chafed in their <u>10\_2SA\_17\_08</u># For, said Hushai, thou knowest thy father and his men, that they [be] mighty men, and they [be] chafed in their minds, as a bear robbed of her whelps in the field: and thy father [is] a man of war, and will not lodge with the people.

confederacy have brought <u>31\_OBA\_01\_07</u> # All the men of thy confederacy have brought thee [even] to the border: the men that were at peace with thee have deceived thee, [and] prevailed against thee; [they that eat] thy bread have laid a wound under thee: [there is] none understanding in him.

confederacy neither fear <u>23\_ISA\_08\_12</u> # Say ye not, A confederacy, to all [them to] whom this people shall say, A confederacy; neither fear ye their fear, nor be afraid.

confederacy to all <u>23\_ISA\_08\_12</u> # Say ye not, A confederacy, to all [them to] whom this people shall say, A confederacy; neither fear ye their fear, nor be afraid.

confederate against thee <u>19\_PSA\_83\_05</u># For they have consulted together with one consent: they are confederate against thee:

confederate with Abram <u>01\_GEN\_14\_13</u># And there came one that had escaped, and told Abram the Hebrew; for he dwelt in the plain of Mamre the Amorite, brother of Eshcol, and brother of Aner: and these [were] confederate with Abram.

confederate with Ephraim 23\_ISA\_07\_02 # And it was told the house of David, saying, Syria is confederate with Ephraim. And his heart was moved, and the heart of his people, as the trees of the wood are moved with the wind.

fed beasts and <u>23\_ISA\_01\_11</u># To what purpose [is] the multitude of your sacrifices unto me? saith the LORD: I am full of the burnt offerings of rams, and the fat of fed beasts; and I delight not in the blood of bullocks, or of lambs, or of he goats.

fed but ye <u>26\_EZE\_34\_03</u> # Ye eat the fat, and ye clothe you with the wool, ye kill them that are fed: [but] ye feed not the flock.

fed him with <u>27\_DAN\_05\_21</u> # And he was driven from the sons of men; and his heart was made like the beasts, and his dwelling [was] with the wild asses: they fed him with grass like oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven; till he knew that the most high God ruled in the kingdom of men, and [that] he appointeth over it whomsoever he will.

fed horses in <u>24\_JER\_05\_08</u># They were [as] fed horses in the morning: every one neighed after his neighbour's wife.

fed in a <u>01\_GEN\_41\_02</u># And, behold, there came up out of the river seven well favoured kine and fatfleshed; and they fed in a meadow.

fed in a <u>01\_GEN\_41\_18</u># And, behold, there came up out of the river seven kine, fatfleshed and well favoured; and they fed in a meadow:

fed in Sharon <u>13\_1CH\_27\_29</u> # And over the herds that fed in Sharon [was] Shitrai the Sharonite: and over the herds [that were] in the valleys [was] Shaphat the son of Adlai:

fed me all <u>01\_GEN\_48\_15</u> # And he blessed Joseph, and said, God, before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac did walk, the God which fed me all my life long unto this day,

fed not my <u>26\_EZE\_34\_08</u> # [As] I live, saith the Lord GOD, surely because my flock became a prey, and my flock became meat to every beast of the field, because [there was] no shepherd, neither did my shepherds search for my flock, but the shepherds fed themselves, and fed not my flock;

fed of it <u>27\_DAN\_04\_12</u> # The leaves thereof [were] fair, and the fruit thereof much, and in it [was] meat for all: the beasts of the field had shadow under it, and the fowls of the heaven dwelt in the boughs thereof, and all flesh was fed of it.

fed the asses <u>01\_GEN\_36\_24</u> # And these [are] the children of Zibeon; both Ajah, and Anah: this [was that] Anah that found the mules in the wilderness, as he fed the asses of Zibeon his father.

fed the flock <u>38\_ZEC\_11\_07</u># And I will feed the flock of slaughter, [even] you, O poor of the flock. And I took unto me two staves; the one I called Beauty, and the other I called Bands; and I fed the flock.

fed the rest <u>01\_GEN\_30\_36</u># And he set three days' journey betwixt himself and Jacob: and Jacob fed the rest of Laban's flocks.

fed the swine <u>41\_MAR\_05\_14</u> # And they that fed the swine fled, and told [it] in the city, and in the country. And they went out to see what it was that was done.

fed thee in <u>05\_DEU\_08\_16</u> # Who fed thee in the wilderness with manna, which thy fathers knew not, that he might humble thee, and that he might prove thee, to do thee good at thy latter end;

fed thee or <u>40\_MAT\_25\_37</u># Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungered, and fed [thee]? or thirsty, and gave [thee] drink?

fed thee thou <u>26\_EZE\_16\_19</u># My meat also which I gave thee, fine flour, and oil, and honey, [wherewith] I fed thee, thou hast even set it before them for a sweet savour: and [thus] it was, saith the Lord GOD.

fed thee with <u>05\_DEU\_08\_03</u> # And he humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that he might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every [word] that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD doth man live.

fed them according <u>19\_PSA\_78\_72</u># So he fed them according to the integrity of his heart; and guided them by the skilfulness of his hands.

fed them also <u>19\_PSA\_81\_16</u># He should have fed them also with the finest of the wheat: and with honey out of the rock should I have satisfied thee.

fed them but <u>10\_2SA\_20\_03</u> # And David came to his house at Jerusalem; and the king took the ten women [his] concubines, whom he had left to keep the house, and put them in ward, and fed them, but went not in unto them. So they were shut up unto the day of their death, living in widowhood.

fed them saw <u>42\_LUK\_08\_34</u> # When they that fed [them] saw what was done, they fled, and went and told [it] in the city and in the country.

fed them to <u>24\_JER\_05\_07</u> # How shall I pardon thee for this? thy children have forsaken me, and sworn by [them that are] no gods: when I had fed them to the full, they then committed adultery, and assembled themselves by troops in the harlots' houses.

fed them with <u>11\_1KI\_18\_04</u># For it was [so], when Jezebel cut off the prophets of the LORD, that Obadiah took an hundred prophets, and hid them by fifty in a cave, and fed them with bread and water.]

fed them with <u>11\_1KI\_18\_13</u># Was it not told my lord what I did when Jezebel slew the prophets of the LORD, how I hid an hundred men of the LORD's prophets by fifty in a cave, and fed them with bread and water?

fed them with <u>01\_GEN\_47\_17</u># And they brought their cattle unto Joseph: and Joseph gave them bread [in exchange] for horses, and for the flocks, and for the cattle of the herds, and for the asses: and he fed them with bread for all their cattle for that year.

fed with the <u>42\_LUK\_16\_21</u> # And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table: moreover the dogs came and licked his sores.

fed you in <u>02\_EXO\_16\_32</u> # And Moses said, This [is] the thing which the LORD commandeth, Fill an omer of it to be kept for your generations; that they may see the bread wherewith I have fed you in the wilderness, when I brought you forth from the land of Egypt.

fed you with <u>46\_1CO\_03\_02</u> # I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able [to bear it], neither yet now are ye able.

fed <u>19\_PSA\_37\_03</u># Trust in the LORD, and do good; [so] shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed.

puffed up and <u>46\_1CO\_05\_02</u> # And ye are puffed up, and have not rather mourned, that he that hath done this deed might be taken away from among you.

puffed up as <u>46\_1CO\_04\_18</u># Now some are puffed up, as though I would not come to you.

puffed up but <u>46\_1CO\_04\_19</u> # But I will come to you shortly, if the Lord will, and will know, not the speech of them which are puffed up, but the power.

puffed up by <u>51\_COL\_02\_18</u># Let no man beguile you of your reward in a voluntary humility and worshipping of angels, intruding into those things which he hath not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind,

puffed up for <u>46\_1CO\_04\_06</u> # And these things, brethren, I have in a figure transferred to myself and [to] Apollos for your sakes; that ye might learn in us not to think [of men] above that which is written, that no one of you be puffed up for one against another.

puffed up <u>46\_1CO\_13\_04</u># Charity suffereth long, [and] is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up,

snuffed at it <u>39\_MAL\_01\_13</u># Ye said also, Behold, what a weariness [is it]! and ye have snuffed at it, saith the LORD of hosts; and ye brought [that which was] torn, and the lame, and the sick; thus ye brought an offering: should I accept this of your hand? saith the LORD.

snuffed up the <u>24\_JER\_14\_06</u># And the wild asses did stand in the high places, they snuffed up the wind like dragons; their eyes did fail, because [there was] no grass.
