Aharah the third <u>13\_1CH\_08\_01</u> # Now Benjamin begat Bela his firstborn, Ashbel the second, and Aharah the third,

Anaharath <u>06\_JOS\_19\_19</u> # And Haphraim, and Shihon, and Anaharath,

Aramnaharaim and with <u>19\_PSA\_60\_01</u># To the chief Musician upon Shushaneduth, Michtam of David, to teach; when he strove with Aramnaharaim and with Aramzobah, when Joab returned, and smote of Edom in the valley of salt twelve thousand. O God, thou hast cast us off, thou hast scattered us, thou hast been displeased; O turn thyself to us again.

Haran and Rezeph <u>23\_ISA\_37\_12</u> # Have the gods of the nations delivered them which my fathers have destroyed, [as] Gozan, and Haran, and Rezeph, and the children of Eden which [were] in Telassar?

Haran and they <u>01\_GEN\_12\_05</u># And Abram took Sarai his wife, and Lot his brother's son, and all their substance that they had gathered, and the souls that they had gotten in Haran; and they went forth to go into the land of Canaan; and into the land of Canaan they came.

Haran are we <u>01\_GEN\_29\_04</u> # And Jacob said unto them, My brethren, whence [be] ye? And they said, Of Haran [are] we.

Pharaoh also called <u>02\_EXO\_07\_11</u># Then Pharaoh also called the wise men and the sorcerers: now the magicians of Egypt, they also did in like manner with their enchantments.

Pharaoh an answer <u>01\_GEN\_41\_16</u># And Joseph answered Pharaoh, saying, [It is] not in me: God shall give Pharaoh an answer of peace.

Pharaoh and Aaron <u>02\_EXO\_07\_01</u> # And the LORD said unto Moses, See, I have made thee a god to Pharaoh: and Aaron thy brother shall be thy prophet.

Pharaoh and all <u>26\_EZE\_31\_18</u> # To whom art thou thus like in glory and in greatness among the trees of Eden? yet shalt thou be brought down with the trees of Eden unto the nether parts of the earth: thou shalt lie in the midst of the uncircumcised with [them that be] slain by the sword. Pharaoh and the <u>01\_GEN\_40\_17</u># And in the uppermost basket [there was] of all manner of bakemeats for Pharaoh; and the birds did eat them out of the basket upon my head.

Pharaoh and they <u>02\_EXO\_07\_10</u> # And Moses and Aaron went in unto Pharaoh, and they did so as the LORD had commanded: and Aaron cast down his rod before Pharaoh, and before his servants, and it became a serpent.

Pharaoh and to <u>05\_DEU\_34\_11</u># In all the signs and the wonders, which the LORD sent him to do in the land of Egypt to Pharaoh, and to all his servants, and to all his land,

Pharaoh and to <u>02\_EXO\_18\_08</u> # And Moses told his father in law all that the LORD had done unto Pharaoh and to the Egyptians for Israel's sake, [and] all the travail that had come upon them by the way, and [how] the LORD delivered them.

Pharaoh and to <u>23\_ISA\_30\_02</u> # That walk to go down into Egypt, and have not asked at my mouth; to strengthen themselves in the strength of Pharaoh, and to trust in the shadow of Egypt!

Pharaoh and unto <u>05\_DEU\_07\_18</u># Thou shalt not be afraid of them: [but] shalt well remember what the LORD thy God did unto Pharaoh, and unto all Egypt;

Pharaoh and unto <u>05\_DEU\_29\_02</u> # And Moses called unto all Israel, and said unto them, Ye have seen all that the LORD did before your eyes in the land of Egypt unto Pharaoh, and unto all his servants, and unto all his land;

Pharaoh and upon <u>05\_DEU\_06\_22</u> # And the LORD showed signs and wonders, great and sore, upon Egypt, upon Pharaoh, and upon all his household, before our eyes:

Pharaoh and upon <u>02\_EXO\_11\_01</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Yet will I bring one plague [more] upon Pharaoh, and upon Egypt; afterwards he will let you go hence: when he shall let [you] go, he shall surely thrust you out hence altogether.

Pharaoh and upon <u>02\_EXO\_14\_04</u># And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, that he shall follow after them; and I will be honoured upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host; that the Egyptians may know that I [am] the LORD. And they did so.

Pharaoh and went <u>01\_GEN\_41\_46</u> # And Joseph [was] thirty years old when he stood before Pharaoh king of Egypt. And Joseph went out from the presence of Pharaoh, and went throughout all the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh and went <u>01\_GEN\_47\_10</u> # And Jacob blessed Pharaoh, and went out from before Pharaoh.

Pharaoh and without <u>01\_GEN\_41\_44</u> # And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I [am] Pharaoh, and without thee shall no man lift up his hand or foot in all the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh awoke and <u>01\_GEN\_41\_07</u># And the seven thin ears devoured the seven rank and full ears. And Pharaoh awoke, and, behold, [it was] a dream.

Pharaoh awoke <u>01\_GEN\_41\_04</u># And the ill favoured and leanfleshed kine did eat up the seven well favoured and fat kine. So Pharaoh awoke.

Pharaoh be your <u>23\_ISA\_30\_03</u># Therefore shall the strength of Pharaoh be your shame, and the trust in the shadow of Egypt [your] confusion.

Pharaoh Because the <u>02\_EXO\_01\_19</u># And the midwives said unto Pharaoh, Because the Hebrew women [are] not as the Egyptian women; for they [are] lively, and are delivered ere the midwives come in unto them.

Pharaoh but he <u>12\_2KI\_23\_35</u> # And Jehoiakim gave the silver and the gold to Pharaoh; but he taxed the land to give the money according to the commandment of Pharaoh: he exacted the silver and the gold of the people of the land, of every one according to his taxation, to give [it] unto Pharaohnechoh.

Pharaoh called Joseph's <u>01\_GEN\_41\_45</u> # And Pharaoh called Joseph's name Zaphnathpaaneah; and he gave him to wife Asenath the daughter of Potipherah priest of On. And Joseph went out over [all] the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh called unto <u>02\_EXO\_10\_24</u> # And Pharaoh called unto Moses, and said, Go ye, serve the LORD; only let your flocks and your herds be stayed: let your little ones also go with you.

Pharaoh came down <u>02\_EXO\_02\_05</u> # And the daughter of Pharaoh came down to wash [herself] at the river; and her maidens walked along by the river's side; and when she saw the ark among the flags, she sent her maid to fetch it.

Pharaoh captain of <u>01\_GEN\_39\_01</u> # And Joseph was brought down to Egypt; and Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh, captain of the guard, an Egyptian, bought him of the hands of the Ishmeelites, which had brought him down thither.

Pharaoh charged all <u>02\_EXO\_01\_22</u> # And Pharaoh charged all his people, saying, Every son that is born ye shall cast into the river, and every daughter ye shall save alive.

Pharaoh commanded his <u>01\_GEN\_12\_20</u> # And Pharaoh commanded [his] men concerning him: and they sent him away, and his wife, and all that he had.

Pharaoh commanded the <u>02\_EXO\_05\_06</u># And Pharaoh commanded the same day the taskmasters of the people, and their officers, saying,

Pharaoh deal deceitfully <u>02\_EXO\_08\_29</u> # And Moses said, Behold, I go out from thee, and I will entreat the LORD that the swarms [of flies] may depart from Pharaoh, from his servants, and from his people, to morrow: but let not Pharaoh deal deceitfully any more in not letting the people go to sacrifice to the LORD.

Pharaoh do this <u>01\_GEN\_41\_34</u># Let Pharaoh do [this], and let him appoint officers over the land, and take up the fifth part of the land of Egypt in the seven plenteous years.

Pharaoh dreamed and <u>01\_GEN\_41\_01</u> # And it came to pass at the end of two full years, that Pharaoh dreamed: and, behold, he stood by the river.

Pharaoh drew nigh <u>02\_EXO\_14\_10</u># And when Pharaoh drew nigh, the children of Israel lifted up their eyes, and, behold, the Egyptians marched after them; and they were sore afraid: and the children of Israel cried out unto the LORD.

Pharaoh Even for <u>45\_ROM\_09\_17</u> # For the scripture saith unto Pharaoh, Even for this same purpose have I raised thee up, that I might show my power in thee, and that my name might be declared throughout all the earth.

Pharaoh for bread <u>01\_GEN\_41\_55</u> # And when all the land of Egypt was famished, the people cried to Pharaoh for bread: and Pharaoh said unto all the Egyptians, Go unto Joseph; what he saith to you, do.

Pharaoh for the <u>01\_GEN\_47\_20</u> # And Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh; for the Egyptians sold every man his field, because the famine prevailed over them: so the land became Pharaoh's.

Pharaoh For to <u>01\_GEN\_47\_04</u> # They said moreover unto Pharaoh, For to sojourn in the land are we come; for thy servants have no pasture for their flocks; for the famine [is] sore in the land of Canaan: now therefore, we pray thee, let thy servants dwell in the land of Goshen.

Pharaoh for with <u>02\_EXO\_06\_01</u> # Then the LORD said unto Moses, Now shalt thou see what I will do to Pharaoh: for with a strong hand shall he let them go, and with a strong hand shall he drive them out of his land.

Pharaoh from his <u>02\_EXO\_08\_29</u> # And Moses said, Behold, I go out from thee, and I will entreat the LORD that the swarms [of flies] may depart from Pharaoh, from his servants, and from his people, to morrow: but let not Pharaoh deal deceitfully any more in not letting the people go to sacrifice to the LORD.

Pharaoh from his <u>02\_EXO\_08\_31</u> # And the LORD did according to the word of Moses; and he removed the swarms [of flies] from Pharaoh, from his servants, and from his people; there remained not one.

Pharaoh gave them <u>01\_GEN\_47\_22</u># Only the land of the priests bought he not; for the priests had a portion [assigned them] of Pharaoh, and did eat their portion which Pharaoh gave them: wherefore they sold not their lands.

Pharaoh Glory over <u>02\_EXO\_08\_09</u> # And Moses said unto Pharaoh, Glory over me: when shall I entreat for thee, and for thy servants, and for thy people, to destroy the frogs from thee and thy houses, [that] they may remain in the river only?

Pharaoh had commanded <u>01\_GEN\_47\_11</u># And Joseph placed his father and his brethren, and gave them a possession in the land of Egypt, in the best of the land, in the land of Rameses, as Pharaoh had commanded.

Pharaoh had let <u>02\_EXO\_13\_17</u> # And it came to pass, when Pharaoh had let the people go, that God led them not [through] the way of the land of the Philistines, although that [was] near; for God said, Lest peradventure the people repent when they see war, and they return to Egypt:

Pharaoh had sent <u>01\_GEN\_46\_05</u># And Jacob rose up from Beersheba: and the sons of Israel carried Jacob their father, and their little ones, and their wives, in the wagons which Pharaoh had sent to carry him.

Pharaoh hardened his <u>02\_EXO\_08\_32</u># And Pharaoh hardened his heart at this time also, neither would he let the people go.

Pharaoh hardened their <u>09\_1SA\_06\_06</u># Wherefore then do ye harden your hearts, as the Egyptians and Pharaoh hardened their hearts? when he had wrought wonderfully among them, did they not let the people go, and they departed?

Pharaoh he exacted <u>12\_2KI\_23\_35</u> # And Jehoiakim gave the silver and the gold to Pharaoh; but he taxed the land to give the money according to the commandment of Pharaoh: he exacted the silver and the gold of the people of the land, of every one according to his taxation, to give [it] unto Pharaohnechoh.

Pharaoh hear me <u>02\_EXO\_06\_12</u> # And Moses spake before the LORD, saying, Behold, the children of Israel have not hearkened unto me; how then shall Pharaoh hear me, who [am] of uncircumcised lips?

Pharaoh heard this <u>02\_EXO\_02\_15</u> # Now when Pharaoh heard this thing, he sought to slay Moses. But Moses fled from the face of Pharaoh, and dwelt in the land of Midian: and he sat down by a well.

Pharaoh heard <u>01\_GEN\_45\_02</u> # And he wept aloud: and the Egyptians and the house of Pharaoh heard.

Pharaoh hearken unto <u>02\_EXO\_06\_30</u> # And Moses said before the LORD, Behold, I [am] of uncircumcised lips, and how shall Pharaoh hearken unto me?

Pharaoh I am <u>23\_ISA\_19\_11</u># Surely the princes of Zoan [are] fools, the counsel of the wise counsellors of Pharaoh is become brutish: how say ye unto Pharaoh, I [am] the son of the wise, the son of ancient kings?

Pharaoh I will <u>02\_EXO\_05\_10</u> # And the taskmasters of the people went out, and their officers, and they spake to the people, saying, Thus saith Pharaoh, I will not give you straw.

Pharaoh in a <u>02\_EXO\_11\_08</u># And all these thy servants shall come down unto me, and bow down themselves unto me, saying, Get thee out, and all the people that follow thee: and after that I will go out. And he went out from Pharaoh in a great anger.

Pharaoh in the <u>02\_EXO\_07\_15</u># Get thee unto Pharaoh in the morning; lo, he goeth out unto the water; and thou shalt stand by the river's brink against he come; and the rod which was turned to a serpent shalt thou take in thine hand.

Pharaoh is become 23\_ISA\_19\_11# Surely the princes of Zoan [are] fools, the counsel of the wise counsellors of Pharaoh is become brutish: how say ye unto Pharaoh, I [am] the son of the wise, the son of ancient kings?

Pharaoh is one <u>01\_GEN\_41\_25</u># And Joseph said unto Pharaoh, The dream of Pharaoh [is] one: God hath showed Pharaoh what he [is] about to do.

Pharaoh king of <u>11\_1KI\_03\_01</u># And Solomon made affinity with Pharaoh king of Egypt, and took Pharaoh's daughter, and brought her into the city of David, until he had made an end of building his own house, and the house of the LORD, and the wall of Jerusalem round about.

Pharaoh king of <u>11\_1KI\_09\_16</u># [For] Pharaoh king of Egypt had gone up, and taken Gezer, and burnt it with fire, and slain the Canaanites that dwelt in the city, and given it [for] a present unto his daughter, Solomon's wife.

Pharaoh king of <u>11\_1KI\_11\_18</u># And they arose out of Midian, and came to Paran: and they took men with them out of Paran, and they came to Egypt, unto Pharaoh king of Egypt; which gave him an house, and appointed him victuals, and gave him land.

Pharaoh king of <u>12\_2KI\_17\_07</u> # For [so] it was, that the children of Israel had sinned against the LORD their God, which had brought them up out of the land of Egypt, from under the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and had feared other gods,

Pharaoh king of <u>12\_2KI\_18\_21</u> # Now, behold, thou trustest upon the staff of this bruised reed, [even] upon Egypt, on which if a man lean, it will go into his hand, and pierce it: so [is] Pharaoh king of Egypt unto all that trust on him.

Pharaoh king of <u>44\_ACT\_07\_10</u> # And delivered him out of all his afflictions, and gave him favour and wisdom in the sight of Pharaoh king of Egypt; and he made him governor over Egypt and all his house.

Pharaoh king of <u>05\_DEU\_07\_08</u> # But because the LORD loved you, and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers, hath the LORD brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.

Pharaoh king of <u>02\_EXO\_06\_11</u># Go in, speak unto Pharaoh king of Egypt, that he let the children of Israel go out of his land.

Pharaoh king of <u>02\_EXO\_06\_13</u> # And the LORD spake unto Moses and unto Aaron, and gave them a charge unto the children of Israel, and unto Pharaoh king of Egypt, to bring the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh king of <u>02\_EXO\_06\_27</u> # These [are] they which spake to Pharaoh king of Egypt, to bring out the children of Israel from Egypt: these [are] that Moses and Aaron.

Pharaoh king of <u>02\_EXO\_06\_29</u> # That the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, I [am] the LORD: speak thou unto Pharaoh king of Egypt all that I say unto thee.

Pharaoh king of <u>02\_EXO\_14\_08</u># And the LORD hardened the heart of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and he pursued after the children of Israel: and the children of Israel went out with an high hand.

Pharaoh king of <u>26\_EZE\_29\_02</u> # Son of man, set thy face against Pharaoh king of Egypt, and prophesy against him, and against all Egypt:

Pharaoh king of <u>26\_EZE\_29\_03</u> # Speak, and say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I [am] against thee, Pharaoh king of Egypt, the great dragon that lieth in the midst of his rivers, which hath said, My river [is] mine own, and I have made [it] for myself.

Pharaoh king of <u>26\_EZE\_30\_21</u># Son of man, I have broken the arm of Pharaoh king of Egypt; and, lo, it shall not be bound up to be healed, to put a roller to bind it, to make it strong to hold the sword.

Pharaoh king of <u>26\_EZE\_30\_22</u># Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I [am] against Pharaoh king of Egypt, and will break his arms, the strong, and that which was broken; and I will cause the sword to fall out of his hand.

Pharaoh king of <u>26\_EZE\_31\_02</u># Son of man, speak unto Pharaoh king of Egypt, and to his multitude; Whom art thou like in thy greatness?

Pharaoh king of <u>26\_EZE\_32\_02</u># Son of man, take up a lamentation for Pharaoh king of Egypt, and say unto him, Thou art like a young lion of the nations, and thou [art] as a whale in the seas: and thou camest forth with thy rivers, and troubledst the waters with thy feet, and fouledst their rivers.

Pharaoh king of <u>01\_GEN\_41\_46</u> # And Joseph [was] thirty years old when he stood before Pharaoh king of Egypt. And Joseph went out from the presence of Pharaoh, and went throughout all the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh king of <u>23\_ISA\_36\_06</u># Lo, thou trustest in the staff of this broken reed, on Egypt; whereon if a man lean, it will go into his hand, and pierce it: so [is] Pharaoh king of Egypt to all that trust in him.

Pharaoh king of <u>24\_JER\_25\_19</u># Pharaoh king of Egypt, and his servants, and his princes, and all his people;

Pharaoh king of <u>24\_JER\_46\_17</u># They did cry there, Pharaoh king of Egypt [is but] a noise; he hath passed the time appointed.

Pharaoh Let me <u>11\_1KI\_11\_21</u># And when Hadad heard in Egypt that David slept with his fathers, and that Joab the captain of the host was dead, Hadad said to Pharaoh, Let me depart, that I may go to mine own country.

Pharaoh lift up <u>01\_GEN\_40\_13</u> # Yet within three days shall Pharaoh lift up thine head, and restore thee unto thy place: and thou shalt deliver Pharaoh's cup into his hand, after the former manner when thou wast his butler.

Pharaoh lift up <u>01\_GEN\_40\_19</u># Yet within three days shall Pharaoh lift up thy head from off thee, and shall hang thee on a tree; and the birds shall eat thy flesh from off thee.

Pharaoh lo he <u>02\_EXO\_08\_20</u> # And the LORD said unto Moses, Rise up early in the morning, and stand before Pharaoh; lo, he cometh forth to the water; and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let my people go, that they may serve me.

Pharaoh lo here <u>01\_GEN\_47\_23</u># Then Joseph said unto the people, Behold, I have bought you this day and your land for Pharaoh: lo, [here is] seed for you, and ye shall sow the land.

Pharaoh look out <u>01\_GEN\_41\_33</u># Now therefore let Pharaoh look out a man discreet and wise, and set him over the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh made his <u>02\_EXO\_09\_20</u> # He that feared the word of the LORD among the servants of Pharaoh made his servants and his cattle flee into the houses:

Pharaoh out of <u>14\_2CH\_08\_11</u> # And Solomon brought up the daughter of Pharaoh out of the city of David unto the house that he had built for her: for he said, My wife shall not dwell in the house of David king of Israel, because [the places are] holy, whereunto the ark of the LORD hath come.

Pharaoh rose up <u>02\_EXO\_12\_30</u> # And Pharaoh rose up in the night, he, and all his servants, and all the Egyptians; and there was a great cry in Egypt; for [there was] not a house where [there was] not one dead.

Pharaoh said Behold <u>02\_EXO\_05\_05</u># And Pharaoh said, Behold, the people of the land now [are] many, and ye make them rest from their burdens.

Pharaoh said Go <u>01\_GEN\_50\_06</u># And Pharaoh said, Go up, and bury thy father, according as he made thee swear.

Pharaoh said I <u>02\_EXO\_08\_28</u> # And Pharaoh said, I will let you go, that ye may sacrifice to the LORD your God in the wilderness; only ye shall not go very far away: entreat for me.

Pharaoh said unto <u>11\_1KI\_11\_22</u># Then Pharaoh said unto him, But what hast thou lacked with me, that, behold, thou seekest to go to thine own country? And he answered, Nothing: howbeit let me go in any wise.

Pharaoh said unto <u>02\_EXO\_10\_28</u># And Pharaoh said unto him, Get thee from me, take heed to thyself, see my face no more; for in [that] day thou seest my face thou shalt die.

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_41\_15</u> # And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I have dreamed a dream, and [there is] none that can interpret it: and I have heard say of thee, [that] thou canst understand a dream to interpret it.

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_41\_17</u># And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, In my dream, behold, I stood upon the bank of the river:

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_41\_38</u> # And Pharaoh said unto his servants, Can we find [such a one] as this [is], a man in whom the Spirit of God [is]?

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_41\_39</u> # And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, Forasmuch as God hath showed thee all this, [there is] none so discreet and wise as thou [art]:

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_41\_41</u># And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, See, I have set thee over all the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_41\_44</u> # And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I [am] Pharaoh, and without thee shall no man lift up his hand or foot in all the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_41\_55</u># And when all the land of Egypt was famished, the people cried to Pharaoh for bread: and Pharaoh said unto all the Egyptians, Go unto Joseph; what he saith to you, do.

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_45\_17</u> # And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, Say unto thy brethren, This do ye; lade your beasts, and go, get you unto the land of Canaan;

Pharaoh said unto <u>01\_GEN\_47\_03</u># And Pharaoh said unto his brethren, What [is] your occupation? And they said unto Pharaoh, Thy servants [are] shepherds, both we, [and] also our fathers.

Pharaoh said unto 01\_GEN\_47\_08 # And Pharaoh said unto Jacob, How old [art] thou?

Pharaoh said Who <u>02\_EXO\_05\_02</u> # And Pharaoh said, Who [is] the LORD, that I should obey his voice to let Israel go? I know not the LORD, neither will I let Israel go.

Pharaoh saw her <u>01\_GEN\_12\_15</u> # The princes also of Pharaoh saw her, and commended her before Pharaoh: and the woman was taken into Pharaoh's house.

Pharaoh saw that <u>02\_EXO\_08\_15</u> # But when Pharaoh saw that there was respite, he hardened his heart, and hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

Pharaoh saw that <u>02\_EXO\_09\_34</u> # And when Pharaoh saw that the rain and the hail and the thunders were ceased, he sinned yet more, and hardened his heart, he and his servants.

Pharaoh saying I <u>01\_GEN\_41\_09</u> # Then spake the chief butler unto Pharaoh, saying, I do remember my faults this day:

Pharaoh saying If <u>01\_GEN\_50\_04</u> # And when the days of his mourning were past, Joseph spake unto the house of Pharaoh, saying, If now I have found grace in your eyes, speak, I pray you, in the ears of Pharaoh, saying,

Pharaoh saying It <u>01\_GEN\_41\_16</u># And Joseph answered Pharaoh, saying, [It is] not in me: God shall give Pharaoh an answer of peace.

Pharaoh saying Wherefore <u>02\_EXO\_05\_15</u># Then the officers of the children of Israel came and cried unto Pharaoh, saying, Wherefore dealest thou thus with thy servants?

Pharaoh saying <u>01\_GEN\_50\_04</u># And when the days of his mourning were past, Joseph spake unto the house of Pharaoh, saying, If now I have found grace in your eyes, speak, I pray you, in the ears of Pharaoh, saying,

Pharaoh sent and <u>02\_EXO\_09\_07</u># And Pharaoh sent, and, behold, there was not one of the cattle of the Israelites dead. And the heart of Pharaoh was hardened, and he did not let the people go.

Pharaoh sent and <u>02\_EXO\_09\_27</u># And Pharaoh sent, and called for Moses and Aaron, and said unto them, I have sinned this time: the LORD [is] righteous, and I and my people [are] wicked.

Pharaoh sent and <u>01\_GEN\_41\_14</u># Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him hastily out of the dungeon: and he shaved [himself], and changed his raiment, and came in unto Pharaoh.

Pharaoh shall call <u>01\_GEN\_46\_33</u># And it shall come to pass, when Pharaoh shall call you, and shall say, What [is] your occupation?

Pharaoh shall fall <u>26\_EZE\_30\_25</u> # But I will strengthen the arms of the king of Babylon, and the arms of Pharaoh shall fall down; and they shall know that I [am] the LORD, when I shall put my sword into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall stretch it out upon the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh shall not <u>02\_EXO\_07\_04</u> # But Pharaoh shall not hearken unto you, that I may lay my hand upon Egypt, and bring forth mine armies, [and] my people the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great judgments.

Pharaoh shall not <u>02\_EXO\_11\_09</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Pharaoh shall not hearken unto you; that my wonders may be multiplied in the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh shall see <u>26\_EZE\_32\_31</u># Pharaoh shall see them, and shall be comforted over all his multitude, [even] Pharaoh and all his army slain by the sword, saith the Lord GOD.

Pharaoh shall speak <u>02\_EXO\_07\_09</u># When Pharaoh shall speak unto you, saying, Show a miracle for you: then thou shalt say unto Aaron, Take thy rod, and cast [it] before Pharaoh, [and] it shall become a serpent.

Pharaoh should have <u>01\_GEN\_47\_26</u> # And Joseph made it a law over the land of Egypt unto this day, [that] Pharaoh should have the fifth [part]; except the land of the priests only, [which] became not Pharaoh's.

Pharaoh smote Gaza <u>24\_JER\_47\_01</u> # The word of the LORD that came to Jeremiah the prophet against the Philistines, before that Pharaoh smote Gaza.

Pharaoh so that <u>11\_1KI\_11\_19</u># And Hadad found great favour in the sight of Pharaoh, so that he gave him to wife the sister of his own wife, the sister of Tahpenes the queen.

Pharaoh spake unto <u>01\_GEN\_47\_05</u> # And Pharaoh spake unto Joseph, saying, Thy father and thy brethren are come unto thee:

Pharaoh surely ye <u>01\_GEN\_42\_16</u># Send one of you, and let him fetch your brother, and ye shall be kept in prison, that your words may be proved, whether [there be any] truth in you: or else by the life of Pharaoh surely ye [are] spies.

Pharaoh that came <u>02\_EXO\_14\_28</u># And the waters returned, and covered the chariots, and the horsemen,

[and] all the host of Pharaoh that came into the sea after them; there remained not so much as one of them.

Pharaoh that he <u>02\_EXO\_07\_02</u># Thou shalt speak all that I command thee: and Aaron thy brother shall speak unto Pharaoh, that he send the children of Israel out of his land.

Pharaoh that sat <u>02\_EXO\_12\_29</u> # And it came to pass, that at midnight the LORD smote all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sat on his throne unto the firstborn of the captive that [was] in the dungeon; and all the firstborn of cattle.

Pharaoh that sitteth <u>02\_EXO\_11\_05</u># And all the firstborn in the land of Egypt shall die, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sitteth upon his throne, even unto the firstborn of the maidservant that [is] behind the mill; and all the firstborn of beasts.

Pharaoh that thou <u>02\_EXO\_03\_10</u># Come now therefore, and I will send thee unto Pharaoh, that thou mayest bring forth my people the children of Israel out of Egypt.

Pharaoh The days <u>01\_GEN\_47\_09</u> # And Jacob said unto Pharaoh, The days of the years of my pilgrimage [are] an hundred and thirty years: few and evil have the days of the years of my life been, and have not attained unto the days of the years of the life of my fathers in the days of their pilgrimage.

Pharaoh The dream <u>01\_GEN\_41\_25</u> # And Joseph said unto Pharaoh, The dream of Pharaoh [is] one: God hath showed Pharaoh what he [is] about to do.

Pharaoh the elders <u>01\_GEN\_50\_07</u> # And Joseph went up to bury his father: and with him went up all the servants of Pharaoh, the elders of his house, and all the elders of the land of Egypt,

Pharaoh the king <u>05\_DEU\_11\_03</u># And his miracles, and his acts, which he did in the midst of Egypt unto Pharaoh the king of Egypt, and unto all his land;

Pharaoh This is <u>02\_EXO\_08\_19</u># Then the magicians said unto Pharaoh, This [is] the finger of God: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

Pharaoh Thus saith <u>02\_EXO\_04\_22</u># And thou shalt say unto Pharaoh, Thus saith the LORD, Israel [is] my son, [even] my firstborn:

Pharaoh Thus saith <u>02\_EXO\_05\_01</u># And afterward Moses and Aaron went in, and told Pharaoh, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Let my people go, that they may hold a feast unto me in the wilderness.

Pharaoh Thy servants <u>01\_GEN\_47\_03</u> # And Pharaoh said unto his brethren, What [is] your occupation? And they said unto Pharaoh, Thy servants [are] shepherds, both we, [and] also our fathers.

Pharaoh to speak <u>02\_EXO\_05\_23</u># For since I came to Pharaoh to speak in thy name, he hath done evil to this people; neither hast thou delivered thy people at all.

Pharaoh told them <u>01\_GEN\_41\_08</u># And it came to pass in the morning that his spirit was troubled; and he sent and called for all the magicians of Egypt, and all the wise men thereof: and Pharaoh told them his dream; but [there was] none that could interpret them unto Pharaoh.

Pharaoh took off <u>01\_GEN\_41\_42</u># And Pharaoh took off his ring from his hand, and put it upon Joseph's hand, and arrayed him in vestures of fine linen, and put a gold chain about his neck;

Pharaoh treasure cities <u>02\_EXO\_01\_11</u># Therefore they did set over them taskmasters to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for Pharaoh treasure cities, Pithom and Raamses.

Pharaoh turned and <u>02\_EXO\_07\_23</u> # And Pharaoh turned and went into his house, neither did he set his

heart to this also.

Pharaoh twice it <u>01\_GEN\_41\_32</u># And for that the dream was doubled unto Pharaoh twice; [it is] because the thing [is] established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass.

Pharaoh upon his <u>02\_EXO\_14\_18</u># And the Egyptians shall know that I [am] the LORD, when I have gotten me honour upon Pharaoh, upon his chariots, and upon his horsemen.

Pharaoh was hardened <u>02\_EXO\_09\_07</u> # And Pharaoh sent, and, behold, there was not one of the cattle of the Israelites dead. And the heart of Pharaoh was hardened, and he did not let the people go.

Pharaoh was hardened <u>02\_EXO\_09\_35</u> # And the heart of Pharaoh was hardened, neither would he let the children of Israel go; as the LORD had spoken by Moses.

Pharaoh was wroth <u>01\_GEN\_40\_02</u> # And Pharaoh was wroth against two [of] his officers, against the chief of the butlers, and against the chief of the bakers.

Pharaoh was wroth <u>01\_GEN\_41\_10</u># Pharaoh was wroth with his servants, and put me in ward in the captain of the guard's house, [both] me and the chief baker:

Pharaoh well and <u>01\_GEN\_45\_16</u># And the fame thereof was heard in Pharaoh's house, saying, Joseph's brethren are come: and it pleased Pharaoh well, and his servants.

Pharaoh went in <u>02\_EXO\_15\_19</u># For the horse of Pharaoh went in with his chariots and with his horsemen into the sea, and the LORD brought again the waters of the sea upon them; but the children of Israel went on dry [land] in the midst of the sea.

Pharaoh What God <u>01\_GEN\_41\_28</u># This [is] the thing which I have spoken unto Pharaoh: What God [is] about to do he showeth unto Pharaoh.

Pharaoh what he <u>01\_GEN\_41\_25</u> # And Joseph said unto Pharaoh, The dream of Pharaoh [is] one: God hath showed Pharaoh what he [is] about to do.

Pharaoh which I <u>02\_EXO\_04\_21</u> # And the LORD said unto Moses, When thou goest to return into Egypt, see that thou do all those wonders before Pharaoh, which I have put in thine hand: but I will harden his heart, that he shall not let the people go.

Pharaoh which Mered <u>13\_1CH\_04\_18</u># And his wife Jehudijah bare Jered the father of Gedor, and Heber the father of Socho, and Jekuthiel the father of Zanoah. And these [are] the sons of Bithiah the daughter of Pharaoh, which Mered took.

Pharaoh who hath <u>02\_EXO\_18\_10</u> # And Jethro said, Blessed [be] the LORD, who hath delivered you out of the hand of the Egyptians, and out of the hand of Pharaoh, who hath delivered the people from under the hand of the Egyptians.

Pharaoh will say <u>02\_EXO\_14\_03</u># For Pharaoh will say of the children of Israel, They [are] entangled in the land, the wilderness hath shut them in.

Pharaoh with his <u>26\_EZE\_17\_17</u> # Neither shall Pharaoh with [his] mighty army and great company make for him in the war, by casting up mounts, and building forts, to cut off many persons:

Pharaoh women of <u>11\_1KI\_11\_01</u># But king Solomon loved many strange women, together with the daughter of Pharaoh, women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Zidonians, [and] Hittites;

Pharaoh would hardly <u>02\_EXO\_13\_15</u># And it came to pass, when Pharaoh would hardly let us go, that

the LORD slew all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both the firstborn of man, and the firstborn of beast: therefore I sacrifice to the LORD all that openeth the matrix, being males; but all the firstborn of my children I redeem.

Pharaoh ye shall <u>01\_GEN\_42\_15</u># Hereby ye shall be proved: By the life of Pharaoh ye shall not go forth hence, except your youngest brother come hither.

Pharaoh <u>11\_1KI\_11\_20</u># And the sister of Tahpenes bare him Genubath his son, whom Tahpenes weaned in Pharaoh's house: and Genubath was in Pharaoh's household among the sons of Pharaoh.

Pharaoh <u>44\_ACT\_07\_13</u> # And at the second [time] Joseph was made known to his brethren; and Joseph's kindred was made known unto Pharaoh.

Pharaoh <u>02\_EXO\_05\_20</u> # And they met Moses and Aaron, who stood in the way, as they came forth from Pharaoh:

Pharaoh <u>02\_EXO\_07\_07</u> # And Moses [was] fourscore years old, and Aaron fourscore and three years old, when they spake unto Pharaoh.

Pharaoh <u>02\_EXO\_08\_12</u> # And Moses and Aaron went out from Pharaoh: and Moses cried unto the LORD because of the frogs which he had brought against Pharaoh.

Pharaoh <u>02\_EXO\_09\_08</u># And the LORD said unto Moses and unto Aaron, Take to you handfuls of ashes of the furnace, and let Moses sprinkle it toward the heaven in the sight of Pharaoh.

Pharaoh <u>02\_EXO\_10\_06</u># And they shall fill thy houses, and the houses of all thy servants, and the houses of all the Egyptians; which neither thy fathers, nor thy fathers' fathers have seen, since the day that they were upon the earth unto this day. And he turned himself, and went out from Pharaoh.

Pharaoh <u>02\_EXO\_18\_04</u> # And the name of the other [was] Eliezer; for the God of my father, [said he, was] mine help, and delivered me from the sword of Pharaoh:

Pharaoh <u>01\_GEN\_41\_08</u># And it came to pass in the morning that his spirit was troubled; and he sent and called for all the magicians of Egypt, and all the wise men thereof: and Pharaoh told them his dream; but [there was] none that could interpret them unto Pharaoh.

Pharaoh <u>01\_GEN\_41\_14</u> # Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him hastily out of the dungeon: and he shaved [himself], and changed his raiment, and came in unto Pharaoh.

Pharaoh <u>01\_GEN\_41\_28</u># This [is] the thing which I have spoken unto Pharaoh: What God [is] about to do he showeth unto Pharaoh.

Pharaoh <u>01\_GEN\_44\_18</u># Then Judah came near unto him, and said, Oh my lord, let thy servant, I pray thee, speak a word in my lord's ears, and let not thine anger burn against thy servant: for thou [art] even as Pharaoh.

Pharaoh <u>01\_GEN\_47\_02</u> # And he took some of his brethren, [even] five men, and presented them unto Pharaoh.

Pharaoh <u>01\_GEN\_47\_07</u># And Joseph brought in Jacob his father, and set him before Pharaoh: and Jacob blessed Pharaoh.

Pharaoh <u>01\_GEN\_47\_10</u># And Jacob blessed Pharaoh, and went out from before Pharaoh.

Pharaoh's and captain 01\_GEN\_37\_36 # And the Midianites sold him into Egypt unto Potiphar, an officer

of Pharaoh's, [and] captain of the guard.

Pharaoh's arms and <u>26\_EZE\_30\_24</u># And I will strengthen the arms of the king of Babylon, and put my sword in his hand: but I will break Pharaoh's arms, and he shall groan before him with the groanings of a deadly wounded [man].

Pharaoh's army was 24\_JER\_37\_05 # Then Pharaoh's army was come forth out of Egypt: and when the Chaldeans that besieged Jerusalem heard tidings of them, they departed from Jerusalem.

Pharaoh's army which <u>24\_JER\_37\_07</u> # Thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel; Thus shall ye say to the king of Judah, that sent you unto me to inquire of me; Behold, Pharaoh's army, which is come forth to help you, shall return to Egypt into their own land.

Pharaoh's army <u>24\_JER\_37\_11</u># And it came to pass, that when the army of the Chaldeans was broken up from Jerusalem for fear of Pharaoh's army,

Pharaoh's birthday that <u>01\_GEN\_40\_20</u># And it came to pass the third day, [which was] Pharaoh's birthday, that he made a feast unto all his servants: and he lifted up the head of the chief butler and of the chief baker among his servants.

Pharaoh's bondmen in <u>05\_DEU\_06\_21</u> # Then thou shalt say unto thy son, We were Pharaoh's bondmen in Egypt; and the LORD brought us out of Egypt with a mighty hand:

Pharaoh's chariots and <u>02\_EXO\_15\_04</u># Pharaoh's chariots and his host hath he cast into the sea: his chosen captains also are drowned in the Red sea.

Pharaoh's chariots <u>22\_SON\_01\_09</u> # I have compared thee, O my love, to a company of horses in Pharaoh's chariots.

Pharaoh's cup and <u>01\_GEN\_40\_11</u># And Pharaoh's cup [was] in my hand: and I took the grapes, and pressed them into Pharaoh's cup, and I gave the cup into Pharaoh's hand.

Pharaoh's cup into <u>01\_GEN\_40\_13</u># Yet within three days shall Pharaoh lift up thine head, and restore thee unto thy place: and thou shalt deliver Pharaoh's cup into his hand, after the former manner when thou wast his butler.

Pharaoh's cup was <u>01\_GEN\_40\_11</u># And Pharaoh's cup [was] in my hand: and I took the grapes, and pressed them into Pharaoh's cup, and I gave the cup into Pharaoh's hand.

Pharaoh's daughter and <u>11\_1KI\_03\_01</u># And Solomon made affinity with Pharaoh king of Egypt, and took Pharaoh's daughter, and brought her into the city of David, until he had made an end of building his own house, and the house of the LORD, and the wall of Jerusalem round about.

Pharaoh's daughter and <u>02\_EXO\_02\_10</u> # And the child grew, and she brought him unto Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. And she called his name Moses: and she said, Because I drew him out of the water.

Pharaoh's daughter came <u>11\_1KI\_09\_24</u># But Pharaoh's daughter came up out of the city of David unto her house which [Solomon] had built for her: then did he build Millo.

Pharaoh's daughter said <u>02\_EXO\_02\_08</u># And Pharaoh's daughter said to her, Go. And the maid went and called the child's mother.

Pharaoh's daughter said <u>02\_EXO\_02\_09</u># And Pharaoh's daughter said unto her, Take this child away, and nurse it for me, and I will give [thee] thy wages. And the woman took the child, and nursed it.

Pharaoh's daughter Shall <u>02\_EXO\_02\_07</u> # Then said his sister to Pharaoh's daughter, Shall I go and call to thee a nurse of the Hebrew women, that she may nurse the child for thee?

Pharaoh's daughter took <u>44\_ACT\_07\_21</u> # And when he was cast out, Pharaoh's daughter took him up, and nourished him for her own son.

Pharaoh's daughter whom <u>11\_1KI\_07\_08</u># And his house where he dwelt [had] another court within the porch, [which] was of the like work. Solomon made also an house for Pharaoh's daughter, whom he had taken [to wife], like unto this porch.

Pharaoh's daughter <u>58\_HEB\_11\_24</u># By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter;

Pharaoh's hand <u>01\_GEN\_40\_11</u># And Pharaoh's cup [was] in my hand: and I took the grapes, and pressed them into Pharaoh's cup, and I gave the cup into Pharaoh's hand.

Pharaoh's hand <u>01\_GEN\_40\_21</u># And he restored the chief butler unto his butlership again; and he gave the cup into Pharaoh's hand:

Pharaoh's heart and <u>02\_EXO\_07\_03</u># And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and multiply my signs and my wonders in the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh's heart and <u>02\_EXO\_10\_27</u># But the LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart, and he would not let them go.

Pharaoh's heart is <u>02\_EXO\_07\_14</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Pharaoh's heart [is] hardened, he refuseth to let the people go.

Pharaoh's heart so <u>02\_EXO\_10\_20</u># But the LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart, so that he would not let the children of Israel go.

Pharaoh's heart so <u>02\_EXO\_11\_10</u># And Moses and Aaron did all these wonders before Pharaoh: and the LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart, so that he would not let the children of Israel go out of his land.

Pharaoh's heart that <u>02\_EXO\_07\_13</u># And he hardened Pharaoh's heart, that he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

Pharaoh's heart that <u>02\_EXO\_14\_04</u> # And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, that he shall follow after them; and I will be honoured upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host; that the Egyptians may know that I [am] the LORD. And they did so.

Pharaoh's heart was <u>02\_EXO\_07\_22</u> # And the magicians of Egypt did so with their enchantments: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, neither did he hearken unto them; as the LORD had said.

Pharaoh's heart was <u>02\_EXO\_08\_19</u> # Then the magicians said unto Pharaoh, This [is] the finger of God: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

Pharaoh's horses his <u>02\_EXO\_14\_23</u> # And the Egyptians pursued, and went in after them to the midst of the sea, [even] all Pharaoh's horses, his chariots, and his horsemen.

Pharaoh's house and <u>11\_1KI\_11\_20</u># And the sister of Tahpenes bare him Genubath his son, whom Tahpenes weaned in Pharaoh's house: and Genubath was in Pharaoh's household among the sons of Pharaoh.

Pharaoh's house in 24\_JER\_43\_09 # Take great stones in thine hand, and hide them in the clay in the brickkiln, which [is] at the entry of Pharaoh's house in Tahpanhes, in the sight of the men of Judah;

Pharaoh's house saying <u>01\_GEN\_45\_16</u># And the fame thereof was heard in Pharaoh's house, saying, Joseph's brethren are come: and it pleased Pharaoh well, and his servants.

Pharaoh's house <u>09\_1SA\_02\_27</u> # And there came a man of God unto Eli, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Did I plainly appear unto the house of thy father, when they were in Egypt in Pharaoh's house?

Pharaoh's house <u>01\_GEN\_12\_15</u># The princes also of Pharaoh saw her, and commended her before Pharaoh: and the woman was taken into Pharaoh's house.

Pharaoh's house <u>01\_GEN\_47\_14</u># And Joseph gathered up all the money that was found in the land of Egypt, and in the land of Canaan, for the corn which they bought: and Joseph brought the money into Pharaoh's house.

Pharaoh's household among <u>11\_1KI\_11\_20</u># And the sister of Tahpenes bare him Genubath his son, whom Tahpenes weaned in Pharaoh's house: and Genubath was in Pharaoh's household among the sons of Pharaoh.

Pharaoh's officers that <u>01\_GEN\_40\_07</u># And he asked Pharaoh's officers that [were] with him in the ward of his lord's house, saying, Wherefore look ye [so] sadly to day?

Pharaoh's presence <u>02\_EXO\_10\_11</u># Not so: go now ye [that are] men, and serve the LORD; for that ye did desire. And they were driven out from Pharaoh's presence.

Pharaoh's servants and <u>02\_EXO\_11\_03</u># And the LORD gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians. Moreover the man Moses [was] very great in the land of Egypt, in the sight of Pharaoh's servants, and in the sight of the people.

Pharaoh's servants said <u>02\_EXO\_10\_07</u> # And Pharaoh's servants said unto him, How long shall this man be a snare unto us? let the men go, that they may serve the LORD their God: knowest thou not yet that Egypt is destroyed?

Pharaoh's servants <u>01\_GEN\_47\_25</u> # And they said, Thou hast saved our lives: let us find grace in the sight of my lord, and we will be Pharaoh's servants.

Pharaoh's taskmasters had <u>02\_EXO\_05\_14</u># And the officers of the children of Israel, which Pharaoh's taskmasters had set over them, were beaten, [and] demanded, Wherefore have ye not fulfilled your task in making brick both yesterday and to day, as heretofore?

Pharaoh's <u>01\_GEN\_47\_20</u> # And Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh; for the Egyptians sold every man his field, because the famine prevailed over them: so the land became Pharaoh's.

Pharaoh's <u>01\_GEN\_47\_26</u> # And Joseph made it a law over the land of Egypt unto this day, [that] Pharaoh should have the fifth [part]; except the land of the priests only, [which] became not Pharaoh's.

Pharaohhophra king of <u>24\_JER\_44\_30</u> # Thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will give Pharaohhophra king of Egypt into the hand of his enemies, and into the hand of them that seek his life; as I gave Zedekiah king of Judah into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, his enemy, and that sought his life.

Pharaohnecho king of <u>24\_JER\_46\_02</u> # Against Egypt, against the army of Pharaohnecho king of Egypt, which was by the river Euphrates in Carchemish, which Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon smote in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah.

Pharaohnechoh king of <u>12\_2KI\_23\_29</u> # In his days Pharaohnechoh king of Egypt went up against the king of Assyria to the river Euphrates: and king Josiah went against him; and he slew him at Megiddo, when he had seen him.

Pharaohnechoh made Eliakim <u>12\_2KI\_23\_34</u> # And Pharaohnechoh made Eliakim the son of Josiah king in the room of Josiah his father, and turned his name to Jehoiakim, and took Jehoahaz away: and he came to Egypt, and died there.

Pharaohnechoh put him <u>12\_2KI\_23\_33</u> # And Pharaohnechoh put him in bands at Riblah in the land of Hamath, that he might not reign in Jerusalem; and put the land to a tribute of an hundred talents of silver, and a talent of gold.

Pharaohnechoh <u>12\_2KI\_23\_35</u> # And Jehoiakim gave the silver and the gold to Pharaoh; but he taxed the land to give the money according to the commandment of Pharaoh: he exacted the silver and the gold of the people of the land, of every one according to his taxation, to give [it] unto Pharaohnechoh.

Sepharad shall possess <u>31\_OBA\_01\_20</u> # And the captivity of this host of the children of Israel [shall possess] that of the Canaanites, [even] unto Zarephath; and the captivity of Jerusalem, which [is] in Sepharad, shall possess the cities of the south.

Shaharaim begat children <u>13\_1CH\_08\_08</u># And Shaharaim begat [children] in the country of Moab, after he had sent them away; Hushim and Baara [were] his wives.

Sharai <u>15\_EZR\_10\_40</u> # Machnadebai, Shashai, Sharai,

Sharaim and Adithaim <u>06\_JOS\_15\_36</u># And Sharaim, and Adithaim, and Gederah, and Gederothaim; fourteen cities with their villages:

Sharar the Hararite <u>10\_2SA\_23\_33</u> # Shammah the Hararite, Ahiam the son of Sharar the Hararite,

Thara which was <u>42\_LUK\_03\_34</u> # Which was [the son] of Jacob, which was [the son] of Isaac, which was [the son] of Abraham, which was [the son] of Thara, which was [the son] of Nachor,
