

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

bloodguiltiness O God <u>19 PSA 51 14 #</u> Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, thou God of my salvation: [and] my tongue shall sing aloud of thy righteousness.

guilt of innocent <u>05\_DEU\_19\_13</u># Thine eye shall not pity him, but thou shalt put away [the guilt of] innocent blood from Israel, that it may go well with thee.

guilt of innocent <u>05 DEU 21 09 #</u> So shalt thou put away the [guilt of] innocent blood from among you, when thou shalt do [that which is] right in the sight of the LORD.

guiltiness upon us <u>01\_GEN\_26\_10</u># And Abimelech said, What [is] this thou hast done unto us? one of the people might lightly have lien with thy wife, and thou shouldest have brought guiltiness upon us.

guiltless and whosoever <u>06\_JOS\_02\_19</u> # And it shall be, [that] whosoever shall go out of the doors of thy house into the street, his blood [shall be] upon his head, and we [will be] guiltless: and whosoever shall be with thee in the house, his blood [shall be] on our head, if [any] hand be upon him.

guiltless before the <u>10\_2SA\_03\_28</u> # And afterward when David heard [it], he said, I and my kingdom [are] guiltless before the LORD for ever from the blood of Abner the son of Ner:

guiltless before the <u>04\_NUM\_32\_22</u># And the land be subdued before the LORD: then afterward ye shall return, and be guiltless before the LORD, and before Israel; and this land shall be your possession before the LORD.

guiltless for thou 11\_1KI\_02\_09 # Now therefore hold him not guiltless: for thou [art] a wise man, and knowest what thou oughtest to do unto him; but his hoar head bring thou down to the grave with blood.

guiltless from iniquity  $\underline{04}$  NUM\_05\_31 # Then shall the man be guiltless from iniquity, and this woman shall bear her iniquity.

guiltless that taketh <u>05\_DEU\_05\_11</u># Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain: for the LORD will not hold [him] guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

guiltless that taketh <u>02\_EXO\_20\_07</u># Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

guiltless <u>09\_1SA\_26\_09</u> # And David said to Abishai, Destroy him not: for who can stretch forth his hand against the LORD'S anointed, and be guiltless?

guiltless <u>10\_2SA\_14\_09</u> # And the woman of Tekoah said unto the king, My lord, O king, the iniquity [be] on me, and on my father's house: and the king and his throne [be] guiltless.

guiltless <u>40\_MAT\_12\_07</u># But if ye had known what [this] meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice, ye would not have condemned the guiltless.

guilty and shall <u>03\_LEV\_05\_17</u># And if a soul sin, and commit any of these things which are forbidden to be done by the commandments of the LORD; though he wist [it] not, yet is he guilty, and shall bear his iniquity.

guilty and they <u>38\_ZEC\_11\_05</u># Whose possessors slay them, and hold themselves not guilty: and they that sell them say, Blessed [be] the LORD; for I am rich: and their own shepherds pity them not.

guilty before God <u>45\_ROM\_03\_19</u> # Now we know that what things soever the law saith, it saith to them who are under the law: that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God.

guilty concerning our <u>01\_GEN\_42\_21</u># And they said one to another, We [are] verily guilty concerning our brother, in that we saw the anguish of his soul, when he besought us, and we would not hear; therefore is this distress come upon us.

guilty in one <u>03\_LEV\_05\_04</u> # Or if a soul swear, pronouncing with [his] lips to do evil, or to do good, whatsoever [it be] that a man shall pronounce with an oath, and it be hid from him; when he knoweth [of it], then he shall be guilty in one of these.

guilty in one <u>03\_LEV\_05\_05</u># And it shall be, when he shall be guilty in one of these [things], that he shall confess that he hath sinned in that [thing]:

guilty in thy <u>26\_EZE\_22\_04</u> # Thou art become guilty in thy blood that thou hast shed; and hast defiled thyself in thine idols which thou hast made; and thou hast caused thy days to draw near, and art come [even] unto thy years: therefore have I made thee a reproach unto the heathen, and a mocking to all countries.

guilty of all <u>59\_JAM\_02\_10</u># For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one [point], he is guilty of all.

guilty of blood <u>04\_NUM\_35\_27</u> # And the revenger of blood find him without the borders of the city of his refuge, and the revenger of blood kill the slayer; he shall not be guilty of blood:

guilty of death <u>41\_MAR\_14\_64</u> # Ye have heard the blasphemy: what think ye? And they all condemned him to be guilty of death.

guilty of death 40\_MAT\_26\_66# What think ye? They answered and said, He is guilty of death.

guilty of death <u>04\_NUM\_35\_31</u> # Moreover ye shall take no satisfaction for the life of a murderer, which [is] guilty of death: but he shall be surely put to death.

guilty of the <u>46\_1CO\_11\_27</u># Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink [this] cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord.

guilty that he <u>03\_LEV\_06\_04</u># Then it shall be, because he hath sinned, and is guilty, that he shall restore that which he took violently away, or the thing which he hath deceitfully gotten, or that which was delivered him to keep, or the lost thing which he found,

guilty they offered <u>15\_EZR\_10\_19</u># And they gave their hands that they would put away their wives; and [being] guilty, [they offered] a ram of the flock for their trespass.

guilty visiting the <u>02\_EXO\_34\_07</u># Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear [the guilty]; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children, unto the third and to the fourth [generation].

guilty visiting the <u>04\_NUM\_14\_18</u> # The LORD [is] longsuffering, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing [the guilty], visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth [generation].

guilty 07\_JUD\_21\_22 # And it shall be, when their fathers or their brethren come unto us to complain, that

we will say unto them, Be favourable unto them for our sakes: because we reserved not to each man his wife in the war: for ye did not give unto them at this time, [that] ye should be guilty.

guilty <u>03\_LEV\_04\_13</u># And if the whole congregation of Israel sin through ignorance, and the thing be hid from the eyes of the assembly, and they have done [somewhat against] any of the commandments of the LORD [concerning things] which should not be done, and are guilty;

guilty <u>03\_LEV\_04\_22</u> # When a ruler hath sinned, and done [somewhat] through ignorance [against] any of the commandments of the LORD his God [concerning things] which should not be done, and is guilty;

guilty <u>03\_LEV\_04\_27</u># And if any one of the common people sin through ignorance, while he doeth [somewhat against] any of the commandments of the LORD [concerning things] which ought not to be done, and be guilty;

guilty <u>03\_LEV\_05\_02</u> # Or if a soul touch any unclean thing, whether [it be] a carcase of an unclean beast, or a carcase of unclean cattle, or the carcase of unclean creeping things, and [if] it be hidden from him; he also shall be unclean, and guilty.

guilty <u>03\_LEV\_05\_03</u> # Or if he touch the uncleanness of man, whatsoever uncleanness [it be] that a man shall be defiled withal, and it be hid from him; when he knoweth [of it], then he shall be guilty.

guilty <u>40\_MAT\_23\_18</u># And, Whosoever shall swear by the altar, it is nothing; but whosoever sweareth by the gift that is upon it, he is guilty.

guilty <u>04\_NUM\_05\_06</u> # Speak unto the children of Israel, When a man or woman shall commit any sin that men commit, to do a trespass against the LORD, and that person be guilty;

guilty 20\_PRO\_30\_10 # Accuse not a servant unto his master, lest he curse thee, and thou be found guilty.
