forget all my <u>01\_GEN\_41\_51</u># And Joseph called the name of the firstborn Manasseh: For God, [said he], hath made me forget all my toil, and all my father's house.

forget also thine 19 PSA 45 10 # Hearken, O daughter, and consider, and incline thine ear; forget also thine own people, and thy father's house;

forget any of <u>30\_AMO\_08\_07</u> # The LORD hath sworn by the excellency of Jacob, Surely I will never forget any of their works.

forget God and <u>18\_JOB\_08\_13</u> # So [are] the paths of all that forget God; and the hypocrite's hope shall perish:

forget God lest 19\_PSA\_50\_22 # Now consider this, ye that forget God, lest I tear [you] in pieces, and [there be] none to deliver.

forget God 19\_PSA\_09\_17 # The wicked shall be turned into hell, [and] all the nations that forget God.

forget her cunning 19\_PSA\_137\_05 # If I forget thee, O Jerusalem, let my right hand forget [her cunning].

forget her ornaments <u>24\_JER\_02\_32</u> # Can a maid forget her ornaments, [or] a bride her attire? yet my people have forgotten me days without number.

forget her sucking 23\_ISA\_49\_15 # Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? yea, they may forget, yet will I not forget thee.

forget him the <u>18\_JOB\_24\_20</u> # The womb shall forget him; the worm shall feed sweetly on him; he shall be no more remembered; and wickedness shall be broken as a tree.

forget his poverty <u>20\_PRO\_31\_07</u> # Let him drink, and forget his poverty, and remember his misery no more.

forget it not <u>20\_PRO\_04\_05</u> # Get wisdom, get understanding: forget [it] not; neither decline from the words of my mouth.

forget it <u>05\_DEU\_25\_19</u> # Therefore it shall be, when the LORD thy God hath given thee rest from all thine enemies round about, in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee [for] an inheritance to possess it, [that] thou shalt blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven; thou shalt not forget [it].

forget me O 19 PSA 13 01 # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. How long wilt thou forget me, O LORD? for ever? how long wilt thou hide thy face from me?

forget my complaint <u>18\_JOB\_09\_27</u> # If I say, I will forget my complaint, I will leave off my heaviness, and comfort [myself]:

forget my holy <u>23\_ISA\_65\_11</u> # But ye [are] they that forsake the LORD, that forget my holy mountain, that prepare a table for that troop, and that furnish the drink offering unto that number.

forget my name 24\_JER\_23\_27 # Which think to cause my people to forget my name by their dreams which

they tell every man to his neighbour, as their fathers have forgotten my name for Baal.

forget neither shall 12\_2KI\_17\_38 # And the covenant that I have made with you ye shall not forget; neither shall ye fear other gods.

forget not all 19\_PSA\_103\_02 # Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:

forget not for <u>58\_HEB\_13\_16</u># But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

forget not how <u>05\_DEU\_09\_07</u># Remember, [and] forget not, how thou provokedst the LORD thy God to wrath in the wilderness: from the day that thou didst depart out of the land of Egypt, until ye came unto this place, ye have been rebellious against the LORD.

forget not my 20\_PRO\_03\_01 # My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments:

forget not the <u>05\_DEU\_08\_11</u># Beware that thou forget not the LORD thy God, in not keeping his commandments, and his judgments, and his statutes, which I command thee this day:

forget not the 19\_PSA\_10\_12 # Arise, O LORD; O God, lift up thine hand: forget not the humble.

forget not the 19\_PSA\_74\_19 # O deliver not the soul of thy turtledove unto the multitude [of the wicked]: forget not the congregation of thy poor for ever.

Forget not the 19\_PSA\_74\_23 # Forget not the voice of thine enemies: the tumult of those that rise up against thee increaseth continually.

forget scatter them 19\_PSA\_59\_11# Slay them not, lest my people forget: scatter them by thy power; and bring them down, O Lord our shield.

forget that which <u>01\_GEN\_27\_45</u># Until thy brother's anger turn away from thee, and he forget [that] which thou hast done to him: then I will send, and fetch thee from thence: why should I be deprived also of you both in one day?

forget the covenant <u>05\_DEU\_04\_23</u> # Take heed unto yourselves, lest ye forget the covenant of the LORD your God, which he made with you, and make you a graven image, [or] the likeness of any [thing], which the LORD thy God hath forbidden thee.

forget the covenant <u>05\_DEU\_04\_31</u># [For the LORD thy God [is] a merciful God;] he will not forsake thee, neither destroy thee, nor forget the covenant of thy fathers which he sware unto them.

forget the law <u>20\_PRO\_31\_05</u># Lest they drink, and forget the law, and pervert the judgment of any of the afflicted.

forget the LORD <u>05\_DEU\_06\_12</u># [Then] beware lest thou forget the LORD, which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.

forget the LORD <u>05\_DEU\_08\_14</u># Then thine heart be lifted up, and thou forget the LORD thy God, which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage;

forget the LORD <u>05\_DEU\_08\_19</u> # And it shall be, if thou do at all forget the LORD thy God, and walk after other gods, and serve them, and worship them, I testify against you this day that ye shall surely perish.

forget the shame <u>23\_ISA\_54\_04</u> # Fear not; for thou shalt not be ashamed: neither be thou confounded; for thou shalt not be put to shame: for thou shalt forget the shame of thy youth, and shalt not remember the

reproach of thy widowhood any more.

forget the things <u>05\_DEU\_04\_09</u># Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul diligently, lest thou forget the things which thine eyes have seen, and lest they depart from thy heart all the days of thy life: but teach them thy sons, and thy sons' sons;

forget the works 19\_PSA\_78\_07 # That they might set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments:

forget thee O 19\_PSA\_137\_05 # If I forget thee, O Jerusalem, let my right hand forget [her cunning].

forget thee <u>23\_ISA\_49\_15</u> # Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? yea, they may forget, yet will I not forget thee.

forget thine handmaid <u>09\_1SA\_01\_11</u># And she vowed a vow, and said, O LORD of hosts, if thou wilt indeed look on the affliction of thine handmaid, and remember me, and not forget thine handmaid, but wilt give unto thine handmaid a man child, then I will give him unto the LORD all the days of his life, and there shall no razor come upon his head.

forget thy children <u>28\_HOS\_04\_06</u> # My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.

forget thy commandments  $\underline{19\_PSA\_119\_176}$  # I have gone astray like a lost sheep; seek thy servant; for I do not forget thy commandments.

forget thy law 19\_PSA\_119\_109 # My soul [is] continually in my hand: yet do I not forget thy law.

forget thy law 19\_PSA\_119\_153 # RESH. Consider mine affliction, and deliver me: for I do not forget thy law.

forget thy misery <u>18\_JOB\_11\_16</u># Because thou shalt forget [thy] misery, [and] remember [it] as waters [that] pass away:

forget thy precepts 19\_PSA\_119\_141 # I [am] small and despised: [yet] do not I forget thy precepts.

forget thy precepts 19\_PSA\_119\_93 # I will never forget thy precepts: for with them thou hast quickened me.

forget thy statutes 19\_PSA\_119\_83 # For I am become like a bottle in the smoke; [yet] do I not forget thy statutes.

forget thy word 19 PSA 119 16 # I will delight myself in thy statutes: I will not forget thy word.

forget to eat 19\_PSA\_102\_04 # My heart is smitten, and withered like grass; so that I forget to eat my bread.

forget us for 25\_LAM\_05\_20 # Wherefore dost thou forget us for ever, [and] forsake us so long time?

forget yet will <u>23\_ISA\_49\_15</u> # Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? yea, they may forget, yet will I not forget thee.

forget you and <u>24\_JER\_23\_39</u> # Therefore, behold, I, even I, will utterly forget you, and I will forsake you, and the city that I gave you and your fathers, [and cast you] out of my presence:

forget your work <u>58\_HEB\_06\_10</u> # For God [is] not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have showed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister.

forgetful hearer but <u>59\_JAM\_01\_25</u> # But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth [therein], he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

forgetful to entertain <u>58\_HEB\_13\_02</u># Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.

forgetfulness 19 PSA 88 12 # Shall thy wonders be known in the dark? and thy righteousness in the land of forgetfulness?

forgettest our affliction 19 PSA 44 24 Wherefore hidest thou thy face, [and] forgettest our affliction and our oppression?

forgettest the LORD <u>23\_ISA\_51\_13</u># And forgettest the LORD thy maker, that hath stretched forth the heavens, and laid the foundations of the earth; and hast feared continually every day because of the fury of the oppressor, as if he were ready to destroy? and where [is] the fury of the oppressor?

forgetteth not the 19\_PSA\_09\_12 # When he maketh inquisition for blood, he remembereth them: he forgetteth not the cry of the humble.

forgetteth that the <u>18\_JOB\_39\_15</u># And forgetteth that the foot may crush them, or that the wild beast may break them.

forgetteth the covenant <u>20\_PRO\_02\_17</u># Which forsaketh the guide of her youth, and forgetteth the covenant of her God.

forgetteth what manner <u>59\_JAM\_01\_24</u># For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.

forgetting those things <u>50\_PHP\_03\_13</u> # Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but [this] one thing [I do], forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before,
