Gerar and Ahuzzath <u>01_GEN_26_26</u># Then Abimelech went to him from Gerar, and Ahuzzath one of his friends, and Phichol the chief captain of his army.

Gerar and dwelt 01_GEN_26_17# And Isaac departed thence, and pitched his tent in the valley of Gerar, and dwelt there.

Gerar and the <u>14_2CH_14_13</u> # And Asa and the people that [were] with him pursued them unto Gerar: and the Ethiopians were overthrown, that they could not recover themselves; for they were destroyed before the LORD, and before his host; and they carried away very much spoil.

Gerar unto Gaza <u>01_GEN_10_19</u># And the border of the Canaanites was from Sidon, as thou comest to Gerar, unto Gaza; as thou goest, unto Sodom, and Gomorrah, and Admah, and Zeboim, even unto Lasha.

Gerar <u>01_GEN_20_01</u># And Abraham journeyed from thence toward the south country, and dwelled between Kadesh and Shur, and sojourned in Gerar.
