forgotten and because [23 ISA 65 16](#) # That he who blesseth himself in the earth shall bless himself in the God of truth; and he that sweareth in the earth shall swear by the God of truth; because the former troubles are forgotten, and because they are hid from mine eyes.

forgotten And how [21 ECC 02 16](#) # For [there is] no remembrance of the wise more than of the fool for ever; seeing that which now [is] in the days to come shall all be forgotten. And how dieth the wise [man]? as the fool.

forgotten as a [19 PSA 31 12](#) # I am forgotten as a dead man out of mind: I am like a broken vessel.

forgotten before God [42 LUK 12 06](#) # Are not five sparrows sold for two farthings, and not one of them is forgotten before God?

forgotten God that [05 DEU 32 18](#) # Of the Rock [that] begat thee thou art unmindful, and hast forgotten God that formed thee.

forgotten he hideth [19 PSA 10 11](#) # He hath said in his heart, God hath forgotten: he hideth his face; he will never see [it].

forgotten his Maker [28 HOS 08 14](#) # For Israel hath forgotten his Maker, and buildeth temples; and Judah hath multiplied fenced cities: but I will send a fire upon his cities, and it shall devour the palaces thereof.

forgotten in the [21 ECC 08 10](#) # And so I saw the wicked buried, who had come and gone from the place of the holy, and they were forgotten in the city where they had so done: this [is] also vanity.

forgotten in the [01 GEN 41 30](#) # And there shall arise after them seven years of famine; and all the plenty shall be forgotten in the land of Egypt; and the famine shall consume the land;

forgotten in Zion [25 LAM 02 06](#) # And he hath violently taken away his tabernacle, as [if it were of] a garden: he hath destroyed his places of the assembly: the LORD hath caused the solemn feasts and sabbaths to be forgotten in Zion, and hath despised in the indignation of his anger the king and the priest.

forgotten make sweet [23 ISA 23 16](#) # Take an harp, go about the city, thou harlot that hast been forgotten; make sweet melody, sing many songs, that thou mayest be remembered.

forgotten me and [26 EZE 23 35](#) # Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thou hast forgotten me, and cast me behind thy back, therefore bear thou also thy lewdness and thy whoredoms.

forgotten me and [24 JER 13 25](#) # This [is] thy lot, the portion of thy measures from me, saith the LORD; because thou hast forgotten me, and trusted in falsehood.

forgotten me days [24 JER 02 32](#) # Can a maid forget her ornaments, [or] a bride her attire? yet my people have forgotten me days without number.

forgotten me saith [26 EZE 22 12](#) # In thee have they taken gifts to shed blood; thou hast taken usury and increase, and thou hast greedily gained of thy neighbours by extortion, and hast forgotten me, saith the Lord GOD.

forgotten me they [24 JER 18 15](#) # Because my people hath forgotten me, they have burned incense to vanity, and they have caused them to stumble in their ways [from] the ancient paths, to walk in paths, [in] a way not cast up;

forgotten me why [19 PSA 42 09](#) # I will say unto God my rock, Why hast thou forgotten me? why go I mourning because of the oppression of the enemy?

forgotten me [28 HOS 13 06](#) # According to their pasture, so were they filled; they were filled, and their heart was exalted; therefore have they forgotten me.

forgotten me [23 ISA 49 14](#) # But Zion said, The LORD hath forsaken me, and my Lord hath forgotten me.

forgotten me [18 JOB 19 14](#) # My kinsfolk have failed, and my familiar friends have forgotten me.

forgotten my name [24 JER 23 27](#) # Which think to cause my people to forget my name by their dreams which they tell every man to his neighbour, as their fathers have forgotten my name for Baal.

forgotten of me [23 ISA 44 21](#) # Remember these, O Jacob and Israel; for thou [art] my servant: I have formed thee; thou [art] my servant: O Israel, thou shalt not be forgotten of me.

forgotten of the [18 JOB 28 04](#) # The flood breaketh out from the inhabitant; [even the waters] forgotten of the foot: they are dried up, they are gone away from men.

forgotten out of [05 DEU 31 21](#) # And it shall come to pass, when many evils and troubles are befallen them, that this song shall testify against them as a witness; for it shall not be forgotten out of the mouths of their seed: for I know their imagination which they go about, even now, before I have brought them into the land which I swear.

forgotten seventy years [23 ISA 23 15](#) # And it shall come to pass in that day, that Tyre shall be forgotten seventy years, according to the days of one king: after the end of seventy years shall Tyre sing as an harlot.

forgotten that he [61 2PE 01 09](#) # But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

forgotten the exhortation [58 HEB 12 05](#) # And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him:

forgotten the expectation [19 PSA 09 18](#) # For the needy shall not alway be forgotten: the expectation of the poor shall [not] perish for ever.

forgotten the God [23 ISA 17 10](#) # Because thou hast forgotten the God of thy salvation, and hast not been mindful of the rock of thy strength, therefore shalt thou plant pleasant plants, and shalt set it with strange slips:

forgotten the law [28 HOS 04 06](#) # My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.

forgotten the LORD [24 JER 03 21](#) # A voice was heard upon the high places, weeping [and] supplications of the children of Israel: for they have perverted their way, [and] they have forgotten the LORD their God.

forgotten the name [19 PSA 44 20](#) # If we have forgotten the name of our God, or stretched out our hands

to a strange god;

forgotten the wickedness [24\\_JER\\_44\\_09](#) # Have ye forgotten the wickedness of your fathers, and the wickedness of the kings of Judah, and the wickedness of their wives, and your own wickedness, and the wickedness of your wives, which they have committed in the land of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem?

forgotten thee neither [19\\_PSA\\_44\\_17](#) # All this is come upon us; yet have we not forgotten thee, neither have we dealt falsely in thy covenant.

forgotten thee they [24\\_JER\\_30\\_14](#) # All thy lovers have forgotten thee; they seek thee not; for I have wounded thee with the wound of an enemy, with the chastisement of a cruel one, for the multitude of thine iniquity; [because] thy sins were increased.

forgotten their restingplace [24\\_JER\\_50\\_06](#) # My people hath been lost sheep: their shepherds have caused them to go astray, they have turned them away [on] the mountains: they have gone from mountain to hill, they have forgotten their restingplace.

forgotten them [05\\_DEU\\_26\\_13](#) # Then thou shalt say before the LORD thy God, I have brought away the hallowed things out of [mine] house, and also have given them unto the Levite, and unto the stranger, to the fatherless, and to the widow, according to all thy commandments which thou hast commanded me: I have not transgressed thy commandments, neither have I forgotten [them]:

forgotten thy law [19\\_PSA\\_119\\_61](#) # The bands of the wicked have robbed me: [but] I have not forgotten thy law.

forgotten thy words [19\\_PSA\\_119\\_139](#) # My zeal hath consumed me, because mine enemies have forgotten thy words.

forgotten to be [19\\_PSA\\_77\\_09](#) # Hath God forgotten to be gracious? hath he in anger shut up his tender mercies? Selah.

forgotten to take [41\\_MAR\\_08\\_14](#) # Now [the disciples] had forgotten to take bread, neither had they in the ship with them more than one loaf.

forgotten to take [40\\_MAT\\_16\\_05](#) # And when his disciples were come to the other side, they had forgotten to take bread.

forgotten [21\\_ECC\\_09\\_05](#) # For the living know that they shall die: but the dead know not any thing, neither have they any more a reward; for the memory of them is forgotten.

forgotten [24\\_JER\\_20\\_11](#) # But the LORD [is] with me as a mighty terrible one: therefore my persecutors shall stumble, and they shall not prevail: they shall be greatly ashamed; for they shall not prosper: [their] everlasting confusion shall never be forgotten.

forgotten [24\\_JER\\_23\\_40](#) # And I will bring an everlasting reproach upon you, and a perpetual shame, which shall not be forgotten.

forgotten [24\\_JER\\_50\\_05](#) # They shall ask the way to Zion with their faces thitherward, [saying], Come, and let us join ourselves to the LORD in a perpetual covenant [that] shall not be forgotten.
