force abated <u>05_DEU_34_07</u> # And Moses [was] an hundred and twenty years old when he died: his eye was not dim, nor his natural force abated.

force after men <u>58_HEB_09_17</u> # For a testament [is] of force after men are dead: otherwise it is of no strength at all while the testator liveth.

force and power <u>15_EZR_04_23</u> # Now when the copy of king Artaxerxes' letter [was] read before Rehum, and Shimshai the scribe, and their companions, they went up in haste to Jerusalem unto the Jews, and made them to cease by force and power.

force and with <u>26_EZE_34_04</u> # The diseased have ye not strengthened, neither have ye healed that which was sick, neither have ye bound up [that which was] broken, neither have ye brought again that which was driven away, neither have ye sought that which was lost; but with force and with cruelty have ye ruled them.

force but a 24_JER_48_45 # They that fled stood under the shadow of Heshbon because of the force: but a fire shall come forth out of Heshbon, and a flame from the midst of Sihon, and shall devour the corner of Moab, and the crown of the head of the tumultuous ones.

force from among <u>44_ACT_23_10</u> # And when there arose a great dissension, the chief captain, fearing lest Paul should have been pulled in pieces of them, commanded the soldiers to go down, and to take him by force from among them, and to bring [him] into the castle.

force her and <u>05_DEU_22_25</u> # But if a man find a betrothed damsel in the field, and the man force her, and lie with her: then the man only that lay with her shall die:

force is in <u>18_JOB_40_16</u># Lo now, his strength [is] in his loins, and his force [is] in the navel of his belly.

force is not <u>24_JER_23_10</u> # For the land is full of adulterers; for because of swearing the land mourneth; the pleasant places of the wilderness are dried up, and their course is evil, and their force [is] not right.

force me for <u>10_2SA_13_12</u> # And she answered him, Nay, my brother, do not force me; for no such thing ought to be done in Israel: do not thou this folly.

force neither shall <u>30_AMO_02_14</u># Therefore the flight shall perish from the swift, and the strong shall not strengthen his force, neither shall the mighty deliver himself:

force of my <u>18_JOB_30_18</u># By the great force [of my disease] is my garment changed: it bindeth me about as the collar of my coat.

force of the <u>26_EZE_35_05</u># Because thou hast had a perpetual hatred, and hast shed [the blood of] the children of Israel by the force of the sword in the time of their calamity, in the time [that their] iniquity [had] an end:

force of the <u>24_JER_18_21</u> # Therefore deliver up their children to the famine, and pour out their [blood] by the force of the sword; and let their wives be bereaved of their children, and [be] widows; and let their men be put to death; [let] their young men [be] slain by the sword in battle.

force the queen <u>17_EST_07_08</u> # Then the king returned out of the palace garden into the place of the banquet of wine; and Haman was fallen upon the bed whereon Esther [was]. Then said the king, Will he force the queen also before me in the house? As the word went out of the king's mouth, they covered Haman's face.

force thy daughters <u>01_GEN_31_31</u> # And Jacob answered and said to Laban, Because I was afraid: for I said, Peradventure thou wouldest take by force thy daughters from me.

force to make <u>43_JOH_06_15</u> # When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take him by force, to make him a king, he departed again into a mountain himself alone.

force <u>09_1SA_02_16</u># And [if] any man said unto him, Let them not fail to burn the fat presently, and [then] take [as much] as thy soul desireth; then he would answer him, [Nay]; but thou shalt give [it me] now: and if not, I will take [it] by force.

force <u>40_MAT_11_12</u># And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.

forced her and <u>10_2SA_13_14</u># Howbeit he would not hearken unto her voice: but, being stronger than she, forced her, and lay with her.

forced him <u>20_PRO_07_21</u># With her much fair speech she caused him to yield, with the flattering of her lips she forced him.

forced his sister <u>10_28A_13_22</u># And Absalom spake unto his brother Amnon neither good nor bad: for Absalom hated Amnon, because he had forced his sister Tamar.

forced his sister <u>10_2SA_13_32</u> # And Jonadab, the son of Shimeah David's brother, answered and said, Let not my lord suppose [that] they have slain all the young men the king's sons; for Amnon only is dead: for by the appointment of Absalom this hath been determined from the day that he forced his sister Tamar.

forced myself therefore <u>09_1SA_13_12</u># Therefore said I, The Philistines will come down now upon me to Gilgal, and I have not made supplication unto the LORD: I forced myself therefore, and offered a burnt offering.

forced that she <u>07_JUD_20_05</u># And the men of Gibeah rose against me, and beset the house round about upon me by night, [and] thought to have slain me: and my concubine have they forced, that she is dead.

forced the children <u>07_JUD_01_34</u> # And the Amorites forced the children of Dan into the mountain: for they would not suffer them to come down to the valley:

forces and a <u>27_DAN_11_38</u># But in his estate shall he honour the God of forces: and a god whom his fathers knew not shall he honour with gold, and silver, and with precious stones, and pleasant things.

forces and all <u>24_JER_43_04</u> # So Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces, and all the people, obeyed not the voice of the LORD, to dwell in the land of Judah.

forces and foreigners <u>31_OBA_01_11</u> # In the day that thou stoodest on the other side, in the day that the strangers carried away captive his forces, and foreigners entered into his gates, and cast lots upon Jerusalem, even thou [wast] as one of them.

forces and Johanan <u>24_JER_42_01</u> # Then all the captains of the forces, and Johanan the son of Kareah, and Jezaniah the son of Hoshaiah, and all the people from the least even unto the greatest, came near,

forces and one <u>27_DAN_11_10</u># But his sons shall be stirred up, and shall assemble a multitude of great

forces: and [one] shall certainly come, and overflow, and pass through: then shall he return, and be stirred up, [even] to his fortress.

forces in all <u>14_2CH_17_02</u> # And he placed forces in all the fenced cities of Judah, and set garrisons in the land of Judah, and in the cities of Ephraim, which Asa his father had taken.

forces of strength <u>18_JOB_36_19</u> # Will he esteem thy riches? [no], not gold, nor all the forces of strength.

forces of the <u>23_ISA_60_05</u> # Then thou shalt see, and flow together, and thine heart shall fear, and be enlarged; because the abundance of the sea shall be converted unto thee, the forces of the Gentiles shall come unto thee.

forces of the <u>23_ISA_60_11</u># Therefore thy gates shall be open continually; they shall not be shut day nor night; that [men] may bring unto thee the forces of the Gentiles, and [that] their kings [may be] brought.

forces that were <u>24_JER_40_13</u> # Moreover Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces that [were] in the fields, came to Gedaliah to Mizpah,

forces that were <u>24_JER_41_11</u># But when Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces that [were] with him, heard of all the evil that Ishmael the son of Nethaniah had done,

forces that were <u>24_JER_41_13</u> # Now it came to pass, [that] when all the people which [were] with Ishmael saw Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces that [were] with him, then they were glad.

forces that were 24_JER_41_16 # Then took Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces that [were] with him, all the remnant of the people whom he had recovered from Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, from Mizpah, after [that] he had slain Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, [even] mighty men of war, and the women, and the children, and the eunuchs, whom he had brought again from Gibeon:

forces took all 24_JER_43_05 # But Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces, took all the remnant of Judah, that were returned from all nations, whither they had been driven, to dwell in the land of Judah;

forces which were 24_JER_40_07 # Now when all the captains of the forces which [were] in the fields, [even] they and their men, heard that the king of Babylon had made Gedaliah the son of Ahikam governor in the land, and had committed unto him men, and women, and children, and of the poor of the land, of them that were not carried away captive to Babylon;

forces which were <u>24_JER_42_08</u> # Then called he Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces which [were] with him, and all the people from the least even to the greatest,
