glass darkly but 46\_1CO\_13\_12 # For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.

glass having the 66 REV\_15\_02 # And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, [and] over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God.

glass like unto <u>66\_REV\_04\_06</u> # And before the throne [there was] a sea of glass like unto crystal: and in the midst of the throne, and round about the throne, [were] four beasts full of eyes before and behind.

glass mingled with <u>66\_REV\_15\_02</u> # And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, [and] over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God.

glass the glory <u>47\_2CO\_03\_18</u># But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, [even] as by the Spirit of the Lord.

glass <u>59\_JAM\_01\_23</u># For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass:

glass <u>18\_JOB\_37\_18</u># Hast thou with him spread out the sky, [which is] strong, [and] as a molten looking glass?

glass <u>66\_REV\_21\_18</u># And the building of the wall of it was [of] jasper: and the city [was] pure gold, like unto clear glass.
