dryshod <u>23\_ISA\_11\_15</u># And the LORD shall utterly destroy the tongue of the Egyptian sea; and with his mighty wind shall he shake his hand over the river, and shall smite it in the seven streams, and make [men] go over dryshod.

ephod all of <u>02\_EXO\_28\_31</u> # And thou shalt make the robe of the ephod all [of] blue.

ephod and a <u>02\_EXO\_28\_04</u> # And these [are] the garments which they shall make; a breastplate, and an ephod, and a robe, and a broidered coat, a mitre, and a girdle: and they shall make holy garments for Aaron thy brother, and his sons, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.

ephod And Abiathar <u>09\_18A\_30\_07</u># And David said to Abiathar the priest, Ahimelech's son, I pray thee, bring me hither the ephod. And Abiathar brought thither the ephod to David.

ephod and in <u>02\_EXO\_25\_07</u> # Onyx stones, and stones to be set in the ephod, and in the breastplate.

ephod and teraphim <u>07\_JUD\_17\_05</u># And the man Micah had an house of gods, and made an ephod, and teraphim, and consecrated one of his sons, who became his priest.

ephod and teraphim <u>07\_JUD\_18\_14</u># Then answered the five men that went to spy out the country of Laish, and said unto their brethren, Do ye know that there is in these houses an ephod, and teraphim, and a graven image, and a molten image? now therefore consider what ye have to do.

ephod if thou <u>09\_1SA\_21\_09</u> # And the priest said, The sword of Goliath the Philistine, whom thou slewest in the valley of Elah, behold, it [is here] wrapped in a cloth behind the ephod: if thou wilt take that, take [it]: for [there is] no other save that here. ephod of gold <u>02\_EXO\_39\_02</u># And he made the ephod [of] gold, blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen.

ephod of gold <u>02\_EXO\_39\_08</u># And he made the breastplate [of] cunning work, like the work of the ephod;

[of] gold, blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen.

ephod of linen <u>13\_1CH\_15\_27</u># And David [was] clothed with a robe of fine linen, and all the Levites that bare the ark, and the singers, and Chenaniah the master of the song with the singers: David also [had] upon him an ephod of linen.

ephod of woven <u>02\_EXO\_39\_22</u> # And he made the robe of the ephod [of] woven work, all [of] blue.

ephod that they <u>02\_EXO\_39\_07</u> # And he put them on the shoulders of the ephod, [that they should be] stones for a memorial to the children of Israel; as the LORD commanded Moses.

ephod that was <u>02\_EXO\_39\_05</u> # And the curious girdle of his ephod, that [was] upon it, [was] of the same, according to the work thereof; [of] gold, blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen; as the LORD commanded Moses.

ephod thereof and <u>07\_JUD\_08\_27</u> # And Gideon made an ephod thereof, and put it in his city, [even] in Ophrah: and all Israel went thither a whoring after it: which thing became a snare unto Gideon, and to his house.

ephod which is <u>02\_EXO\_28\_08</u># And the curious girdle of the ephod, which [is] upon it, shall be of the same, according to the work thereof; [even of] gold, [of] blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen.

ephod with a <u>02\_EXO\_28\_28</u># And they shall bind the breastplate by the rings thereof unto the rings of the ephod with a lace of blue, that [it] may be above the curious girdle of the ephod, and that the breastplate be not loosed from the ephod.

ephod <u>02\_EXO\_28\_27</u> # And two [other] rings of gold thou shalt make, and shalt put them on the two sides of the ephod underneath, toward the forepart thereof, over against the [other] coupling thereof, above the curious girdle of the ephod.

Hodaiah and Eliashib <u>13\_1CH\_03\_24</u> # And the sons of Elioenai [were], Hodaiah, and Eliashib, and Pelaiah, and Akkub, and Johanan, and Dalaiah, and Anani, seven.

Hodaviah and Jahdiel <u>13\_1CH\_05\_24</u> # And these [were] the heads of the house of their fathers, even Epher, and Ishi, and Eliel, and Azriel, and Jeremiah, and Hodaviah, and Jahdiel, mighty men of valour, famous men, [and] heads of the house of their fathers.

Hodaviah seventy and <u>15\_EZR\_02\_40</u> # The Levites: the children of Jeshua and Kadmiel, of the children of Hodaviah, seventy and four.

Hodaviah the son <u>13\_1CH\_09\_07</u># And of the sons of Benjamin; Sallu the son of Meshullam, the son of Hodaviah, the son of Hasenuah,

Hodesh his wife <u>13\_1CH\_08\_09</u> # And he begat of Hodesh his wife, Jobab, and Zibia, and Mesha, and Malcham,

Hodevah seventy and <u>16\_NEH\_07\_43</u> # The Levites: the children of Jeshua, of Kadmiel, [and] of the children of Hodevah, seventy and four.

Hodiah the sister <u>13\_1CH\_04\_19</u># And the sons of [his] wife Hodiah the sister of Naham, the father of Keilah the Garmite, and Eshtemoa the Maachathite.

Hodijah Bani Beninu <u>16\_NEH\_10\_13</u># Hodijah, Bani, Beninu.

Hodijah Hashum Bezai 16\_NEH\_10\_18 # Hodijah, Hashum, Bezai,

Hodijah Kelita Pelaiah 16\_NEH\_10\_10 # And their brethren, Shebaniah, Hodijah, Kelita, Pelaiah, Hanan,

Hodijah Maaseiah Kelita 16\_NEH\_08\_07 # Also Jeshua, and Bani, and Sherebiah, Jamin, Akkub,

Shabbethai, Hodijah, Maaseiah, Kelita, Azariah, Jozabad, Hanan, Pelaiah, and the Levites, caused the people to understand the law: and the people [stood] in their place.

Hodijah Shebaniah and <u>16\_NEH\_09\_05</u># Then the Levites, Jeshua, and Kadmiel, Bani, Hashabniah, Sherebiah, Hodijah, Shebaniah, [and] Pethahiah, said, Stand up [and] bless the LORD your God for ever and ever: and blessed be thy glorious name, which is exalted above all blessing and praise.

Ishod and Abiezer <u>13\_1CH\_07\_18</u># And his sister Hammoleketh bare Ishod, and Abiezer, and Mahalah.

Rhoda <u>44\_ACT\_12\_13</u> # And as Peter knocked at the door of the gate, a damsel came to hearken, named Rhoda.

Rhodes and from <u>44\_ACT\_21\_01</u> # And it came to pass, that after we were gotten from them, and had launched, we came with a straight course unto Coos, and the [day] following unto Rhodes, and from thence unto Patara:

Tahtimhodshi and they <u>10\_2SA\_24\_06</u># Then they came to Gilead, and to the land of Tahtimhodshi; and they came to Danjaan, and about to Zidon,

unshod and thy <u>24\_JER\_02\_25</u> # Withhold thy foot from being unshod, and thy throat from thirst: but thou saidst, There is no hope: no; for I have loved strangers, and after them will I go.
