governor against Paul <u>44_ACT_24_01</u> # And after five days Ananias the high priest descended with the elders, and [with] a certain orator [named] Tertullus, who informed the governor against Paul.

governor among the <u>19_PSA_22_28</u># For the kingdom [is] the LORD'S: and he [is] the governor among the nations.

governor and Bernice <u>44_ACT_26_30</u> # And when he had thus spoken, the king rose up, and the governor, and Bernice, and they that sat with them:

governor and of <u>16_NEH_12_26</u># These [were] in the days of Joiakim the son of Jeshua, the son of Jozadak, and in the days of Nehemiah the governor, and of Ezra the priest, the scribe.

governor and the <u>40_MAT_27_11</u># And Jesus stood before the governor: and the governor asked him, saying, Art thou the King of the Jews? And Jesus said unto him, Thou sayest.

governor and Zadok <u>13_1CH_29_22</u> # And did eat and drink before the LORD on that day with great gladness. And they made Solomon the son of David king the second time, and anointed [him] unto the LORD [to be] the chief governor, and Zadok [to be] priest.

governor answered and <u>40_MAT_27_21</u># The governor answered and said unto them, Whether of the twain will ye that I release unto you? They said, Barabbas.

governor asked him <u>40_MAT_27_11</u># And Jesus stood before the governor: and the governor asked him, saying, Art thou the King of the Jews? And Jesus said unto him, Thou sayest.

governor because the <u>16_NEH_05_18</u> # Now [that] which was prepared [for me] daily [was] one ox [and] six choice sheep; also fowls were prepared for me, and once in ten days store of all sorts of wine: yet for all this required not I the bread of the governor, because the bondage was heavy upon this people.

governor beyond the <u>15_EZR_06_06</u># Now [therefore], Tatnai, governor beyond the river, Shetharboznai, and your companions the Apharsachites, which [are] beyond the river, be ye far from thence:

governor Felix sendeth <u>44_ACT_23_26</u># Claudius Lysias unto the most excellent governor Felix [sendeth] greeting.

governor had beckoned <u>44_ACT_24_10</u> # Then Paul, after that the governor had beckoned unto him to speak, answered, Forasmuch as I know that thou hast been of many years a judge unto this nation, I do the more cheerfully answer for myself:

governor had read <u>44_ACT_23_34</u> # And when the governor had read [the letter], he asked of what province he was. And when he understood that [he was] of Cilicia;

governor in all <u>14_2CH_01_02</u> # Then Solomon spake unto all Israel, to the captains of thousands and of hundreds, and to the judges, and to every governor in all Israel, the chief of the fathers.

governor in Judah <u>38_ZEC_09_07</u> # And I will take away his blood out of his mouth, and his abominations from between his teeth: but he that remaineth, even he, [shall be] for our God, and he shall be as a governor in Judah, and Ekron as a Jebusite.

governor in the <u>24_JER_20_01</u># Now Pashur the son of Immer the priest, who [was] also chief governor in the house of the LORD, heard that Jeremiah prophesied these things.

governor in the <u>24_JER_40_07</u> # Now when all the captains of the forces which [were] in the fields, [even] they and their men, heard that the king of Babylon had made Gedaliah the son of Ahikam governor in the land, and had committed unto him men, and women, and children, and of the poor of the land, of them that were not carried away captive to Babylon;

governor in the <u>24_JER_41_18</u># Because of the Chaldeans: for they were afraid of them, because Ishmael the son of Nethaniah had slain Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, whom the king of Babylon made governor in the land.

governor in the <u>16_NEH_05_14</u> # Moreover from the time that I was appointed to be their governor in the land of Judah, from the twentieth year even unto the two and thirtieth year of Artaxerxes the king, [that is], twelve years, I and my brethren have not eaten the bread of the governor.

governor listeth <u>59_JAM_03_04</u># Behold also the ships, which though [they be] so great, and [are] driven of fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small helm, whithersoever the governor listeth.

governor marvelled greatly <u>40_MAT_27_14</u># And he answered him to never a word; insomuch that the governor marvelled greatly.

governor of his <u>11_1KI_18_03</u># And Ahab called Obadiah, which [was] the governor of [his] house. [Now Obadiah feared the LORD greatly:

governor of Judaea <u>42_LUK_03_01</u> # Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being governor of Judaea, and Herod being tetrarch of Galilee, and his brother Philip tetrarch of Ituraea and of the region of Trachonitis, and Lysanias the tetrarch of Abilene,

governor of Judah <u>37_HAG_01_01</u> # In the second year of Darius the king, in the sixth month, in the first day of the month, came the word of the LORD by Haggai the prophet unto Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, saying,

governor of Judah <u>37_HAG_01_14</u> # And the LORD stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, and the spirit of all the remnant of the people; and they came and did work in the house of the LORD of hosts, their God,

governor of Judah <u>37_HAG_02_02</u># Speak now to Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, and to the residue of the people, saying,

governor of Judah <u>37_HAG_02_21</u># Speak to Zerubbabel, governor of Judah, saying, I will shake the heavens and the earth;

governor of Syria <u>42_LUK_02_02</u> # [[And] this taxing was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.]

governor of the <u>11_1KI_22_26</u># And the king of Israel said, Take Micaiah, and carry him back unto Amon the governor of the city, and to Joash the king's son;

governor of the <u>14_2CH_18_25</u> # Then the king of Israel said, Take ye Micaiah, and carry him back to Amon the governor of the city, and to Joash the king's son;

governor of the <u>14_2CH_28_07</u> # And Zichri, a mighty man of Ephraim, slew Maaseiah the king's son, and Azrikam the governor of the house, and Elkanah [that was] next to the king.

governor of the <u>14_2CH_34_08</u># Now in the eighteenth year of his reign, when he had purged the land, and the house, he sent Shaphan the son of Azaliah, and Maaseiah the governor of the city, and Joah the son of Joahaz the recorder, to repair the house of the LORD his God.

governor of the <u>12_2KI_23_08</u> # And he brought all the priests out of the cities of Judah, and defiled the high places where the priests had burned incense, from Geba to Beersheba, and brake down the high places of the gates that [were] in the entering in of the gate of Joshua the governor of the city, which [were] on a man's left hand at the gate of the city.

governor of the <u>15_EZR_06_07</u> # Let the work of this house of God alone; let the governor of the Jews and the elders of the Jews build this house of God in his place.

governor of the <u>43_JOH_02_08</u># And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare [it].

governor of the <u>43_JOH_02_09</u> # When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: [but the servants which drew the water knew;] the governor of the feast called the bridegroom,

governor on this <u>15_EZR_05_03</u> # At the same time came to them Tatnai, governor on this side the river, and Shetharboznai, and their companions, and said thus unto them, Who hath commanded you to build this house, and to make up this wall?

governor on this <u>15_EZR_05_06</u> # The copy of the letter that Tatnai, governor on this side the river, and Shetharboznai, and his companions the Apharsachites, which [were] on this side the river, sent unto Darius the king:

governor on this <u>15_EZR_06_13</u># Then Tatnai, governor on this side the river, Shetharboznai, and their companions, according to that which Darius the king had sent, so they did speedily.

governor on this <u>16_NEH_03_07</u> # And next unto them repaired Melatiah the Gibeonite, and Jadon the Meronothite, the men of Gibeon, and of Mizpah, unto the throne of the governor on this side the river.

governor over all <u>01_GEN_45_26</u> # And told him, saying, Joseph [is] yet alive, and he [is] governor over all the land of Egypt. And Jacob's heart fainted, for he believed them not.

governor over Egypt <u>44_ACT_07_10</u> # And delivered him out of all his afflictions, and gave him favour and wisdom in the sight of Pharaoh king of Egypt; and he made him governor over Egypt and all his house.

governor over the <u>01_GEN_42_06</u># And Joseph [was] the governor over the land, [and] he [it was] that sold to all the people of the land: and Joseph's brethren came, and bowed down themselves before him [with] their faces to the earth.

governor over the 24_JER_40_05 # Now while he was not yet gone back, [he said], Go back also to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, whom the king of Babylon hath made governor over the cities of Judah, and dwell with him among the people: or go wheresoever it seemeth convenient unto thee to go. So the captain of the guard gave him victuals and a reward, and let him go.

governor over the <u>24_JER_41_02</u> # Then arose Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and the ten men that were with him, and smote Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan with the sword, and slew him, whom the king of Babylon had made governor over the land.

governor presented Paul <u>44_ACT_23_33</u> # Who, when they came to Caesarea, and delivered the epistle to the governor, presented Paul also before him.

governor said Why <u>40_MAT_27_23</u># And the governor said, Why, what evil hath he done? But they cried out the more, saying, Let him be crucified.

governor shall proceed <u>24_JER_30_21</u> # And their nobles shall be of themselves, and their governor shall proceed from the midst of them; and I will cause him to draw near, and he shall approach unto me: for who [is] this that engaged his heart to approach unto me? saith the LORD.

Governor that shall <u>40_MAT_02_06</u># And thou Bethlehem, [in] the land of Juda, art not the least among the princes of Juda: for out of thee shall come a Governor, that shall rule my people Israel.

governor there came <u>12_2KI_25_23</u> # And when all the captains of the armies, they and their men, heard that the king of Babylon had made Gedaliah governor, there came to Gedaliah to Mizpah, even Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and Johanan the son of Careah, and Seraiah the son of Tanhumeth the Netophathite, and Jaazaniah the son of a Maachathite, they and their men.

governor took Jesus <u>40 MAT_27_27</u># Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus into the common hall, and gathered unto him the whole band [of soldiers].

governor under Aretas <u>47_2CO_11_32</u># In Damascus the governor under Aretas the king kept the city of the Damascenes with a garrison, desirous to apprehend me:

governor was wont <u>40_MAT_27_15</u># Now at [that] feast the governor was wont to release unto the people a prisoner, whom they would.

governor will he <u>39 MAL_01_08</u> # And if ye offer the blind for sacrifice, [is it] not evil? and if ye offer the lame and sick, [is it] not evil? offer it now unto thy governor; will he be pleased with thee, or accept thy person? saith the LORD of hosts.

governor <u>44_ACT_23_24</u> # And provide [them] beasts, that they may set Paul on, and bring [him] safe unto Felix the governor.

governor <u>15_EZR_05_14</u> # And the vessels also of gold and silver of the house of God, which Nebuchadnezzar took out of the temple that [was] in Jerusalem, and brought them into the temple of Babylon, those did Cyrus the king take out of the temple of Babylon, and they were delivered unto [one], whose name [was] Sheshbazzar, whom he had made governor;

governor <u>42_LUK_20_20</u> # And they watched [him], and sent forth spies, which should feign themselves just men, that they might take hold of his words, that so they might deliver him unto the power and authority of the governor.

governor <u>40_MAT_27_02</u># And when they had bound him, they led [him] away, and delivered him to Pontius Pilate the governor.

governor <u>16_NEH_05_14</u> # Moreover from the time that I was appointed to be their governor in the land of Judah, from the twentieth year even unto the two and thirtieth year of Artaxerxes the king, [that is], twelve years, I and my brethren have not eaten the bread of the governor.

governor's ears we <u>40_MAT_28_14</u># And if this come to the governor's ears, we will persuade him, and secure you.

governors and captains <u>27_DAN_03_03</u># Then the princes, the governors, and captains, the judges, the treasurers, the counsellors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, were gathered together unto the dedication of the image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up; and they stood before the image that Nebuchadnezzar had set up.

governors and captains <u>27_DAN_03_27</u> # And the princes, governors, and captains, and the king's counsellors, being gathered together, saw these men, upon whose bodies the fire had no power, nor was an hair of their head singed, neither were their coats changed, nor the smell of fire had passed on them.

governors and kings <u>40_MAT_10_18</u># And ye shall be brought before governors and kings for my sake, for a testimony against them and the Gentiles.

governors and out <u>07_JUD_05_14</u># Out of Ephraim [was there] a root of them against Amalek; after thee, Benjamin, among thy people; out of Machir came down governors, and out of Zebulun they that handle the pen of the writer.

governors and the <u>27_DAN_03_02</u> # Then Nebuchadnezzar the king sent to gather together the princes, the governors, and the captains, the judges, the treasurers, the counsellors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, to come to the dedication of the image which Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up.

governors and the <u>27_DAN_06_07</u> # All the presidents of the kingdom, the governors, and the princes, the counsellors, and the captains, have consulted together to establish a royal statute, and to make a firm decree, that whosoever shall ask a petition of any God or man for thirty days, save of thee, O king, he shall be cast into the den of lions.

governors as unto <u>60_1PE_02_14</u> # Or unto governors, as unto them that are sent by him for the punishment of evildoers, and for the praise of them that do well.

governors beyond the <u>16_NEH_02_07</u> # Moreover I said unto the king, If it please the king, let letters be given me to the governors beyond the river, that they may convey me over till I come into Judah;

governors beyond the <u>16_NEH_02_09</u># Then I came to the governors beyond the river, and gave them the king's letters. Now the king had sent captains of the army and horsemen with me.

governors of Israel <u>07_JUD_05_09</u> # My heart [is] toward the governors of Israel, that offered themselves willingly among the people. Bless ye the LORD.

governors of Judah <u>38_ZEC_12_05</u># And the governors of Judah shall say in their heart, The inhabitants of Jerusalem [shall be] my strength in the LORD of hosts their God.

governors of Judah <u>38_ZEC_12_06</u> # In that day will I make the governors of Judah like an hearth of fire among the wood, and like a torch of fire in a sheaf; and they shall devour all the people round about, on the right hand and on the left: and Jerusalem shall be inhabited again in her own place, [even] in Jerusalem.

governors of the <u>13_1CH_24_05</u># Thus were they divided by lot, one sort with another; for the governors of the sanctuary, and governors [of the house] of God, were of the sons of Eleazar, and of the sons of Ithamar.

governors of the 14_2CH_23_20 # And he took the captains of hundreds, and the nobles, and the governors

of the people, and all the people of the land, and brought down the king from the house of the LORD: and they came through the high gate into the king's house, and set the king upon the throne of the kingdom.

governors on this <u>15_EZR_08_36</u> # And they delivered the king's commissions unto the king's lieutenants, and to the governors on this side the river: and they furthered the people, and the house of God.

governors over all <u>27_DAN_02_48</u># Then the king made Daniel a great man, and gave him many great gifts, and made him ruler over the whole province of Babylon, and chief of the governors over all the wise [men] of Babylon.

governors that had <u>16 NEH_05_15</u> # But the former governors that [had been] before me were chargeable unto the people, and had taken of them bread and wine, beside forty shekels of silver; yea, even their servants bare rule over the people: but so did not I, because of the fear of God.

governors that were <u>17_EST_03_12</u> # Then were the king's scribes called on the thirteenth day of the first month, and there was written according to all that Haman had commanded unto the king's lieutenants, and to the governors that [were] over every province, and to the rulers of every people of every province according to the writing thereof, and [to] every people after their language; in the name of king Ahasuerus was it written, and sealed with the king's ring.

governors until the <u>48_GAL_04_02</u> # But is under tutors and governors until the time appointed of the father.
