Abraham a son <u>01_GEN_21_02</u># For Sarah conceived, and bare Abraham a son in his old age, at the set time of which God had spoken to him.

Abraham Abraham and <u>01_GEN_22_11</u># And the angel of the LORD called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, Here [am] I.

Abraham afar off <u>42_LUK_16_23</u># And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.

Abraham and Abraham <u>01_GEN_18_33</u> # And the LORD went his way, as soon as he had left communing with Abraham: and Abraham returned unto his place.

Abraham and blessed <u>58_HEB_07_06</u> # But he whose descent is not counted from them received tithes of Abraham, and blessed him that had the promises.

Abraham and God <u>01_GEN_32_09</u># And Jacob said, O God of my father Abraham, and God of my father Isaac, the LORD which saidst unto me, Return unto thy country, and to thy kindred, and I will deal well with thee:

Abraham and he <u>01_GEN_22_01</u># And it came to pass after these things, that God did tempt Abraham, and said unto him, Abraham: and he said, Behold, [here] I [am].

Abraham and he <u>01_GEN_22_11</u># And the angel of the LORD called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham: and he said, Here [am] I.

Abraham and he <u>01_GEN_26_18</u># And Isaac digged again the wells of water, which they had digged in the days of Abraham his father; for the Philistines had stopped them after the death of Abraham: and he called their names after the names by which his father had called them.

Abraham and his <u>48_GAL_03_16</u> # Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ.

Abraham and his <u>19_PSA_105_09</u># Which [covenant] he made with Abraham, and his oath unto Isaac;

Abraham And in <u>44_ACT_03_25</u> # Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, And in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed.

Abraham And Isaac <u>01_GEN_26_01</u> # And there was a famine in the land, beside the first famine that was in the days of Abraham. And Isaac went unto Abimelech king of the Philistines unto Gerar.

Abraham and Isaac <u>01_GEN_35_12</u># And the land which I gave Abraham and Isaac, to thee I will give it, and to thy seed after thee will I give the land.

Abraham and Isaac <u>01_GEN_35_27</u># And Jacob came unto Isaac his father unto Mamre, unto the city of Arbah, which [is] Hebron, where Abraham and Isaac sojourned.

Abraham and Isaac <u>01_GEN_48_15</u># And he blessed Joseph, and said, God, before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac did walk, the God which fed me all my life long unto this day,

Abraham and Isaac <u>01_GEN_48_16</u># The Angel which redeemed me from all evil, bless the lads; and let my name be named on them, and the name of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; and let them grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth.

Abraham and Isaac <u>42_LUK_13_28</u># There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of God, and you [yourselves] thrust out.

Abraham and Isaac <u>40_MAT_08_11</u># And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven.

Abraham and of <u>13_1CH_16_16</u># [Even of the covenant] which he made with Abraham, and of his oath unto Isaac;

Abraham and of <u>44_ACT_03_13</u># The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let [him] go.

Abraham and restored <u>01_GEN_20_14</u> # And Abimelech took sheep, and oxen, and menservants, and womenservants, and gave [them] unto Abraham, and restored him Sarah his wife.

Abraham and said <u>01_GEN_20_09</u># Then Abimelech called Abraham, and said unto him, What hast thou done unto us? and what have I offended thee, that thou hast brought on me and on my kingdom a great sin? thou hast done deeds unto me that ought not to be done.

Abraham and said <u>01_GEN_22_01</u># And it came to pass after these things, that God did tempt Abraham, and said unto him, Abraham: and he said, Behold, [here] I [am].

Abraham and Sarah <u>01_GEN_18_11</u># Now Abraham and Sarah [were] old [and] well stricken in age; [and] it ceased to be with Sarah after the manner of women.

Abraham and Sarah <u>01_GEN_49_31</u># There they buried Abraham and Sarah his wife; there they buried Isaac and Rebekah his wife; and there I buried Leah.

Abraham and sent <u>01_GEN_19_29</u> # And it came to pass, when God destroyed the cities of the plain, that God remembered Abraham, and sent Lot out of the midst of the overthrow, when he overthrew the cities in the which Lot dwelt.

Abraham and the <u>44_ACT_07_32</u> # [Saying], I [am] the God of thy fathers, the God of Abraham, and the God of Jacob. Then Moses trembled, and durst not behold.

Abraham and the <u>01_GEN_31_42</u># Except the God of my father, the God of Abraham, and the fear of Isaac, had been with me, surely thou hadst sent me away now empty. God hath seen mine affliction and the labour of my hands, and rebuked [thee] yesternight.

Abraham and the <u>01_GEN_31_53</u># The God of Abraham, and the God of Nahor, the God of their father, judge betwixt us. And Jacob sware by the fear of his father Isaac.

Abraham and the <u>06_JOS_24_02</u> # And Joshua said unto all the people, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Your fathers dwelt on the other side of the flood in old time, [even] Terah, the father of Abraham, and the father of Nachor: and they served other gods.

Abraham and the <u>42_LUK_20_37</u> # Now that the dead are raised, even Moses showed at the bush, when he calleth the Lord the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.

Abraham and the <u>41_MAR_12_26</u> # And as touching the dead, that they rise: have ye not read in the book of Moses, how in the bush God spake unto him, saying, I [am] the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob?

Abraham and the <u>40_MAT_22_32</u># I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living.

Abraham and to <u>42_LUK_01_55</u> # As he spake to our fathers, to Abraham, and to his seed for ever.

Abraham and whosoever <u>44_ACT_13_26</u> # Men [and] brethren, children of the stock of Abraham, and whosoever among you feareth God, to you is the word of this salvation sent.

Abraham answered and <u>01_GEN_18_27</u># And Abraham answered and said, Behold now, I have taken upon me to speak unto the Lord, which [am but] dust and ashes:

Abraham are they <u>45_ROM_09_07</u> # Neither, because they are the seed of Abraham, [are they] all children: but, In Isaac shall thy seed be called.

Abraham As for <u>01_GEN_17_15</u># And God said unto Abraham, As for Sarai thy wife, thou shalt not call her name Sarai, but Sarah [shall] her name [be].

Abraham be ignorant <u>23_ISA_63_16</u># Doubtless thou [art] our father, though Abraham be ignorant of us, and Israel acknowledge us not: thou, O LORD, [art] our father, our redeemer; thy name [is] from everlasting.

Abraham because he <u>58_HEB_06_13</u># For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he sware by himself,

Abraham begat Isaac <u>13_1CH_01_34</u> # And Abraham begat Isaac. The sons of Isaac; Esau and Israel.

Abraham begat Isaac <u>44_ACT_07_08</u> # And he gave him the covenant of circumcision: and so [Abraham] begat Isaac, and circumcised him the eighth day; and Isaac [begat] Jacob; and Jacob [begat] the twelve patriarchs.

Abraham begat Isaac <u>01_GEN_25_19</u># And these [are] the generations of Isaac, Abraham's son: Abraham begat Isaac:

Abraham begat Isaac <u>40_MAT_01_02</u># Abraham begat Isaac; and Isaac begat Jacob; and Jacob begat Judas and his brethren;

Abraham believed God <u>48_GAL_03_06</u> # Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.

Abraham believed God <u>59_JAM_02_23</u># And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God.

Abraham believed God <u>45_ROM_04_03</u># For what saith the scripture? Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.

Abraham bought for <u>44_ACT_07_16</u> # And were carried over into Sychem, and laid in the sepulchre that Abraham bought for a sum of money of the sons of Emmor [the father] of Sychem.

Abraham bought with <u>01_GEN_49_30</u># In the cave that [is] in the field of Machpelah, which [is] before Mamre, in the land of Canaan, which Abraham bought with the field of Ephron the Hittite for a possession

of a buryingplace.

Abraham bought with <u>01_GEN_50_13</u># For his sons carried him into the land of Canaan, and buried him in the cave of the field of Machpelah, which Abraham bought with the field for a possession of a buryingplace of Ephron the Hittite, before Mamre.

Abraham bowed down <u>01_GEN_23_12</u># And Abraham bowed down himself before the people of the land.

Abraham built an <u>01_GEN_22_09</u># And they came to the place which God had told him of; and Abraham built an altar there, and laid the wood in order, and bound Isaac his son, and laid him on the altar upon the wood.

Abraham buried and <u>01_GEN_25_10</u># The field which Abraham purchased of the sons of Heth: there was Abraham buried, and Sarah his wife.

Abraham buried Sarah <u>01_GEN_23_19</u># And after this, Abraham buried Sarah his wife in the cave of the field of Machpelah before Mamre: the same [is] Hebron in the land of Canaan.

Abraham but if <u>42_LUK_16_30</u> # And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent.

Abraham by promise <u>48_GAL_03_18</u> # For if the inheritance [be] of the law, [it is] no more of promise: but God gave [it] to Abraham by promise.

Abraham called the <u>01_GEN_21_03</u># And Abraham called the name of his son that was born unto him, whom Sarah bare to him, Isaac.

Abraham called the <u>01_GEN_22_14</u> # And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovahjireh: as it is said [to] this day, In the mount of the LORD it shall be seen.

Abraham calling him <u>60_1PE_03_06</u> # Even as Sara obeyed Abraham, calling him lord: whose daughters ye are, as long as ye do well, and are not afraid with any amazement.

Abraham came to <u>01_GEN_23_02</u># And Sarah died in Kirjatharba; the same [is] Hebron in the land of Canaan: and Abraham came to mourn for Sarah, and to weep for her.

Abraham Cast out <u>01_GEN_21_10</u># Wherefore she said unto Abraham, Cast out this bondwoman and her son: for the son of this bondwoman shall not be heir with my son, [even] with Isaac.

Abraham circumcised and <u>01_GEN_17_26</u># In the selfsame day was Abraham circumcised, and Ishmael his son.

Abraham circumcised his <u>01_GEN_21_04</u># And Abraham circumcised his son Isaac being eight days old, as God had commanded him.

Abraham concerning the <u>23_ISA_29_22</u># Therefore thus saith the LORD, who redeemed Abraham, concerning the house of Jacob, Jacob shall not now be ashamed, neither shall his face now wax pale.

Abraham drew near <u>01_GEN_18_23</u> # And Abraham drew near, and said, Wilt thou also destroy the righteous with the wicked?

Abraham dwelt at <u>01_GEN_22_19</u># So Abraham returned unto his young men, and they rose up and went together to Beersheba; and Abraham dwelt at Beersheba.

Abraham fell upon <u>01_GEN_17_17</u># Then Abraham fell upon his face, and laughed, and said in his heart,

Shall [a child] be born unto him that is an hundred years old? and shall Sarah, that is ninety years old, bear?

Abraham for a <u>01_GEN_17_05</u> # Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made thee.

Abraham for a <u>01_GEN_23_18</u> # Unto Abraham for a possession in the presence of the children of Heth, before all that went in at the gate of his city.

Abraham for a <u>01_GEN_23_20</u> # And the field, and the cave that [is] therein, were made sure unto Abraham for a possession of a buryingplace by the sons of Heth.

Abraham for righteousness <u>45_ROM_04_09</u># [Cometh] this blessedness then upon the circumcision [only], or upon the uncircumcision also? for we say that faith was reckoned to Abraham for righteousness.

Abraham for the <u>19_PSA_47_09</u> # The princes of the people are gathered together, [even] the people of the God of Abraham: for the shields of the earth [belong] unto God: he is greatly exalted.

Abraham from the <u>06_JOS_24_03</u> # And I took your father Abraham from the other side of the flood, and led him throughout all the land of Canaan, and multiplied his seed, and gave him Isaac.

Abraham gat up <u>01_GEN_19_27</u># And Abraham gat up early in the morning to the place where he stood before the LORD:

Abraham gave a <u>58_HEB_07_02</u> # To whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all; first being by interpretation King of righteousness, and after that also King of Salem, which is, King of peace;

Abraham gave all <u>01_GEN_25_05</u># And Abraham gave all that he had unto Isaac.

Abraham gave gifts <u>01_GEN_25_06</u># But unto the sons of the concubines, which Abraham had, Abraham gave gifts, and sent them away from Isaac his son, while he yet lived, eastward, unto the east country.

Abraham gave the <u>58_HEB_07_04</u> # Now consider how great this man [was], unto whom even the patriarch Abraham gave the tenth of the spoils.

Abraham gave up <u>01_GEN_25_08</u># Then Abraham gave up the ghost, and died in a good old age, an old man, and full [of years]; and was gathered to his people.

Abraham had Abraham <u>01_GEN_25_06</u> # But unto the sons of the concubines, which Abraham had, Abraham gave gifts, and sent them away from Isaac his son, while he yet lived, eastward, unto the east country.

Abraham had two <u>48_GAL_04_22</u># For it is written, that Abraham had two sons, the one by a bondmaid, the other by a freewoman.

Abraham hastened into <u>01_GEN_18_06</u># And Abraham hastened into the tent unto Sarah, and said, Make ready quickly three measures of fine meal, knead [it], and make cakes upon the hearth.

Abraham have mercy <u>42_LUK_16_24</u> # And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.

Abraham hearkened unto <u>01_GEN_23_16</u> # And Abraham hearkened unto Ephron; and Abraham weighed to Ephron the silver, which he had named in the audience of the sons of Heth, four hundred shekels of silver, current [money] with the merchant.

Abraham his father <u>01_GEN_22_07</u># And Isaac spake unto Abraham his father, and said, My father: and he said, Here [am] I, my son. And he said, Behold the fire and the wood: but where [is] the lamb for a burnt offering?

Abraham his father <u>01_GEN_26_15</u># For all the wells which his father's servants had digged in the days of Abraham his father, the Philistines had stopped them, and filled them with earth.

Abraham his father <u>01_GEN_26_18</u># And Isaac digged again the wells of water, which they had digged in the days of Abraham his father; for the Philistines had stopped them after the death of Abraham: and he called their names after the names by which his father had called them.

Abraham his master <u>01_GEN_24_09</u># And the servant put his hand under the thigh of Abraham his master, and sware to him concerning that matter.

Abraham his servant <u>19_PSA_105_06</u> # O ye seed of Abraham his servant, ye children of Jacob his chosen.

Abraham his servant <u>19_PSA_105_42</u> # For he remembered his holy promise, [and] Abraham his servant.

Abraham I pray <u>01_GEN_24_12</u> # And he said, O LORD God of my master Abraham, I pray thee, send me good speed this day, and show kindness unto my master Abraham.

Abraham if now <u>01_GEN_24_42</u> # And I came this day unto the well, and said, O LORD God of my master Abraham, if now thou do prosper my way which I go:

Abraham in all <u>01_GEN_24_01</u># And Abraham was old, [and] well stricken in age: and the LORD had blessed Abraham in all things.

Abraham in the <u>01_GEN_23_10</u># And Ephron dwelt among the children of Heth: and Ephron the Hittite answered Abraham in the audience of the children of Heth, [even] of all that went in at the gate of his city, saying,

Abraham is dead <u>43_JOH_08_52</u># Then said the Jews unto him, Now we know that thou hast a devil. Abraham is dead, and the prophets; and thou sayest, If a man keep my saying, he shall never taste of death.

Abraham is our <u>43_JOH_08_39</u># They answered and said unto him, Abraham is our father. Jesus saith unto them, If ye were Abraham's children, ye would do the works of Abraham.

Abraham Isaac and <u>13_1CH_01_28</u># The sons of Abraham; Isaac, and Ishmael.

Abraham Isaac and <u>13_1CH_29_18</u> # O LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, our fathers, keep this for ever in the imagination of the thoughts of the heart of thy people, and prepare their heart unto thee:

Abraham Isaac and <u>11_1KI_18_36</u># And it came to pass at [the time of] the offering of the [evening] sacrifice, that Elijah the prophet came near, and said, LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, let it be known this day that thou [art] God in Israel, and [that] I [am] thy servant, and [that] I have done all these things at thy word.

Abraham Isaac and <u>14_2CH_30_06</u># So the posts went with the letters from the king and his princes throughout all Israel and Judah, and according to the commandment of the king, saying, Ye children of Israel, turn again unto the LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, and he will return to the remnant of you, that are escaped out of the hand of the kings of Assyria.

Abraham Isaac and <u>12_2KI_13_23</u> # And the LORD was gracious unto them, and had compassion on them, and had respect unto them, because of his covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and would not

destroy them, neither cast he them from his presence as yet.

Abraham Isaac and <u>05_DEU_01_08</u> # Behold, I have set the land before you: go in and possess the land which the LORD sware unto your fathers, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give unto them and to their seed after them.

Abraham Isaac and <u>05_DEU_09_05</u> # Not for thy righteousness, or for the uprightness of thine heart, dost thou go to possess their land: but for the wickedness of these nations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee, and that he may perform the word which the LORD sware unto thy fathers, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

Abraham Isaac and <u>05_DEU_09_27</u># Remember thy servants, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; look not unto the stubbornness of this people, nor to their wickedness, nor to their sin:

Abraham Isaac and <u>02_EXO_32_13</u># Remember Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, thy servants, to whom thou swarest by thine own self, and saidst unto them, I will multiply your seed as the stars of heaven, and all this land that I have spoken of will I give unto your seed, and they shall inherit [it] for ever.

Abraham Isaac and <u>24_JER_33_26</u> # Then will I cast away the seed of Jacob, and David my servant, [so] that I will not take [any] of his seed [to be] rulers over the seed of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob: for I will cause their captivity to return, and have mercy on them.

Abraham journeyed from <u>01_GEN_20_01</u># And Abraham journeyed from thence toward the south country, and dwelled between Kadesh and Shur, and sojourned in Gerar.

Abraham Let it <u>01_GEN_21_12</u> # And God said unto Abraham, Let it not be grievous in thy sight because of the lad, and because of thy bondwoman; in all that Sarah hath said unto thee, hearken unto her voice; for in Isaac shall thy seed be called.

Abraham lifted up <u>01_GEN_22_04</u># Then on the third day Abraham lifted up his eyes, and saw the place afar off.

Abraham lifted up <u>01_GEN_22_13</u># And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind [him] a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son.

Abraham made a <u>01_GEN_21_08</u># And the child grew, and was weaned: and Abraham made a great feast the [same] day that Isaac was weaned.

Abraham might come <u>48_GAL_03_14</u> # That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Abraham mocking <u>01_GEN_21_09</u># And Sarah saw the son of Hagar the Egyptian, which she had born unto Abraham, mocking.

Abraham my friend 23_ISA_41_08 # But thou, Israel, [art] my servant, Jacob whom I have chosen, the seed of Abraham my friend.

Abraham obeyed my <u>01_GEN_26_05</u># Because that Abraham obeyed my voice, and kept my charge, my commandments, my statutes, and my laws.

Abraham of Isaac <u>02_EXO_03_16</u> # Go, and gather the elders of Israel together, and say unto them, The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, of Isaac, and of Jacob, appeared unto me, saying, I have surely visited you, and [seen] that which is done to you in Egypt:

Abraham of the <u>45_ROM_11_01</u># I say then, Hath God cast away his people? God forbid. For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, [of] the tribe of Benjamin.

Abraham or to <u>45_ROM_04_13</u> # For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, [was] not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.

Abraham our father <u>59_JAM_02_21</u> # Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar?

Abraham our father <u>45_ROM_04_01</u> # What shall we say then that Abraham our father, as pertaining to the flesh, hath found?

Abraham out of <u>01_GEN_22_15</u># And the angel of the LORD called unto Abraham out of heaven the second time,

Abraham planted a <u>01_GEN_21_33</u># And [Abraham] planted a grove in Beersheba, and called there on the name of the LORD, the everlasting God.

Abraham prayed unto <u>01_GEN_20_17</u># So Abraham prayed unto God: and God healed Abimelech, and his wife, and his maidservants; and they bare [children].

Abraham purchased of <u>01_GEN_25_10</u> # The field which Abraham purchased of the sons of Heth: there was Abraham buried, and Sarah his wife.

Abraham ran unto <u>01_GEN_18_07</u> # And Abraham ran unto the herd, and fetched a calf tender and good, and gave [it] unto a young man; and he hasted to dress it.

Abraham rejoiced to <u>43_JOH_08_56</u> # Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw [it], and was glad.

Abraham reproved Abimelech <u>01_GEN_21_25</u># And Abraham reproved Abimelech because of a well of water, which Abimelech's servants had violently taken away.

Abraham returned unto <u>01_GEN_18_33</u> # And the LORD went his way, as soon as he had left communing with Abraham: and Abraham returned unto his place.

Abraham returned unto <u>01_GEN_22_19</u># So Abraham returned unto his young men, and they rose up and went together to Beersheba; and Abraham dwelt at Beersheba.

Abraham returning from <u>58_HEB_07_01</u> # For this Melchisedec, king of Salem, priest of the most high God, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings, and blessed him;

Abraham rose up <u>01_GEN_21_14</u> # And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and took bread, and a bottle of water, and gave [it] unto Hagar, putting [it] on her shoulder, and the child, and sent her away: and she departed, and wandered in the wilderness of Beersheba.

Abraham rose up <u>01_GEN_22_03</u># And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and saddled his ass, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son, and clave the wood for the burnt offering, and rose up, and went unto the place of which God had told him.

Abraham said Because <u>01_GEN_20_11</u># And Abraham said, Because I thought, Surely the fear of God [is] not in this place; and they will slay me for my wife's sake.

Abraham said I <u>01_GEN_21_24</u># And Abraham said, I will swear.

Abraham said My <u>01_GEN_22_08</u># And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together.

Abraham said of <u>01_GEN_20_02</u># And Abraham said of Sarah his wife, She [is] my sister: and Abimelech king of Gerar sent, and took Sarah.

Abraham said Son <u>42_LUK_16_25</u> # But Abraham said, Son, remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things: but now he is comforted, and thou art tormented.

Abraham said unto 01_GEN_17_18 # And Abraham said unto God, O that Ishmael might live before thee!

Abraham said unto <u>01_GEN_24_06</u># And Abraham said unto him, Beware thou that thou bring not my son thither again.

Abraham saith unto <u>42_LUK_16_29</u># Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.

Abraham saying Behold <u>01_GEN_22_20</u> # And it came to pass after these things, that it was told Abraham, saying, Behold, Milcah, she hath also born children unto thy brother Nahor;

Abraham saying God <u>01_GEN_21_22</u># And it came to pass at that time, that Abimelech and Phichol the chief captain of his host spake unto Abraham, saying, God [is] with thee in all that thou doest:

Abraham saying In <u>48_GAL_03_08</u> # And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, [saying], In thee shall all nations be blessed.

Abraham saying unto <u>01_GEN_23_05</u># And the children of Heth answered Abraham, saying unto him,

Abraham saying unto 01_GEN_23_14 # And Ephron answered Abraham, saying unto him,

Abraham set seven <u>01_GEN_21_28</u># And Abraham set seven ewe lambs of the flock by themselves.

Abraham shall surely <u>01_GEN_18_18</u> # Seeing that Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?

Abraham so am <u>47_2CO_11_22</u># Are they Hebrews? so [am] I. Are they Israelites? so [am] I. Are they the seed of Abraham? so [am] I.

Abraham sojourned in <u>01_GEN_21_34</u> # And Abraham sojourned in the Philistines' land many days.

Abraham stood up <u>01_GEN_23_03</u># And Abraham stood up from before his dead, and spake unto the sons of Heth, saying,

Abraham stood up <u>01_GEN_23_07</u># And Abraham stood up, and bowed himself to the people of the land, [even] to the children of Heth.

Abraham stood yet <u>01_GEN_18_22</u># And the men turned their faces from thence, and went toward Sodom: but Abraham stood yet before the LORD.

Abraham stretched forth <u>01_GEN_22_10</u># And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son.

Abraham that God <u>01_GEN_25_11</u># And it came to pass after the death of Abraham, that God blessed his son Isaac; and Isaac dwelt by the well Lahairoi.

Abraham that Sarah <u>01_GEN_21_07</u># And she said, Who would have said unto Abraham, that Sarah should have given children suck? for I have born [him] a son in his old age.

Abraham that thing <u>01_GEN_18_17</u># And the LORD said, Shall I hide from Abraham that thing which I do;

Abraham that which <u>01_GEN_18_19</u># For I know him, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the LORD, to do justice and judgment; that the LORD may bring upon Abraham that which he hath spoken of him.

Abraham the God <u>02_EXO_03_06</u># Moreover he said, I [am] the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God.

Abraham the God <u>02_EXO_03_15</u># And God said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this [is] my name for ever, and this [is] my memorial unto all generations.

Abraham the God <u>02_EXO_04_05</u># That they may believe that the LORD God of their fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath appeared unto thee.

Abraham the people <u>44_ACT_07_17</u># But when the time of the promise drew nigh, which God had sworn to Abraham, the people grew and multiplied in Egypt,

Abraham Thou shalt <u>01_GEN_17_09</u># And God said unto Abraham, Thou shalt keep my covenant therefore, thou, and thy seed after thee in their generations.

Abraham thy father <u>01_GEN_26_03</u># Sojourn in this land, and I will be with thee, and will bless thee; for unto thee, and unto thy seed, I will give all these countries, and I will perform the oath which I sware unto Abraham thy father;

Abraham was old <u>01_GEN_24_01</u># And Abraham was old, [and] well stricken in age: and the LORD had blessed Abraham in all things.

Abraham was one <u>26_EZE_33_24</u># Son of man, they that inhabit those wastes of the land of Israel speak, saying, Abraham was one, and he inherited the land: but we [are] many; the land is given us for inheritance.

Abraham weighed to <u>01_GEN_23_16</u># And Abraham hearkened unto Ephron; and Abraham weighed to Ephron the silver, which he had named in the audience of the sons of Heth, four hundred shekels of silver, current [money] with the merchant.

Abraham went and <u>01_GEN_22_13</u> # And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind [him] a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son.

Abraham What sawest <u>01_GEN_20_10</u># And Abimelech said unto Abraham, What sawest thou, that thou hast done this thing?

Abraham when he <u>44_ACT_07_02</u> # And he said, Men, brethren, and fathers, hearken; The God of glory appeared unto our father Abraham, when he was in Mesopotamia, before he dwelt in Charran,

Abraham when he <u>58_HEB_11_08</u># By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went.

Abraham when he <u>58_HEB_11_17</u># By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten [son].

Abraham Wherefore did <u>01_GEN_18_13</u> # And the LORD said unto Abraham, Wherefore did Sarah laugh, saying, Shall I of a surety bear a child, which am old?

Abraham which had <u>01_GEN_24_48</u># And I bowed down my head, and worshipped the LORD, and blessed the LORD God of my master Abraham, which had led me in the right way to take my master's brother's daughter unto his son.

Abraham which he <u>45_ROM_04_12</u> # And the father of circumcision to them who are not of the circumcision only, but who also walk in the steps of that faith of our father Abraham, which [he had] being [yet] uncircumcised.

Abraham which is <u>43_JOH_08_53</u> # Art thou greater than our father Abraham, which is dead? and the prophets are dead: whom makest thou thyself?

Abraham which thou <u>33_MIC_07_20</u># Thou wilt perform the truth to Jacob, [and] the mercy to Abraham, which thou hast sworn unto our fathers from the days of old.

Abraham which was <u>42_LUK_03_34</u> # Which was [the son] of Jacob, which was [the son] of Isaac, which was [the son] of Abraham, which was [the son] of Thara, which was [the son] of Nachor,

Abraham who hath <u>01_GEN_24_27</u> # And he said, Blessed [be] the LORD God of my master Abraham, who hath not left destitute my master of his mercy and his truth: I [being] in the way, the LORD led me to the house of my master's brethren.

Abraham who is <u>45_ROM_04_16</u> # Therefore [it is] of faith, that [it might be] by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,

Abraham whom Satan <u>42_LUK_13_16</u> # And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?

Abraham will I <u>03_LEV_26_42</u># Then will I remember my covenant with Jacob, and also my covenant with Isaac, and also my covenant with Abraham will I remember; and I will remember the land.

Abraham with Isaac <u>02_EXO_02_24</u> # And God heard their groaning, and God remembered his covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob.

Abraham your father 23_ISA_51_02 # Look unto Abraham your father, and unto Sarah [that] bare you: for I called him alone, and blessed him, and increased him.

Abraham <u>13_1CH_01_27</u> # Abram; the same [is] Abraham.

Abraham <u>48_GAL_03_07</u> # Know ye therefore that they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham.

Abraham <u>48_GAL_03_09</u> # So then they which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham.

Abraham <u>01_GEN_17_22</u># And he left off talking with him, and God went up from Abraham.

Abraham <u>01_GEN_24_12</u> # And he said, O LORD God of my master Abraham, I pray thee, send me good speed this day, and show kindness unto my master Abraham.

Abraham <u>01_GEN_25_12</u># Now these [are] the generations of Ishmael, Abraham's son, whom Hagar the Egyptian, Sarah's handmaid, bare unto Abraham:

chamber that was <u>26_EZE_42_01</u> # Then he brought me forth into the utter court, the way toward the north: and he brought me into the chamber that [was] over against the separate place, and which [was] before the building toward the north.

chamber to Amnon <u>10_2SA_13_10</u> # And Amnon said unto Tamar, Bring the meat into the chamber, that I may eat of thine hand. And Tamar took the cakes which she had made, and brought [them] into the chamber to Amnon her brother.

chamber to hide <u>11_1KI_22_25</u># And Micaiah said, Behold, thou shalt see in that day, when thou shalt go into an inner chamber to hide thyself.

chamber to hide <u>14_2CH_18_24</u> # And Micaiah said, Behold, thou shalt see on that day when thou shalt go into an inner chamber to hide thyself.

chamber to the <u>26_EZE_40_13</u># He measured then the gate from the roof of [one] little chamber to the roof of another: the breadth [was] five and twenty cubits, door against door.

chamber was five <u>11_1KI_06_06</u># The nethermost chamber [was] five cubits broad, and the middle [was] six cubits broad, and the third [was] seven cubits broad: for without [in the wall] of the house he made narrowed rests round about, that [the beams] should not be fastened in the walls of the house.

chamber was in <u>11_1KI_06_08</u># The door for the middle chamber [was] in the right side of the house: and they went up with winding stairs into the middle [chamber], and out of the middle into the third.

chamber whose prospect <u>26_EZE_40_46</u> # And the chamber whose prospect [is] toward the north [is] for the priests, the keepers of the charge of the altar: these [are] the sons of Zadok among the sons of Levi, which come near to the LORD to minister unto him.

chamber <u>16_NEH_03_30</u> # After him repaired Hananiah the son of Shelemiah, and Hanun the sixth son of Zalaph, another piece. After him repaired Meshullam the son of Berechiah over against his chamber.

chamber <u>16_NEH_13_08</u># And it grieved me sore: therefore I cast forth all the household stuff of Tobiah out of the chamber.

chambering and wantonness <u>45_ROM_13_13</u> # Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying.

chamberlain keeper of <u>17_EST_02_03</u> # And let the king appoint officers in all the provinces of his kingdom, that they may gather together all the fair young virgins unto Shushan the palace, to the house of the women, unto the custody of Hege the king's chamberlain, keeper of the women; and let their things for purification be given [them]:

chamberlain of the <u>45_ROM_16_23</u> # Gaius mine host, and of the whole church, saluteth you. Erastus the chamberlain of the city saluteth you, and Quartus a brother.

chamberlain their friend <u>44_ACT_12_20</u># And Herod was highly displeased with them of Tyre and Sidon: but they came with one accord to him, and, having made Blastus the king's chamberlain their friend, desired peace; because their country was nourished by the king's [country].

chamberlain which kept <u>17_EST_02_14</u> # In the evening she went, and on the morrow she returned into the second house of the women, to the custody of Shaashgaz, the king's chamberlain, which kept the concubines: she came in unto the king no more, except the king delighted in her, and that she were called by name.

chamberlains the keepers <u>17_EST_06_02</u> # And it was found written, that Mordecai had told of Bigthana and Teresh, two of the king's chamberlains, the keepers of the door, who sought to lay hand on the king Ahasuerus.

chamberlains therefore was <u>17_EST_01_12</u> # But the queen Vashti refused to come at the king's commandment by [his] chamberlains: therefore was the king very wroth, and his anger burned in him.

chamberlains whom he <u>17_EST_04_05</u> # Then called Esther for Hatach, [one] of the king's chamberlains, whom he had appointed to attend upon her, and gave him a commandment to Mordecai, to know what it [was], and why it [was].

chamberlains <u>17_EST_01_15</u> # What shall we do unto the queen Vashti according to law, because she hath not performed the commandment of the king Ahasuerus by the chamberlains?

chambers against all <u>11_1KI_06_10</u># And [then] he built chambers against all the house, five cubits high: and they rested on the house [with] timber of cedar.

chambers and a <u>26_EZE_40_17</u> # Then brought he me into the outward court, and, lo, [there were] chambers, and a pavement made for the court round about: thirty chambers [were] upon the pavement.

chambers and cutteth <u>24_JER_22_14</u> # That saith, I will build me a wide house and large chambers, and cutteth him out windows; and [it is] ceiled with cedar, and painted with vermilion.

champaign over against <u>05_DEU_11_30</u># [Are] they not on the other side Jordan, by the way where the sun goeth down, in the land of the Canaanites, which dwell in the champaign over against Gilgal, beside the plains of Moreh?

champion out of <u>09_1SA_17_04</u> # And there went out a champion out of the camp of the Philistines, named Goliath, of Gath, whose height [was] six cubits and a span.

champion the Philistine <u>09_1SA_17_23</u># And as he talked with them, behold, there came up the champion, the Philistine of Gath, Goliath by name, out of the armies of the Philistines, and spake according to the same words: and David heard [them].

Elishama and Eliada <u>13_1CH_03_08</u># And Elishama, and Eliada, and Eliphelet, nine.

Elishama and Eliada <u>10_28A_05_16</u> # And Elishama, and Eliada, and Eliphalet.

Elishama and Eliphelet <u>13_1CH_03_06</u># Ibhar also, and Elishama, and Eliphelet,

Elishama and Jehoram <u>14_2CH_17_08</u> # And with them [he sent] Levites, [even] Shemaiah, and Nethaniah, and Zebadiah, and Asahel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehonathan, and Adonijah, and Tobijah, and Tobadonijah, Levites; and with them Elishama and Jehoram, priests.

Elishama his son <u>13_1CH_07_26</u> # Laadan his son, Ammihud his son, Elishama his son,

Elishama of the <u>12_2KI_25_25</u> # But it came to pass in the seventh month, that Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, the son of Elishama, of the seed royal, came, and ten men with him, and smote Gedaliah, that he died, and the Jews and the Chaldees that were with him at Mizpah.

Elishama <u>13_1CH_02_41</u> # And Shallum begat Jekamiah, and Jekamiah begat Elishama.

Etham and pitched <u>04_NUM_33_08</u># And they departed from before Pihahiroth, and passed through the midst of the sea into the wilderness, and went three days' journey in the wilderness of Etham, and pitched in Marah.

Etham and turned <u>04_NUM_33_07</u> # And they removed from Etham, and turned again unto Pihahiroth, which [is] before Baalzephon: and they pitched before Migdol.

Etham in the <u>02_EXO_13_20</u> # And they took their journey from Succoth, and encamped in Etham, in the edge of the wilderness.

Etham which is <u>04_NUM_33_06</u># And they departed from Succoth, and pitched in Etham, which [is] in the edge of the wilderness.

Gaham and Thahash <u>01_GEN_22_24</u> # And his concubine, whose name [was] Reumah, she bare also Tebah, and Gaham, and Thahash, and Maachah.

Gesham and Pelet <u>13_1CH_02_47</u> # And the sons of Jahdai; Regem, and Jotham, and Gesham, and Pelet, and Ephah, and Shaaph.

guestchamber where I <u>42_LUK_22_11</u> # And ye shall say unto the goodman of the house, The Master saith unto thee, Where is the guestchamber, where I shall eat the passover with my disciples?

guestchamber where I <u>41_MAR_14_14</u> # And wheresoever he shall go in, say ye to the goodman of the house, The Master saith, Where is the guestchamber, where I shall eat the passover with my disciples?

Ham after their <u>01_GEN_10_20</u># These [are] the sons of Ham, after their families, after their tongues, in their countries, [and] in their nations.

Ham and Japheth <u>13_1CH_01_04</u> # Noah, Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

Ham and Japheth <u>01_GEN_05_32</u> # And Noah was five hundred years old: and Noah begat Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

Haman come this <u>17_EST_05_04</u> # And Esther answered, If [it seem] good unto the king, let the king and Haman come this day unto the banquet that I have prepared for him.

Haman come to <u>17_EST_05_08</u> # If I have found favour in the sight of the king, and if it please the king to grant my petition, and to perform my request, let the king and Haman come to the banquet that I shall prepare for them, and I will do to morrow as the king hath said.

Haman for the <u>17_EST_03_02</u> # And all the king's servants, that [were] in the king's gate, bowed, and reverenced Haman: for the king had so commanded concerning him. But Mordecai bowed not, nor did [him] reverence.

Haman forth that <u>17_EST_05_09</u> # Then went Haman forth that day joyful and with a glad heart: but when Haman saw Mordecai in the king's gate, that he stood not up, nor moved for him, he was full of indignation against Mordecai.

Haman full of <u>17_EST_03_05</u># And when Haman saw that Mordecai bowed not, nor did him reverence, then was Haman full of wrath.

Haman had commanded <u>17_EST_03_12</u> # Then were the king's scribes called on the thirteenth day of the first month, and there was written according to all that Haman had commanded unto the king's lieutenants, and to the governors that [were] over every province, and to the rulers of every people of every province according to the writing thereof, and [to] every people after their language; in the name of king Ahasuerus was it written, and sealed with the king's ring.

Haman had made <u>17_EST_07_09</u># And Harbonah, one of the chamberlains, said before the king, Behold also, the gallows fifty cubits high, which Haman had made for Mordecai, who had spoken good for the king, standeth in the house of Haman. Then the king said, Hang him thereon.

Haman said moreover <u>17_EST_05_12</u># Haman said moreover, Yea, Esther the queen did let no man come in with the king unto the banquet that she had prepared but myself; and to morrow am I invited unto her also with the king.

Haman said unto <u>17_EST_03_08</u># And Haman said unto king Ahasuerus, There is a certain people scattered abroad and dispersed among the people in all the provinces of thy kingdom; and their laws [are] diverse from all people; neither keep they the king's laws: therefore it [is] not for the king's profit to suffer them.

Haman sat down <u>17_EST_03_15</u> # The posts went out, being hastened by the king's commandment, and the decree was given in Shushan the palace. And the king and Haman sat down to drink; but the city Shushan was perplexed.

Haman saw Mordecai <u>17_EST_05_09</u> # Then went Haman forth that day joyful and with a glad heart: but when Haman saw Mordecai in the king's gate, that he stood not up, nor moved for him, he was full of indignation against Mordecai.

Haman saw that <u>17_EST_03_05</u># And when Haman saw that Mordecai bowed not, nor did him reverence, then was Haman full of wrath.

Haman sought to <u>17_EST_03_06</u># And he thought scorn to lay hands on Mordecai alone; for they had showed him the people of Mordecai: wherefore Haman sought to destroy all the Jews that [were] throughout the whole kingdom of Ahasuerus, [even] the people of Mordecai.

Haman standeth in <u>17_EST_06_05</u># And the king's servants said unto him, Behold, Haman standeth in the court. And the king said, Let him come in.

Haman stood up <u>17_EST_07_07</u># And the king arising from the banquet of wine in his wrath [went] into the palace garden: and Haman stood up to make request for his life to Esther the queen; for he saw that there was evil determined against him by the king.

Haman the Agagite <u>17_EST_08_03</u> # And Esther spake yet again before the king, and fell down at his feet, and besought him with tears to put away the mischief of Haman the Agagite, and his device that he had devised against the Jews.

Haman the apparel <u>17_EST_06_11</u># Then took Haman the apparel and the horse, and arrayed Mordecai, and brought him on horseback through the street of the city, and proclaimed before him, Thus shall it be done unto the man whom the king delighteth to honour.

Haman the Jews' <u>17_EST_08_01</u> # On that day did the king Ahasuerus give the house of Haman the Jews' enemy unto Esther the queen. And Mordecai came before the king; for Esther had told what he [was] unto her.

Haman The silver <u>17_EST_03_11</u># And the king said unto Haman, The silver [is] given to thee, the people also, to do with them as it seemeth good to thee.

Haman the son <u>17_EST_03_01</u> # After these things did king Ahasuerus promote Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, and advanced him, and set his seat above all the princes that [were] with him.

Haman the son <u>17_EST_03_10</u> # And the king took his ring from his hand, and gave it unto Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, the Jews' enemy.

Haman the son <u>17_EST_08_05</u> # And said, If it please the king, and if I have found favour in his sight, and the thing [seem] right before the king, and I [be] pleasing in his eyes, let it be written to reverse the letters devised by Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, which he wrote to destroy the Jews which [are] in all the king's provinces:

Haman the son <u>17_EST_09_10</u># The ten sons of Haman the son of Hammedatha, the enemy of the Jews, slew they; but on the spoil laid they not their hand.

Haman the son <u>17_EST_09_24</u> # Because Haman the son of Hammedatha, the Agagite, the enemy of all the Jews, had devised against the Jews to destroy them, and had cast Pur, that [is], the lot, to consume them, and to destroy them;

Haman Then Haman <u>17_EST_07_06</u># And Esther said, The adversary and enemy [is] this wicked Haman. Then Haman was afraid before the king and the queen.

Haman Then the <u>17_EST_07_09</u> # And Harbonah, one of the chamberlains, said before the king, Behold also, the gallows fifty cubits high, which Haman had made for Mordecai, who had spoken good for the king, standeth in the house of Haman. Then the king said, Hang him thereon.

Haman thought in <u>17_EST_06_06</u> # So Haman came in. And the king said unto him, What shall be done unto the man whom the king delighteth to honour? Now Haman thought in his heart, To whom would the king delight to do honour more than to myself?

Hamath for these <u>26_EZE_48_01</u> # Now these [are] the names of the tribes. From the north end to the coast of the way of Hethlon, as one goeth to Hamath, Hazarenan, the border of Damascus northward, to the coast of Hamath; for these are his sides east [and] west; a [portion for] Dan.

Hamath Hazarenan the <u>26_EZE_48_01</u> # Now these [are] the names of the tribes. From the north end to the coast of the way of Hethlon, as one goeth to Hamath, Hazarenan, the border of Damascus northward, to the coast of Hamath; for these are his sides east [and] west; a [portion for] Dan.

Hamath is confounded 24_JER_49_23 # Concerning Damascus. Hamath is confounded, and Arpad: for they have heard evil tidings: they are fainthearted; [there is] sorrow on the sea; it cannot be quiet.

Hamath made Ashima <u>12_2KI_17_30</u> # And the men of Babylon made Succothbenoth, and the men of Cuth made Nergal, and the men of Hamath made Ashima,

Hamath So Judah <u>12_2KI_25_21</u> # And the king of Babylon smote them, and slew them at Riblah in the land of Hamath. So Judah was carried away out of their land.

Hamath that he <u>12_2KI_23_33</u># And Pharaohnechoh put him in bands at Riblah in the land of Hamath, that he might not reign in Jerusalem; and put the land to a tribute of an hundred talents of silver, and a talent of gold.

Hammedatha the Agagite <u>17_EST_08_05</u> # And said, If it please the king, and if I have found favour in his sight, and the thing [seem] right before the king, and I [be] pleasing in his eyes, let it be written to reverse the letters devised by Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, which he wrote to destroy the Jews which [are] in all the king's provinces:

Hammedatha the Agagite <u>17_EST_09_24</u># Because Haman the son of Hammedatha, the Agagite, the enemy of all the Jews, had devised against the Jews to destroy them, and had cast Pur, that [is], the lot, to consume them, and to destroy them;

Hammedatha the enemy <u>17_EST_09_10</u> # The ten sons of Haman the son of Hammedatha, the enemy of the Jews, slew they; but on the spoil laid they not their hand.

Hammelech and Seraiah <u>24_JER_36_26</u># But the king commanded Jerahmeel the son of Hammelech, and Seraiah the son of Azriel, and Shelemiah the son of Abdeel, to take Baruch the scribe and Jeremiah the prophet: but the LORD hid them.

Hammelech that was 24_JER_38_06 # Then took they Jeremiah, and cast him into the dungeon of Malchiah the son of Hammelech, that [was] in the court of the prison: and they let down Jeremiah with cords. And in the dungeon [there was] no water, but mire: so Jeremiah sunk in the mire.

hammer and with <u>07_JUD_05_26</u># She put her hand to the nail, and her right hand to the workmen's hammer; and with the hammer she smote Sisera, she smote off his head, when she had pierced and stricken through his temples.

hammers that it <u>24_JER_10_04</u> # They deck it with silver and with gold; they fasten it with nails and with hammers, that it move not.

hammers <u>19_PSA_74_06</u># But now they break down the carved work thereof at once with axes and hammers.

Hammoleketh bare Ishod <u>13_1CH_07_18</u># And his sister Hammoleketh bare Ishod, and Abiezer, and Mahalah.

Hammon and Kanah <u>06_JOS_19_28</u> # And Hebron, and Rehob, and Hammon, and Kanah, [even] unto great Zidon;

Hamor the father <u>06_JOS_24_32</u># And the bones of Joseph, which the children of Israel brought up out of Egypt, buried they in Shechem, in a parcel of ground which Jacob bought of the sons of Hamor the father of Shechem for an hundred pieces of silver: and it became the inheritance of the children of Joseph.

Hamor the father <u>07_JUD_09_28</u># And Gaal the son of Ebed said, Who [is] Abimelech, and who [is] Shechem, that we should serve him? [is] not [he] the son of Jerubbaal? and Zebul his officer? serve the men of Hamor the father of Shechem: for why should we serve him?

Hamor the Hivite <u>01_GEN_34_02</u> # And when Shechem the son of Hamor the Hivite, prince of the country, saw her, he took her, and lay with her, and defiled her.

Hamor's son <u>01_GEN_34_18</u># And their words pleased Hamor, and Shechem Hamor's son.

Hamuel his son <u>13_1CH_04_26</u># And the sons of Mishma; Hamuel his son, Zacchur his son, Shimei his son.

Hamul the family <u>04_NUM_26_21</u> # And the sons of Pharez were; of Hezron, the family of the Hezronites: of Hamul, the family of the Hamulites.

Hamul <u>13_1CH_02_05</u># The sons of Pharez; Hezron, and Hamul.

Hamul <u>01_GEN_46_12</u># And the sons of Judah; Er, and Onan, and Shelah, and Pharez, and Zarah: but Er and Onan died in the land of Canaan. And the sons of Pharez were Hezron and Hamul.

Hamulites <u>04_NUM_26_21</u> # And the sons of Pharez were; of Hezron, the family of the Hezronites: of Hamul, the family of the Hamulites.

Hamutal the daughter <u>12_2KI_23_31</u> # Jehoahaz [was] twenty and three years old when he began to reign; and he reigned three months in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Hamutal, the daughter of Jeremiah of Libnah.

Hamutal the daughter <u>12_2KI_24_18</u> # Zedekiah [was] twenty and one years old when he began to reign, and he reigned eleven years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Hamutal, the daughter of Jeremiah of Libnah.

Hamutal the daughter <u>24_JER_52_01</u> # Zedekiah [was] one and twenty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned eleven years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Hamutal the daughter of Jeremiah of Libnah.

Hoham king of <u>06_JOS_10_03</u> # Wherefore Adonizedek king of Jerusalem sent unto Hoham king of Hebron, and unto Piram king of Jarmuth, and unto Japhia king of Lachish, and unto Debir king of Eglon, saying,

Hoshama and Nedabiah <u>13_1CH_03_18</u># Malchiram also, and Pedaiah, and Shenazar, Jecamiah, Hoshama, and Nedabiah.

Hotham and Shua <u>13_1CH_07_32</u># And Heber begat Japhlet, and Shomer, and Hotham, and Shua their sister.

Hupham the family <u>04_NUM_26_39</u> # Of Shupham, the family of the Shuphamites: of Hupham, the family of the Huphamites.

Huphamites <u>04_NUM_26_39</u> # Of Shupham, the family of the Shuphamites: of Hupham, the family of the Huphamites.

Husham died and <u>01_GEN_36_35</u># And Husham died, and Hadad the son of Bedad, who smote Midian in the field of Moab, reigned in his stead: and the name of his city [was] Avith.

Husham of the <u>13_1CH_01_45</u> # And when Jobab was dead, Husham of the land of the Temanites reigned in his stead.

Husham of the <u>01_GEN_36_34</u># And Jobab died, and Husham of the land of Temani reigned in his stead.

Husham was dead <u>13_1CH_01_46</u># And when Husham was dead, Hadad the son of Bedad, which smote Midian in the field of Moab, reigned in his stead: and the name of his city [was] Avith.

Ithamar Aaron's sons <u>02_EXO_28_01</u> # And take thou unto thee Aaron thy brother, and his sons with him, from among the children of Israel, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office, [even] Aaron, Nadab and Abihu, Eleazar and Ithamar, Aaron's sons.

Ithamar according to <u>13_1CH_24_03</u> # And David distributed them, both Zadok of the sons of Eleazar, and Ahimelech of the sons of Ithamar, according to their offices in their service.

Jeroham of Gedor <u>13_1CH_12_07</u> # And Joelah, and Zebadiah, the sons of Jeroham of Gedor.

Jeroham the son 13_1CH_06_34 # The son of Elkanah, the son of Jeroham, the son of Eliel, the son of Toah,

Jeroham the son 13_1CH_09_12 # And Adaiah the son of Jeroham, the son of Pashur, the son of Malchijah,

and Maasiai the son of Adiel, the son of Jahzerah, the son of Meshullam, the son of Meshillemith, the son of Immer;

Jeroham the son <u>09_1SA_01_01</u># Now there was a certain man of Ramathaimzophim, of mount Ephraim, and his name [was] Elkanah, the son of Jeroham, the son of Elihu, the son of Tohu, the son of Zuph, an Ephrathite:

Jeroham the son <u>16_NEH_11_12</u># And their brethren that did the work of the house [were] eight hundred twenty and two: and Adaiah the son of Jeroham, the son of Pelaliah, the son of Amzi, the son of Zechariah, the son of Pashur, the son of Malchiah,

Jeroham These were <u>13_1CH_27_22</u> # Of Dan, Azareel the son of Jeroham. These [were] the princes of the tribes of Israel.

Jeroham <u>13_1CH_08_27</u> # And Jaresiah, and Eliah, and Zichri, the sons of Jeroham.

Joatham and Joatham <u>40_MAT_01_09</u># And Ozias begat Joatham; and Joatham begat Achaz; and Achaz begat Ezekias;

Joatham begat Achaz <u>40_MAT_01_09</u># And Ozias begat Joatham; and Joatham begat Achaz; and Achaz begat Ezekias;
