Hamor and Shechem 01_GEN_34_18 # And their words pleased Hamor, and Shechem Hamor's son.

Hamor and Shechem <u>01_GEN_34_20</u># And Hamor and Shechem his son came unto the gate of their city, and communed with the men of their city, saying,

Hamor and Shechem <u>01_GEN_34_26</u> # And they slew Hamor and Shechem his son with the edge of the sword, and took Dinah out of Shechem's house, and went out.

Hamor and unto <u>01_GEN_34_24</u> # And unto Hamor and unto Shechem his son hearkened all that went out of the gate of his city; and every male was circumcised, all that went out of the gate of his city.

Hamor communed with <u>01_GEN_34_08</u># And Hamor communed with them, saying, The soul of my son Shechem longeth for your daughter: I pray you give her him to wife.

Hamor his father <u>01_GEN_34_13</u># And the sons of Jacob answered Shechem and Hamor his father deceitfully, and said, because he had defiled Dinah their sister:

Hamor saying Get <u>01_GEN_34_04</u># And Shechem spake unto his father Hamor, saying, Get me this damsel to wife.

Hamor Shechem's father <u>01_GEN_33_19</u># And he bought a parcel of a field, where he had spread his tent, at the hand of the children of Hamor, Shechem's father, for an hundred pieces of money.

Hamor the father <u>01_GEN_34_06</u># And Hamor the father of Shechem went out unto Jacob to commune with him.

Hamor the father <u>06_JOS_24_32</u> # And the bones of Joseph, which the children of Israel brought up out of Egypt, buried they in Shechem, in a parcel of ground which Jacob bought of the sons of Hamor the father of Shechem for an hundred pieces of silver: and it became the inheritance of the children of Joseph.

Hamor the father <u>07_JUD_09_28</u> # And Gaal the son of Ebed said, Who [is] Abimelech, and who [is] Shechem, that we should serve him? [is] not [he] the son of Jerubbaal? and Zebul his officer? serve the men of Hamor the father of Shechem: for why should we serve him?

Hamor the Hivite <u>01_GEN_34_02</u> # And when Shechem the son of Hamor the Hivite, prince of the country, saw her, he took her, and lay with her, and defiled her.
