

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Gibeah accompanying the <u>10_2SA_06_04</u> # And they brought it out of the house of Abinadab which [was] at Gibeah, accompanying the ark of God: and Ahio went before the ark.

Gibeah against the <u>28_HOS_10_09</u> # O Israel, thou hast sinned from the days of Gibeah: there they stood: the battle in Gibeah against the children of iniquity did not overtake them.

Gibeah and destroyed <u>07_JUD_20_21</u> # And the children of Benjamin came forth out of Gibeah, and destroyed down to the ground of the Israelites that day twenty and two thousand men.

Gibeah and the <u>28_HOS_05_08</u> # Blow ye the cornet in Gibeah, [and] the trumpet in Ramah: cry aloud [at] Bethaven, after thee, O Benjamin.

Gibeah and the <u>07_JUD_20_37</u># And the liers in wait hasted, and rushed upon Gibeah; and the liers in wait drew [themselves] along, and smote all the city with the edge of the sword.

Gibeah and there <u>09_1SA_10_26</u># And Saul also went home to Gibeah; and there went with him a band of men, whose hearts God had touched.

Gibeah And there <u>14_2CH_13_02</u> # He reigned three years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Michaiah the daughter of Uriel of Gibeah. And there was war between Abijah and Jeroboam.

Gibeah and Timnah <u>06_JOS_15_57</u># Cain, Gibeah, and Timnah; ten cities with their villages:

Gibeah and Uzzah <u>10_2SA_06_03</u> # And they set the ark of God upon a new cart, and brought it out of the house of Abinadab that [was] in Gibeah: and Uzzah and Ahio, the sons of Abinadab, drave the new cart.

Gibeah and when <u>07_JUD_19_15</u> # And they turned aside thither, to go in [and] to lodge in Gibeah: and when he went in, he sat him down in a street of the city: for [there was] no man that took them into his house to lodging.

Gibeah as at <u>07_JUD_20_30</u> # And the children of Israel went up against the children of Benjamin on the third day, and put themselves in array against Gibeah, as at other times.

Gibeah but the <u>07_JUD_19_16</u> # And, behold, there came an old man from his work out of the field at even, which [was] also of mount Ephraim; and he sojourned in Gibeah: but the men of the place [were] Benjamites.

Gibeah in the <u>07_JUD_20_31</u> # And the children of Benjamin went out against the people, [and] were drawn away from the city; and they began to smite of the people, [and] kill, as at other times, in the highways, of which one goeth up to the house of God, and the other to Gibeah in the field, about thirty men of Israel.

Gibeah of Benjamin <u>09_1SA_13_02</u> # Saul chose him three thousand [men] of Israel; [whereof] two thousand were with Saul in Michmash and in mount Bethel, and a thousand were with Jonathan in Gibeah of Benjamin: and the rest of the people he sent every man to his tent.

Gibeah of Benjamin <u>09_1SA_13_15</u> # And Samuel arose, and gat him up from Gilgal unto Gibeah of Benjamin. And Saul numbered the people [that were] present with him, about six hundred men.

Gibeah of Benjamin <u>09_1SA_13_16</u> # And Saul, and Jonathan his son, and the people [that were] present with them, abode in Gibeah of Benjamin: but the Philistines encamped in Michmash.

Gibeah of Benjamin <u>09_1SA_14_16</u> # And the watchmen of Saul in Gibeah of Benjamin looked; and, behold, the multitude melted away, and they went on beating down [one another].

Gibeah of Benjamin <u>07_JUD_20_10</u> # And we will take ten men of an hundred throughout all the tribes of Israel, and an hundred of a thousand, and a thousand out of ten thousand, to fetch victual for the people, that they may do, when they come to Gibeah of Benjamin, according to all the folly that they have wrought in Israel.

Gibeah of Saul <u>09_1SA_11_04</u># Then came the messengers to Gibeah of Saul, and told the tidings in the ears of the people: and all the people lifted up their voices, and wept.

Gibeah of Saul <u>09_18A_15_34</u># Then Samuel went to Ramah; and Saul went up to his house to Gibeah of Saul.

Gibeah of Saul <u>10_2SA_21_06</u># Let seven men of his sons be delivered unto us, and we will hang them up unto the LORD in Gibeah of Saul, [whom] the LORD did choose. And the king said, I will give [them].

Gibeah of Saul <u>23_ISA_10_29</u># They are gone over the passage: they have taken up their lodging at Geba; Ramah is afraid; Gibeah of Saul is fled.

Gibeah of the <u>10_2SA_23_29</u> # Heleb the son of Baanah, a Netophathite, Ittai the son of Ribai out of Gibeah of the children of Benjamin,

Gibeah or in <u>07_JUD_19_13</u> # And he said unto his servant, Come, and let us draw near to one of these places to lodge all night, in Gibeah, or in Ramah.

Gibeah rose against <u>07_JUD_20_05</u> # And the men of Gibeah rose against me, and beset the house round about upon me by night, [and] thought to have slain me: and my concubine have they forced, that she is dead.

Gibeah saying Doth <u>09_1SA_23_19</u># Then came up the Ziphites to Saul to Gibeah, saying, Doth not David hide himself with us in strong holds in the wood, in the hill of Hachilah, which [is] on the south of Jeshimon?

Gibeah saying Doth <u>09_1SA_26_01</u># And the Ziphites came unto Saul to Gibeah, saying, Doth not David hide himself in the hill of Hachilah, [which is] before Jeshimon?

Gibeah ten thousand <u>07_JUD_20_34</u> # And there came against Gibeah ten thousand chosen men out of all Israel, and the battle was sore: but they knew not that evil [was] near them.

Gibeah that belongeth <u>07_JUD_20_04</u> # And the Levite, the husband of the woman that was slain, answered and said, I came into Gibeah that [belongeth] to Benjamin, I and my concubine, to lodge.

Gibeah that pertained <u>13_1CH_11_31</u># Ithai the son of Ribai of Gibeah, [that pertained] to the children of Benjamin, Benaiah the Pirathonite,

Gibeah that we <u>07_JUD_20_13</u> # Now therefore deliver [us] the men, the children of Belial, which [are] in Gibeah, that we may put them to death, and put away evil from Israel. But the children of Benjamin would not hearken to the voice of their brethren the children of Israel:

Gibeah the second <u>07_JUD_20_25</u> # And Benjamin went forth against them out of Gibeah the second day,

and destroyed down to the ground of the children of Israel again eighteen thousand men; all these drew the sword.

Gibeah there they <u>28_HOS_10_09</u> # O Israel, thou hast sinned from the days of Gibeah: there they stood: the battle in Gibeah against the children of iniquity did not overtake them.

Gibeah therefore he <u>28_HOS_09_09</u> # They have deeply corrupted [themselves], as in the days of Gibeah: [therefore] he will remember their iniquity, he will visit their sins.

Gibeah to go <u>07_JUD_20_14</u> # But the children of Benjamin gathered themselves together out of the cities unto Gibeah, to go out to battle against the children of Israel.

Gibeah toward the <u>07_JUD_20_43</u># [Thus] they enclosed the Benjamites round about, [and] chased them, [and] trode them down with ease over against Gibeah toward the sunrising.

Gibeah under a <u>09_1SA_14_02</u># And Saul tarried in the uttermost part of Gibeah under a pomegranate tree which [is] in Migron: and the people that [were] with him [were] about six hundred men;

Gibeah under a <u>09_1SA_22_06</u># When Saul heard that David was discovered, and the men that [were] with him, [now Saul abode in Gibeah under a tree in Ramah, having his spear in his hand, and all his servants [were] standing about him;]

Gibeah we will <u>07_JUD_20_09</u># But now this [shall be] the thing which we will do to Gibeah; [we will go up] by lot against it;

Gibeah which belongeth <u>07_JUD_19_14</u> # And they passed on and went their way; and the sun went down upon them [when they were] by Gibeah, which [belongeth] to Benjamin.

Gibeah which were <u>07_JUD_20_15</u> # And the children of Benjamin were numbered at that time out of the cities twenty and six thousand men that drew sword, beside the inhabitants of Gibeah, which were numbered seven hundred chosen men.

Gibeah <u>09_1SA_14_05</u> # The forefront of the one [was] situate northward over against Michmash, and the other southward over against Gibeah.

Gibeah <u>07_JUD_19_12</u> # And his master said unto him, We will not turn aside hither into the city of a stranger, that [is] not of the children of Israel; we will pass over to Gibeah.

Gibeah <u>07_JUD_20_19</u># And the children of Israel rose up in the morning, and encamped against Gibeah.

Gibeah <u>07_JUD_20_20</u> # And the men of Israel went out to battle against Benjamin; and the men of Israel put themselves in array to fight against them at Gibeah.

Gibeah 07_JUD_20_29 # And Israel set liers in wait round about Gibeah.

Gibeah <u>07_JUD_20_33</u># And all the men of Israel rose up out of their place, and put themselves in array at Baaltamar: and the liers in wait of Israel came forth out of their places, [even] out of the meadows of Gibeah.

Gibeah <u>07_JUD_20_36</u># So the children of Benjamin saw that they were smitten: for the men of Israel gave place to the Benjamites, because they trusted unto the liers in wait which they had set beside Gibeah.
