

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Gibeon all other <u>06\_JOS\_11\_19</u># There was not a city that made peace with the children of Israel, save the Hivites the inhabitants of Gibeon: all [other] they took in battle.

Gibeon Amasa went 10 2SA 20 08 # When they [were] at the great stone which [is] in Gibeon, Amasa went before them. And Joab's garment that he had put on was girded unto him, and upon it a girdle [with] a sword fastened upon his loins in the sheath thereof; and as he went forth it fell out.

Gibeon and chased <u>06\_JOS\_10\_10</u># And the LORD discomfited them before Israel, and slew them with a great slaughter at Gibeon, and chased them along the way that goeth up to Bethhoron, and smote them to Azekah, and unto Makkedah.

Gibeon and Chephirah <u>06\_JOS\_09\_17</u># And the children of Israel journeyed, and came unto their cities on the third day. Now their cities [were] Gibeon, and Chephirah, and Beeroth, and Kirjathjearim.

Gibeon and made <u>06\_JOS\_10\_05</u> # Therefore the five kings of the Amorites, the king of Jerusalem, the king of Hebron, the king of Jarmuth, the king of Lachish, the king of Eglon, gathered themselves together, and went up, they and all their hosts, and encamped before Gibeon, and made war against it.

Gibeon and of <u>16\_NEH\_03\_07</u># And next unto them repaired Melatiah the Gibeonite, and Jadon the Meronothite, the men of Gibeon, and of Mizpah, unto the throne of the governor on this side the river.

Gibeon and Ramah 06\_JOS\_18\_25 # Gibeon, and Ramah, and Beeroth,

Gibeon and they 10\_2SA\_02\_13 # And Joab the son of Zeruiah, and the servants of David, went out, and met together by the pool of Gibeon: and they sat down, the one on the one side of the pool, and the other on the other side of the pool.

Gibeon and thou <u>06\_JOS\_10\_12</u> # Then spake Joshua to the LORD in the day when the LORD delivered up the Amorites before the children of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel, Sun, stand thou still upon Gibeon; and thou, Moon, in the valley of Ajalon.

Gibeon dwelt the <u>13\_1CH\_08\_29</u> # And at Gibeon dwelt the father of Gibeon; whose wife's name [was] Maachah:

Gibeon dwelt the 13\_1CH\_09\_35 # And in Gibeon dwelt the father of Gibeon, Jehiel, whose wife's name [was] Maachah:

Gibeon even to 13\_1CH\_14\_16 # David therefore did as God commanded him: and they smote the host of the Philistines from Gibeon even to Gazer.

Gibeon for it <u>06\_JOS\_10\_04</u> # Come up unto me, and help me, that we may smite Gibeon: for it hath made peace with Joshua and with the children of Israel.

Gibeon for there <u>14\_2CH\_01\_03</u> # So Solomon, and all the congregation with him, went to the high place that [was] at Gibeon; for there was the tabernacle of the congregation of God, which Moses the servant of the LORD had made in the wilderness.

Gibeon had made 06\_JOS\_10\_01 # Now it came to pass, when Adonizedek king of Jerusalem had heard

how Joshua had taken Ai, and had utterly destroyed it; as he had done to Jericho and her king, so he had done to Ai and her king; and how the inhabitants of Gibeon had made peace with Israel, and were among them;

Gibeon heard what <u>06\_JOS\_09\_03</u># And when the inhabitants of Gibeon heard what Joshua had done unto Jericho and to Ai,

Gibeon in the <u>10\_2SA\_03\_30</u> # So Joab and Abishai his brother slew Abner, because he had slain their brother Asahel at Gibeon in the battle.

Gibeon Jehiel whose <u>13\_1CH\_09\_35</u> # And in Gibeon dwelt the father of Gibeon, Jehiel, whose wife's name [was] Maachah:

Gibeon ninety and 16\_NEH\_07\_25 # The children of Gibeon, ninety and five.

Gibeon sent unto <u>06\_JOS\_10\_06</u># And the men of Gibeon sent unto Joshua to the camp to Gilgal, saying, Slack not thy hand from thy servants; come up to us quickly, and save us, and help us: for all the kings of the Amorites that dwell in the mountains are gathered together against us.

Gibeon spake unto 24\_JER\_28\_01# And it came to pass the same year, in the beginning of the reign of Zedekiah king of Judah, in the fourth year, [and] in the fifth month, [that] Hananiah the son of Azur the prophet, which [was] of Gibeon, spake unto me in the house of the LORD, in the presence of the priests and of all the people, saying,

Gibeon that he 23\_ISA\_28\_21 # For the LORD shall rise up as [in] mount Perazim, he shall be wroth as [in] the valley of Gibeon, that he may do his work, his strange work; and bring to pass his act, his strange act.

Gibeon the LORD <u>11\_1KI\_03\_05</u># In Gibeon the LORD appeared to Solomon in a dream by night: and God said, Ask what I shall give thee.

Gibeon to Jerusalem 14\_2CH\_01\_13 # Then Solomon came [from his journey] to the high place that [was] at Gibeon to Jerusalem, from before the tabernacle of the congregation, and reigned over Israel.

Gibeon to sacrifice 11\_1KI\_03\_04 # And the king went to Gibeon to sacrifice there; for that [was] the great high place: a thousand burnt offerings did Solomon offer upon that altar.

Gibeon was a <u>06\_JOS\_10\_02</u> # That they feared greatly, because Gibeon [was] a great city, as one of the royal cities, and because it [was] greater than Ai, and all the men thereof [were] mighty.

Gibeon whose wife's 13\_1CH\_08\_29 # And at Gibeon dwelt the father of Gibeon; whose wife's name [was] Maachah:

Gibeon with her <u>06\_JOS\_21\_17</u># And out of the tribe of Benjamin, Gibeon with her suburbs, Geba with her suburbs,

Gibeon <u>13\_1CH\_16\_39</u> # And Zadok the priest, and his brethren the priests, before the tabernacle of the LORD in the high place that [was] at Gibeon,

Gibeon 13\_1CH\_21\_29 # For the tabernacle of the LORD, which Moses made in the wilderness, and the altar of the burnt offering, [were] at that season in the high place at Gibeon.

Gibeon <u>11\_1KI\_09\_02</u># That the LORD appeared to Solomon the second time, as he had appeared unto him at Gibeon.

Gibeon 10\_2SA\_02\_12 # And Abner the son of Ner, and the servants of Ishbosheth the son of Saul, went out

from Mahanaim to Gibeon.

Gibeon <u>10\_2SA\_02\_16</u># And they caught every one his fellow by the head, and [thrust] his sword in his fellow's side; so they fell down together: wherefore that place was called Helkathhazzurim, which [is] in Gibeon.

Gibeon 10\_2SA\_02\_24 # Joab also and Abishai pursued after Abner: and the sun went down when they were come to the hill of Ammah, that [lieth] before Giah by the way of the wilderness of Gibeon.

Gibeon 24\_JER\_41\_12 # Then they took all the men, and went to fight with Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and found him by the great waters that [are] in Gibeon.

Gibeon 24\_JER\_41\_16 # Then took Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces that [were] with him, all the remnant of the people whom he had recovered from Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, from Mizpah, after [that] he had slain Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, [even] mighty men of war, and the women, and the children, and the eunuchs, whom he had brought again from Gibeon:

Gibeon <u>06\_JOS\_10\_41</u> # And Joshua smote them from Kadeshbarnea even unto Gaza, and all the country of Goshen, even unto Gibeon.

Gibeonite a mighty 13\_1CH\_12\_04 # And Ismaiah the Gibeonite, a mighty man among the thirty, and over the thirty; and Jeremiah, and Jahaziel, and Johanan, and Josabad the Gederathite,

Gibeonite and Jadon <u>16\_NEH\_03\_07</u> # And next unto them repaired Melatiah the Gibeonite, and Jadon the Meronothite, the men of Gibeon, and of Mizpah, unto the throne of the governor on this side the river.

Gibeonites and said 10\_2SA\_21\_02 # And the king called the Gibeonites, and said unto them; [now the Gibeonites [were] not of the children of Israel, but of the remnant of the Amorites; and the children of Israel had sworn unto them: and Saul sought to slay them in his zeal to the children of Israel and Judah.]

Gibeonites and they <u>10\_2SA\_21\_09</u># And he delivered them into the hands of the Gibeonites, and they hanged them in the hill before the LORD: and they fell [all] seven together, and were put to death in the days of harvest, in the first [days], in the beginning of barley harvest.

Gibeonites said unto 10\_2SA\_21\_04 # And the Gibeonites said unto him, We will have no silver nor gold of Saul, nor of his house; neither for us shalt thou kill any man in Israel. And he said, What ye shall say, [that] will I do for you.

Gibeonites were not 10\_2SA\_21\_02 # And the king called the Gibeonites, and said unto them; [now the Gibeonites [were] not of the children of Israel, but of the remnant of the Amorites; and the children of Israel had sworn unto them: and Saul sought to slay them in his zeal to the children of Israel and Judah.]

Gibeonites What shall <u>10\_2SA\_21\_03</u># Wherefore David said unto the Gibeonites, What shall I do for you? and wherewith shall I make the atonement, that ye may bless the inheritance of the LORD?

Gibeonites <u>10\_2SA\_21\_01</u> # Then there was a famine in the days of David three years, year after year; and David inquired of the LORD. And the LORD answered, [It is] for Saul, and for [his] bloody house, because he slew the Gibeonites.
