out <u>19\_PSA\_10\_05</u># His ways are always grievous; thy judgments [are] far above out of his sight: [as for] all his enemies, he puffeth at them.

far above rubies 20\_PRO\_31\_10 # Who can find a virtuous woman? for her price [is] far above rubies.

far abroad for <u>14\_2CH\_26\_15</u> # And he made in Jerusalem engines, invented by cunning men, to be on the towers and upon the bulwarks, to shoot arrows and great stones withal. And his name spread far abroad; for he was marvellously helped, till he was strong.

far and delivered <u>07\_JUD\_09\_17</u># [For my father fought for you, and adventured his life far, and delivered you out of the hand of Midian:

far And he <u>42\_LUK\_22\_51</u># And Jesus answered and said, Suffer ye thus far. And he touched his ear, and healed him.

far and lo <u>23\_ISA\_49\_12</u> # Behold, these shall come from far: and, lo, these from the north and from the west; and these from the land of Sinim.

far and my <u>23\_ISA\_43\_06</u># I will say to the north, Give up; and to the south, Keep not back: bring my sons from far, and my daughters from the ends of the earth;

far and near <u>24\_JER\_25\_26</u># And all the kings of the north, far and near, one with another, and all the kingdoms of the world, which [are] upon the face of the earth: and the king of Sheshach shall drink after them.

far and thy <u>23\_ISA\_60\_04</u> # Lift up thine eyes round about, and see: all they gather themselves together, they come to thee: thy sons shall come from far, and thy daughters shall be nursed at [thy] side.

far and will <u>23\_ISA\_05\_26</u> # And he will lift up an ensign to the nations from far, and will hiss unto them from the end of the earth: and, behold, they shall come with speed swiftly:

far as light 21\_ECC\_02\_13 # Then I saw that wisdom excelleth folly, as far as light excelleth darkness.

far as Phenice <u>44\_ACT\_11\_19</u># Now they which were scattered abroad upon the persecution that arose about Stephen travelled as far as Phenice, and Cyprus, and Antioch, preaching the word to none but unto the Jews only.

far as the <u>19\_PSA\_103\_12</u># As far as the east is from the west, [so] far hath he removed our transgressions from us.

far as to <u>47\_2CO\_10\_14</u> # For we stretch not ourselves beyond [our measure], as though we reached not unto you: for we are come as far as to you also in [preaching] the gospel of Christ:

far as to <u>42\_LUK\_24\_50</u># And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he lifted up his hands, and blessed them.

far away and 23\_ISA\_06\_12 # And the LORD have removed men far away, and [there be] a great forsaking in the midst of the land.

far country for 42\_LUK\_20\_09 # Then began he to speak to the people this parable; A certain man planted a vineyard, and let it forth to husbandmen, and went into a far country for a long time.

far country from <u>23\_ISA\_13\_05</u># They come from a far country, from the end of heaven, [even] the LORD, and the weapons of his indignation, to destroy the whole land.

far country Is 24 JER 08 19 # Behold the voice of the cry of the daughter of my people because of them that dwell in a far country: [Is] not the LORD in Zion? [is] not her king in her? Why have they provoked me to anger with their graven images, [and] with strange vanities?

far country yea 23\_ISA\_46\_11 # Calling a ravenous bird from the east, the man that executeth my counsel from a far country: yea, I have spoken [it], I will also bring it to pass; I have purposed [it], I will also do it.

far country your <u>24\_JER\_06\_20</u> # To what purpose cometh there to me incense from Sheba, and the sweet cane from a far country? your burnt offerings [are] not acceptable, nor your sacrifices sweet unto me.

far from helping 19\_PSA\_22\_01 # To the chief Musician upon Aijeleth Shahar, A Psalm of David. My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? [why art thou so] far from helping me, [and from] the words of my roaring?

far from her 20\_PRO\_05\_08 # Remove thy way far from her, and come not nigh the door of her house:

far from him 20\_PRO\_19\_07 # All the brethren of the poor do hate him: how much more do his friends go far from him? he pursueth [them with] words, [yet] they [are] wanting [to him].

far from him <u>20\_PRO\_22\_15</u># Foolishness [is] bound in the heart of a child; [but] the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.

far from him 19 PSA 109 17 # As he loved cursing, so let it come unto him: as he delighted not in blessing, so let it be far from him.

far from land <u>43\_JOH\_21\_08</u># And the other disciples came in a little ship; [for they were not far from land, but as it were two hundred cubits,] dragging the net with fishes.

far from me <u>09\_1SA\_02\_30</u> # Wherefore the LORD God of Israel saith, I said indeed [that] thy house, and the house of thy father, should walk before me for ever: but now the LORD saith, Be it far from me; for them that honour me I will honour, and they that despise me shall be lightly esteemed.

far from me <u>09\_1SA\_22\_15</u># Did I then begin to inquire of God for him? be it far from me: let not the king impute [any] thing unto his servant, [nor] to all the house of my father: for thy servant knew nothing of all this, less or more.

far from me <u>25\_LAM\_01\_16</u># For these [things] I weep; mine eye, mine eye runneth down with water, because the comforter that should relieve my soul is far from me: my children are desolate, because the enemy prevailed.

far from me <u>41\_MAR\_07\_06</u># He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with [their] lips, but their heart is far from me.

far from me <u>40\_MAT\_15\_08</u># This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with [their] lips; but their heart is far from me.

far from me <u>20\_PRO\_30\_08</u> # Remove far from me vanity and lies: give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with food convenient for me:

far from me 19\_PSA\_22\_11 # Be not far from me; for trouble [is] near; for [there is] none to help.

far from me 19\_PSA\_22\_19 # But be not thou far from me, O LORD: O my strength, haste thee to help me.

far from me 19\_PSA\_27\_09 # Hide not thy face [far] from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.

far from me 19 PSA 35 22 # [This] thou hast seen, O LORD: keep not silence: O LORD, be not far from me.

far from me 19 PSA 38 21 # Forsake me not, O LORD: O my God, be not far from me.

far from me 19\_PSA\_71\_12 # O God, be not far from me: O my God, make haste for my help.

far from me 19 PSA 88 08 # Thou hast put away mine acquaintance far from me; thou hast made me an abomination unto them: [I am] shut up, and I cannot come forth.

far from me 19\_PSA\_88\_18 # Lover and friend hast thou put far from me, [and] mine acquaintance into darkness.

far from oppression <u>23\_ISA\_54\_14</u> # In righteousness shalt thou be established: thou shalt be far from oppression; for thou shalt not fear: and from terror; for it shall not come near thee.

far from righteousness <u>23\_ISA\_46\_12</u># Hearken unto me, ye stouthearted, that [are] far from righteousness:

far from safety <u>18\_JOB\_05\_04</u> # His children are far from safety, and they are crushed in the gate, neither [is there] any to deliver [them].

far from the <u>05\_DEU\_28\_49</u> # The LORD shall bring a nation against thee from far, from the end of the earth, [as swift] as the eagle flieth; a nation whose tongue thou shalt not understand;

far from the <u>26\_EZE\_11\_15</u># Son of man, thy brethren, [even] thy brethren, the men of thy kindred, and all the house of Israel wholly, [are] they unto whom the inhabitants of Jerusalem have said, Get you far from the LORD: unto us is this land given in possession.

far from the <u>06\_JOS\_03\_16</u># That the waters which came down from above stood [and] rose up upon an heap very far from the city Adam, that [is] beside Zaretan: and those that came down toward the sea of the plain, [even] the salt sea, failed, [and] were cut off: and the people passed over right against Jericho.

far from the <u>06\_JOS\_08\_04</u> # And he commanded them, saying, Behold, ye shall lie in wait against the city, [even] behind the city: go not very far from the city, but be ye all ready:

far from the 19\_PSA\_119\_155 # Salvation [is] far from the wicked: for they seek not thy statutes.

far from thee <u>05\_DEU\_12\_21</u># If the place which the LORD thy God hath chosen to put his name there be too far from thee, then thou shalt kill of thy herd and of thy flock, which the LORD hath given thee, as I have commanded thee, and thou shalt eat in thy gates whatsoever thy soul lusteth after.

farewell which are <u>42\_LUK\_09\_61</u> # And another also said, Lord, I will follow thee; but let me first go bid them farewell, which are at home at my house.

Farewell <u>44\_ACT\_23\_30</u> # And when it was told me how that the Jews laid wait for the man, I sent straightway to thee, and gave commandment to his accusers also to say before thee what [they had] against him. Farewell.

farm another to 40 MAT\_22\_05# But they made light of [it], and went their ways, one to his farm, another to his merchandise:

warfare any time 46\_1CO\_09\_07 # Who goeth a warfare any time at his own charges? who planteth a

vineyard, and eateth not of the fruit thereof? or who feedeth a flock, and eateth not of the milk of the flock?

warfare are not <u>47\_2CO\_10\_04</u> # [For the weapons of our warfare [are] not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;]

warfare is accomplished <u>23\_ISA\_40\_02</u># Speak ye comfortably to Jerusalem, and cry unto her, that her warfare is accomplished, that her iniquity is pardoned: for she hath received of the LORD's hand double for all her sins.

warfare to fight <u>09\_1SA\_28\_01</u># And it came to pass in those days, that the Philistines gathered their armies together for warfare, to fight with Israel. And Achish said unto David, Know thou assuredly, that thou shalt go out with me to battle, thou and thy men.

warfare <u>54\_1TI\_01\_18</u> # This charge I commit unto thee, son Timothy, according to the prophecies which went before on thee, that thou by them mightest war a good warfare;

wayfaring man ceaseth <u>23\_ISA\_33\_08</u># The highways lie waste, the wayfaring man ceaseth: he hath broken the covenant, he hath despised the cities, he regardeth no man.

wayfaring man in <u>07\_JUD\_19\_17</u> # And when he had lifted up his eyes, he saw a wayfaring man in the street of the city: and the old man said, Whither goest thou? and whence comest thou?

wayfaring man that <u>10\_2SA\_12\_04</u># And there came a traveller unto the rich man, and he spared to take of his own flock and of his own herd, to dress for the wayfaring man that was come unto him; but took the poor man's lamb, and dressed it for the man that was come to him.

wayfaring man that <u>24\_JER\_14\_08</u># O the hope of Israel, the saviour thereof in time of trouble, why shouldest thou be as a stranger in the land, and as a wayfaring man [that] turneth aside to tarry for a night?

wayfaring men that <u>24\_JER\_09\_02</u> # Oh that I had in the wilderness a lodging place of wayfaring men; that I might leave my people, and go from them! for they [be] all adulterers, an assembly of treacherous men.

wayfaring men though <u>23\_ISA\_35\_08</u># And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it [shall be] for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err [therein].

welfare and said <u>01\_GEN\_43\_27</u># And he asked them of [their] welfare, and said, [Is] your father well, the old man of whom ye spake? [Is] he yet alive?

welfare and they <u>02\_EXO\_18\_07</u> # And Moses went out to meet his father in law, and did obeisance, and kissed him; and they asked each other of [their] welfare; and they came into the tent.

welfare let it 19\_PSA\_69\_22 # Let their table become a snare before them: and [that which should have been] for [their] welfare, [let it become] a trap.

welfare of the <u>16\_NEH\_02\_10</u># When Sanballat the Horonite, and Tobiah the servant, the Ammonite, heard [of it], it grieved them exceedingly that there was come a man to seek the welfare of the children of Israel.

welfare of this <u>24\_JER\_38\_04</u># Therefore the princes said unto the king, We beseech thee, let this man be put to death: for thus he weakeneth the hands of the men of war that remain in this city, and the hands of all the people, in speaking such words unto them: for this man seeketh not the welfare of this people, but the hurt.

welfare passeth away <u>18\_JOB\_30\_15</u> # Terrors are turned upon me: they pursue my soul as the wind: and my welfare passeth away as a cloud.
