

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

bountifully shall reap <u>47\_2CO\_09\_06</u># But this [I say], He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully.

bountifully with me 19\_PSA\_13\_06 # I will sing unto the LORD, because he hath dealt bountifully with me.

bountifully with me 19\_PSA\_142\_07 # Bring my soul out of prison, that I may praise thy name: the righteous shall compass me about; for thou shalt deal bountifully with me.

bountifully with thee <u>19\_PSA\_116\_07</u># Return unto thy rest, O my soul; for the LORD hath dealt bountifully with thee.

bountifully with thy <u>19\_PSA\_119\_17</u># GIMEL. Deal bountifully with thy servant, [that] I may live, and keep thy word.

bountifully <u>47\_2CO\_09\_06</u> # But this [I say], He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully.

carefully for good <u>33\_MIC\_01\_12</u># For the inhabitant of Maroth waited carefully for good: but evil came down from the LORD unto the gate of Jerusalem.

carefully hearken unto <u>05\_DEU\_15\_05</u> # Only if thou carefully hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all these commandments which I command thee this day.

carefully that when <u>50\_PHP\_02\_28</u> # I sent him therefore the more carefully, that, when ye see him again, ye may rejoice, and that I may be the less sorrowful.

carefully with tears <u>58\_HEB\_12\_17</u> # For ye know how that afterward, when he would have inherited the blessing, he was rejected: for he found no place of repentance, though he sought it carefully with tears.

cheerfully answer for <u>44\_ACT\_24\_10</u># Then Paul, after that the governor had beckoned unto him to speak, answered, Forasmuch as I know that thou hast been of many years a judge unto this nation, I do the more cheerfully answer for myself:

deceitfully and cursed 24\_JER\_48\_10 # Cursed [be] he that doeth the work of the LORD deceitfully, and cursed [be] he that keepeth back his sword from blood.

deceitfully and said <u>01\_GEN\_34\_13</u># And the sons of Jacob answered Shechem and Hamor his father deceitfully, and said, because he had defiled Dinah their sister:

deceitfully any more <u>02\_EXO\_08\_29</u> # And Moses said, Behold, I go out from thee, and I will entreat the LORD that the swarms [of flies] may depart from Pharaoh, from his servants, and from his people, to morrow: but let not Pharaoh deal deceitfully any more in not letting the people go to sacrifice to the LORD.

deceitfully as a <u>18\_JOB\_06\_15</u># My brethren have dealt deceitfully as a brook, [and] as the stream of brooks they pass away;

deceitfully but by <u>47\_2CO\_04\_02</u># But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending

ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.

deceitfully for he <u>27\_DAN\_11\_23</u># And after the league [made] with him he shall work deceitfully: for he shall come up, and shall become strong with a small people.

deceitfully for him 18\_JOB\_13\_07 # Will ye speak wickedly for God? and talk deceitfully for him?

deceitfully gotten or <u>03 LEV\_06\_04</u># Then it shall be, because he hath sinned, and is guilty, that he shall restore that which he took violently away, or the thing which he hath deceitfully gotten, or that which was delivered him to keep, or the lost thing which he found,

deceitfully with her <u>02\_EXO\_21\_08</u># If she please not her master, who hath betrothed her to himself, then shall he let her be redeemed: to sell her unto a strange nation he shall have no power, seeing he hath dealt deceitfully with her.

deceitfully 19\_PSA\_24\_04 # He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.

deceitfully 19\_PSA\_52\_02 # Thy tongue deviseth mischiefs; like a sharp razor, working deceitfully.

despitefully and to <u>44\_ACT\_14\_05</u> # And when there was an assault made both of the Gentiles, and also of the Jews with their rulers, to use [them] despitefully, and to stone them,

despitefully use you <u>42\_LUK\_06\_28</u># Bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you.

despitefully use you <u>40\_MAT\_05\_44</u># But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;

faithfully and the 14\_2CH\_34\_12 # And the men did the work faithfully: and the overseers of them [were] Jahath and Obadiah, the Levites, of the sons of Merari; and Zechariah and Meshullam, of the sons of the Kohathites, to set [it] forward; and [other of] the Levites, all that could skill of instruments of music.

faithfully and with 14\_2CH\_19\_09 # And he charged them, saying, Thus shall ye do in the fear of the LORD, faithfully, and with a perfect heart.

faithfully judgeth the <u>20\_PRO\_29\_14</u># The king that faithfully judgeth the poor, his throne shall be established for ever.

faithfully over which 14\_2CH\_31\_12 # And brought in the offerings and the tithes and the dedicated [things] faithfully: over which Cononiah the Levite [was] ruler, and Shimei his brother [was] the next.

faithfully What is 24\_JER\_23\_28 # The prophet that hath a dream, let him tell a dream; and he that hath my word, let him speak my word faithfully. What [is] the chaff to the wheat? saith the LORD.

faithfully whatsoever thou <u>64\_3JO\_01\_05</u># Beloved, thou doest faithfully whatsoever thou doest to the brethren, and to strangers;

faithfully 12\_2KI\_12\_15 # Moreover they reckoned not with the men, into whose hand they delivered the money to be bestowed on workmen: for they dealt faithfully.

faithfully 12\_2KI\_22\_07 # Howbeit there was no reckoning made with them of the money that was delivered into their hand, because they dealt faithfully.

fearfully and wonderfully 19\_PSA\_139\_14 # I will praise thee; for I am fearfully [and] wonderfully made:

marvellous [are] thy works; and [that] my soul knoweth right well.

fully after the 11\_1KI\_11\_06# And Solomon did evil in the sight of the LORD, and went not fully after the LORD, as [did] David his father.

fully been showed <u>08\_RUT\_02\_11</u># And Boaz answered and said unto her, It hath fully been showed me, all that thou hast done unto thy mother in law since the death of thine husband: and [how] thou hast left thy father and thy mother, and the land of thy nativity, and art come unto a people which thou knewest not heretofore.

fully come they <u>44\_ACT\_02\_01</u># And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

fully dry <u>34\_NAH\_01\_10</u># For while [they be] folden together [as] thorns, and while they are drunken [as] drunkards, they shall be devoured as stubble fully dry.

fully him will <u>04\_NUM\_14\_24</u> # But my servant Caleb, because he had another spirit with him, and hath followed me fully, him will I bring into the land whereinto he went; and his seed shall possess it.

fully known and <u>55\_2TI\_04\_17</u># Notwithstanding the Lord stood with me, and strengthened me; that by me the preaching might be fully known, and [that] all the Gentiles might hear: and I was delivered out of the mouth of the lion.

fully known my <u>55\_2TI\_03\_10</u> # But thou hast fully known my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, charity, patience,

fully persuaded in <u>45\_ROM\_14\_05</u> # One man esteemeth one day above another: another esteemeth every day [alike]. Let every man be fully persuaded in his own mind.

fully persuaded that <u>45\_ROM\_04\_21</u># And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.

fully preached the <u>45\_ROM\_15\_19</u> # Through mighty signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God; so that from Jerusalem, and round about unto Illyricum, I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.

fully ripe 66\_REV\_14\_18 # And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

fully set in <u>21\_ECC\_08\_11</u># Because sentence against an evil work is not executed speedily, therefore the heart of the sons of men is fully set in them to do evil.

fully set up <u>04\_NUM\_07\_01</u># And it came to pass on the day that Moses had fully set up the tabernacle, and had anointed it, and sanctified it, and all the instruments thereof, both the altar and all the vessels thereof, and had anointed them, and sanctified them;

hatefully and shall <u>26\_EZE\_23\_29</u> # And they shall deal with thee hatefully, and shall take away all thy labour, and shall leave thee naked and bare: and the nakedness of thy whoredoms shall be discovered, both thy lewdness and thy whoredoms.

joyfully the spoiling <u>58\_HEB\_10\_34</u># For ye had compassion of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that ye have in heaven a better and an enduring substance.

joyfully with the <u>21\_ECC\_09\_09</u> # Live joyfully with the wife whom thou lovest all the days of the life of thy vanity, which he hath given thee under the sun, all the days of thy vanity: for that [is] thy portion in [this]

life, and in thy labour which thou takest under the sun.

joyfully 42\_LUK\_19\_06 # And he made haste, and came down, and received him joyfully.

lawfully 54\_1TI\_01\_08 # But we know that the law [is] good, if a man use it lawfully;

lawfully <u>55\_2TI\_02\_05</u># And if a man also strive for masteries, [yet] is he not crowned, except he strive lawfully.

mournfully before the <u>39\_MAL\_03\_14</u> # Ye have said, It [is] vain to serve God: and what profit [is it] that we have kept his ordinance, and that we have walked mournfully before the LORD of hosts?

plentifully declared the <u>18\_JOB\_26\_03</u> # How hast thou counselled [him that hath] no wisdom? and [how] hast thou plentifully declared the thing as it is?

plentifully rewardeth the 19\_PSA\_31\_23 # O love the LORD, all ye his saints: [for] the LORD preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer.

plentifully <u>42\_LUK\_12\_16</u> # And he spake a parable unto them, saying, The ground of a certain rich man brought forth plentifully:

reproachfully they have <u>18\_JOB\_16\_10</u> # They have gaped upon me with their mouth; they have smitten me upon the cheek reproachfully; they have gathered themselves together against me.

reproachfully <u>54\_1TI\_05\_14</u> # I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house, give none occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully.

shamefully and sent <u>42\_LUK\_20\_11</u># And again he sent another servant: and they beat him also, and entreated [him] shamefully, and sent [him] away empty.

shamefully entreated as <u>52\_1TH\_02\_02</u># But even after that we had suffered before, and were shamefully entreated, as ye know, at Philippi, we were bold in our God to speak unto you the gospel of God with much contention.

shamefully for she 28\_HOS\_02\_05 # For their mother hath played the harlot: she that conceived them hath done shamefully: for she said, I will go after my lovers, that give [me] my bread and my water, my wool and my flax, mine oil and my drink.

shamefully handled 41\_MAR\_12\_04 # And again he sent unto them another servant; and at him they cast stones, and wounded [him] in the head, and sent [him] away shamefully handled.

skilfully with a 19\_PSA\_33\_03 # Sing unto him a new song; play skilfully with a loud noise.

spitefully and slew <u>40\_MAT\_22\_06</u># And the remnant took his servants, and entreated [them] spitefully, and slew [them].

spitefully entreated and <u>42\_LUK\_18\_32</u> # For he shall be delivered unto the Gentiles, and shall be mocked, and spitefully entreated, and spitted on:

unfaithfully like their 19\_PSA\_78\_57 # But turned back, and dealt unfaithfully like their fathers: they were turned aside like a deceitful bow.

wilfully after that <u>58\_HEB\_10\_26</u> # For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,

wonderfully among them <u>09\_1SA\_06\_06</u># Wherefore then do ye harden your hearts, as the Egyptians and Pharaoh hardened their hearts? when he had wrought wonderfully among them, did they not let the people go, and they departed?

wonderfully and shall <u>27\_DAN\_08\_24</u># And his power shall be mighty, but not by his own power: and he shall destroy wonderfully, and shall prosper, and practice, and shall destroy the mighty and the holy people.

wonderfully made marvellous <u>19\_PSA\_139\_14</u> # I will praise thee; for I am fearfully [and] wonderfully made: marvellous [are] thy works; and [that] my soul knoweth right well.

wonderfully she had <u>25\_LAM\_01\_09</u># Her filthiness [is] in her skirts; she remembereth not her last end; therefore she came down wonderfully: she had no comforter. O LORD, behold my affliction: for the enemy hath magnified [himself].

wrongfully are mighty 19\_PSA\_69\_04 # They that hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of mine head: they that would destroy me, [being] mine enemies wrongfully, are mighty: then I restored [that] which I took not away.

wrongfully are multiplied <u>19\_PSA\_38\_19</u> # But mine enemies [are] lively, [and] they are strong: and they that hate me wrongfully are multiplied.

wrongfully help thou <u>19\_PSA\_119\_86</u># All thy commandments [are] faithful: they persecute me wrongfully; help thou me.

wrongfully imagine against <u>18\_JOB\_21\_27</u> # Behold, I know your thoughts, and the devices [which] ye wrongfully imagine against me.

wrongfully rejoice over 19 PSA 35 19 # Let not them that are mine enemies wrongfully rejoice over me: [neither] let them wink with the eye that hate me without a cause.

wrongfully 60\_1PE\_02\_19 # For this [is] thankworthy, if a man for conscience toward God endure grief, suffering wrongfully.

wrongfully <u>26\_EZE\_22\_29</u> # The people of the land have used oppression, and exercised robbery, and have vexed the poor and needy: yea, they have oppressed the stranger wrongfully.
