

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

guard a servant 12 2KI 25 08 # And in the fifth month, on the seventh [day] of the month, which [is] the nineteenth year of king Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, came Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard, a servant of the king of Babylon, unto Jerusalem:

guard an Egyptian <u>01\_GEN\_39\_01</u># And Joseph was brought down to Egypt; and Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh, captain of the guard, an Egyptian, bought him of the hands of the Ishmeelites, which had brought him down thither.

guard and all 12 2KI 11 19 # And he took the rulers over hundreds, and the captains, and the guard, and all the people of the land; and they brought down the king from the house of the LORD, and came by the way of the guard to the king's house. And he sat on the throne of the kings.

guard and brought 12 2KI 11 04 # And the seventh year Jehoiada sent and fetched the rulers over hundreds, with the captains and the guard, and brought them to him into the house of the LORD, and made a covenant with them, and took an oath of them in the house of the LORD, and showed them the king's son.

guard away 24\_JER\_52\_19 # And the basins, and the firepans, and the bowls, and the caldrons, and the candlesticks, and the spoons, and the cups; [that] which [was] of gold [in] gold, and [that] which [was] of silver [in] silver, took the captain of the guard away.

guard bare them <u>11\_1KI\_14\_28</u># And it was [so], when the king went into the house of the LORD, that the guard bare them, and brought them back into the guard chamber.

guard brake down 12\_2KI\_25\_10 # And all the army of the Chaldees, that [were with] the captain of the guard, brake down the walls of Jerusalem round about.

guard brake down <u>24\_JER\_52\_14</u> # And all the army of the Chaldeans, that [were] with the captain of the guard, brake down all the walls of Jerusalem round about.

guard but Paul 44\_ACT\_28\_16 # And when we came to Rome, the centurion delivered the prisoners to the

captain of the guard: but Paul was suffered to dwell by himself with a soldier that kept him.

guard came and <a href="14">14</a> 2CH\_12\_11 # And when the king entered into the house of the LORD, the guard came and fetched them, and brought them again into the guard chamber.

guard carried away 24\_JER\_39\_09 # Then Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive into Babylon the remnant of the people that remained in the city, and those that fell away, that fell to him, with the rest of the people that remained.

guard carried away <u>24\_JER\_52\_15</u># Then Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive [certain] of the poor of the people, and the residue of the people that remained in the city, and those that fell away, that fell to the king of Babylon, and the rest of the multitude.

guard carried away <u>24\_JER\_52\_30</u># In the three and twentieth year of Nebuchadrezzar Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive of the Jews seven hundred forty and five persons: all the persons [were] four thousand and six hundred.

guard carry away 12 2KI 25 11 # Now the rest of the people [that were] left in the city, and the fugitives that fell away to the king of Babylon, with the remnant of the multitude, did Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carry away.

guard chamber 11\_1KI\_14\_28# And it was [so], when the king went into the house of the LORD, that the guard bare them, and brought them back into the guard chamber.

guard chamber 14\_2CH\_12\_11# And when the king entered into the house of the LORD, the guard came and fetched them, and brought them again into the guard chamber.

guard charged Joseph <u>01\_GEN\_40\_04</u> # And the captain of the guard charged Joseph with them, and he served them: and they continued a season in ward.

guard gave him 24\_JER\_40\_05 # Now while he was not yet gone back, [he said], Go back also to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, whom the king of Babylon hath made governor over the cities of Judah, and dwell with him among the people: or go wheresoever it seemeth convenient unto thee to go. So the captain of the guard gave him victuals and a reward, and let him go.

guard had committed 24\_JER\_41\_10 # Then Ishmael carried away captive all the residue of the people that [were] in Mizpah, [even] the king's daughters, and all the people that remained in Mizpah, whom Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had committed to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam: and Ishmael the son of Nethaniah carried them away captive, and departed to go over to the Ammonites.

guard had left <u>24\_JER\_43\_06</u># [Even] men, and women, and children, and the king's daughters, and every person that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had left with Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Jeremiah the prophet, and Baruch the son of Neriah.

guard had let <u>24\_JER\_40\_01</u> # The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD, after that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had let him go from Ramah, when he had taken him being bound in chains among all that were carried away captive of Jerusalem and Judah, which were carried away captive unto Babylon.

guard into the <u>01\_GEN\_40\_03</u> # And he put them in ward in the house of the captain of the guard, into the prison, the place where Joseph [was] bound.

guard left certain <u>24\_JER\_52\_16</u> # But Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard left [certain] of the poor of the land for vinedressers and for husbandmen.

guard left of 12\_2KI\_25\_12 # But the captain of the guard left of the poor of the land [to be] vinedressers

and husbandmen.

guard left of <u>24\_JER\_39\_10</u># But Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard left of the poor of the people, which had nothing, in the land of Judah, and gave them vineyards and fields at the same time.

guard saying 24\_JER\_39\_11 # Now Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon gave charge concerning Jeremiah to Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard, saying,

guard sent and 24\_JER\_39\_13\_# So Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard sent, and Nebushasban, Rabsaris, and Nergalsharezer, Rabmag, and all the king of Babylon's princes;

guard so shall 12 2KI 11 06 # And a third part [shall be] at the gate of Sur; and a third part at the gate behind the guard: so shall ye keep the watch of the house, that it be not broken down.

guard stood every 12 2KI 11 11 # And the guard stood, every man with his weapons in his hand, round about the king, from the right corner of the temple to the left corner of the temple, [along] by the altar and the temple.

guard that kept 14\_2CH\_12\_10 # Instead of which king Rehoboam made shields of brass, and committed [them] to the hands of the chief of the guard, that kept the entrance of the king's house.

guard to the 12\_2KI\_11\_19# And he took the rulers over hundreds, and the captains, and the guard, and all the people of the land; and they brought down the king from the house of the LORD, and came by the way of the gate of the guard to the king's house. And he sat on the throne of the kings.

guard to us <u>16\_NEH\_04\_22</u> # Likewise at the same time said I unto the people, Let every one with his servant lodge within Jerusalem, that in the night they may be a guard to us, and labour on the day.

guard which kept 11\_1KI\_14\_27 # And king Rehoboam made in their stead brazen shields, and committed [them] unto the hands of the chief of the guard, which kept the door of the king's house.

guard which served <u>24\_JER\_52\_12</u># Now in the fifth month, in the tenth [day] of the month, which [was] the nineteenth year of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, came Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard, [which] served the king of Babylon, into Jerusalem,

guard which was <u>27\_DAN\_02\_14</u># Then Daniel answered with counsel and wisdom to Arioch the captain of the king's guard, which was gone forth to slay the wise [men] of Babylon:

guard 13\_1CH\_11\_25 # Behold, he was honourable among the thirty, but attained not to the [first] three: and David set him over his guard.

guard <u>10\_2SA\_23\_23</u># He was more honourable than the thirty, but he attained not to the [first] three. And David set him over his guard.

guard <u>01\_GEN\_37\_36</u># And the Midianites sold him into Egypt unto Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh's, [and] captain of the guard.

guard's house both <u>01\_GEN\_41\_10</u> # Pharaoh was wroth with his servants, and put me in ward in the captain of the guard's house, [both] me and the chief baker:

safeguard <u>09\_1SA\_22\_23</u> # Abide thou with me, fear not: for he that seeketh my life seeketh thy life: but with me thou [shalt be] in safeguard.
