friend And he <u>02\_EXO\_33\_11</u># And the LORD spake unto Moses face to face, as a man speaketh unto his friend. And he turned again into the camp: but his servant Joshua, the son of Nun, a young man, departed not out of the tabernacle.

friend and shall <u>42\_LUK\_11\_05</u> # And he said unto them, Which of you shall have a friend, and shall go unto him at midnight, and say unto him, Friend, lend me three loaves;

friendly and there <u>20\_PRO\_18\_24</u> # A man [that hath] friends must show himself friendly: and there is a friend [that] sticketh closer than a brother.

friendly unto her <u>07\_JUD\_19\_03</u> # And her husband arose, and went after her, to speak friendly unto her, [and] to bring her again, having his servant with him, and a couple of asses: and she brought him into her father's house: and when the father of the damsel saw him, he rejoiced to meet him.

friendly unto thine <u>08\_RUT\_02\_13</u># Then she said, Let me find favour in thy sight, my lord; for that thou hast comforted me, and for that thou hast spoken friendly unto thine handmaid, though I be not like unto one of thine handmaidens.

friends every thing <u>17\_EST\_06\_13</u># And Haman told Zeresh his wife and all his friends every [thing] that had befallen him. Then said his wise men and Zeresh his wife unto him, If Mordecai [be] of the seed of the Jews, before whom thou hast begun to fall, thou shalt not prevail against him, but shalt surely fall before him.

friends for all <u>43\_JOH\_15\_15</u># Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you.

friends for the <u>18\_JOB\_19\_21</u># Have pity upon me, have pity upon me, O ye my friends; for the hand of God hath touched me.

friends For thou <u>10\_2SA\_19\_06</u># In that thou lovest thine enemies, and hatest thy friends. For thou hast declared this day, that thou regardest neither princes nor servants: for this day I perceive, that if Absalom had lived, and all we had died this day, then it had pleased thee well.

friends for ye <u>18\_JOB\_42\_07</u> # And it was [so], that after the LORD had spoken these words unto Job, the LORD said to Eliphaz the Temanite, My wrath is kindled against thee, and against thy two friends: for ye have not spoken of me [the thing that is] right, as my servant Job [hath].

friends have set 24\_JER\_38\_22 # And, behold, all the women that are left in the king of Judah's house [shall be] brought forth to the king of Babylon's princes, and those [women] shall say, Thy friends have set thee on, and have prevailed against thee: thy feet are sunk in the mire, [and] they are turned away back.

friends heard of <u>18\_JOB\_02\_11</u># Now when Job's three friends heard of all this evil that was come upon him, they came every one from his own place; Eliphaz the Temanite, and Bildad the Shuhite, and Zophar

the Naamathite: for they had made an appointment together to come to mourn with him and to comfort him.

friends stand aloof <u>19\_PSA\_38\_11</u># My lovers and my friends stand aloof from my sore; and my kinsmen stand afar off.

friends to him <u>42\_LUK\_07\_06</u> # Then Jesus went with them. And when he was now not far from the house, the centurion sent friends to him, saying unto him, Lord, trouble not thyself: for I am not worthy that thou shouldest enter under my roof:

friends to refresh <u>44\_ACT\_27\_03</u> # And the next [day] we touched at Sidon. And Julius courteously entreated Paul, and gave [him] liberty to go unto his friends to refresh himself.
