fasten him as [23 ISA 22 23](#) # And I will fasten him [as] a nail in a sure place; and he shall be for a glorious throne to his father's house.

fasten in the [02 EXO 28 25](#) # And [the other] two ends of the two wreathen [chains] thou shalt fasten in the two ouches, and put [them] on the shoulder pieces of the ephod before it.

fasten it on [02 EXO 39 31](#) # And they tied unto it a lace of blue, to fasten [it] on high upon the mitre; as the LORD commanded Moses.

fasten it with [24 JER 10 04](#) # They deck it with silver and with gold; they fasten it with nails and with hammers, that it move not.

fasten the wreathen [02 EXO 28 14](#) # And two chains [of] pure gold at the ends; [of] wreathen work shalt thou make them, and fasten the wreathen chains to the ouches.

fastened by the [21 ECC 12 11](#) # The words of the wise [are] as goads, and as nails fastened [by] the masters of assemblies, [which] are given from one shepherd.

fastened his body [09 ISA 31 10](#) # And they put his armour in the house of Ashtaroth: and they fastened his body to the wall of Bethshan.

fastened his head [13 1CH 10 10](#) # And they put his armour in the house of their gods, and fastened his head in the temple of Dagon.

fastened his sockets [02 EXO 40 18](#) # And Moses reared up the tabernacle, and fastened his sockets, and set up the boards thereof, and put in the bars thereof, and reared up his pillars.

fastened in the [11 1KI 06 06](#) # The nethermost chamber [was] five cubits broad, and the middle [was] six cubits broad, and the third [was] seven cubits broad: for without [in the wall] of the house he made narrowed rests round about, that [the beams] should not be fastened in the walls of the house.

fastened in the [02 EXO 39 18](#) # And the two ends of the two wreathen chains they fastened in the two ouches, and put them on the shoulderpieces of the ephod, before it.

fastened in the [23 ISA 22 25](#) # In that day, saith the LORD of hosts, shall the nail that is fastened in the sure place be removed, and be cut down, and fall; and the burden that [was] upon it shall be cut off: for the LORD hath spoken [it].

fastened it into [07 JUD 04 21](#) # Then Jael Heber's wife took a nail of the tent, and took an hammer in her hand, and went softly unto him, and smote the nail into his temples, and fastened it into the ground: for he was fast asleep and weary. So he died.

fastened it with [23 ISA 41 07](#) # So the carpenter encouraged the goldsmith, [and] he that smootheth [with] the hammer him that smote the anvil, saying, It [is] ready for the soldering: and he fastened it with nails, [that] it should not be moved.

fastened it with [07 JUD 16 14](#) # And she fastened [it] with the pin, and said unto him, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And he awaked out of his sleep, and went away with the pin of the beam, and with the web.

fastened mine eyes [44 ACT 11 06](#) # Upon the which when I had fastened mine eyes, I considered, and saw fourfooted beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping things, and fowls of the air.

fastened on him [42 LUK 04 20](#) # And he closed the book, and he gave [it] again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on him.

fastened on his [44 ACT 28 03](#) # And when Paul had gathered a bundle of sticks, and laid [them] on the fire, there came a viper out of the heat, and fastened on his hand.

fastened or who [18 JOB 38 06](#) # Whereupon are the foundations thereof fastened? or who laid the corner stone thereof;

fastened round about [26 EZE 40 43](#) # And within [were] hooks, an hand broad, fastened round about: and upon the tables [was] the flesh of the offering.

fastened to the [14 2CH 09 18](#) # And [there were] six steps to the throne, with a footstool of gold, [which were] fastened to the throne, and stays on each side of the sitting place, and two lions standing by the stays:

fastened upon his [10 2SA 20 08](#) # When they [were] at the great stone which [is] in Gibeon, Amasa went before them. And Joab's garment that he had put on was girded unto him, and upon it a girdle [with] a sword fastened upon his loins in the sheath thereof; and as he went forth it fell out.

fastened with cords [17 EST 01 06](#) # [Where were] white, green, and blue, [hangings], fastened with cords of fine linen and purple to silver rings and pillars of marble: the beds [were of] gold and silver, upon a pavement of red, and blue, and white, and black, marble.

fastening his eyes [44 ACT 03 04](#) # And Peter, fastening his eyes upon him with John, said, Look on us.
