

# KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Abihail and Mordecai <u>17 EST 09 29</u> # Then Esther the queen, the daughter of Abihail, and Mordecai the Jew, wrote with all authority, to confirm this second letter of Purim.

Abihail and she <u>13\_1CH\_02\_29</u># And the name of the wife of Abishur [was] Abihail, and she bare him Ahban, and Molid.

Abihail the daughter <u>14\_2CH\_11\_18</u># And Rehoboam took him Mahalath the daughter of Jerimoth the son of David to wife, [and] Abihail the daughter of Eliab the son of Jesse;

Abihail the son <u>13\_1CH\_05\_14</u># These [are] the children of Abihail the son of Huri, the son of Jaroah, the son of Gilead, the son of Michael, the son of Jeshishai, the son of Jahdo, the son of Buz;

Abihail the uncle <u>17\_EST\_02\_15</u> # Now when the turn of Esther, the daughter of Abihail the uncle of Mordecai, who had taken her for his daughter, was come to go in unto the king, she required nothing but what Hegai the king's chamberlain, the keeper of the women, appointed. And Esther obtained favour in the sight of all them that looked upon her.

Abihail these shall <u>04\_NUM\_03\_35</u># And the chief of the house of the father of the families of Merari [was] Zuriel the son of Abihail: [these] shall pitch on the side of the tabernacle northward.

Abishai and Asahel <u>10\_2SA\_02\_18</u># And there were three sons of Zeruiah there, Joab, and Abishai, and Asahel: and Asahel [was as] light of foot as a wild roe.

Abishai and entered <u>10\_2SA\_10\_14</u> # And when the children of Ammon saw that the Syrians were fled, then fled they also before Abishai, and entered into the city. So Joab returned from the children of Ammon, and came to Jerusalem.

Abishai and Ittai <u>10\_2SA\_18\_05</u> # And the king commanded Joab and Abishai and Ittai, saying, [Deal] gently for my sake with the young man, [even] with Absalom. And all the people heard when the king gave all the captains charge concerning Absalom.

Abishai and Ittai <u>10\_2SA\_18\_12</u> # And the man said unto Joab, Though I should receive a thousand [shekels] of silver in mine hand, [yet] would I not put forth mine hand against the king's son: for in our hearing the king charged thee and Abishai and Ittai, saying, Beware that none [touch] the young man Absalom.

Abishai and Joab <u>13\_1CH\_02\_16</u># Whose sisters [were] Zeruiah, and Abigail. And the sons of Zeruiah; Abishai, and Joab, and Asahel, three.

Abishai and to <u>10\_2SA\_16\_11</u># And David said to Abishai, and to all his servants, Behold, my son, which came forth of my bowels, seeketh my life: how much more now [may this] Benjamite [do it]? let him alone, and let him curse; for the LORD hath bidden him.

Abishai came to <u>09\_1SA\_26\_07</u> # So David and Abishai came to the people by night: and, behold, Saul lay sleeping within the trench, and his spear stuck in the ground at his bolster: but Abner and the people lay round about him.

Abishai Destroy him <u>09\_1SA\_26\_09</u># And David said to Abishai, Destroy him not: for who can stretch

forth his hand against the LORD'S anointed, and be guiltless?

Abishai his brother <u>13\_1CH\_19\_11</u># And the rest of the people he delivered unto the hand of Abishai his brother, and they set [themselves] in array against the children of Ammon.

Abishai his brother <u>13\_1CH\_19\_15</u> # And when the children of Ammon saw that the Syrians were fled, they likewise fled before Abishai his brother, and entered into the city. Then Joab came to Jerusalem.

Abishai his brother <u>10\_2SA\_03\_30</u> # So Joab and Abishai his brother slew Abner, because he had slain their brother Asahel at Gibeon in the battle.

Abishai his brother <u>10\_2SA\_10\_10</u> # And the rest of the people he delivered into the hand of Abishai his brother, that he might put [them] in array against the children of Ammon.

Abishai his brother <u>10\_2SA\_20\_10</u> # But Amasa took no heed to the sword that [was] in Joab's hand: so he smote him therewith in the fifth [rib], and shed out his bowels to the ground, and struck him not again; and he died. So Joab and Abishai his brother pursued after Sheba the son of Bichri.

Abishai Now shall <u>10\_2SA\_20\_06</u> # And David said to Abishai, Now shall Sheba the son of Bichri do us more harm than [did] Absalom: take thou thy lord's servants, and pursue after him, lest he get him fenced cities, and escape us.

Abishai pursued after <u>10\_2SA\_02\_24</u> # Joab also and Abishai pursued after Abner: and the sun went down when they were come to the hill of Ammah, that [lieth] before Giah by the way of the wilderness of Gibeon.

Abishai said I <u>09\_1SA\_26\_06</u># Then answered David and said to Ahimelech the Hittite, and to Abishai the son of Zeruiah, brother to Joab, saying, Who will go down with me to Saul to the camp? And Abishai said, I will go down with thee.

Abishai the brother <u>13\_1CH\_11\_20</u> # And Abishai the brother of Joab, he was chief of the three: for lifting up his spear against three hundred, he slew [them], and had a name among the three.

Abishai the brother <u>10\_2SA\_23\_18</u> # And Abishai, the brother of Joab, the son of Zeruiah, was chief among three. And he lifted up his spear against three hundred, [and] slew [them], and had the name among three.

Abishai the son <u>13\_1CH\_18\_12</u> # Moreover Abishai the son of Zeruiah slew of the Edomites in the valley of salt eighteen thousand.

Abishai the son <u>09\_1SA\_26\_06</u># Then answered David and said to Ahimelech the Hittite, and to Abishai the son of Zeruiah, brother to Joab, saying, Who will go down with me to Saul to the camp? And Abishai said, I will go down with thee.

Abishai the son <u>10\_2SA\_16\_09</u># Then said Abishai the son of Zeruiah unto the king, Why should this dead dog curse my lord the king? let me go over, I pray thee, and take off his head.

Abishai the son <u>10\_2SA\_18\_02</u> # And David sent forth a third part of the people under the hand of Joab, and a third part under the hand of Abishai the son of Zeruiah, Joab's brother, and a third part under the hand of Ittai the Gittite. And the king said unto the people, I will surely go forth with you myself also.

Abishai the son <u>10\_2SA\_19\_21</u> # But Abishai the son of Zeruiah answered and said, Shall not Shimei be put to death for this, because he cursed the LORD'S anointed?

Abishai the son <u>10\_2SA\_21\_17</u> # But Abishai the son of Zeruiah succoured him, and smote the Philistine, and killed him. Then the men of David sware unto him, saying, Thou shalt go no more out with us to battle, that thou quench not the light of Israel.

Abishai to David <u>09\_1SA\_26\_08</u># Then said Abishai to David, God hath delivered thine enemy into thine hand this day: now therefore let me smite him, I pray thee, with the spear even to the earth at once, and I will not [smite] him the second time.

Achaia and that <u>46\_1CO\_16\_15</u># I beseech you, brethren, [ye know the house of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and [that] they have addicted themselves to the ministry of the saints,]

Achaia but also <u>52\_1TH\_01\_08</u># For from you sounded out the word of the Lord not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place your faith to God ward is spread abroad; so that we need not to speak any thing.

Achaia the brethren <u>44\_ACT\_18\_27</u> # And when he was disposed to pass into Achaia, the brethren wrote, exhorting the disciples to receive him: who, when he was come, helped them much which had believed through grace:

Achaia the Jews <u>44\_ACT\_18\_12</u> # And when Gallio was the deputy of Achaia, the Jews made insurrection with one accord against Paul, and brought him to the judgment seat,

Achaia to go <u>44\_ACT\_19\_21</u> # After these things were ended, Paul purposed in the spirit, when he had passed through Macedonia and Achaia, to go to Jerusalem, saying, After I have been there, I must also see Rome.

Achaia to make <u>45\_ROM\_15\_26</u># For it hath pleased them of Macedonia and Achaia to make a certain contribution for the poor saints which are at Jerusalem.

Achaia unto Christ <u>45\_ROM\_16\_05</u> # Likewise [greet] the church that is in their house. Salute my wellbeloved Epaenetus, who is the firstfruits of Achaia unto Christ.

Achaia was ready <u>47\_2CO\_09\_02</u> # For I know the forwardness of your mind, for which I boast of you to them of Macedonia, that Achaia was ready a year ago; and your zeal hath provoked very many.

Achaia <u>52\_1TH\_01\_07</u># So that ye were ensamples to all that believe in Macedonia and Achaia.

Achaia <u>47\_2CO\_01\_01</u> # Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Timothy [our] brother, unto the church of God which is at Corinth, with all the saints which are in all Achaia:

Achaia <u>47\_2CO\_11\_10</u># As the truth of Christ is in me, no man shall stop me of this boasting in the regions of Achaia.

Achaicus for that <u>46\_1CO\_16\_17</u># I am glad of the coming of Stephanas and Fortunatus and Achaicus: for that which was lacking on your part they have supplied.

Adithaim and Gederah <u>06\_JOS\_15\_36</u># And Sharaim, and Adithaim, and Gederah, and Gederothaim; fourteen cities with their villages:

Almondiblathaim and pitched <u>04\_NUM\_33\_47</u> # And they removed from Almondiblathaim, and pitched in the mountains of Abarim, before Nebo.

Almondiblathaim <u>04\_NUM\_33\_46</u># And they removed from Dibongad, and encamped in Almondiblathaim.

Amashai the son <u>16\_NEH\_11\_13</u># And his brethren, chief of the fathers, two hundred forty and two: and Amashai the son of Azareel, the son of Ahasai, the son of Meshillemoth, the son of Immer,

Athaiah the son <u>16\_NEH\_11\_04</u># And at Jerusalem dwelt [certain] of the children of Judah, and of the children of Benjamin. Of the children of Judah; Athaiah the son of Uzziah, the son of Zechariah, the son of Amariah, the son of Shephatiah, the son of Mahalaleel, of the children of Perez;

Beerlahairoi behold it <u>01\_GEN\_16\_14</u># Wherefore the well was called Beerlahairoi; behold, [it is] between Kadesh and Bered.

Benhail and to <u>14\_2CH\_17\_07</u> # Also in the third year of his reign he sent to his princes, [even] to Benhail, and to Obadiah, and to Zechariah, and to Nethaneel, and to Michaiah, to teach in the cities of Judah.

Berothai cities of <u>10\_2SA\_08\_08</u># And from Betah, and from Berothai, cities of Hadadezer, king David took exceeding much brass.

Bethdiblathaim <u>24\_JER\_48\_22</u> # And upon Dibon, and upon Nebo, and upon Bethdiblathaim,

chain about his <u>01\_GEN\_41\_42</u> # And Pharaoh took off his ring from his hand, and put it upon Joseph's hand, and arrayed him in vestures of fine linen, and put a gold chain about his neck;

chain for the <u>26\_EZE\_07\_23</u> # Make a chain: for the land is full of bloody crimes, and the city is full of violence.

chain heavy <u>25\_LAM\_03\_07</u># He hath hedged me about, that I cannot get out: he hath made my chain heavy.

chain in his <u>66\_REV\_20\_01</u># And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.

chain of gold <u>27\_DAN\_05\_07</u># The king cried aloud to bring in the astrologers, the Chaldeans, and the soothsayers. [And] the king spake, and said to the wise [men] of Babylon, Whosoever shall read this writing, and show me the interpretation thereof, shall be clothed with scarlet, and [have] a chain of gold about his neck, and shall be the third ruler in the kingdom.

chain of gold <u>27\_DAN\_05\_16</u># And I have heard of thee, that thou canst make interpretations, and dissolve doubts: now if thou canst read the writing, and make known to me the interpretation thereof, thou shalt be clothed with scarlet, and [have] a chain of gold about thy neck, and shalt be the third ruler in the kingdom.

chain of gold <u>27\_DAN\_05\_29</u># Then commanded Belshazzar, and they clothed Daniel with scarlet, and [put] a chain of gold about his neck, and made a proclamation concerning him, that he should be the third ruler in the kingdom.

chain of thy <u>22\_SON\_04\_09</u># Thou hast ravished my heart, my sister, [my] spouse; thou hast ravished my heart with one of thine eyes, with one chain of thy neck.

chain on thy <u>26\_EZE\_16\_11</u># I decked thee also with ornaments, and I put bracelets upon thy hands, and a chain on thy neck.

chain violence covereth <u>19\_PSA\_73\_06</u># Therefore pride compasseth them about as a chain; violence covereth them [as] a garment.

chain work for <u>11\_1KI\_07\_17</u># [And] nets of checker work, and wreaths of chain work, for the chapiters which [were] upon the top of the pillars; seven for the one chapiter, and seven for the other chapiter.

chain <u>55\_2TI\_01\_16</u># The Lord give mercy unto the house of Onesiphorus; for he oft refreshed me, and was not ashamed of my chain:

chain <u>44\_ACT\_28\_20</u># For this cause therefore have I called for you, to see [you], and to speak with [you]: because that for the hope of Israel I am bound with this chain.

chains about thy <u>20\_PRO\_01\_09</u># For they [shall be] an ornament of grace unto thy head, and chains about thy neck.

chains among all <u>24\_JER\_40\_01</u> # The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD, after that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had let him go from Ramah, when he had taken him being bound in chains among all that were carried away captive of Jerusalem and Judah, which were carried away captive unto Babylon.

chains and bracelets <u>04\_NUM\_31\_50</u># We have therefore brought an oblation for the LORD, what every man hath gotten, of jewels of gold, chains, and bracelets, rings, earrings, and tablets, to make an atonement for our souls before the LORD.

chains and brought <u>26\_EZE\_19\_09</u># And they put him in ward in chains, and brought him to the king of Babylon: they brought him into holds, that his voice should no more be heard upon the mountains of Israel.

chains and carried <u>24\_JER\_52\_11</u># Then he put out the eyes of Zedekiah; and the king of Babylon bound him in chains, and carried him to Babylon, and put him in prison till the day of his death.

chains and demanded <u>44\_ACT\_21\_33</u> # Then the chief captain came near, and took him, and commanded [him] to be bound with two chains; and demanded who he was, and what he had done.

chains and in <u>42\_LUK\_08\_29</u> # [For he had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he brake the bands, and was driven of the devil into the wilderness.]

chains and the <u>44\_ACT\_12\_06</u> # And when Herod would have brought him forth, the same night Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, bound with two chains: and the keepers before the door kept the prison.

chains and the <u>23\_ISA\_03\_19</u># The chains, and the bracelets, and the mufflers,

chains and the <u>41\_MAR\_05\_04</u> # Because that he had been often bound with fetters and chains, and the chains had been plucked asunder by him, and the fetters broken in pieces: neither could any [man] tame him.

chains and their <u>19\_PSA\_149\_08</u># To bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron;

chains as in <u>14\_2CH\_03\_16</u># And he made chains, [as] in the oracle, and put [them] on the heads of the pillars; and made an hundred pomegranates, and put [them] on the chains.

chains at the <u>02\_EXO\_28\_22</u> # And thou shalt make upon the breastplate chains at the ends [of] wreathen work [of] pure gold.

chains at the <u>02\_EXO\_39\_15</u># And they made upon the breastplate chains at the ends, [of] wreathen work [of] pure gold.

chains but the <u>19\_PSA\_68\_06</u># God setteth the solitary in families: he bringeth out those which are bound with chains: but the rebellious dwell in a dry [land].

chains fell off <u>44\_ACT\_12\_07</u> # And, behold, the angel of the Lord came upon [him], and a light shined in the prison: and he smote Peter on the side, and raised him up, saying, Arise up quickly. And his chains fell off from [his] hands.

chains had been <u>41\_MAR\_05\_04</u># Because that he had been often bound with fetters and chains, and the chains had been plucked asunder by him, and the fetters broken in pieces: neither could any [man] tame him.

chains of darkness <u>61\_2PE\_02\_04</u># For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast [them] down to hell, and delivered [them] into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

chains of gold <u>11\_1KI\_06\_21</u># So Solomon overlaid the house within with pure gold: and he made a partition by the chains of gold before the oracle; and he overlaid it with gold.

chains of gold <u>02\_EXO\_28\_24</u> # And thou shalt put the two wreathen [chains] of gold in the two rings [which are] on the ends of the breastplate.

chains of gold <u>02\_EXO\_39\_17</u># And they put the two wreathen chains of gold in the two rings on the ends of the breastplate.

chains of gold <u>22\_SON\_01\_10</u># Thy cheeks are comely with rows [of jewels], thy neck with chains [of gold].

chains of pure <u>02\_EXO\_28\_14</u> # And two chains [of] pure gold at the ends; [of] wreathen work shalt thou make them, and fasten the wreathen chains to the ouches.

chains that were <u>07\_JUD\_08\_26</u># And the weight of the golden earrings that he requested was a thousand and seven hundred [shekels] of gold; beside ornaments, and collars, and purple raiment that [was] on the kings of Midian, and beside the chains that [were] about their camels' necks.

chains they fastened <u>02\_EXO\_39\_18</u># And the two ends of the two wreathen chains they fastened in the two ouches, and put them on the shoulderpieces of the ephod, before it.

chains they shall <u>23\_ISA\_45\_14</u> # Thus saith the LORD, The labour of Egypt, and merchandise of Ethiopia and of the Sabeans, men of stature, shall come over unto thee, and they shall be thine: they shall come after thee; in chains they shall come over, and they shall fall down unto thee, they shall make supplication unto thee, [saying], Surely God [is] in thee; and [there is] none else, [there is] no God.

chains thou shalt <u>02\_EXO\_28\_25</u> # And [the other] two ends of the two wreathen [chains] thou shalt fasten in the two ouches, and put [them] on the shoulder pieces of the ephod before it.

chains to carry <u>24\_JER\_39\_07</u># Moreover he put out Zedekiah's eyes, and bound him with chains, to carry him to Babylon.

chains to the <u>02\_EXO\_28\_14</u> # And two chains [of] pure gold at the ends; [of] wreathen work shalt thou make them, and fasten the wreathen chains to the ouches.

chains under darkness <u>65\_JDE\_01\_06</u> # And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.

chains unto the <u>26\_EZE\_19\_04</u># The nations also heard of him; he was taken in their pit, and they brought him with chains unto the land of Egypt.

chains which were 24\_JER\_40\_04 # And now, behold, I loose thee this day from the chains which [were] upon thine hand. If it seem good unto thee to come with me into Babylon, come; and I will look well unto thee: but if it seem ill unto thee to come with me into Babylon, forbear: behold, all the land [is] before thee: whither it seemeth good and convenient for thee to go, thither go.

chains <u>23\_ISA\_40\_19</u> # The workman melteth a graven image, and the goldsmith spreadeth it over with gold, and casteth silver chains.

Hai on the <u>01\_GEN\_12\_08</u># And he removed from thence unto a mountain on the east of Bethel, and pitched his tent, [having] Bethel on the west, and Hai on the east: and there he builded an altar unto the LORD, and called upon the name of the LORD.

Hai <u>01\_GEN\_13\_03</u># And he went on his journeys from the south even to Bethel, unto the place where his tent had been at the beginning, between Bethel and Hai;

hail for rain <u>19\_PSA\_105\_32</u># He gave them hail for rain, [and] flaming fire in their land.

hail for the <u>66\_REV\_16\_21</u># And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, [every stone] about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great.

hail had left <u>02\_EXO\_10\_15</u> # For they covered the face of the whole earth, so that the land was darkened; and they did eat every herb of the land, and all the fruit of the trees which the hail had left: and there remained not any green thing in the trees, or in the herbs of the field, through all the land of Egypt.

Hushai unto Zadok <u>10\_2SA\_17\_15</u># Then said Hushai unto Zadok and to Abiathar the priests, Thus and thus did Ahithophel counsel Absalom and the elders of Israel; and thus and thus have I counselled.

Hushai was come <u>10\_2SA\_17\_06</u># And when Hushai was come to Absalom, Absalom spake unto him, saying, Ahithophel hath spoken after this manner: shall we do [after] his saying? if not; speak thou.

Hushai was in <u>11\_1KI\_04\_16</u># Baanah the son of Hushai [was] in Asher and in Aloth:

Ithai the son <u>13\_1CH\_11\_31</u># Ithai the son of Ribai of Gibeah, [that pertained] to the children of Benjamin, Benaiah the Pirathonite,

Jeshaiah Hashabiah and <u>13\_1CH\_25\_03</u> # Of Jeduthun: the sons of Jeduthun; Gedaliah, and Zeri, and Jeshaiah, Hashabiah, and Mattithiah, six, under the hands of their father Jeduthun, who prophesied with a harp, to give thanks and to praise the LORD.

Jeshaiah he his <u>13\_1CH\_25\_15</u># The eighth to Jeshaiah, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:

Jeshaiah his son <u>13 1CH\_26\_25</u> # And his brethren by Eliezer; Rehabiah his son, and Jeshaiah his son, and Joram his son, and Zichri his son, and Shelomith his son.

Jeshaiah of the <u>15\_EZR\_08\_19</u> # And Hashabiah, and with him Jeshaiah of the sons of Merari, his brethren and their sons, twenty;

Jeshaiah the son <u>15\_EZR\_08\_07</u> # And of the sons of Elam; Jeshaiah the son of Athaliah, and with him seventy males.

Jeshishai the son <u>13\_1CH\_05\_14</u># These [are] the children of Abihail the son of Huri, the son of Jaroah, the son of Michael, the son of Jeshishai, the son of Jahdo, the son of Buz;

Jeshohaiah and Asaiah <u>13\_1CH\_04\_36</u> # And Elioenai, and Jaakobah, and Jeshohaiah, and Asaiah, and Adiel, and Jesimiel, and Benaiah,

Kiriathaim and upon 24\_JER\_48\_23 # And upon Kiriathaim, and upon Bethgamul, and upon Bethmeon,

Kiriathaim is confounded <u>24\_JER\_48\_01</u> # Against Moab thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Woe unto Nebo! for it is spoiled: Kiriathaim is confounded [and] taken: Misgab is confounded and dismayed.

Kiriathaim <u>26\_EZE\_25\_09</u># Therefore, behold, I will open the side of Moab from the cities, from his cities [which are] on his frontiers, the glory of the country, Bethjeshimoth, Baalmeon, and Kiriathaim,

Kiriathaim <u>01\_GEN\_14\_05</u> # And in the fourteenth year came Chedorlaomer, and the kings that [were] with him, and smote the Rephaims in Ashteroth Karnaim, and the Zuzims in Ham, and the Emims in Shaveh Kiriathaim,

Kirjathaim and Sibmah <u>06\_JOS\_13\_19</u># And Kirjathaim, and Sibmah, and Zarethshahar in the mount of the valley,

Kirjathaim with her <u>13\_1CH\_06\_76</u># And out of the tribe of Naphtali; Kedesh in Galilee with her suburbs, and Hammon with her suburbs, and Kirjathaim with her suburbs.

Kirjathaim <u>04\_NUM\_32\_37</u># And the children of Reuben built Heshbon, and Elealeh, and Kirjathaim,

Kushaiah <u>13\_1CH\_15\_17</u># So the Levites appointed Heman the son of Joel; and of his brethren, Asaph the son of Berechiah; and of the sons of Merari their brethren, Ethan the son of Kushaiah;

Lahairoi for he <u>01\_GEN\_24\_62</u> # And Isaac came from the way of the well Lahairoi; for he dwelt in the south country.

Lahairoi <u>01\_GEN\_25\_11</u># And it came to pass after the death of Abraham, that God blessed his son Isaac; and Isaac dwelt by the well Lahairoi.

Meonothai begat Ophrah <u>13\_1CH\_04\_14</u> # And Meonothai begat Ophrah: and Seraiah begat Joab, the father of the valley of Charashim; for they were craftsmen.

Merathaim even against 24\_JER\_50\_21 # Go up against the land of Merathaim, [even] against it, and against the inhabitants of Pekod: waste and utterly destroy after them, saith the LORD, and do according to all that I have commanded thee.

Michaiah and Shaphan <u>12\_2KI\_22\_12</u> # And the king commanded Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Achbor the son of Michaiah, and Shaphan the scribe, and Asahiah a servant of the king's, saying,

Michaiah declared unto 24\_JER\_36\_13 # Then Michaiah declared unto them all the words that he had heard, when Baruch read the book in the ears of the people.

Michaiah Elioenai Zechariah <u>16\_NEH\_12\_41</u> # And the priests; Eliakim, Maaseiah, Miniamin, Michaiah, Elioenai, Zechariah, [and] Hananiah, with trumpets;

Michaiah the daughter <u>14\_2CH\_13\_02</u> # He reigned three years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Michaiah the daughter of Uriel of Gibeah. And there was war between Abijah and Jeroboam.

Michaiah the son <u>24\_JER\_36\_11</u># When Michaiah the son of Gemariah, the son of Shaphan, had heard out of the book all the words of the LORD,

Michaiah the son <u>16\_NEH\_12\_35</u> # And [certain] of the priests' sons with trumpets; [namely], Zechariah the son of Jonathan, the son of Shemaiah, the son of Mattaniah, the son of Michaiah, the son of Zaccur, the son of Asaph:

Michaiah to teach <u>14\_2CH\_17\_07</u> # Also in the third year of his reign he sent to his princes, [even] to Benhail, and to Obadiah, and to Zechariah, and to Nethaneel, and to Michaiah, to teach in the cities of

Peulthai the eighth <u>13\_1CH\_26\_05</u> # Ammiel the sixth, Issachar the seventh, Peulthai the eighth: for God blessed him.

Ramathaimzophim of mount <u>09\_1SA\_01\_01</u># Now there was a certain man of Ramathaimzophim, of mount Ephraim, and his name [was] Elkanah, the son of Jeroham, the son of Elihu, the son of Tohu, the son of Zuph, an Ephrathite:

Rephaiah and Jeriel <u>13\_1CH\_07\_02</u> # And the sons of Tola; Uzzi, and Rephaiah, and Jeriel, and Jahmai, and Jibsam, and Shemuel, heads of their father's house, [to wit], of Tola: [they were] valiant men of might in their generations; whose number [was] in the days of David two and twenty thousand and six hundred.

Rephaiah and Uzziel <u>13\_1CH\_04\_42</u> # And [some] of them, [even] of the sons of Simeon, five hundred men, went to mount Seir, having for their captains Pelatiah, and Neariah, and Rephaiah, and Uzziel, the sons of Ishi.

Rephaiah his son <u>13\_1CH\_09\_43</u> # And Moza begat Binea; and Rephaiah his son, Eleasah his son, Azel his son.

Rephaiah the son <u>16\_NEH\_03\_09</u> # And next unto them repaired Rephaiah the son of Hur, the ruler of the half part of Jerusalem.

Rephaiah the sons <u>13\_1CH\_03\_21</u># And the sons of Hananiah; Pelatiah, and Jesaiah: the sons of Rephaiah, the sons of Arnan, the sons of Obadiah, the sons of Shechaniah.

Rephaim <u>13\_1CH\_11\_15</u># Now three of the thirty captains went down to the rock to David, into the cave of Adullam; and the host of the Philistines encamped in the valley of Rephaim.

Rephaim <u>13\_1CH\_14\_09</u># And the Philistines came and spread themselves in the valley of Rephaim.

**Rephaim** <u>**10**</u> <u>**2SA**</u> **05** <u>18</u> # The Philistines also came and spread themselves in the valley of Rephaim.</u>

Rephaim <u>10\_2SA\_05\_22</u> # And the Philistines came up yet again, and spread themselves in the valley of Rephaim.

Rephaim <u>10\_2SA\_23\_13</u> # And three of the thirty chief went down, and came to David in the harvest time unto the cave of Adullam: and the troop of the Philistines pitched in the valley of Rephaim.

Rephaim <u>23\_ISA\_17\_05</u> # And it shall be as when the harvestman gathereth the corn, and reapeth the ears with his arm; and it shall be as he that gathereth ears in the valley of Rephaim.

Rephaims in Ashteroth <u>01\_GEN\_14\_05</u> # And in the fourteenth year came Chedorlaomer, and the kings that [were] with him, and smote the Rephaims in Ashteroth Karnaim, and the Zuzims in Ham, and the Emims in Shaveh Kiriathaim,

Rephaims <u>01\_GEN\_15\_20</u># And the Hittites, and the Perizzites, and the Rephaims,

Shabbethai and Jozabad <u>16\_NEH\_11\_16</u># And Shabbethai and Jozabad, of the chief of the Levites, [had] the oversight of the outward business of the house of God.

Shabbethai Hodijah Maaseiah <u>16\_NEH\_08\_07</u> # Also Jeshua, and Bani, and Sherebiah, Jamin, Akkub, Shabbethai, Hodijah, Maaseiah, Kelita, Azariah, Jozabad, Hanan, Pelaiah, and the Levites, caused the people to understand the law: and the people [stood] in their place.

Shabbethai the Levite <u>15\_EZR\_10\_15</u># Only Jonathan the son of Asahel and Jahaziah the son of Tikvah were employed about this [matter]: and Meshullam and Shabbethai the Levite helped them.

Shashai Sharai 15\_EZR\_10\_40 # Machnadebai, Shashai, Sharai,

Sheshai and Ahiman <u>06\_JOS\_15\_14</u># And Caleb drove thence the three sons of Anak, Sheshai, and Ahiman, and Talmai, the children of Anak.

Sheshai and Ahiman <u>07\_JUD\_01\_10</u> # And Judah went against the Canaanites that dwelt in Hebron: [now the name of Hebron before [was] Kirjatharba:] and they slew Sheshai, and Ahiman, and Talmai.

Sheshai and Talmai <u>04\_NUM\_13\_22</u> # And they ascended by the south, and came unto Hebron; where Ahiman, Sheshai, and Talmai, the children of Anak, [were]. [Now Hebron was built seven years before Zoan in Egypt.]

Shimshai the scribe <u>15\_EZR\_04\_08</u> # Rehum the chancellor and Shimshai the scribe wrote a letter against Jerusalem to Artaxerxes the king in this sort:

Shimshai the scribe <u>15\_EZR\_04\_09</u> # Then [wrote] Rehum the chancellor, and Shimshai the scribe, and the rest of their companions; the Dinaites, the Apharsathchites, the Tarpelites, the Apharsites, the Archevites, the Babylonians, the Susanchites, the Dehavites, [and] the Elamites,

Shimshai the scribe <u>15\_EZR\_04\_17</u> # [Then] sent the king an answer unto Rehum the chancellor, and [to] Shimshai the scribe, and [to] the rest of their companions that dwell in Samaria, and [unto] the rest beyond the river, Peace, and at such a time.

Shimshai the scribe <u>15\_EZR\_04\_23</u> # Now when the copy of king Artaxerxes' letter [was] read before Rehum, and Shimshai the scribe, and their companions, they went up in haste to Jerusalem unto the Jews, and made them to cease by force and power.

Sibbechai the Hushathite <u>13\_1CH\_20\_04</u># And it came to pass after this, that there arose war at Gezer with the Philistines; at which time Sibbechai the Hushathite slew Sippai, [that was] of the children of the giant: and they were subdued.

Sibbechai the Hushathite <u>10\_2SA\_21\_18</u> # And it came to pass after this, that there was again a battle with the Philistines at Gob: then Sibbechai the Hushathite slew Saph, which [was] of the sons of the giant.

Uthai and Zabbud <u>15\_EZR\_08\_14</u> # Of the sons also of Bigvai; Uthai, and Zabbud, and with them seventy males.

Uthai the son <u>13\_1CH\_09\_04</u> # Uthai the son of Ammihud, the son of Omri, the son of Imri, the son of Bani, of the children of Pharez the son of Judah.

Zilthai and Eliel <u>13\_1CH\_08\_20</u> # And Elienai, and Zilthai, and Eliel,

Zilthai captains of <u>13\_1CH\_12\_20</u># As he went to Ziklag, there fell to him of Manasseh, Adnah, and Jozabad, and Jediael, and Michael, and Jozabad, and Elihu, and Zilthai, captains of the thousands that [were] of Manasseh.

Zophai his son <u>13\_1CH\_06\_26</u> # [As for] Elkanah: the sons of Elkanah; Zophai his son, and Nahath his son,
