Howbeit as the [44 ACT 14 20](#) # Howbeit, as the disciples stood round about him, he rose up, and came into the city: and the next day he departed with Barnabas to Derbe.

Howbeit because by [10 2SA 12 14](#) # Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also [that is] born unto thee shall surely die.

Howbeit certain men [44 ACT 17 34](#) # Howbeit certain men clave unto him, and believed: among the which [was] Dionysius the Areopagite, and a woman named Damaris, and others with them.

Howbeit every nation [12 2KI 17 29](#) # Howbeit every nation made gods of their own, and put [them] in the houses of the high places which the Samaritans had made, every nation in their cities wherein they dwelt.

Howbeit for this [54 1TI 01 16](#) # Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might show forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting.

Howbeit from the [12 2KI 10 29](#) # Howbeit [from] the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin, Jehu departed not from after them, [to wit], the golden calves that [were] in Bethel, and that [were] in Dan.

howbeit he attained [13 1CH 11 21](#) # Of the three, he was more honourable than the two; for he was their captain: howbeit he attained not to the [first] three.

howbeit he attained [10 2SA 23 19](#) # Was he not most honourable of three? therefore he was their captain: howbeit he attained not unto the [first] three.

howbeit he entered [14 2CH 27 02](#) # And he did [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father Uzziah did: howbeit he entered not into the temple of the LORD. And the people did yet corruptly.

Howbeit he meaneth [23 ISA 10 07](#) # Howbeit he meaneth not so, neither doth his heart think so; but [it is] in his heart to destroy and cut off nations not a few.

Howbeit he refused [10 2SA 02 23](#) # Howbeit he refused to turn aside: wherefore Abner with the hinder end of the spear smote him under the fifth [rib], that the spear came out behind him; and he fell down there, and died in the same place: and it came to pass, [that] as many as came to the place where Asahel fell down and died stood still.

Howbeit he will [18 JOB 30 24](#) # Howbeit he will not stretch out [his] hand to the grave, though they cry in his destruction.

Howbeit he would [10 2SA 13 14](#) # Howbeit he would not hearken unto her voice: but, being stronger than she, forced her, and lay with her.

howbeit he would [10 2SA 13 25](#) # And the king said to Absalom, Nay, my son, let us not all now go, lest we be chargeable unto thee. And he pressed him: howbeit he would not go, but blessed him.

Howbeit I believed [11 1KI 10 07](#) # Howbeit I believed not the words, until I came, and mine eyes had seen

[it]: and, behold, the half was not told me: thy wisdom and prosperity exceedeth the fame which I heard.

Howbeit I believed [14 2CH 09 06](#) # Howbeit I believed not their words, until I came, and mine eyes had seen [it]: and, behold, the one half of the greatness of thy wisdom was not told me: [for] thou exceedest the fame that I heard.

Howbeit I sent [24 JER 44 04](#) # Howbeit I sent unto you all my servants the prophets, rising early and sending [them], saying, Oh, do not this abominable thing that I hate.

Howbeit I will [11 1KI 11 13](#) # Howbeit I will not rend away all the kingdom; [but] will give one tribe to thy son for David my servant's sake, and for Jerusalem's sake which I have chosen.

Howbeit I will [11 1KI 11 34](#) # Howbeit I will not take the whole kingdom out of his hand: but I will make him prince all the days of his life for David my servant's sake, whom I chose, because he kept my commandments and my statutes:

howbeit in malice [46 1CO 14 20](#) # Brethren, be not children in understanding: howbeit in malice be ye children, but in understanding be men.

howbeit in the [46 1CO 14 02](#) # For he that speaketh in an [unknown] tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth [him]; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries.

Howbeit in the [14 2CH 32 31](#) # Howbeit in [the business of] the ambassadors of the princes of Babylon, who sent unto him to inquire of the wonder that was [done] in the land, God left him, to try him, that he might know all [that was] in his heart.

Howbeit in vain [41 MAR 07 07](#) # Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching [for] doctrines the commandments of men.

Howbeit Jesus spake [43 JOH 11 13](#) # Howbeit Jesus spake of his death: but they thought that he had spoken of taking of rest in sleep.

Howbeit Jesus suffered [41 MAR 05 19](#) # Howbeit Jesus suffered him not, but saith unto him, Go home to thy friends, and tell them how great things the Lord hath done for thee, and hath had compassion on thee.

howbeit let me [11 1KI 11 22](#) # Then Pharaoh said unto him, But what hast thou lacked with me, that, behold, thou seekest to go to thine own country? And he answered, Nothing: howbeit let me go in any wise.

Howbeit many of [44 ACT 04 04](#) # Howbeit many of them which heard the word believed; and the number of the men was about five thousand.

Howbeit no man [43 JOH 07 13](#) # Howbeit no man spake openly of him for fear of the Jews.

howbeit not all [58 HEB 03 16](#) # For some, when they had heard, did provoke: howbeit not all that came out of Egypt by Moses.

howbeit our God [16 NEH 13 02](#) # Because they met not the children of Israel with bread and with water, but hired Balaam against them, that he should curse them: howbeit our God turned the curse into a blessing.

Howbeit Sisera fled [07 JUD 04 17](#) # Howbeit Sisera fled away on his feet to the tent of Jael the wife of Heber the Kenite: for [there was] peace between Jabin the king of Hazor and the house of Heber the Kenite.

Howbeit that was [46 1CO 15 46](#) # Howbeit that [was] not first which is spiritual, but that which is

natural; and afterward that which is spiritual.

Howbeit the hair [07\\_JUD\\_16\\_22](#) # Howbeit the hair of his head began to grow again after he was shaven.

Howbeit the high [14\\_2CH\\_20\\_33](#) # Howbeit the high places were not taken away: for as yet the people had not prepared their hearts unto the God of their fathers.

Howbeit the high [12\\_2KI\\_14\\_04](#) # Howbeit the high places were not taken away: as yet the people did sacrifice and burnt incense on the high places.

Howbeit the high [12\\_2KI\\_15\\_35](#) # Howbeit the high places were not removed: the people sacrificed and burned incense still in the high places. He built the higher gate of the house of the LORD.

howbeit the king [14\\_2CH\\_18\\_34](#) # And the battle increased that day: howbeit the king of Israel stayed [himself] up in [his] chariot against the Syrians until the even: and about the time of the sun going down he died.

Howbeit the king [07\\_JUD\\_11\\_28](#) # Howbeit the king of the children of Ammon hearkened not unto the words of Jephthah which he sent him.

howbeit the kingdom [11\\_1KI\\_02\\_15](#) # And he said, Thou knowest that the kingdom was mine, and [that] all Israel set their faces on me, that I should reign: howbeit the kingdom is turned about, and is become my brother's: for it was his from the LORD.

Howbeit the Levites [14\\_2CH\\_24\\_05](#) # And he gathered together the priests and the Levites, and said to them, Go out unto the cities of Judah, and gather of all Israel money to repair the house of your God from year to year, and see that ye hasten the matter. Howbeit the Levites hastened [it] not.

howbeit the name [07\\_JUD\\_18\\_29](#) # And they called the name of the city Dan, after the name of Dan their father, who was born unto Israel: howbeit the name of the city [was] Laish at the first.

howbeit the slingers [12\\_2KI\\_03\\_25](#) # And they beat down the cities, and on every good piece of land cast every man his stone, and filled it; and they stopped all the wells of water, and felled all the good trees: only in Kirharaseth left they the stones thereof; howbeit the slingers went about [it], and smote it.

Howbeit then when [48\\_GAL\\_04\\_08](#) # Howbeit then, when ye knew not God, ye did service unto them which by nature are no gods.

Howbeit there came [43\\_JOH\\_06\\_23](#) # [Howbeit there came other boats from Tiberias nigh unto the place where they did eat bread, after that the Lord had given thanks:]

Howbeit there is [46\\_1CO\\_08\\_07](#) # Howbeit [there is] not in every man that knowledge: for some with conscience of the idol unto this hour eat [it] as a thing offered unto an idol; and their conscience being weak is defiled.

howbeit there is [08\\_RUT\\_03\\_12](#) # And now it is true that I [am thy] near kinsman: howbeit there is a kinsman nearer than I.

Howbeit there was [12\\_2KI\\_22\\_07](#) # Howbeit there was no reckoning made with them of the money that was delivered into their hand, because they dealt faithfully.

Howbeit there were [12\\_2KI\\_12\\_13](#) # Howbeit there were not made for the house of the LORD bowls of silver, snuffers, basins, trumpets, any vessels of gold, or vessels of silver, of the money [that was] brought into the house of the LORD:

Howbeit they buried [14\\_2CH\\_21\\_20](#) # Thirty and two years old was he when he began to reign, and he reigned in Jerusalem eight years, and departed without being desired. Howbeit they buried him in the city of David, but not in the sepulchres of the kings.

Howbeit they did [12\\_2KI\\_17\\_40](#) # Howbeit they did not hearken, but they did after their former manner.

Howbeit they looked [44\\_ACT\\_28\\_06](#) # Howbeit they looked when he should have swollen, or fallen down dead suddenly: but after they had looked a great while, and saw no harm come to him, they changed their minds, and said that he was a god.

Howbeit this kind [40\\_MAT\\_17\\_21](#) # Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting.

Howbeit thou art [16\\_NEH\\_09\\_33](#) # Howbeit thou [art] just in all that is brought upon us; for thou hast done right, but we have done wickedly:

Howbeit we know [43\\_JOH\\_07\\_27](#) # Howbeit we know this man whence he is: but when Christ cometh, no man knoweth whence he is.

Howbeit we may [07\\_JUD\\_21\\_18](#) # Howbeit we may not give them wives of our daughters: for the children of Israel have sworn, saying, Cursed [be] he that giveth a wife to Benjamin.

Howbeit we must [44\\_ACT\\_27\\_26](#) # Howbeit we must be cast upon a certain island.

Howbeit we speak [46\\_1CO\\_02\\_06](#) # Howbeit we speak wisdom among them that are perfect: yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to nought:

Howbeit when he [43\\_JOH\\_16\\_13](#) # Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, [that] shall he speak: and he will show you things to come.

Howbeit whereinsoever any [47\\_2CO\\_11\\_21](#) # I speak as concerning reproach, as though we had been weak. Howbeit whereinsoever any is bold, [I speak foolishly,] I am bold also.

howbeit yet protest [09\\_1SA\\_08\\_09](#) # Now therefore hearken unto their voice: howbeit yet protest solemnly unto them, and show them the manner of the king that shall reign over them.
