fool and rewardeth [20_PRO_26_10](#) # The great [God] that formed all [things] both rewardeth the fool, and rewardeth transgressors.

fool and the [19_PSA_49_10](#) # For he seeth [that] wise men die, likewise the fool and the brutish person perish, and leave their wealth to others.

fool for he [20_PRO_23_09](#) # Speak not in the ears of a fool: for he will despise the wisdom of thy words.

fool for I [47_2CO_12_06](#) # For though I would desire to glory, I shall not be a fool; for I will say the truth: but [now] I forbear, lest any man should think of me above that which he seeth me [to be], or [that] he heareth of me.

fool hath no [20_PRO_17_21](#) # He that begetteth a fool [doeth it] to his sorrow: and the father of a fool hath no joy.

fool hath no [20 PRO 18 02](#) # A fool hath no delight in understanding, but that his heart may discover itself.

fool hath said [19 PSA 14 01](#) # To the chief Musician, [A Psalm] of David. The fool hath said in his heart, [There is] no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, [there is] none that doeth good.

fool hath said [19 PSA 53 01](#) # To the chief Musician upon Mahalath, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David. The fool hath said in his heart, [There is] no God. Corrupt are they, and have done abominable iniquity: [there is] none that doeth good.

fool he openeth [20 PRO 24 07](#) # Wisdom [is] too high for a fool: he openeth not his mouth in the gate.

fool I am [47 2CO 11 23](#) # Are they ministers of Christ? [I speak as a fool] I [am] more; in labours more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft.

fool if otherwise [47 2CO 11 16](#) # I say again, Let no man think me a fool; if otherwise, yet as a fool receive me, that I may boast myself a little.

fool in a [20 PRO 27 22](#) # Though thou shouldest bray a fool in a mortar among wheat with a pestle, [yet] will not his foolishness depart from him.

fool in glorying [47 2CO 12 11](#) # I am become a fool in glorying; ye have compelled me: for I ought to have been commended of you: for in nothing am I behind the very chiefest apostles, though I be nothing.

fool in his [20 PRO 17 12](#) # Let a bear robbed of her whelps meet a man, rather than a fool in his folly.

fool is right [20 PRO 12 15](#) # The way of a fool [is] right in his own eyes: but he that hearkeneth unto counsel [is] wise.

fool layeth open [20 PRO 13 16](#) # Every prudent [man] dealeth with knowledge: but a fool layeth open [his] folly.

fool much less [20 PRO 17 07](#) # Excellent speech becometh not a fool: much less do lying lips a prince.

fool much less [20 PRO 19 10](#) # Delight is not seemly for a fool; much less for a servant to have rule over princes.

fool rageth and [20 PRO 14 16](#) # A wise [man] feareth, and departeth from evil: but the fool rageth, and is confident.

fool receive me [47 2CO 11 16](#) # I say again, Let no man think me a fool; if otherwise, yet as a fool receive me, that I may boast myself a little.

fool returneth to [20 PRO 26 11](#) # As a dog returneth to his vomit, [so] a fool returneth to his folly.

fool shall be [40 MAT 05 22](#) # But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.

fool shall be [20 PRO 11 29](#) # He that troubleth his own house shall inherit the wind: and the fool [shall be] servant to the wise of heart.

fool shall fall [20 PRO 10 08](#) # The wise in heart will receive commandments: but a prating fool shall fall.

fool to do [20_PRO_10_23](#) # [It is] as sport to a fool to do mischief: but a man of understanding hath wisdom.

fool to the [20_PRO_07_22](#) # He goeth after her straightway, as an ox goeth to the slaughter, or as a fool to the correction of the stocks;

fool what hath [21_ECC_06_08](#) # For what hath the wise more than the fool? what hath the poor, that knoweth to walk before the living?

fool when he [20_PRO_17_28](#) # Even a fool, when he holdeth his peace, is counted wise: [and] he that shutteth his lips [is esteemed] a man of understanding.

fool when he [20_PRO_30_22](#) # For a servant when he reigneth; and a fool when he is filled with meat;

fool will be [20_PRO_20_03](#) # [It is] an honour for a man to cease from strife: but every fool will be meddling.

fool will swallow [21 ECC 10 12](#) # The words of a wise man's mouth [are] gracious; but the lips of a fool will swallow up himself.

fool [20 PRO 19 01](#) # Better [is] the poor that walketh in his integrity, than [he that is] perverse in his lips, and is a fool.

fool [20 PRO 26 01](#) # As snow in summer, and as rain in harvest, so honour is not seemly for a fool.

fool [20 PRO 26 08](#) # As he that bindeth a stone in a sling, so [is] he that giveth honour to a fool.

fool's back [20 PRO 26 03](#) # A whip for the horse, a bridle for the ass, and a rod for the fool's back.

fool's heart at [21 ECC 10 02](#) # A wise man's heart [is] at his right hand; but a fool's heart at his left.

fool's lips enter [20 PRO 18 06](#) # A fool's lips enter into contention, and his mouth calleth for strokes.

fool's mouth is [20 PRO 18 07](#) # A fool's mouth [is] his destruction, and his lips [are] the snare of his soul.

fool's voice is [21 ECC 05 03](#) # For a dream cometh through the multitude of business; and a fool's voice [is known] by multitude of words.

fool's wrath is [20 PRO 12 16](#) # A fool's wrath is presently known: but a prudent [man] covereth shame.

fool's wrath is [20 PRO 27 03](#) # A stone [is] heavy, and the sand weighty; but a fool's wrath [is] heavier than them both.

foolish a teacher [45 ROM 02 20](#) # An instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, which hast the form of knowledge and of the truth in the law.

foolish and hurtful [54 1TI 06 09](#) # But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and [into] many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition.

foolish and live [20 PRO 09 06](#) # Forsake the foolish, and live; and go in the way of understanding.

foolish and unlearned [55 2TI 02 23](#) # But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes.

foolish disobedient deceived [56 TIT 03 03](#) # For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, [and] hating one another.

foolish doeth not [20 PRO 15 07](#) # The lips of the wise disperse knowledge: but the heart of the foolish [doeth] not so.

foolish for they [24 JER 05 04](#) # Therefore I said, Surely these [are] poor; they are foolish: for they know not the way of the LORD, [nor] the judgment of their God.

foolish Galatians who [48 GAL 03 01](#) # O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?

foolish having begun [48 GAL 03 03](#) # Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh?

foolish heart was [45 ROM 01 21](#) # Because that, when they knew God, they glorified [him] not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

foolish is a [20 PRO 14 03](#) # In the mouth of the foolish [is] a rod of pride: but the lips of the wise shall preserve them.

foolish is near [20 PRO 10 14](#) # Wise [men] lay up knowledge: but the mouth of the foolish [is] near destruction.

foolish king who [21 ECC 04 13](#) # Better [is] a poor and a wise child than an old and foolish king, who will no more be admonished.

foolish man and [18 JOB 05 02](#) # For wrath killeth the foolish man, and envy slayeth the silly one.

foolish man despiseth [20 PRO 15 20](#) # A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish man despiseth his mother.

foolish man reproacheth [19 PSA 74 22](#) # Arise, O God, plead thine own cause: remember how the foolish man reproacheth thee daily.

foolish man spendeth [20 PRO 21 20](#) # [There is] treasure to be desired and oil in the dwelling of the wise; but a foolish man spendeth it up.

foolish man when [20 PRO 14 07](#) # Go from the presence of a foolish man, when thou perceivest not [in him] the lips of knowledge.

foolish man whether [20 PRO 29 09](#) # [If] a wise man contendeth with a foolish man, whether he rage or laugh, [there is] no rest.

foolish man which [40 MAT 07 26](#) # And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand:

foolish men [60 1PE 02 15](#) # For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men:

foolish nation I [45 ROM 10 19](#) # But I say, Did not Israel know? First Moses saith, I will provoke you to jealousy by [them that are] no people, [and] by a foolish nation I will anger you.

foolish nation [05 DEU 32 21](#) # They have moved me to jealousy with [that which is] not God; they have provoked me to anger with their vanities: and I will move them to jealousy with [those which are] not a

people; I will provoke them to anger with a foolish nation.

foolish people and [05 DEU 32 06](#) # Do ye thus requite the LORD, O foolish people and unwise? [is] not he thy father [that] hath bought thee? hath he not made thee, and established thee?

foolish people and [24 JER 05 21](#) # Hear now this, O foolish people, and without understanding; which have eyes, and see not; which have ears, and hear not:

foolish people have [19 PSA 74 18](#) # Remember this, [that] the enemy hath reproached, O LORD, and [that] the foolish people have blasphemed thy name.

foolish plucketh it [20 PRO 14 01](#) # Every wise woman buildeth her house: but the foolish plucketh it down with her hands.

foolish prophets that [26 EZE 13 03](#) # Thus saith the Lord GOD; Woe unto the foolish prophets, that follow their own spirit, and have seen nothing!

foolish questions and [56 TIT 03 09](#) # But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain.

foolish said unto [40 MAT 25 08](#) # And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out.

foolish shall not [19 PSA 05 05](#) # The foolish shall not stand in thy sight: thou hatest all workers of iniquity.

foolish shepherd [38 ZEC 11 15](#) # And the LORD said unto me, Take unto thee yet the instruments of a foolish shepherd.

foolish son is [20 PRO 10 01](#) # The proverbs of Solomon. A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish son [is] the heaviness of his mother.

foolish son is [20 PRO 17 25](#) # A foolish son [is] a grief to his father, and bitterness to her that bare him.

foolish son is [20 PRO 19 13](#) # A foolish son [is] the calamity of his father: and the contentions of a wife [are] a continual dropping.

foolish taking root [18 JOB 05 03](#) # I have seen the foolish taking root: but suddenly I cursed his habitation.

foolish talking nor [49 EPH 05 04](#) # Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks.

foolish the stock [24 JER 10 08](#) # But they are altogether brutish and foolish: the stock [is] a doctrine of vanities.

foolish the wisdom [46 1CO 01 20](#) # Where [is] the wise? where [is] the scribe? where [is] the disputer of this world? hath not God made foolish the wisdom of this world?

foolish they have [24 JER 04 22](#) # For my people [is] foolish, they have not known me; they [are] sottish children, and they have none understanding: they [are] wise to do evil, but to do good they have no knowledge.

foolish things for [25 LAM 02 14](#) # Thy prophets have seen vain and foolish things for thee: and they have not discovered thine iniquity, to turn away thy captivity; but have seen for thee false burdens and causes of

banishment.

foolish things of [46 1CO 01 27](#) # But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty;

foolish took their [40 MAT 25 03](#) # They that [were] foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them:

foolish was I [19 PSA 73 22](#) # So foolish [was] I, and ignorant: I was [as] a beast before thee.

foolish wearieth every [21 ECC 10 15](#) # The labour of the foolish wearieth every one of them, because he knoweth not how to go to the city.

foolish when I [19 PSA 73 03](#) # For I was envious at the foolish, [when] I saw the prosperity of the wicked.

foolish why shouldest [21 ECC 07 17](#) # Be not over much wicked, neither be thou foolish: why shouldest thou die before thy time?

foolish woman is [20 PRO 09 13](#) # A foolish woman [is] clamorous: [she is] simple, and knoweth nothing.

foolish women speaketh [18 JOB 02 10](#) # But he said unto her, Thou speakest as one of the foolish women speaketh. What? shall we receive good at the hand of God, and shall we not receive evil? In all this did not Job sin with his lips.

foolish [23 ISA 44 25](#) # That frustrateth the tokens of the liars, and maketh diviners mad; that turneth wise [men] backward, and maketh their knowledge foolish;

foolish [40 MAT 25 02](#) # And five of them were wise, and five [were] foolish.

foolish [19 PSA 39 08](#) # Deliver me from all my transgressions: make me not the reproach of the foolish.

foolishly and a [20 PRO 14 17](#) # [He that is] soon angry dealeth foolishly: and a man of wicked devices is hated.

foolishly and to [19 PSA 75 04](#) # I said unto the fools, Deal not foolishly: and to the wicked, Lift not up the horn:

foolishly and wherein [04 NUM 12 11](#) # And Aaron said unto Moses, Alas, my lord, I beseech thee, lay not the sin upon us, wherein we have done foolishly, and wherein we have sinned.

foolishly I am [47 2CO 11 21](#) # I speak as concerning reproach, as though we had been weak. Howbeit whereinsoever any is bold, [I speak foolishly,] I am bold also.

foolishly in lifting [20 PRO 30 32](#) # If thou hast done foolishly in lifting up thyself, or if thou hast thought evil, [lay] thine hand upon thy mouth.

foolishly in so [01 GEN 31 28](#) # And hast not suffered me to kiss my sons and my daughters? thou hast now done foolishly in [so] doing.

foolishly in this [47 2CO 11 17](#) # That which I speak, I speak [it] not after the Lord, but as it were foolishly, in this confidence of boasting.

foolishly therefore from [14 2CH 16 09](#) # For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show himself strong in the behalf of [them] whose heart [is] perfect toward him. Herein thou hast done foolishly: therefore from henceforth thou shalt have wars.

foolishly thou hast [09 ISA 13 13](#) # And Samuel said to Saul, Thou hast done foolishly: thou hast not kept the commandment of the LORD thy God, which he commanded thee: for now would the LORD have established thy kingdom upon Israel for ever.

foolishly [10 2SA 24 10](#) # And David's heart smote him after that he had numbered the people. And David said unto the LORD, I have sinned greatly in that I have done: and now, I beseech thee, O LORD, take away the iniquity of thy servant; for I have done very foolishly.

foolishly [18 JOB 01 22](#) # In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.

foolishness and madness [21 ECC 07 25](#) # I applied mine heart to know, and to search, and to seek out wisdom, and the reason [of things], and to know the wickedness of folly, even of foolishness [and] madness:

foolishness and my [19 PSA 69 05](#) # O God, thou knowest my foolishness; and my sins are not hid from thee.

foolishness and the [21 ECC 10 13](#) # The beginning of the words of his mouth [is] foolishness: and the end of his talk [is] mischievous madness.

foolishness but unto [46 1CO 01 18](#) # For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.

foolishness depart from [20 PRO 27 22](#) # Though thou shouldest bray a fool in a mortar among wheat with a pestle, [yet] will not his foolishness depart from him.

Foolishness is bound [20 PRO 22 15](#) # Foolishness [is] bound in the heart of a child; [but] the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.

foolishness is sin [20 PRO 24 09](#) # The thought of foolishness [is] sin: and the scorner [is] an abomination to men.

foolishness of fools [20 PRO 14 24](#) # The crown of the wise [is] their riches: [but] the foolishness of fools [is] folly.

foolishness of God [46 1CO 01 25](#) # Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

foolishness of man [20 PRO 19 03](#) # The foolishness of man perverteth his way: and his heart fretteth against the LORD.

foolishness of preaching [46 1CO 01 21](#) # For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe.

foolishness unto him [46 1CO 02 14](#) # But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know [them], because they are spiritually discerned.

foolishness with God [46 1CO 03 19](#) # For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness.

foolishness [46 1CO 01 23](#) # But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness;

foolishness [20 PRO 12 23](#) # A prudent man concealeth knowledge: but the heart of fools proclaimeth foolishness.

foolishness [20 PRO 15 02](#) # The tongue of the wise useth knowledge aright: but the mouth of fools poureth out foolishness.

foolishness [20 PRO 15 14](#) # The heart of him that hath understanding seeketh knowledge: but the mouth of fools feedeth on foolishness.

foolishness [19 PSA 38 05](#) # My wounds stink [and] are corrupt because of my foolishness.

fools and blind [40 MAT 23 17](#) # [Ye] fools and blind: for whether is greater, the gold, or the temple that sanctifieth the gold?

fools and blind [40 MAT 23 19](#) # [Ye] fools and blind: for whether [is] greater, the gift, or the altar that sanctifieth the gift?

fools and slow [42 LUK 24 25](#) # Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken:

fools be ye [20 PRO 08 05](#) # O ye simple, understand wisdom: and, ye fools, be ye of an understanding heart.

Fools because of [19 PSA 107 17](#) # Fools because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted.

fools but as [49 EPH 05 15](#) # See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise,

fools Deal not [19 PSA 75 04](#) # I said unto the fools, Deal not foolishly: and to the wicked, Lift not up the horn:

fools despise wisdom [20 PRO 01 07](#) # The fear of the LORD [is] the beginning of knowledge: [but] fools despise wisdom and instruction.

fools did not [42 LUK 11 40](#) # [Ye] fools, did not he that made that which is without make that which is within also?

fools die for [20 PRO 10 21](#) # The lips of the righteous feed many: but fools die for want of wisdom.

fools feedeth on [20 PRO 15 14](#) # The heart of him that hath understanding seeketh knowledge: but the mouth of fools feedeth on foolishness.

fools for Christ's [46 1CO 04 10](#) # We [are] fools for Christ's sake, but ye [are] wise in Christ; we [are] weak, but ye [are] strong; ye [are] honourable, but we [are] despised.

fools for they [21 ECC 05 01](#) # Keep thy foot when thou goest to the house of God, and be more ready to hear, than to give the sacrifice of fools: for they consider not that they do evil.

fools gladly seeing [47 2CO 11 19](#) # For ye suffer fools gladly, seeing ye [yourselves] are wise.
