flat and the 06\_JOS\_06\_05\_# And it shall come to pass, that when they make a long [blast] with the ram's horn, [and] when ye hear the sound of the trumpet, all the people shall shout with a great shout; and the wall of the city shall fall down flat, and the people shall ascend up every man straight before him.

flat nose or 03 LEV 21 18 # For whatsoever man [he be] that hath a blemish, he shall not approach: a blind man, or a lame, or he that hath a flat nose, or any thing superfluous,

flat on his 64 NUM 22 31 # Then the LORD opened the eyes of Balaam, and he saw the angel of the LORD standing in the way, and his sword drawn in his hand: and he bowed down his head, and fell flat on his face.

flat so that 96 JOS 06 20 # So the people shouted when [the priests] blew with the trumpets: and it came to pass, when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and the people shouted with a great shout, that the wall fell down flat, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they took the city.

flatter him with 19 PSA 78 36# Nevertheless they did flatter him with their mouth, and they lied unto him with their tongues.

flatter with their 19 PSA 05 09 # For [there is] no faithfulness in their mouth; their inward part [is] very wickedness; their throat [is] an open sepulchre; they flatter with their tongue.

flattereth himself in 19 PSA 36 02 # For he flattereth himself in his own eyes, until his iniquity be found to be hateful.

flattereth his neighbour 20 PRO 29 05 # A man that flattereth his neighbour spreadeth a net for his feet.

flattereth with her 20 PRO 02 16 # To deliver thee from the strange woman, [even] from the stranger [which] flattereth with her words;

flattereth with her 20 PRO 07 05 # That they may keep thee from the strange woman, from the stranger [which] flattereth with her words.

flattereth with his 20 PRO 20 19 # He that goeth about [as] a talebearer revealeth secrets: therefore meddle not with him that flattereth with his lips.

flattereth with the 20 PRO 28 23 # He that rebuketh a man afterwards shall find more favour than he that flattereth with the tongue.

flatteries but the 27 DAN 11 32# And such as do wickedly against the covenant shall he corrupt by flatteries: but the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do [exploits].

flatteries 27 DAN 11 21# And in his estate shall stand up a vile person, to whom they shall not give the honour of the kingdom: but he shall come in peaceably, and obtain the kingdom by flatteries.

flatteries 27 DAN 11 34# Now when they shall fall, they shall be holpen with a little help: but many shall cleave to them with flatteries.

flattering divination within 26 EZE 12 24 # For there shall be no more any vain vision nor flattering divination within the house of Israel.

flattering lips and 19 PSA 12 02 # They speak vanity every one with his neighbour: [with] flattering lips [and] with a double heart do they speak.

flattering lips and 19 PSA 12 03 # The LORD shall cut off all flattering lips, [and] the tongue that speaketh proud things:

flattering mouth worketh 20 PRO 26 28 # A lying tongue hateth [those that are] afflicted by it; and a flattering mouth worketh ruin.

flattering of her 20 PRO 07 21 #With her much fair speech she caused him to yield, with the flattering of her lips she forced him.
