Hebron all that 10\_2SA\_03\_19 # And Abner also spake in the ears of Benjamin: and Abner went also to speak in the ears of David in Hebron all that seemed good to Israel, and that seemed good to the whole house of Benjamin.

Hebron and built <u>01\_GEN\_13\_18</u># Then Abram removed [his] tent, and came and dwelt in the plain of Mamre, which [is] in Hebron, and built there an altar unto the LORD.

Hebron and David <u>13\_1CH\_11\_03</u># Therefore came all the elders of Israel to the king to Hebron; and David made a covenant with them in Hebron before the LORD; and they anointed David king over Israel, according to the word of the LORD by Samuel.

Hebron and he <u>01\_GEN\_37\_14</u># And he said to him, Go, I pray thee, see whether it be well with thy brethren, and well with the flocks; and bring me word again. So he sent him out of the vale of Hebron, and he came to Shechem.

Hebron and his <u>10\_2SA\_03\_02</u> # And unto David were sons born in Hebron: and his firstborn was Amnon, of Ahinoam the Jezreelitess;

Hebron and king 10\_2SA\_05\_03 # So all the elders of Israel came to the king to Hebron; and king David made a league with them in Hebron before the LORD: and they anointed David king over Israel.

Hebron and Rehob <u>06\_JOS\_19\_28</u># And Hebron, and Rehob, and Hammon, and Kanah, [even] unto great Zidon;

Hebron and said <u>10\_2SA\_04\_08</u> # And they brought the head of Ishbosheth unto David to Hebron, and said to the king, Behold the head of Ishbosheth the son of Saul thine enemy, which sought thy life; and the LORD hath avenged my lord the king this day of Saul, and of his seed.

Hebron and spake 10\_2SA\_05\_01 # Then came all the tribes of Israel to David unto Hebron, and spake, saying, Behold, we [are] thy bone and thy flesh.

Hebron and the 10\_2SA\_03\_32 # And they buried Abner in Hebron: and the king lifted up his voice, and wept at the grave of Abner; and all the people wept.

Hebron and there <u>13\_1CH\_03\_04</u> # [These] six were born unto him in Hebron; and there he reigned seven years and six months: and in Jerusalem he reigned thirty and three years.

Hebron and there <u>10\_2SA\_05\_13</u> # And David took [him] more concubines and wives out of Jerusalem, after he was come from Hebron: and there were yet sons and daughters born to David.

Hebron and they <u>06\_JOS\_10\_36</u> # And Joshua went up from Eglon, and all Israel with him, unto Hebron; and they fought against it:

Hebron and thirty <u>13\_1CH\_29\_27</u> # And the time that he reigned over Israel [was] forty years; seven years reigned he in Hebron, and thirty and three [years] reigned he in Jerusalem.

Hebron and thirty <u>11\_1KI\_02\_11</u># And the days that David reigned over Israel [were] forty years: seven years reigned he in Hebron, and thirty and three years reigned he in Jerusalem.

Hebron and to <u>09\_1SA\_30\_31</u> # And to [them] which [were] in Hebron, and to all the places where David himself and his men were wont to haunt.

Hebron and twenty <u>10\_2SA\_03\_20</u> # So Abner came to David to Hebron, and twenty men with him. And David made Abner and the men that [were] with him a feast.

Hebron and unto <u>06\_JOS\_10\_03</u> # Wherefore Adonizedek king of Jerusalem sent unto Hoham king of Hebron, and unto Piram king of Jarmuth, and unto Japhia king of Lachish, and unto Debir king of Eglon, saying,

Hebron and Uzziel 13\_1CH\_06\_02 # And the sons of Kohath; Amram, Izhar, and Hebron, and Uzziel.

Hebron and Uzziel <u>13\_1CH\_06\_18</u> # And the sons of Kohath [were], Amram, and Izhar, and Hebron, and Uzziel.

Hebron and Uzziel 13\_1CH\_23\_12 # The sons of Kohath; Amram, Izhar, Hebron, and Uzziel, four.

Hebron and Uzziel <u>02\_EXO\_06\_18</u> # And the sons of Kohath; Amram, and Izhar, and Hebron, and Uzziel: and the years of the life of Kohath [were] an hundred thirty and three years.

Hebron and Uzziel <u>04\_NUM\_03\_19</u># And the sons of Kohath by their families; Amram, and Izehar, Hebron, and Uzziel.

Hebron and Zior <u>06\_JOS\_15\_54</u># And Humtah, and Kirjatharba, which [is] Hebron, and Zior; nine cities with their villages:

Hebron at break 10\_2SA\_02\_32 # And they took up Asahel, and buried him in the sepulchre of his father, which [was in] Bethlehem. And Joab and his men went all night, and they came to Hebron at break of day.

Hebron before the <u>13\_1CH\_11\_03</u># Therefore came all the elders of Israel to the king to Hebron; and David made a covenant with them in Hebron before the LORD; and they anointed David king over Israel, according to the word of the LORD by Samuel.

Hebron before the <u>10\_2SA\_05\_03</u> # So all the elders of Israel came to the king to Hebron; and king David made a league with them in Hebron before the LORD: and they anointed David king over Israel.

Hebron before was <u>06\_JOS\_14\_15</u> # And the name of Hebron before [was] Kirjatharba; [which Arba was] a great man among the Anakims. And the land had rest from war.

Hebron before was <u>07\_JUD\_01\_10</u> # And Judah went against the Canaanites that dwelt in Hebron: [now the name of Hebron before [was] Kirjatharba:] and they slew Sheshai, and Ahiman, and Talmai.

Hebron But they <u>10\_2SA\_04\_12</u> # And David commanded his young men, and they slew them, and cut off their hands and their feet, and hanged [them] up over the pool in Hebron. But they took the head of Ishbosheth, and buried [it] in the sepulchre of Abner in Hebron.

Hebron Eliel the 13\_1CH\_15\_09 # Of the sons of Hebron; Eliel the chief, and his brethren fourscore:

Hebron for an <u>06\_JOS\_14\_13</u> # And Joshua blessed him, and gave unto Caleb the son of Jephunneh Hebron for an inheritance.

Hebron for he <u>10\_2SA\_03\_22</u> # And, behold, the servants of David and Joab came from [pursuing] a troop, and brought in a great spoil with them: but Abner [was] not with David in Hebron; for he had sent him away, and he was gone in peace.

Hebron from Debir <u>06\_JOS\_11\_21</u># And at that time came Joshua, and cut off the Anakims from the mountains, from Hebron, from Debir, from Anab, and from all the mountains of Judah, and from all the mountains of Israel: Joshua destroyed them utterly with their cities.

Hebron he reigned 10\_2SA\_05\_05 # In Hebron he reigned over Judah seven years and six months: and in Jerusalem he reigned thirty and three years over all Israel and Judah.

Hebron his hands <u>10\_2SA\_04\_01</u> # And when Saul's son heard that Abner was dead in Hebron, his hands were feeble, and all the Israelites were troubled.

Hebron in the <u>13\_1CH\_06\_55</u># And they gave them Hebron in the land of Judah, and the suburbs thereof round about it.

Hebron in the <u>01\_GEN\_23\_02</u> # And Sarah died in Kirjatharba; the same [is] Hebron in the land of Canaan: and Abraham came to mourn for Sarah, and to weep for her.

Hebron in the <u>01\_GEN\_23\_19</u># And after this, Abraham buried Sarah his wife in the cave of the field of Machpelah before Mamre: the same [is] Hebron in the land of Canaan.

Hebron in the <u>06\_JOS\_20\_07</u> # And they appointed Kedesh in Galilee in mount Naphtali, and Shechem in mount Ephraim, and Kirjatharba, which [is] Hebron, in the mountain of Judah.

Hebron in the <u>06\_JOS\_21\_11</u> # And they gave them the city of Arba the father of Anak, which [city is] Hebron, in the hill [country] of Judah, with the suburbs thereof round about it.

Hebron Jeriah the <u>13\_1CH\_23\_19</u> # Of the sons of Hebron; Jeriah the first, Amariah the second, Jahaziel the third, and Jekameam the fourth.

Hebron Jeriah the <u>13\_1CH\_24\_23</u> # And the sons [of Hebron]; Jeriah [the first], Amariah the second, Jahaziel the third, Jekameam the fourth.

Hebron Joab took 10\_2SA\_03\_27 # And when Abner was returned to Hebron, Joab took him aside in the gate to speak with him quietly, and smote him there under the fifth [rib], that he died, for the blood of Asahel his brother.

Hebron Korah and 13\_1CH\_02\_43 # And the sons of Hebron; Korah, and Tappuah, and Rekem, and Shema.

Hebron now the <u>07\_JUD\_01\_10</u># And Judah went against the Canaanites that dwelt in Hebron: [now the name of Hebron before [was] Kirjatharba:] and they slew Sheshai, and Ahiman, and Talmai.

Hebron one <u>06\_JOS\_12\_10</u> # The king of Jerusalem, one; the king of Hebron, one;

Hebron over the <u>10\_2SA\_02\_11</u># And the time that David was king in Hebron over the house of Judah was seven years and six months.

Hebron saying Behold <u>13\_1CH\_11\_01</u># Then all Israel gathered themselves to David unto Hebron, saying, Behold, we [are] thy bone and thy flesh.

Hebron so he <u>06\_JOS\_10\_39</u># And he took it, and the king thereof, and all the cities thereof; and they smote them with the edge of the sword, and utterly destroyed all the souls that [were] therein; he left none remaining: as he had done to Hebron, so he did to Debir, and to the king thereof; as he had done also to Libnah, and to her king.

Hebron the city <u>13\_1CH\_06\_57</u> # And to the sons of Aaron they gave the cities of Judah, [namely], Hebron, [the city] of refuge, and Libnah with her suburbs, and Jattir, and Eshtemoa, with their suburbs,

Hebron the firstborn 13\_1CH\_03\_01 # Now these were the sons of David, which were born unto him in Hebron; the firstborn Amnon, of Ahinoam the Jezreelitess; the second Daniel, of Abigail the Carmelitess:

Hebron the king <u>06\_JOS\_10\_05</u># Therefore the five kings of the Amorites, the king of Jerusalem, the king of Hebron, the king of Jarmuth, the king of Lachish, the king of Eglon, gathered themselves together, and went up, they and all their hosts, and encamped before Gibeon, and made war against it.

Hebron the king <u>06\_JOS\_10\_23</u> # And they did so, and brought forth those five kings unto him out of the cave, the king of Jerusalem, the king of Hebron, the king of Jarmuth, the king of Lachish, [and] the king of Eglon.

Hebron therefore became <u>06\_JOS\_14\_14</u># Hebron therefore became the inheritance of Caleb the son of Jephunneh the Kenezite unto this day, because that he wholly followed the LORD God of Israel.

Hebron to make 13\_1CH\_12\_38 # All these men of war, that could keep rank, came with a perfect heart to Hebron, to make David king over all Israel: and all the rest also of Israel [were] of one heart to make David king.

Hebron to turn 13\_1CH\_12\_23 # And these [are] the numbers of the bands [that were] ready armed to the war, [and] came to David to Hebron, to turn the kingdom of Saul to him, according to the word of the LORD.

Hebron unto Caleb <u>07\_JUD\_01\_20</u> # And they gave Hebron unto Caleb, as Moses said: and he expelled thence the three sons of Anak.

Hebron was built <u>04\_NUM\_13\_22</u># And they ascended by the south, and came unto Hebron; where Ahiman, Sheshai, and Talmai, the children of Anak, [were]. [Now Hebron was built seven years before Zoan in Egypt.]

Hebron where Abraham <u>01\_GEN\_35\_27</u> # And Jacob came unto Isaac his father unto Mamre, unto the city of Arbah, which [is] Hebron, where Abraham and Isaac sojourned.

Hebron where Ahiman <u>04\_NUM\_13\_22</u># And they ascended by the south, and came unto Hebron; where Ahiman, Sheshai, and Talmai, the children of Anak, [were]. [Now Hebron was built seven years before Zoan in Egypt.]

Hebron which are <u>14\_2CH\_11\_10</u># And Zorah, and Aijalon, and Hebron, which [are] in Judah and in Benjamin fenced cities.

Hebron with her <u>06\_JOS\_21\_13</u> # Thus they gave to the children of Aaron the priest Hebron with her suburbs, [to be] a city of refuge for the slayer; and Libnah with her suburbs,

Hebron <u>13\_1CH\_02\_42</u> # Now the sons of Caleb the brother of Jerahmeel [were], Mesha his firstborn, which was the father of Ziph; and the sons of Mareshah the father of Hebron.

Hebron <u>10\_2SA\_02\_01</u> # And it came to pass after this, that David inquired of the LORD, saying, Shall I go up into any of the cities of Judah? And the LORD said unto him, Go up. And David said, Whither shall I go up? And he said, Unto Hebron.

Hebron 10\_2SA\_02\_03 # And his men that [were] with him did David bring up, every man with his household: and they dwelt in the cities of Hebron.

Hebron <u>10\_2SA\_03\_05</u># And the sixth, Ithream, by Eglah David's wife. These were born to David in Hebron.

Hebron <u>10\_2SA\_04\_12</u> # And David commanded his young men, and they slew them, and cut off their hands and their feet, and hanged [them] up over the pool in Hebron. But they took the head of Ishbosheth, and buried [it] in the sepulchre of Abner in Hebron.

Hebron 10\_2SA\_15\_07 # And it came to pass after forty years, that Absalom said unto the king, I pray thee, let me go and pay my vow, which I have vowed unto the LORD, in Hebron.

Hebron 10\_2SA\_15\_09 # And the king said unto him, Go in peace. So he arose, and went to Hebron.

Hebron <u>10\_2SA\_15\_10</u> # But Absalom sent spies throughout all the tribes of Israel, saying, As soon as ye hear the sound of the trumpet, then ye shall say, Absalom reigneth in Hebron.

Hebron <u>06\_JOS\_15\_13</u># And unto Caleb the son of Jephunneh he gave a part among the children of Judah, according to the commandment of the LORD to Joshua, [even] the city of Arba the father of Anak, which [city is] Hebron.

Hebron <u>07\_JUD\_16\_03</u># And Samson lay till midnight, and arose at midnight, and took the doors of the gate of the city, and the two posts, and went away with them, bar and all, and put [them] upon his shoulders, and carried them up to the top of an hill that [is] before Hebron.

Hebronites and the <u>13\_1CH\_26\_23</u> # Of the Amramites, [and] the Izharites, the Hebronites, [and] the Uzzielites:

Hebronites and the <u>04\_NUM\_03\_27</u># And of Kohath [was] the family of the Amramites, and the family of the Izeharites, and the family of the Hebronites, and the family of the Uzzielites: these [are] the families of the Kohathites.

Hebronites Hashabiah and 13\_1CH\_26\_30 # [And] of the Hebronites, Hashabiah and his brethren, men of valour, a thousand and seven hundred, [were] officers among them of Israel on this side Jordan westward in all the business of the LORD, and in the service of the king.

Hebronites the family <u>04\_NUM\_26\_58</u> # These [are] the families of the Levites: the family of the Libnites, the family of the Hebronites, the family of the Mahlites, the family of the Mushites, the family of the Korathites. And Kohath begat Amram.
