

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Greek a Syrophenician 41 MAR 07 26 # The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and she besought him that he would cast forth the devil out of her daughter.

Greek and Latin 43 JOH 19 20 # This title then read many of the Jews: for the place where Jesus was crucified was nigh to the city: and it was written in Hebrew, [and] Greek, [and] Latin.

Greek and Latin 42 LUK 23 38 # And a superscription also was written over him in letters of Greek, and Latin, and Hebrew, THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS.

Greek for the 45 ROM 10 12 # For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek; for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him.

Greek nor Jew 51 COL 03 11# Where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond [nor] free: but Christ [is] all, and in all.

Greek there is 48 GAL 03 28 # There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.

Greek tongue hath 66 REV 09 11 # And they had a king over them, [which is] the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue [is] Abaddon, but in the Greek tongue hath [his] name Apollyon.

Greek was compelled 48 GAL 02 03 # But neither Titus, who was with me, being a Greek, was compelled to be circumcised:

Greek 44 ACT 16 01 # Then came he to Derbe and Lystra: and, behold, a certain disciple was there, named Timotheus, the son of a certain woman, which was a Jewess, and believed; but his father [was] a Greek:

Greek 44 ACT 16 03 # Him would Paul have to go forth with him; and took and circumcised him because of the Jews which were in those quarters: for they knew all that his father was a Greek.

Greek 44 ACT 21 37 # And as Paul was to be led into the castle, he said unto the chief captain, May I speak unto thee? Who said, Canst thou speak Greek?

Greek 45 ROM 01 16 # For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Greeks a great 44 ACT 17 04# And some of them believed, and consorted with Paul and Silas; and of the devout Greeks a great multitude, and of the chief women not a few.

Greeks also dwelling 44 ACT 19 17 # And this was known to all the Jews and Greeks also dwelling at Ephesus; and fear fell on them all, and the name of the Lord Jesus was magnified.

Greeks also into 44 ACT 21 28 Crying out, Men of Israel, help: This is the man, that teacheth all [men] every where against the people, and the law, and this place: and further brought Greeks also into the temple, and hath polluted this holy place.

Greeks among them 43 JOH 12 20 # And there were certain Greeks among them that came up to worship at the feast:

Greeks and of 44 ACT 17 12 #Therefore many of them believed; also of honourable women which were Greeks, and of men, not a few.

Greeks and to 45 ROM 01 14#I am debtor both to the Greeks, and to the Barbarians; both to the wise, and to the unwise.

Greeks believed 44 ACT 14 01 # And it came to pass in Iconium, that they went both together into the synagogue of the Jews, and so spake, that a great multitude both of the Jews and also of the Greeks believed.

Greeks Christ the 46 1CO 01 24# But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God.

Greeks foolishness 46 1CO 01 23 # But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness;

Greeks repentance toward 44 ACT 20 21 # Testifying both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, repentance toward God, and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ.

Greeks seek after 46 1CO 01 22 # For the Jews require a sign, and the Greeks seek after wisdom:

Greeks took Sosthenes 44 ACT 18 17 # Then all the Greeks took Sosthenes, the chief ruler of the synagogue, and beat [him] before the judgment seat. And Gallio cared for none of those things.

Greeks 44 ACT 18 04 # And he reasoned in the synagogue every sabbath, and persuaded the Jews and the Greeks.

Greeks 44 ACT 19 10 # And this continued by the space of two years; so that all they which dwelt in Asia heard the word of the Lord Jesus, both Jews and Greeks.
