fetch a compass [10\\_2SA\\_05\\_23](#) # And when David inquired of the LORD, he said, Thou shalt not go up; [but] fetch a compass behind them, and come upon them over against the mulberry trees.

fetch a compass [04\\_NUM\\_34\\_05](#) # And the border shall fetch a compass from Azmon unto the river of Egypt, and the goings out of it shall be at the sea.

fetch a morsel [01\\_GEN\\_18\\_05](#) # And I will fetch a morsel of bread, and comfort ye your hearts; after that ye shall pass on: for therefore are ye come to your servant. And they said, So do, as thou hast said.

fetch about this [10\\_2SA\\_14\\_20](#) # To fetch about this form of speech hath thy servant Joab done this thing: and my lord [is] wise, according to the wisdom of an angel of God, to know all [things] that [are] in the earth.

fetch him And [12\\_2KI\\_06\\_13](#) # And he said, Go and spy where he [is], that I may send and fetch him. And it was told him, saying, Behold, [he is] in Dothan.

fetch him for [09\\_ISA\\_16\\_11](#) # And Samuel said unto Jesse, Are here all [thy] children? And he said, There remaineth yet the youngest, and, behold, he keepeth the sheep. And Samuel said unto Jesse, Send and fetch him: for we will not sit down till he come hither.

fetch him thence [05\\_DEU\\_19\\_12](#) # Then the elders of his city shall send and fetch him thence, and deliver him into the hand of the avenger of blood, that he may die.

fetch him unto [09\\_ISA\\_20\\_31](#) # For as long as the son of Jesse liveth upon the ground, thou shalt not be established, nor thy kingdom. Wherefore now send and fetch him unto me, for he shall surely die.

fetch his pledge [05\\_DEU\\_24\\_10](#) # When thou dost lend thy brother any thing, thou shalt not go into his house to fetch his pledge.

fetch home again [10\\_2SA\\_14\\_13](#) # And the woman said, Wherefore then hast thou thought such a thing against the people of God? for the king doth speak this thing as one which is faulty, in that the king doth not fetch home again his banished.

fetch it he [11\\_1KI\\_17\\_11](#) # And as she was going to fetch [it], he called to her, and said, Bring me, I pray thee, a morsel of bread in thine hand.

fetch it it [05\\_DEU\\_24\\_19](#) # When thou cuttest down thine harvest in thy field, and hast forgot a sheaf in the field, thou shalt not go again to fetch it: it shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow: that the LORD thy God may bless thee in all the work of thine hands.

fetch it up [09\\_ISA\\_06\\_21](#) # And they sent messengers to the inhabitants of Kirjathjearim, saying, The Philistines have brought again the ark of the LORD; come ye down, [and] fetch it up to you.

fetch it [09\\_ISA\\_26\\_22](#) # And David answered and said, Behold the king's spear! and let one of the young men come over and fetch it.

fetch it [02\\_EXO\\_02\\_05](#) # And the daughter of Pharaoh came down to wash [herself] at the river; and her maidens walked along by the river's side; and when she saw the ark among the flags, she sent her maid to

fetch Jephthah out [07\\_JUD\\_11\\_05](#) # And it was so, that when the children of Ammon made war against Israel, the elders of Gilead went to fetch Jephthah out of the land of Tob:

fetch me from [01\\_GEN\\_27\\_09](#) # Go now to the flock, and fetch me from thence two good kids of the goats; and I will make them savoury meat for thy father, such as he loveth:

Fetch me I [11\\_1KI\\_17\\_10](#) # So he arose and went to Zarephath. And when he came to the gate of the city, behold, the widow woman [was] there gathering of sticks: and he called to her, and said, Fetch me, I pray thee, a little water in a vessel, that I may drink.

fetch me them [01\\_GEN\\_27\\_13](#) # And his mother said unto him, Upon me [be] thy curse, my son: only obey my voice, and go fetch me [them].

fetch my knowledge [18\\_JOB\\_36\\_03](#) # I will fetch my knowledge from afar, and will ascribe righteousness to my Maker.

fetch olive branches [16\\_NEH\\_08\\_15](#) # And that they should publish and proclaim in all their cities, and in Jerusalem, saying, Go forth unto the mount, and fetch olive branches, and pine branches, and myrtle branches, and palm branches, and branches of thick trees, to make booths, as [it is] written.

Fetch quickly Micaiah [14\\_2CH\\_18\\_08](#) # And the king of Israel called for one [of his] officers, and said, Fetch quickly Micaiah the son of Imla.

fetch the ark [09\\_ISA\\_04\\_03](#) # And when the people were come into the camp, the elders of Israel said, Wherefore hath the LORD smitten us to day before the Philistines? Let us fetch the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of Shiloh unto us, that, when it cometh among us, it may save us out of the hand of our enemies.

fetch the roll [24\\_JER\\_36\\_21](#) # So the king sent Jehudi to fetch the roll: and he took it out of Elishama the scribe's chamber. And Jehudi read it in the ears of the king, and in the ears of all the princes which stood beside the king.

fetch thee from [01\\_GEN\\_27\\_45](#) # Until thy brother's anger turn away from thee, and he forget [that] which thou hast done to him: then I will send, and fetch thee from thence: why should I be deprived also of you both in one day?

fetch thee [05\\_DEU\\_30\\_04](#) # If [any] of thine be driven out unto the outmost [parts] of heaven, from thence will the LORD thy God gather thee, and from thence will he fetch thee:

fetch you water [04\\_NUM\\_20\\_10](#) # And Moses and Aaron gathered the congregation together before the rock, and he said unto them, Hear now, ye rebels; must we fetch you water out of this rock?

fetch your brother [01 GEN 42 16](#) # Send one of you, and let him fetch your brother, and ye shall be kept in prison, that your words may be proved, whether [there be any] truth in you: or else by the life of Pharaoh surely ye [are] spies.

fetch a calf [01 GEN 18 07](#) # And Abraham ran unto the herd, and fetched a calf tender and good, and gave [it] unto a young man; and he hastened to dress it.

fetch a compass [12 2KI 03 09](#) # So the king of Israel went, and the king of Judah, and the king of Edom: and they fetched a compass of seven days' journey: and there was no water for the host, and for the cattle that followed them.

fetch a compass [44 ACT 28 13](#) # And from thence we fetched a compass, and came to Rhegium: and after one day the south wind blew, and we came the next day to Puteoli:

fetch a compass [06 JOS 15 03](#) # And it went out to the south side to Maalehacrabbinim, and passed along to Zin, and ascended up on the south side unto Kadeshbarnea, and passed along to Hezron, and went up to Adar, and fetched a compass to Karkaa:

fetch and brought [01 GEN 27 14](#) # And he went, and fetched, and brought [them] to his mother: and his mother made savoury meat, such as his father loved.

fetch and wash [01 GEN 18 04](#) # Let a little water, I pray you, be fetched, and wash your feet, and rest yourselves under the tree:

fetch forth Urijah [24 JER 26 23](#) # And they fetched forth Urijah out of Egypt, and brought him unto Jehoiakim the king; who slew him with the sword, and cast his dead body into the graves of the common people.

fetch from thence [11 1KI 09 28](#) # And they came to Ophir, and fetched from thence gold, four hundred and twenty talents, and brought [it] to king Solomon.

fetch her to [10 2SA 11 27](#) # And when the mourning was past, David sent and fetched her to his house, and she became his wife, and bare him a son. But the thing that David had done displeased the LORD.

fetch him out [10 2SA 09 05](#) # Then king David sent, and fetched him out of the house of Machir, the son of Ammiel, from Lodebar.

fetch him thence [09 ISA 10 23](#) # And they ran and fetched him thence: and when he stood among the people, he was higher than any of the people from his shoulders and upward.

fetch Hiram out [11 1KI 07 13](#) # And king Solomon sent and fetched Hiram out of Tyre.

fetch the carved [07 JUD 18 18](#) # And these went into Micah's house, and fetched the carved image, the ephod, and the teraphim, and the molten image. Then said the priest unto them, What do ye?

fetch the rulers [12 2KI 11 04](#) # And the seventh year Jehoiada sent and fetched the rulers over hundreds, with the captains and the guard, and brought them to him into the house of the LORD, and made a covenant with them, and took an oath of them in the house of the LORD, and showed them the king's son.

fetch them and [14 2CH 12 11](#) # And when the king entered into the house of the LORD, the guard came and fetched them, and brought them again into the guard chamber.

fetch thence a [10 2SA 14 02](#) # And Joab sent to Tekoah, and fetched thence a wise woman, and said

unto her, I pray thee, feign thyself to be a mourner, and put on now mourning apparel, and anoint not thyself with oil, but be as a woman that had a long time mourned for the dead:

fetcheth up and [14 2CH 01 17](#) # And they fetched up, and brought forth out of Egypt a chariot for six hundred [shekels] of silver, and an horse for an hundred and fifty: and so brought they out [horses] for all the kings of the Hittites, and for the kings of Syria, by their means.

fetcheth up the [09 1SA 07 01](#) # And the men of Kirjathjearim came, and fetched up the ark of the LORD, and brought it into the house of Abinadab in the hill, and sanctified Eleazar his son to keep the ark of the LORD.

fetcheth wheat and [10 2SA 04 06](#) # And they came thither into the midst of the house, [as though] they would have fetched wheat; and they smote him under the fifth [rib]: and Rechab and Baanah his brother escaped.

fetcheth a stroke [05 DEU 19 05](#) # As when a man goeth into the wood with his neighbour to hew wood, and his hand fetcheth a stroke with the ax to cut down the tree, and the head slippeth from the helve, and lighteth upon his neighbour, that he die; he shall flee unto one of those cities, and live:
