abhor an Edomite <u>05\_DEU\_23\_07</u># Thou shalt not abhor an Edomite; for he [is] thy brother: thou shalt not abhor an Egyptian; because thou wast a stranger in his land.

abhor an Egyptian <u>05\_DEU\_23\_07</u># Thou shalt not abhor an Edomite; for he [is] thy brother: thou shalt not abhor an Egyptian; because thou wast a stranger in his land.

abhor him that <u>30\_AMO\_05\_10</u># They hate him that rebuketh in the gate, and they abhor him that speaketh uprightly.

abhor him therefore <u>09\_1SA\_27\_12</u> # And Achish believed David, saying, He hath made his people Israel utterly to abhor him; therefore he shall be my servant for ever.

abhor him <u>20\_PRO\_24\_24</u> # He that saith unto the wicked, Thou [art] righteous; him shall the people curse, nations shall abhor him:

abhor it for <u>05\_DEU\_07\_26</u># Neither shalt thou bring an abomination into thine house, lest thou be a cursed thing like it: [but] thou shalt utterly detest it, and thou shalt utterly abhor it; for it [is] a cursed thing.

abhor judgment and 33\_MIC\_03\_09 # Hear this, I pray you, ye heads of the house of Jacob, and princes of the house of Israel, that abhor judgment, and pervert all equity.

abhor lying but 19\_PSA\_119\_163 # I hate and abhor lying: [but] thy law do I love.

abhor me they 18\_JOB\_30\_10 # They abhor me, they flee far from me, and spare not to spit in my face.

abhor me 18\_JOB\_09\_31 # Yet shalt thou plunge me in the ditch, and mine own clothes shall abhor me.

abhor my judgments <u>03\_LEV\_26\_15</u> # And if ye shall despise my statutes, or if your soul abhor my judgments, so that ye will not do all my commandments, [but] that ye break my covenant:

abhor myself and 18\_JOB\_42\_06 # Wherefore I abhor [myself], and repent in dust and ashes.

Abhor that which <u>45\_ROM\_12\_09</u> # [Let] love be without dissimulation. Abhor that which is evil; cleave to that which is good.

abhor the bloody <u>19\_PSA\_05\_06</u># Thou shalt destroy them that speak leasing: the LORD will abhor the bloody and deceitful man.

abhor the excellency <u>30\_AMO\_06\_08</u># The Lord GOD hath sworn by himself, saith the LORD the God of hosts, I abhor the excellency of Jacob, and hate his palaces: therefore will I deliver up the city with all that is therein.

abhor them to <u>03\_LEV\_26\_44</u> # And yet for all that, when they be in the land of their enemies, I will not cast them away, neither will I abhor them, to destroy them utterly, and to break my covenant with them: for I [am] the LORD their God.

abhor us for 24\_JER\_14\_21 # Do not abhor [us], for thy name's sake, do not disgrace the throne of thy

glory: remember, break not thy covenant with us.

abhor you 03\_LEV\_26\_11# And I will set my tabernacle among you: and my soul shall not abhor you.

abhor you <u>03\_LEV\_26\_30</u> # And I will destroy your high places, and cut down your images, and cast your carcases upon the carcases of your idols, and my soul shall abhor you.

abhorred and hast <u>26\_EZE\_16\_25</u># Thou hast built thy high place at every head of the way, and hast made thy beauty to be abhorred, and hast opened thy feet to every one that passed by, and multiplied thy whoredoms.

abhorred his own 19\_PSA\_106\_40 # Therefore was the wrath of the LORD kindled against his people, insomuch that he abhorred his own inheritance.

abhorred his sanctuary 25 LAM 02 07 # The Lord hath cast off his altar, he hath abhorred his sanctuary, he hath given up into the hand of the enemy the walls of her palaces; they have made a noise in the house of the LORD, as in the day of a solemn feast.

abhorred in the <u>02\_EXO\_05\_21</u> # And they said unto them, The LORD look upon you, and judge; because ye have made our savour to be abhorred in the eyes of Pharaoh, and in the eyes of his servants, to put a sword in their hand to slay us.

abhorred Israel and <u>11\_1KI\_11\_25</u># And he was an adversary to Israel all the days of Solomon, beside the mischief that Hadad [did]: and he abhorred Israel, and reigned over Syria.

abhorred Israel 19\_PSA\_78\_59 # When God heard [this], he was wroth, and greatly abhorred Israel:

abhorred me and <u>18\_JOB\_19\_19</u> # All my inward friends abhorred me: and they whom I loved are turned against me.

abhorred me <u>38\_ZEC\_11\_08</u># Three shepherds also I cut off in one month; and my soul loathed them, and their soul also abhorred me.

abhorred my statutes <u>03 LEV\_26\_43</u># The land also shall be left of them, and shall enjoy her sabbaths, while she lieth desolate without them: and they shall accept of the punishment of their iniquity: because, even because they despised my judgments, and because their soul abhorred my statutes.

abhorred of the <u>20\_PRO\_22\_14</u># The mouth of strange women [is] a deep pit: he that is abhorred of the LORD shall fall therein.

abhorred of thy <u>10\_2SA\_16\_21</u> # And Ahithophel said unto Absalom, Go in unto thy father's concubines, which he hath left to keep the house; and all Israel shall hear that thou art abhorred of thy father: then shall the hands of all that [are] with thee be strong.

abhorred the affliction 19\_PSA\_22\_24 # For he hath not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; neither hath he hid his face from him; but when he cried unto him, he heard.

abhorred the offering <u>09\_1SA\_02\_17</u># Wherefore the sin of the young men was very great before the LORD: for men abhorred the offering of the LORD.

abhorred them because <u>05\_DEU\_32\_19</u># And when the LORD saw [it], he abhorred [them], because of the provoking of his sons, and of his daughters.

abhorred them <u>03\_LEV\_20\_23</u> # And ye shall not walk in the manners of the nation, which I cast out before you: for they committed all these things, and therefore I abhorred them.

abhorred thou hast 19\_PSA\_89\_38 # But thou hast cast off and abhorred, thou hast been wroth with thine anointed.

abhorrest idols dost <u>45\_ROM\_02\_22</u> # Thou that sayest a man should not commit adultery, dost thou commit adultery? thou that abhorrest idols, dost thou commit sacrilege?

abhorrest shall be <u>23\_ISA\_07\_16</u> # For before the child shall know to refuse the evil, and choose the good, the land that thou abhorrest shall be forsaken of both her kings.

abhorreth all manner 19\_PSA\_107\_18 # Their soul abhorreth all manner of meat; and they draw near unto the gates of death.

abhorreth bread and 18\_JOB\_33\_20 # So that his life abhorreth bread, and his soul dainty meat.

abhorreth not evil 19\_PSA\_36\_04 # He deviseth mischief upon his bed; he setteth himself in a way [that is] not good; he abhorreth not evil.

abhorreth to a <u>23\_ISA\_49\_07</u> # Thus saith the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, [and] his Holy One, to him whom man despiseth, to him whom the nation abhorreth, to a servant of rulers, Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of the LORD that is faithful, [and] the Holy One of Israel, and he shall choose thee.

abhorreth <u>19\_PSA\_10\_03</u># For the wicked boasteth of his heart's desire, and blesseth the covetous, [whom] the LORD abhorreth.

abhorring unto all <u>23\_ISA\_66\_24</u># And they shall go forth, and look upon the carcases of the men that have transgressed against me: for their worm shall not die, neither shall their fire be quenched; and they shall be an abhorring unto all flesh.

Achor a place 23\_ISA\_65\_10 # And Sharon shall be a fold of flocks, and the valley of Achor a place for the herds to lie down in, for my people that have sought me.

Achor and so <u>06\_JOS\_15\_07</u># And the border went up toward Debir from the valley of Achor, and so northward, looking toward Gilgal, that [is] before the going up to Adummim, which [is] on the south side of the river: and the border passed toward the waters of Enshemesh, and the goings out thereof were at Enrogel:

Achor for a 28\_HOS\_02\_15 # And I will give her her vineyards from thence, and the valley of Achor for a door of hope: and she shall sing there, as in the days of her youth, and as in the day when she came up out of the land of Egypt.

Achor unto this <u>06\_JOS\_07\_26</u># And they raised over him a great heap of stones unto this day. So the LORD turned from the fierceness of his anger. Wherefore the name of that place was called, The valley of Achor, unto this day.

Achor <u>06\_JOS\_07\_24</u> # And Joshua, and all Israel with him, took Achan the son of Zerah, and the silver, and the garment, and the wedge of gold, and his sons, and his daughters, and his oxen, and his asses, and his sheep, and his tent, and all that he had: and they brought them unto the valley of Achor.

anchor of the <u>58\_HEB\_06\_19</u># Which [hope] we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;

anchors out of <u>44\_ACT\_27\_29</u># Then fearing lest we should have fallen upon rocks, they cast four anchors out of the stern, and wished for the day.

anchors out of 44\_ACT\_27\_30 # And as the shipmen were about to flee out of the ship, when they had let down the boat into the sea, under colour as though they would have cast anchors out of the foreship,

anchors they committed <u>44\_ACT\_27\_40</u># And when they had taken up the anchors, they committed [themselves] unto the sea, and loosed the rudder bands, and hoisted up the mainsail to the wind, and made toward shore.

author and finisher <u>58\_HEB\_12\_02</u># Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of [our] faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

author of confusion 46\_1CO\_14\_33 # For God is not [the author] of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.

author of eternal <u>58\_HEB\_05\_09</u># And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;

authorities and powers 60\_1PE\_03\_22 # Who is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.

authority and commission <u>44\_ACT\_26\_12</u> # Whereupon as I went to Damascus with authority and commission from the chief priests,

authority and not <u>41\_MAR\_01\_22</u> # And they were astonished at his doctrine: for he taught them as one that had authority, and not as the scribes.

authority and not 40\_MAT\_07\_29 # For he taught them as [one] having authority, and not as the scribes.

authority and power 46\_1CO\_15\_24 # Then [cometh] the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power.

authority and power <u>42\_LUK\_04\_36</u># And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word [is] this! for with authority and power he commandeth the unclean spirits, and they come out.

authority commandeth he <u>41\_MAR\_01\_27</u># And they were all amazed, insomuch that they questioned among themselves, saying, What thing is this? what new doctrine [is] this? for with authority commandeth he even the unclean spirits, and they do obey him.

authority doest thou <u>42\_LUK\_20\_02</u> # And spake unto him, saying, Tell us, by what authority doest thou these things? or who is he that gave thee this authority?

authority doest thou <u>41\_MAR\_11\_28</u># And say unto him, By what authority doest thou these things? and who gave thee this authority to do these things?

authority doest thou <u>40\_MAT\_21\_23</u># And when he was come into the temple, the chief priests and the elders of the people came unto him as he was teaching, and said, By what authority doest thou these things? and who gave thee this authority?

authority from the <u>44\_ACT\_09\_14</u># And here he hath authority from the chief priests to bind all that call on thy name.

authority from the <u>44\_ACT\_26\_10</u># Which thing I also did in Jerusalem: and many of the saints did I shut up in prison, having received authority from the chief priests; and when they were put to death, I gave my voice against [them].

authority having soldiers <u>40\_MAT\_08\_09</u># For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this [man], Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth [it].

authority having under 42\_LUK\_07\_08 # For I also am a man set under authority, having under me soldiers, and I say unto one, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth [it].

authority I do <u>42\_LUK\_20\_08</u># And Jesus said unto them, Neither tell I you by what authority I do these things.

authority I do 41 MAR 11 29 # And Jesus answered and said unto them, I will also ask of you one question, and answer me, and I will tell you by what authority I do these things.

authority I do <u>41\_MAR\_11\_33</u># And they answered and said unto Jesus, We cannot tell. And Jesus answering saith unto them, Neither do I tell you by what authority I do these things.

authority I do 40 MAT\_21\_24# And Jesus answered and said unto them, I also will ask you one thing, which if ye tell me, I in like wise will tell you by what authority I do these things.

authority I do 40\_MAT\_21\_27# And they answered Jesus, and said, We cannot tell. And he said unto them, Neither tell I you by what authority I do these things.

authority Let no <u>56\_TIT\_02\_15</u># These things speak, and exhort, and rebuke with all authority. Let no man despise thee.

authority of the <u>42\_LUK\_20\_20</u># And they watched [him], and sent forth spies, which should feign themselves just men, that they might take hold of his words, that so they might deliver him unto the power and authority of the governor.

authority over all <u>42\_LUK\_09\_01</u> # Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.

authority over ten <u>42\_LUK\_19\_17</u> # And he said unto him, Well, thou good servant: because thou hast been faithful in a very little, have thou authority over ten cities.

authority over the <u>54\_1TI\_02\_12</u># But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence.

authority that we  $\underline{54\_1TI\_02\_02}$  # For kings, and [for] all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.

authority the people <u>20\_PRO\_29\_02</u> # When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice: but when the wicked beareth rule, the people mourn.

authority to confirm <u>17\_EST\_09\_29</u> # Then Esther the queen, the daughter of Abihail, and Mordecai the Jew, wrote with all authority, to confirm this second letter of Purim.

authority to do 41\_MAR\_11\_28 # And say unto him, By what authority doest thou these things? and who gave thee this authority to do these things?

authority to execute <u>43\_JOH\_05\_27</u> # And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man.

authority to his 41\_MAR\_13\_34 # [For the Son of man is] as a man taking a far journey, who left his house, and gave authority to his servants, and to every man his work, and commanded the porter to watch.

authority under Candace 44 ACT 08 27 # And he arose and went: and, behold, a man of Ethiopia, an eunuch of great authority under Candace queen of the Ethiopians, who had the charge of all her treasure, and had come to Jerusalem for to worship,

authority upon them <u>42\_LUK\_22\_25</u> # And he said unto them, The kings of the Gentiles exercise lordship over them; and they that exercise authority upon them are called benefactors.

authority upon them <u>41\_MAR\_10\_42</u> # But Jesus called them [to him], and saith unto them, Ye know that they which are accounted to rule over the Gentiles exercise lordship over them; and their great ones exercise authority upon them.

authority upon them 40 MAT 20 25 # But Jesus called them [unto him], and said, Ye know that the princes of the Gentiles exercise dominion over them, and they that are great exercise authority upon them.

authority which the <u>47\_2CO\_10\_08</u># For though I should boast somewhat more of our authority, which the Lord hath given us for edification, and not for your destruction, I should not be ashamed:

authority <u>42\_LUK\_20\_02</u> # And spake unto him, saying, Tell us, by what authority doest thou these things? or who is he that gave thee this authority?

authority <u>40\_MAT\_21\_23</u># And when he was come into the temple, the chief priests and the elders of the people came unto him as he was teaching, and said, By what authority doest thou these things? and who gave thee this authority?

authority <u>66\_REV\_13\_02</u># And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as [the feet] of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority.

Bechorath the son <u>09\_1SA\_09\_01</u> # Now there was a man of Benjamin, whose name [was] Kish, the son of Abiel, the son of Zeror, the son of Bechorath, the son of Aphiah, a Benjamite, a mighty man of power.

Bethhoron and another <u>09\_1SA\_13\_18</u># And another company turned the way [to] Bethhoron: and another company turned [to] the way of the border that looketh to the valley of Zeboim toward the wilderness.

Bethhoron and smote 14\_2CH\_25\_13 # But the soldiers of the army which Amaziah sent back, that they should not go with him to battle, fell upon the cities of Judah, from Samaria even unto Bethhoron, and smote three thousand of them, and took much spoil.

Bethhoron and smote <u>06\_JOS\_10\_10</u># And the LORD discomfited them before Israel, and slew them with a great slaughter at Gibeon, and chased them along the way that goeth up to Bethhoron, and smote them to Azekah, and unto Makkedah.

Bethhoron southward and <u>06\_JOS\_18\_14</u># And the border was drawn [thence], and compassed the corner of the sea southward, from the hill that [lieth] before Bethhoron southward; and the goings out thereof were at Kirjathbaal, which [is] Kirjathjearim, a city of the children of Judah: this [was] the west quarter.

Bethhoron that the <u>06\_JOS\_10\_11</u># And it came to pass, as they fled from before Israel, [and] were in the going down to Bethhoron, that the LORD cast down great stones from heaven upon them unto Azekah, and they died: [they were] more which died with hailstones than [they] whom the children of Israel slew with the sword.

Bethhoron the nether <u>13\_1CH\_07\_24</u> # [And his daughter [was] Sherah, who built Bethhoron the nether, and the upper, and Uzzensherah.]

Bethhoron the nether 11\_1KI\_09\_17 # And Solomon built Gezer, and Bethhoron the nether,

Bethhoron the nether <u>14\_2CH\_08\_05</u> # Also he built Bethhoron the upper, and Bethhoron the nether, fenced cities, with walls, gates, and bars;

Bethhoron the nether <u>06\_JOS\_16\_03</u> # And goeth down westward to the coast of Japhleti, unto the coast of Bethhoron the nether, and to Gezer: and the goings out thereof are at the sea.

Bethhoron the upper 14\_2CH\_08\_05 # Also he built Bethhoron the upper, and Bethhoron the nether, fenced cities, with walls, gates, and bars;

Bethhoron the upper <u>06\_JOS\_16\_05</u> # And the border of the children of Ephraim according to their families was [thus]: even the border of their inheritance on the east side was Atarothaddar, unto Bethhoron the upper;

Bethhoron with her 13\_1CH\_06\_68 # And Jokmeam with her suburbs, and Bethhoron with her suburbs,

Bethhoron with her <u>06\_JOS\_21\_22</u># And Kibzaim with her suburbs, and Bethhoron with her suburbs; four cities.

Bethhoron <u>06\_JOS\_18\_13</u> # And the border went over from thence toward Luz, to the side of Luz, which [is] Bethel, southward; and the border descended to Atarothadar, near the hill that [lieth] on the south side of the nether Bethhoron.

Caphthorim 13\_1CH\_01\_12 # And Pathrusim, and Casluhim, [of whom came the Philistines,] and Caphthorim.

Chorashan and to <u>09\_1SA\_30\_30</u> # And to [them] which [were] in Hormah, and to [them] which [were] in Chorashan, and to [them] which [were] in Athach,

Chorazin woe unto <u>42\_LUK\_10\_13</u> # Woe unto thee, Chorazin! woe unto thee, Bethsaida! for if the mighty works had been done in Tyre and Sidon, which have been done in you, they had a great while ago repented, sitting in sackcloth and ashes.

Chorazin woe unto 40\_MAT\_11\_21# Woe unto thee, Chorazin! woe unto thee, Bethsaida! for if the mighty works, which were done in you, had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes.

Elihoreph and Ahiah <u>11\_1KI\_04\_03</u># Elihoreph and Ahiah, the sons of Shisha, scribes; Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud, the recorder.

exhort and rebuke <u>56\_TIT\_02\_15</u># These things speak, and exhort, and rebuke with all authority. Let no man despise thee.

exhort and to <u>56\_TIT\_01\_09</u># Holding fast the faithful word as he hath been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers.

exhort by our <u>53\_2TH\_03\_12</u># Now them that are such we command and exhort by our Lord Jesus Christ, that with quietness they work, and eat their own bread.

exhort one another <u>58\_HEB\_03\_13</u># But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

exhort saying Save <u>44\_ACT\_02\_40</u> # And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation.

Exhort servants to <u>56\_TIT\_02\_09</u> # [Exhort] servants to be obedient unto their own masters, [and] to please [them] well in all [things]; not answering again;

exhort the brethren <u>47\_2CO\_09\_05</u># Therefore I thought it necessary to exhort the brethren, that they would go before unto you, and make up before hand your bounty, whereof ye had notice before, that the same might be ready, as [a matter of] bounty, and not as [of] covetousness.

exhort therefore that <u>54\_1TI\_02\_01</u> # I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, [and] giving of thanks, be made for all men;

exhort to be 56\_TIT\_02\_06 # Young men likewise exhort to be sober minded.

exhort who am <u>60\_1PE\_05\_01</u># The elders which are among you I exhort, who am also an elder, and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that shall be revealed:

exhort with all <u>55\_2TI\_04\_02</u> # Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.

exhort you brethren <u>52\_1TH\_05\_14</u> # Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all [men].

exhort you by <u>52\_1TH\_04\_01</u># Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort [you] by the Lord Jesus, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to please God, [so] ye would abound more and more.

exhort you that <u>65\_JDE\_01\_03</u> # Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort [you] that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.

exhort you to 44\_ACT\_27\_22 # And now I exhort you to be of good cheer: for there shall be no loss of [any man's] life among you, but of the ship.

exhort <u>54\_1TI\_06\_02</u># And they that have believing masters, let them not despise [them], because they are brethren; but rather do [them] service, because they are faithful and beloved, partakers of the benefit. These things teach and exhort.

exhortation and comfort <u>46\_1CO\_14\_03</u># But he that prophesieth speaketh unto men [to] edification, and exhortation, and comfort.

exhortation but being <u>47\_2CO\_08\_17</u> # For indeed he accepted the exhortation; but being more forward, of his own accord he went unto you.

exhortation for I <u>58\_HEB\_13\_22</u> # And I beseech you, brethren, suffer the word of exhortation: for I have written a letter unto you in few words.

exhortation for the <u>44\_ACT\_13\_15</u># And after the reading of the law and the prophets the rulers of the synagogue sent unto them, saying, [Ye] men [and] brethren, if ye have any word of exhortation for the people, say on.

exhortation he came <u>44\_ACT\_20\_02</u># And when he had gone over those parts, and had given them much exhortation, he came into Greece,

exhortation he that <u>45\_ROM\_12\_08</u> # Or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, [let him do it] with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that showeth mercy, with cheerfulness.

exhortation preached he <u>42\_LUK\_03\_18</u># And many other things in his exhortation preached he unto the people.

exhortation to doctrine 54\_1TI\_04\_13 # Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.

exhortation was not <u>52\_1TH\_02\_03</u># For our exhortation [was] not of deceit, nor of uncleanness, nor in guile:

exhortation which speaketh <u>58\_HEB\_12\_05</u># And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him:

exhorted and comforted <u>52\_1TH\_02\_11</u> # As ye know how we exhorted and comforted and charged every one of you, as a father [doth] his children,

exhorted the brethren <u>44\_ACT\_15\_32</u> # And Judas and Silas, being prophets also themselves, exhorted the brethren with many words, and confirmed [them].

exhorted them all <u>44\_ACT\_11\_23</u># Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord.

exhorteth on exhortation <u>45\_ROM\_12\_08</u># Or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, [let him do it] with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that showeth mercy, with cheerfulness.

exhorting and testifying 60\_1PE\_05\_12 # By Silvanus, a faithful brother unto you, as I suppose, I have written briefly, exhorting, and testifying that this is the true grace of God wherein ye stand.

exhorting one another <u>58\_HEB\_10\_25</u> # Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some [is]; but exhorting [one another]: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

exhorting the disciples 44\_ACT\_18\_27 # And when he was disposed to pass into Achaia, the brethren wrote, exhorting the disciples to receive him: who, when he was come, helped them much which had believed through grace:

exhorting them to <u>44\_ACT\_14\_22</u> # Confirming the souls of the disciples, [and] exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God.

Hor and pitched 04\_NUM\_33\_41 # And they departed from mount Hor, and pitched in Zalmonah.

Hor and was <u>05\_DEU\_32\_50</u> # And die in the mount whither thou goest up, and be gathered unto thy people; as Aaron thy brother died in mount Hor, and was gathered unto his people:

Hor at the <u>04\_NUM\_33\_38</u> # And Aaron the priest went up into mount Hor at the commandment of the LORD, and died there, in the fortieth year after the children of Israel were come out of the land of Egypt, in the first [day] of the fifth month.

Hor by the <u>04\_NUM\_20\_23</u># And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron in mount Hor, by the coast of the land of Edom, saying,

Hor by the <u>04\_NUM\_21\_04</u> # And they journeyed from mount Hor by the way of the Red sea, to compass the land of Edom: and the soul of the people was much discouraged because of the way.

Hor in the <u>04\_NUM\_20\_27</u> # And Moses did as the LORD commanded: and they went up into mount Hor in the sight of all the congregation.

Hor in the <u>04\_NUM\_33\_37</u> # And they removed from Kadesh, and pitched in mount Hor, in the edge of the land of Edom.

Hor ye shall <u>04\_NUM\_34\_08</u> # From mount Hor ye shall point out [your border] unto the entrance of Hamath; and the goings forth of the border shall be to Zedad:

Hor <u>04\_NUM\_20\_25</u> # Take Aaron and Eleazar his son, and bring them up unto mount Hor:

Hor <u>04\_NUM\_33\_39</u> # And Aaron [was] an hundred and twenty and three years old when he died in mount Hor.

Hor <u>04\_NUM\_34\_07</u> # And this shall be your north border: from the great sea ye shall point out for you mount Hor:

Horam king of <u>06\_JOS\_10\_33</u> # Then Horam king of Gezer came up to help Lachish; and Joshua smote him and his people, until he had left him none remaining.

Horeb and thou <u>02\_EXO\_17\_06</u># Behold, I will stand before thee there upon the rock in Horeb; and thou shalt smite the rock, and there shall come water out of it, that the people may drink. And Moses did so in the sight of the elders of Israel.

Horeb and worshipped 19\_PSA\_106\_19 # They made a calf in Horeb, and worshipped the molten image.

Horeb by the <u>05\_DEU\_01\_02</u> # [[There are] eleven days' [journey] from Horeb by the way of mount Seir unto Kadeshbarnea.]

Horeb for all <u>39\_MAL\_04\_04</u> # Remember ye the law of Moses my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, [with] the statutes and judgments.

Horeb in the <u>05\_DEU\_18\_16</u> # According to all that thou desiredst of the LORD thy God in Horeb in the day of the assembly, saying, Let me not hear again the voice of the LORD my God, neither let me see this great fire any more, that I die not.

Horeb out of <u>05\_DEU\_04\_15</u> # Take ye therefore good heed unto yourselves; for ye saw no manner of similitude on the day [that] the LORD spake unto you in Horeb out of the midst of the fire:

Horeb saying Ye <u>05\_DEU\_01\_06</u># The LORD our God spake unto us in Horeb, saying, Ye have dwelt long enough in this mount:

Horeb the mount <u>11\_1KI\_19\_08</u># And he arose, and did eat and drink, and went in the strength of that meat forty days and forty nights unto Horeb the mount of God.

Horeb we went <u>05\_DEU\_01\_19</u># And when we departed from Horeb, we went through all that great and terrible wilderness, which ye saw by the way of the mountain of the Amorites, as the LORD our God commanded us; and we came to Kadeshbarnea.

Horeb when the 11\_1KI\_08\_09 # [There was] nothing in the ark save the two tables of stone, which Moses put there at Horeb, when the LORD made [a covenant] with the children of Israel, when they came out of

the land of Egypt.

Horeb when the <u>14\_2CH\_05\_10</u># [There was] nothing in the ark save the two tables which Moses put [therein] at Horeb, when the LORD made [a covenant] with the children of Israel, when they came out of Egypt.

Horeb when the <u>05\_DEU\_04\_10</u># [Specially] the day that thou stoodest before the LORD thy God in Horeb, when the LORD said unto me, Gather me the people together, and I will make them hear my words, that they may learn to fear me all the days that they shall live upon the earth, and [that] they may teach their children.

Horeb ye provoked <u>05\_DEU\_09\_08</u> # Also in Horeb ye provoked the LORD to wrath, so that the LORD was angry with you to have destroyed you.

Horeb 05\_DEU\_05\_02 # The LORD our God made a covenant with us in Horeb.

Horeb <u>05\_DEU\_29\_01</u> # These [are] the words of the covenant, which the LORD commanded Moses to make with the children of Israel in the land of Moab, beside the covenant which he made with them in Horeb.

Horeb <u>02\_EXO\_03\_01</u> # Now Moses kept the flock of Jethro his father in law, the priest of Midian: and he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, [even] to Horeb.

Horeb <u>02\_EXO\_33\_06</u> # And the children of Israel stripped themselves of their ornaments by the mount Horeb.

Horem and Bethanath <u>06\_JOS\_19\_38</u># And Iron, and Migdalel, Horem, and Bethanath, and Bethshemesh; nineteen cities with their villages.

Horhagidgad and pitched 04\_NUM\_33\_33 # And they went from Horhagidgad, and pitched in Jotbathah.

Horhagidgad 04\_NUM\_33\_32 # And they removed from Benejaakan, and encamped at Horhagidgad.

Hori among their <u>01\_GEN\_36\_30</u> # Duke Dishon, duke Ezer, duke Dishan: these [are] the dukes [that came] of Hori, among their dukes in the land of Seir.

Hori and Hemam <u>01\_GEN\_36\_22</u> # And the children of Lotan were Hori and Hemam; and Lotan's sister [was] Timna.

Hori and Homam <u>13\_1CH\_01\_39</u># And the sons of Lotan; Hori, and Homam: and Timna [was] Lotan's sister.

Hori 04\_NUM\_13\_05 # Of the tribe of Simeon, Shaphat the son of Hori.

Horims also dwelt <u>05\_DEU\_02\_12</u> # The Horims also dwelt in Seir beforetime; but the children of Esau succeeded them, when they had destroyed them from before them, and dwelt in their stead; as Israel did unto the land of his possession, which the LORD gave unto them.

Horims from before <u>05\_DEU\_02\_22</u> # As he did to the children of Esau, which dwelt in Seir, when he destroyed the Horims from before them; and they succeeded them, and dwelt in their stead even unto this day:

Horite who inhabited <u>01\_GEN\_36\_20</u> # These [are] the sons of Seir the Horite, who inhabited the land; Lotan, and Shobal, and Zibeon, and Anah,

Horites duke Lotan <u>01\_GEN\_36\_29</u> # These [are] the dukes [that came] of the Horites; duke Lotan, duke Shobal, duke Zibeon, duke Anah,

Horites in their <u>01\_GEN\_14\_06</u> # And the Horites in their mount Seir, unto Elparan, which [is] by the wilderness.

Horites the children <u>01\_GEN\_36\_21</u># And Dishon, and Ezer, and Dishan: these [are] the dukes of the Horites, the children of Seir in the land of Edom.

Hormah and at 13\_1CH\_04\_30 # And at Bethuel, and at Hormah, and at Ziklag,

Hormah and to <u>09\_1SA\_30\_30</u> # And to [them] which [were] in Hormah, and to [them] which [were] in Chorashan, and to [them] which [were] in Athach,

Hormah one the <a>06\_JOS\_12\_14</a># The king of Hormah, one; the king of Arad, one;

Hormah <u>05\_DEU\_01\_44</u> # And the Amorites, which dwelt in that mountain, came out against you, and chased you, as bees do, and destroyed you in Seir, [even] unto Hormah.

Hormah <u>06\_JOS\_15\_30</u> # And Eltolad, and Chesil, and Hormah,

Hormah 06\_JOS\_19\_04 # And Eltolad, and Bethul, and Hormah,

Hormah <u>07\_JUD\_01\_17</u> # And Judah went with Simeon his brother, and they slew the Canaanites that inhabited Zephath, and utterly destroyed it. And the name of the city was called Hormah.

Hormah <u>04\_NUM\_14\_45</u># Then the Amalekites came down, and the Canaanites which dwelt in that hill, and smote them, and discomfited them, [even] unto Hormah.

Hormah <u>04\_NUM\_21\_03</u> # And the LORD hearkened to the voice of Israel, and delivered up the Canaanites; and they utterly destroyed them and their cities: and he called the name of the place Hormah.

horn And God <u>13\_1CH\_25\_05</u> # All these [were] the sons of Heman the king's seer in the words of God, to lift up the horn. And God gave to Heman fourteen sons and three daughters.

horn and when <u>06\_JOS\_06\_05</u># And it shall come to pass, that when they make a long [blast] with the ram's horn, [and] when ye hear the sound of the trumpet, all the people shall shout with a great shout; and the wall of the city shall fall down flat, and the people shall ascend up every man straight before him.

horn be exalted 19\_PSA\_89\_24 # But my faithfulness and my mercy [shall be] with him: and in my name shall his horn be exalted.

horn before whom <u>27\_DAN\_07\_08</u># I considered the horns, and, behold, there came up among them another little horn, before whom there were three of the first horns plucked up by the roots: and, behold, in this horn [were] eyes like the eyes of man, and a mouth speaking great things.

horn between his <u>27\_DAN\_08\_05</u># And as I was considering, behold, an he goat came from the west on the face of the whole earth, and touched not the ground: and the goat [had] a notable horn between his eyes.

horn in the 18\_JOB\_16\_15 # I have sewed sackcloth upon my skin, and defiled my horn in the dust.

horn in time <u>02\_EXO\_21\_29</u> # But if the ox were wont to push with his horn in time past, and it hath been testified to his owner, and he hath not kept him in, but that he hath killed a man or a woman; the ox shall be stoned, and his owner also shall be put to death.

horn iron and <u>33 MIC\_04\_13</u> # Arise and thresh, O daughter of Zion: for I will make thine horn iron, and I will make thy hoofs brass: and thou shalt beat in pieces many people: and I will consecrate their gain unto the LORD, and their substance unto the Lord of the whole earth.

horn is exalted <u>09\_1SA\_02\_01</u> # And Hannah prayed, and said, My heart rejoiceth in the LORD, mine horn is exalted in the LORD: my mouth is enlarged over mine enemies; because I rejoice in thy salvation.

horn made war <u>27\_DAN\_07\_21</u># I beheld, and the same horn made war with the saints, and prevailed against them;

horn of an 19\_PSA\_92\_10 # But my horn shalt thou exalt like [the horn of] an unicorn: I shall be anointed with fresh oil.

horn of David 19\_PSA\_132\_17 # There will I make the horn of David to bud: I have ordained a lamp for mine anointed.

horn of his <u>09\_1SA\_02\_10</u> # The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken to pieces; out of heaven shall he thunder upon them: the LORD shall judge the ends of the earth; and he shall give strength unto his king, and exalt the horn of his anointed.

horn of his 19 PSA 148 14 He also exalteth the horn of his people, the praise of all his saints; [even] of the children of Israel, a people near unto him. Praise ye the LORD.

horn of Israel <u>25\_LAM\_02\_03</u># He hath cut off in [his] fierce anger all the horn of Israel: he hath drawn back his right hand from before the enemy, and he burned against Jacob like a flaming fire, [which] devoureth round about.

horn of Moab 24\_JER\_48\_25 # The horn of Moab is cut off, and his arm is broken, saith the LORD.

horn of my 10\_2SA\_22\_03 # The God of my rock; in him will I trust: [he is] my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my saviour; thou savest me from violence.

horn of my 19 PSA 18 02 # The LORD [is] my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, [and] my high tower.

horn of oil 11\_1KI\_01\_39# And Zadok the priest took an horn of oil out of the tabernacle, and anointed Solomon. And they blew the trumpet; and all the people said, God save king Solomon.

horn of oil <u>09\_1SA\_16\_13</u> # Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

horn of salvation <u>42\_LUK\_01\_69</u># And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David;

horn of the <u>26\_EZE\_29\_21</u># In that day will I cause the horn of the house of Israel to bud forth, and I will give thee the opening of the mouth in the midst of them; and they shall know that I [am] the LORD.

horn of thine <u>25\_LAM\_02\_17</u> # The LORD hath done [that] which he had devised; he hath fulfilled his word that he had commanded in the days of old: he hath thrown down, and hath not pitied: and he hath caused [thine] enemy to rejoice over thee, he hath set up the horn of thine adversaries.

horn on high 19\_PSA\_75\_05 # Lift not up your horn on high: speak [not with] a stiff neck.

horn over the 38\_ZEC\_01\_21 # Then said I, What come these to do? And he spake, saying, These [are] the

horns which have scattered Judah, so that no man did lift up his head: but these are come to fray them, to cast out the horns of the Gentiles, which lifted up [their] horn over the land of Judah to scatter it.

horn shall be 19\_PSA\_112\_09# He hath dispersed, he hath given to the poor; his righteousness endureth for ever; his horn shall be exalted with honour.

horn shall be 19\_PSA\_89\_17 # For thou [art] the glory of their strength: and in thy favour our horn shall be exalted.

horn shalt thou 19\_PSA\_92\_10 # But my horn shalt thou exalt like [the horn of] an unicorn: I shall be anointed with fresh oil.

horn spake I <u>27\_DAN\_07\_11</u># I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spake: I beheld [even] till the beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame.

horn that had <u>27\_DAN\_07\_20</u> # And of the ten horns that [were] in his head, and [of] the other which came up, and before whom three fell; even [of] that horn that had eyes, and a mouth that spake very great things, whose look [was] more stout than his fellows.

horn that is <u>27\_DAN\_08\_21</u> # And the rough goat [is] the king of Grecia: and the great horn that [is] between his eyes [is] the first king.

horn was broken <u>27\_DAN\_08\_08</u> # Therefore the he goat waxed very great: and when he was strong, the great horn was broken; and for it came up four notable ones toward the four winds of heaven.

horns and Abraham <u>01\_GEN\_22\_13</u># And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind [him] a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son.

horns and behold <u>27\_DAN\_07\_08</u> # I considered the horns, and, behold, there came up among them another little horn, before whom there were three of the first horns plucked up by the roots: and, behold, in this horn [were] eyes like the eyes of man, and a mouth speaking great things.

horns and hoofs 19 PSA 69 31 # [This] also shall please the LORD better than an ox [or] bullock that hath horns and hoofs.

horns and seven <u>66\_REV\_05\_06</u># And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

horns and seven <u>66\_REV\_12\_03</u> # And there appeared another wonder in heaven; and behold a great red dragon, having seven heads and ten horns, and seven crowns upon his heads.

horns and the <u>27\_DAN\_08\_03</u># Then I lifted up mine eyes, and saw, and, behold, there stood before the river a ram which had [two] horns: and the [two] horns [were] high; but one [was] higher than the other, and the higher came up last.

horns before the <u>06\_JOS\_06\_13</u> # And seven priests bearing seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark of the LORD went on continually, and blew with the trumpets: and the armed men went before them; but the rereward came after the ark of the LORD, [the priests] going on, and blowing with the trumpets.

horns by our <u>30\_AMO\_06\_13</u> # Ye which rejoice in a thing of nought, which say, Have we not taken to us horns by our own strength?

horns coming out <u>35\_HAB\_03\_04</u># And [his] brightness was as the light; he had horns [coming] out of his hand: and there [was] the hiding of his power.

horns like a 66\_REV\_13\_11 # And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon.

horns of iron 11\_1KI\_22\_11# And Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah made him horns of iron: and he said, Thus saith the LORD, With these shalt thou push the Syrians, until thou have consumed them.

horns of iron <u>14\_2CH\_18\_10</u> # And Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah had made him horns of iron, and said, Thus saith the LORD, With these thou shalt push Syria until they be consumed.

horns of it <u>02\_EXO\_27\_02</u> # And thou shalt make the horns of it upon the four corners thereof: his horns shall be of the same: and thou shalt overlay it with brass.

horns of it <u>02\_EXO\_30\_10</u> # And Aaron shall make an atonement upon the horns of it once in a year with the blood of the sin offering of atonements: once in the year shall he make atonement upon it throughout your generations: it [is] most holy unto the LORD.

horns of it <u>02\_EXO\_37\_26</u># And he overlaid it with pure gold, [both] the top of it, and the sides thereof round about, and the horns of it: also he made unto it a crown of gold round about.

horns of it <u>26\_EZE\_43\_20</u># And thou shalt take of the blood thereof, and put [it] on the four horns of it, and on the four corners of the settle, and upon the border round about: thus shalt thou cleanse and purge it.

horns of ivory <u>26\_EZE\_27\_15</u> # The men of Dedan [were] thy merchants; many isles [were] the merchandise of thine hand: they brought thee [for] a present horns of ivory and ebony.

horns of the <u>11\_1KI\_01\_50</u># And Adonijah feared because of Solomon, and arose, and went, and caught hold on the horns of the altar.

horns of the <u>11\_1KI\_01\_51</u># And it was told Solomon, saying, Behold, Adonijah feareth king Solomon: for, lo, he hath caught hold on the horns of the altar, saying, Let king Solomon swear unto me to day that he will not slay his servant with the sword.

horns of the <u>03\_LEV\_04\_34</u># And the priest shall take of the blood of the sin offering with his finger, and put [it] upon the horns of the altar of burnt offering, and shall pour out all the blood thereof at the bottom of the altar:

horns of the <u>03 LEV 08\_15</u> # And he slew [it]; and Moses took the blood, and put [it] upon the horns of the altar round about with his finger, and purified the altar, and poured the blood at the bottom of the altar, and sanctified it, to make reconciliation upon it.

horns of the <u>03\_LEV\_09\_09</u> # And the sons of Aaron brought the blood unto him: and he dipped his finger in the blood, and put [it] upon the horns of the altar, and poured out the blood at the bottom of the altar:

horns of the <u>03\_LEV\_16\_18</u># And he shall go out unto the altar that [is] before the LORD, and make an atonement for it; and shall take of the blood of the bullock, and of the blood of the goat, and put [it] upon the horns of the altar round about.

horses shall he <u>26\_EZE\_26\_11</u># With the hoofs of his horses shall he tread down all thy streets: he shall slay thy people by the sword, and thy strong garrisons shall go down to the ground.

horses speckled and <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_08</u># I saw by night, and behold a man riding upon a red horse, and he stood among the myrtle trees that [were] in the bottom; and behind him [were there] red horses, speckled, and white.

horses that remain 12\_2KI\_07\_13 # And one of his servants answered and said, Let [some] take, I pray thee, five of the horses that remain, which are left in the city, [behold, they [are] as all the multitude of Israel that are left in it: behold, [I say], they [are] even as all the multitude of the Israelites that are

consumed:] and let us send and see.

horses that the <u>12\_2KI\_23\_11</u># And he took away the horses that the kings of Judah had given to the sun, at the entering in of the house of the LORD, by the chamber of Nathanmelech the chamberlain, which [was] in the suburbs, and burned the chariots of the sun with fire.

horses their dust <u>26\_EZE\_26\_10</u># By reason of the abundance of his horses their dust shall cover thee: thy walls shall shake at the noise of the horsemen, and of the wheels, and of the chariots, when he shall enter into thy gates, as men enter into a city wherein is made a breach.

horses therefore shall <u>23\_ISA\_30\_16</u> # But ye said, No; for we will flee upon horses; therefore shall ye flee: and, We will ride upon the swift; therefore shall they that pursue you be swift.

horses they and <u>24\_JER\_17\_25</u> # Then shall there enter into the gates of this city kings and princes sitting upon the throne of David, riding in chariots and on horses, they, and their princes, the men of Judah, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem: and this city shall remain for ever.

horses through the <u>35\_HAB\_03\_15</u># Thou didst walk through the sea with thine horses, [through] the heap of great waters.

horses tied and 12 2KI 07 10 # So they came and called unto the porter of the city: and they told them, saying, We came to the camp of the Syrians, and, behold, [there was] no man there, neither voice of man, but horses tied, and asses tied, and the tents as they [were].

horses to come <u>24\_JER\_51\_27</u># Set ye up a standard in the land, blow the trumpet among the nations, prepare the nations against her, call together against her the kingdoms of Ararat, Minni, and Ashchenaz; appoint a captain against her; cause the horses to come up as the rough caterpillars.

horses to himself <u>05\_DEU\_17\_16</u># But he shall not multiply horses to himself, nor cause the people to return to Egypt, to the end that he should multiply horses: forasmuch as the LORD hath said unto you, Ye shall henceforth return no more that way.

horses upon the <u>02\_EXO\_09\_03</u> # Behold, the hand of the LORD is upon thy cattle which [is] in the field, upon the horses, upon the asses, upon the camels, upon the oxen, and upon the sheep: [there shall be] a very grievous murrain.

horses was heard 24 JER\_08\_16# The snorting of his horses was heard from Dan: the whole land trembled at the sound of the neighing of his strong ones; for they are come, and have devoured the land, and all that is in it; the city, and those that dwell therein.

horses were as <u>66\_REV\_09\_17</u># And thus I saw the horses in the vision, and them that sat on them, having breastplates of fire, and of jacinth, and brimstone: and the heads of the horses [were] as the heads of lions; and out of their mouths issued fire and smoke and brimstone.

horses were seven <u>15\_EZR\_02\_66</u> # Their horses [were] seven hundred thirty and six; their mules, two hundred forty and five;

horses which are 38\_ZEC\_06\_06 # The black horses which [are] therein go forth into the north country; and the white go forth after them; and the grisled go forth toward the south country.

horses <u>11\_1KI\_22\_04</u># And he said unto Jehoshaphat, Wilt thou go with me to battle to Ramothgilead? And Jehoshaphat said to the king of Israel, I [am] as thou [art], my people as thy people, my horses as thy horses.

horses 12\_2KI\_03\_07 # And he went and sent to Jehoshaphat the king of Judah, saying, The king of Moab

hath rebelled against me: wilt thou go with me against Moab to battle? And he said, I will go up: I [am] as thou [art], my people as thy people, [and] my horses as thy horses.

horses <u>26\_EZE\_23\_06</u> # [Which were] clothed with blue, captains and rulers, all of them desirable young men, horsemen riding upon horses.

horses <u>26\_EZE\_23\_20</u> # For she doted upon their paramours, whose flesh [is as] the flesh of asses, and whose issue [is like] the issue of horses.

horses <u>26\_EZE\_23\_23</u> # The Babylonians, and all the Chaldeans, Pekod, and Shoa, and Koa, [and] all the Assyrians with them: all of them desirable young men, captains and rulers, great lords and renowned, all of them riding upon horses.

horses 38\_ZEC\_06\_02 # In the first chariot [were] red horses; and in the second chariot black horses;

horses <u>38\_ZEC\_06\_03</u># And in the third chariot white horses; and in the fourth chariot grisled and bay horses.

inkhorn by his <u>26\_EZE\_09\_02</u># And, behold, six men came from the way of the higher gate, which lieth toward the north, and every man a slaughter weapon in his hand; and one man among them [was] clothed with linen, with a writer's inkhorn by his side: and they went in, and stood beside the brazen altar.

inkhorn by his <u>26\_EZE\_09\_03</u># And the glory of the God of Israel was gone up from the cherub, whereupon he was, to the threshold of the house. And he called to the man clothed with linen, which [had] the writer's inkhorn by his side;

inkhorn by his <u>26\_EZE\_09\_11</u># And, behold, the man clothed with linen, which [had] the inkhorn by his side, reported the matter, saying, I have done as thou hast commanded me.

Jehoram against Jehu 14\_2CH\_22\_07# And the destruction of Ahaziah was of God by coming to Joram: for when he was come, he went out with Jehoram against Jehu the son of Nimshi, whom the LORD had anointed to cut off the house of Ahab.

Jehoram and Ahaziah 12\_2KI\_12\_18 # And Jehoash king of Judah took all the hallowed things that Jehoshaphat, and Jehoram, and Ahaziah, his fathers, kings of Judah, had dedicated, and his own hallowed things, and all the gold [that was] found in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and in the king's house, and sent [it] to Hazael king of Syria: and he went away from Jerusalem.

Jehoram because he <u>14\_2CH\_21\_03</u> # And their father gave them great gifts of silver, and of gold, and of precious things, with fenced cities in Judah: but the kingdom gave he to Jehoram; because he [was] the firstborn.

Jehoram between his 12\_2KI\_09\_24 # And Jehu drew a bow with his full strength, and smote Jehoram between his arms, and the arrow went out at his heart, and he sunk down in his chariot.

Jehoram his son 11\_1KI\_22\_50 # And Jehoshaphat slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David his father: and Jehoram his son reigned in his stead.

Jehoram his son 14\_2CH\_21\_01 # Now Jehoshaphat slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David. And Jehoram his son reigned in his stead.

Jehoram king of 14\_2CH\_22\_01 # And the inhabitants of Jerusalem made Ahaziah his youngest son king in his stead: for the band of men that came with the Arabians to the camp had slain all the eldest. So Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah reigned.

Jehoram king of 14\_2CH\_22\_06 # And he returned to be healed in Jezreel because of the wounds which were given him at Ramah, when he fought with Hazael king of Syria. And Azariah the son of Jehoram king of Judah went down to see Jehoram the son of Ahab at Jezreel, because he was sick.

Jehoram king of 12\_2KI\_08\_25 # In the twelfth year of Joram the son of Ahab king of Israel did Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah begin to reign.

Jehoram king of 12 2KI 08 29 # And king Joram went back to be healed in Jezreel of the wounds which the Syrians had given him at Ramah, when he fought against Hazael king of Syria. And Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah went down to see Joram the son of Ahab in Jezreel, because he was sick.

Jehoram priests <u>14\_2CH\_17\_08</u># And with them [he sent] Levites, [even] Shemaiah, and Nethaniah, and Zebadiah, and Asahel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehonathan, and Adonijah, and Tobijah, and Tobadonijah, Levites; and with them Elishama and Jehoram, priests.

Jehoram reigned in 12\_2KI\_01\_17 # So he died according to the word of the LORD which Elijah had spoken. And Jehoram reigned in his stead in the second year of Jehoram the son of Jehoshaphat king of Judah; because he had no son.

Jehoram the son 14\_2CH\_22\_05 # He walked also after their counsel, and went with Jehoram the son of Ahab king of Israel to war against Hazael king of Syria at Ramothgilead: and the Syrians smote Joram.

Jehoram the son 14\_2CH\_22\_06 # And he returned to be healed in Jezreel because of the wounds which were given him at Ramah, when he fought with Hazael king of Syria. And Azariah the son of Jehoram king of Judah went down to see Jehoram the son of Ahab at Jezreel, because he was sick.

Jehoram the son 12 2KI 01 17 # So he died according to the word of the LORD which Elijah had spoken. And Jehoram reigned in his stead in the second year of Jehoram the son of Jehoshaphat king of Judah; because he had no son.

Jehoram the son 12\_2KI\_03\_01 # Now Jehoram the son of Ahab began to reign over Israel in Samaria the eighteenth year of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, and reigned twelve years.

Jehoram the son 12\_2KI\_08\_16 # And in the fifth year of Joram the son of Ahab king of Israel, Jehoshaphat [being] then king of Judah, Jehoram the son of Jehoshaphat king of Judah began to reign.

Jehoram the spirit <u>14\_2CH\_21\_16</u> # Moreover the LORD stirred up against Jehoram the spirit of the Philistines, and of the Arabians, that [were] near the Ethiopians:

Jehoram the wife 14\_2CH\_22\_11# But Jehoshabeath, the daughter of the king, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons that were slain, and put him and his nurse in a bedchamber. So Jehoshabeath, the daughter of king Jehoram, the wife of Jehoiada the priest, [for she was the sister of Ahaziah,] hid him from Athaliah, so that she slew him not.

Jehoram was risen <u>14\_2CH\_21\_04</u> # Now when Jehoram was risen up to the kingdom of his father, he strengthened himself, and slew all his brethren with the sword, and [divers] also of the princes of Israel.

Jehoram was thirty 14\_2CH\_21\_05 # Jehoram [was] thirty and two years old when he began to reign, and he reigned eight years in Jerusalem.

Jehoram went forth 14\_2CH\_21\_09 # Then Jehoram went forth with his princes, and all his chariots with him: and he rose up by night, and smote the Edomites which compassed him in, and the captains of the chariots.

Jehoram went out 12\_2KI\_03\_06 # And king Jehoram went out of Samaria the same time, and numbered

all Israel.

Nachor and they <u>06\_JOS\_24\_02</u> # And Joshua said unto all the people, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Your fathers dwelt on the other side of the flood in old time, [even] Terah, the father of Abraham, and the father of Nachor: and they served other gods.

Nachor <u>42\_LUK\_03\_34</u> # Which was [the son] of Jacob, which was [the son] of Isaac, which was [the son] of Abraham, which was [the son] of Nachor,

Nahor Abraham's brother <u>01\_GEN\_22\_23</u># And Bethuel begat Rebekah: these eight Milcah did bear to Nahor, Abraham's brother.

Nahor Abraham's brother <u>01\_GEN\_24\_15</u># And it came to pass, before he had done speaking, that, behold, Rebekah came out, who was born to Bethuel, son of Milcah, the wife of Nahor, Abraham's brother, with her pitcher upon her shoulder.

Nahor and Haran <u>01\_GEN\_11\_26</u># And Terah lived seventy years, and begat Abram, Nahor, and Haran.

Nahor and Haran <u>01\_GEN\_11\_27</u> # Now these [are] the generations of Terah: Terah begat Abram, Nahor, and Haran; and Haran begat Lot.

Nahor And they <u>01\_GEN\_29\_05</u># And he said unto them, Know ye Laban the son of Nahor? And they said, We know [him].

Nahor lived after <u>01\_GEN\_11\_25</u># And Nahor lived after he begat Terah an hundred and nineteen years, and begat sons and daughters.

Nahor lived nine 01\_GEN\_11\_24# And Nahor lived nine and twenty years, and begat Terah:

Nahor Terah 13\_1CH\_01\_26# Serug, Nahor, Terah,

Nahor the God <u>01\_GEN\_31\_53</u># The God of Abraham, and the God of Nahor, the God of their father, judge betwixt us. And Jacob sware by the fear of his father Isaac.

Nahor took them <u>01\_GEN\_11\_29</u># And Abram and Nahor took them wives: the name of Abram's wife [was] Sarai; and the name of Nahor's wife, Milcah, the daughter of Haran, the father of Milcah, and the father of Iscah.

Nahor two hundred <u>01\_GEN\_11\_23</u># And Serug lived after he begat Nahor two hundred years, and begat sons and daughters.

Nahor <u>01\_GEN\_11\_22</u># And Serug lived thirty years, and begat Nahor:

Nahor <u>01\_GEN\_22\_20</u># And it came to pass after these things, that it was told Abraham, saying, Behold, Milcah, she hath also born children unto thy brother Nahor;

Nahor <u>01\_GEN\_24\_10</u> # And the servant took ten camels of the camels of his master, and departed; for all the goods of his master [were] in his hand: and he arose, and went to Mesopotamia, unto the city of Nahor.

Nahor <u>01\_GEN\_24\_24</u># And she said unto him, I [am] the daughter of Bethuel the son of Milcah, which she bare unto Nahor.

Nahor's son whom <u>01\_GEN\_24\_47</u># And I asked her, and said, Whose daughter [art] thou? And she said, The daughter of Bethuel, Nahor's son, whom Milcah bare unto him: and I put the earring upon her face, and the bracelets upon her hands.

Nahor's wife Milcah <u>01 GEN 11 29 #</u> And Abram and Nahor took them wives: the name of Abram's wife [was] Sarai; and the name of Nahor's wife, Milcah, the daughter of Haran, the father of Milcah, and the father of Iscah.

Onesiphorus for he <u>55\_2TI\_01\_16</u># The Lord give mercy unto the house of Onesiphorus; for he oft refreshed me, and was not ashamed of my chain:

Onesiphorus 55\_2TI\_04\_19 # Salute Prisca and Aquila, and the household of Onesiphorus.

Pethor of Mesopotamia <u>05\_DEU\_23\_04</u> # Because they met you not with bread and with water in the way, when ye came forth out of Egypt; and because they hired against thee Balaam the son of Beor of Pethor of Mesopotamia, to curse thee.

Pethor which is <u>04\_NUM\_22\_05</u> # He sent messengers therefore unto Balaam the son of Beor to Pethor, which [is] by the river of the land of the children of his people, to call him, saying, Behold, there is a people come out from Egypt: behold, they cover the face of the earth, and they abide over against me:

Prochorus and Nicanor 44\_ACT\_06\_05 # And the saying pleased the whole multitude: and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Ghost, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolas a proselyte of Antioch:

Shihor of Egypt <u>13\_1CH\_13\_05</u> # So David gathered all Israel together, from Shihor of Egypt even unto the entering of Hemath, to bring the ark of God from Kirjathjearim.

Shihorlibnath <u>06\_JOS\_19\_26</u> # And Alammelech, and Amad, and Misheal; and reacheth to Carmel westward, and to Shihorlibnath;

shore and abode <u>07\_JUD\_05\_17</u> # Gilead abode beyond Jordan: and why did Dan remain in ships? Asher continued on the sea shore, and abode in his breaches.

shore and prayed <u>44\_ACT\_21\_05</u># And when we had accomplished those days, we departed and went our way; and they all brought us on our way, with wives and children, till [we were] out of the city: and we kneeled down on the shore, and prayed.

shore and sat <u>40\_MAT\_13\_48</u># Which, when it was full, they drew to shore, and sat down, and gathered the good into vessels, but cast the bad away.

shore and thy <u>01\_GEN\_22\_17</u># That in blessing I will bless thee, and in multiplying I will multiply thy seed as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which [is] upon the sea shore; and thy seed shall possess the gate of his enemies;

shore but the <u>43\_JOH\_21\_04</u> # But when the morning was now come, Jesus stood on the shore: but the disciples knew not that it was Jesus.

shore in multitude <u>09\_1SA\_13\_05</u># And the Philistines gathered themselves together to fight with Israel, thirty thousand chariots, and six thousand horsemen, and people as the sand which [is] on the sea shore in multitude: and they came up, and pitched in Michmash, eastward from Bethaven.

short because of 18\_JOB\_17\_12 # They change the night into day: the light [is] short because of darkness.

short in righteousness <u>45\_ROM\_09\_28</u> # For he will finish the work, and cut [it] short in righteousness: because a short work will the Lord make upon the earth.

short it remaineth <u>46\_1CO\_07\_29</u> # But this I say, brethren, the time [is] short: it remaineth, that both they that have wives be as though they had none;

short my time 19 PSA 89 47 # Remember how short my time is: wherefore hast thou made all men in

vain?

short of it <u>58\_HEB\_04\_01</u> # Let us therefore fear, lest, a promise being left [us] of entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it.

short of the 45\_ROM\_03\_23 # For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

short space <u>66\_REV\_17\_10</u># And there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is, [and] the other is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue a short space.

short thou shalt <u>04\_NUM\_11\_23</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Is the LORD'S hand waxed short? thou shalt see now whether my word shall come to pass unto thee or not.

short time in <u>52\_1TH\_02\_17</u># But we, brethren, being taken from you for a short time in presence, not in heart, endeavoured the more abundantly to see your face with great desire.

short time <u>66\_REV\_12\_12</u> # Therefore rejoice, [ye] heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabiters of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.

shortened the days <u>41\_MAR\_13\_20</u># And except that the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh should be saved: but for the elect's sake, whom he hath chosen, he hath shortened the days.

shortly be brought <u>24\_JER\_27\_16</u># Also I spake to the priests and to all this people, saying, Thus saith the LORD; Hearken not to the words of your prophets that prophesy unto you, saying, Behold, the vessels of the LORD'S house shall now shortly be brought again from Babylon: for they prophesy a lie unto you.

shortly be done <u>66\_REV\_22\_06</u># And he said unto me, These sayings [are] faithful and true: and the Lord God of the holy prophets sent his angel to show unto his servants the things which must shortly be done.
