Hamath also shall <u>38\_ZEC\_09\_02</u># And Hamath also shall border thereby; Tyrus, and Zidon, though it be very wise.

Hamath and Arphad <u>23\_ISA\_36\_19</u> # Where [are] the gods of Hamath and Arphad? where [are] the gods of Sepharvaim? and have they delivered Samaria out of my hand?

Hamath and from <u>12\_2KI\_17\_24</u> # And the king of Assyria brought [men] from Babylon, and from Cuthah, and from Ava, and from Hamath, and from Sepharvaim, and placed [them] in the cities of Samaria instead of the children of Israel: and they possessed Samaria, and dwelt in the cities thereof.

Hamath Berothah Sibraim <u>26\_EZE\_47\_16</u> # Hamath, Berothah, Sibraim, which [is] between the border of Damascus and the border of Hamath; Hazarhatticon, which [is] by the coast of Hauran.

Hamath for these <u>26\_EZE\_48\_01</u> # Now these [are] the names of the tribes. From the north end to the coast of the way of Hethlon, as one goeth to Hamath, Hazarenan, the border of Damascus northward, to the coast of Hamath; for these are his sides east [and] west; a [portion for] Dan.

Hamath heard how <u>13\_1CH\_18\_09</u># Now when Tou king of Hamath heard how David had smitten all the host of Hadarezer king of Zobah;

Hamath heard that <u>10\_2SA\_08\_09</u># When Toi king of Hamath heard that David had smitten all the host of Hadadezer,

Hamath is confounded <u>24\_JER\_49\_23</u># Concerning Damascus. Hamath is confounded, and Arpad: for they have heard evil tidings: they are fainthearted; [there is] sorrow on the sea; it cannot be quiet.

Hamath made Ashima <u>12\_2KI\_17\_30</u> # And the men of Babylon made Succothbenoth, and the men of Cuth made Nergal, and the men of Hamath made Ashima,

Hamath So Judah <u>12\_2KI\_25\_21</u> # And the king of Babylon smote them, and slew them at Riblah in the land of Hamath. So Judah was carried away out of their land.

Hamath that he <u>12\_2KI\_23\_33</u># And Pharaohnechoh put him in bands at Riblah in the land of Hamath, that he might not reign in Jerusalem; and put the land to a tribute of an hundred talents of silver, and a talent of gold.

Hamath This is <u>26\_EZE\_47\_20</u># The west side also [shall be] the great sea from the border, till a man come over against Hamath. This [is] the west side.

Hamath Thus Judah <u>24\_JER\_52\_27</u> # And the king of Babylon smote them, and put them to death in Riblah in the land of Hamath. Thus Judah was carried away captive out of his own land.

Hamath unto the <u>11\_1KI\_08\_65</u># And at that time Solomon held a feast, and all Israel with him, a great congregation, from the entering in of Hamath unto the river of Egypt, before the LORD our God, seven days and seven days, [even] fourteen days.

Hamath <u>14\_2CH\_08\_04</u> # And he built Tadmor in the wilderness, and all the store cities, which he built in Hamath.

Hamath <u>06\_JOS\_13\_05</u># And the land of the Giblites, and all Lebanon, toward the sunrising, from Baalgad under mount Hermon unto the entering into Hamath.

Hamath <u>07\_JUD\_03\_03</u> # [Namely], five lords of the Philistines, and all the Canaanites, and the Sidonians, and the Hivites that dwelt in mount Lebanon, from mount Baalhermon unto the entering in of Hamath.

Hamath <u>04\_NUM\_13\_21</u># So they went up, and searched the land from the wilderness of Zin unto Rehob, as men come to Hamath.

Hamathite and afterward <u>01\_GEN\_10\_18</u># And the Arvadite, and the Zemarite, and the Hamathite: and afterward were the families of the Canaanites spread abroad.
