Abishur was Abihail <u>13\_1CH\_02\_29</u> # And the name of the wife of Abishur [was] Abihail, and she bare him Ahban, and Molid.

Abishur <u>13\_1CH\_02\_28</u># And the sons of Onam were, Shammai, and Jada. And the sons of Shammai; Nadab, and Abishur.

Ashur the father 13\_1CH\_02\_24 # And after that Hezron was dead in Calebephratah, then Abiah Hezron's wife bare him Ashur the father of Tekoa.

Ashur the father 13\_1CH\_04\_05 # And Ashur the father of Tekoa had two wives, Helah and Naarah.

Ashurites and over <u>10\_2SA\_02\_09</u># And made him king over Gilead, and over the Ashurites, and over Jezreel, and over Ephraim, and over Benjamin, and over all Israel.

Ashurites have made <u>26\_EZE\_27\_06</u> # [Of] the oaks of Bashan have they made thine oars; the company of the Ashurites have made thy benches [of] ivory, [brought] out of the isles of Chittim.

Asshur and Arphaxad <u>13\_1CH\_01\_17</u> # The sons of Shem; Elam, and Asshur, and Arphaxad, and Lud, and Aram, and Uz, and Hul, and Gether, and Meshech.

Asshur and Arphaxad <u>01\_GEN\_10\_22</u># The children of Shem; Elam, and Asshur, and Arphaxad, and Lud, and Aram.

Asshur and builded <u>01\_GEN\_10\_11</u># Out of that land went forth Asshur, and builded Nineveh, and the city Rehoboth, and Calah,

Asshur and Chilmad <u>26\_EZE\_27\_23</u> # Haran, and Canneh, and Eden, the merchants of Sheba, Asshur, [and] Chilmad, [were] thy merchants.

Asshur and shall <u>04\_NUM\_24\_24</u> # And ships [shall come] from the coast of Chittim, and shall afflict Asshur, and shall afflict Eber, and he also shall perish for ever.

Asshur is there <u>26\_EZE\_32\_22</u> # Asshur [is] there and all her company: his graves [are] about him: all of them slain, fallen by the sword:

Asshur shall carry <u>04\_NUM\_24\_22</u> # Nevertheless the Kenite shall be wasted, until Asshur shall carry thee away captive.

Asshur shall not <u>28\_HOS\_14\_03</u> # Asshur shall not save us; we will not ride upon horses: neither will we say any more to the work of our hands, [Ye are] our gods: for in thee the fatherless findeth mercy.

Asshurim and Letushim <u>01\_GEN\_25\_03</u># And Jokshan begat Sheba, and Dedan. And the sons of Dedan were Asshurim, and Letushim, and Leummim.

Bahurim behold thence <u>10\_2SA\_16\_05</u># And when king David came to Bahurim, behold, thence came out a man of the family of the house of Saul, whose name [was] Shimei, the son of Gera: he came forth, and cursed still as he came.

Bahurim hasted and 10\_2SA\_19\_16 # And Shimei the son of Gera, a Benjamite, which [was] of Bahurim, hasted and came down with the men of Judah to meet king David.

Bahurim Then said 10\_2SA\_03\_16 # And her husband went with her along weeping behind her to Bahurim. Then said Abner unto him, Go, return. And he returned.

Bahurim which cursed <a href="mailto:11\_1KI\_02\_08">11\_1KI\_02\_08</a> # And, behold, [thou hast] with thee Shimei the son of Gera, a Benjamite of Bahurim, which cursed me with a grievous curse in the day when I went to Mahanaim: but he came down to meet me at Jordan, and I sware to him by the LORD, saying, I will not put thee to death with the sword.

Bahurim which had <u>10 2SA 17 18</u> # Nevertheless a lad saw them, and told Absalom: but they went both of them away quickly, and came to a man's house in Bahurim, which had a well in his court; whither they went down.

church and gave 49\_EPH\_05\_25\_# Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;

church and had <u>44\_ACT\_14\_23</u># And when they had ordained them elders in every church, and had prayed with fasting, they commended them to the Lord, on whom they believed.

church and he <u>49\_EPH\_05\_23</u> # For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.

church and let <u>46\_1CO\_14\_28</u> # But if there be no interpreter, let him keep silence in the church; and let him speak to himself, and to God.

church and let <u>59\_JAM\_05\_14</u># Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

church and of <u>44\_ACT\_15\_04</u> # And when they were come to Jerusalem, they were received of the church, and [of] the apostles and elders, and they declared all things that God had done with them.

church and taught <u>44\_ACT\_11\_26</u># And when he had found him, he brought him unto Antioch. And it came to pass, that a whole year they assembled themselves with the church, and taught much people. And the disciples were called Christians first in Antioch.

church and the <u>40\_MAT\_16\_18</u># And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

church and upon  $\underline{44\_ACT\_05\_11}$ # And great fear came upon all the church, and upon as many as heard these things.

church be charged <u>54\_1TI\_05\_16</u> # If any man or woman that believeth have widows, let them relieve them, and let not the church be charged; that it may relieve them that are widows indeed.

church be come <u>46\_1CO\_14\_23</u># If therefore the whole church be come together into one place, and all speak with tongues, and there come in [those that are] unlearned, or unbelievers, will they not say that ye are mad?

church but Diotrephes <u>64\_3JO\_01\_09</u> # I wrote unto the church: but Diotrephes, who loveth to have the preeminence among them, receiveth us not.

church but if <u>40\_MAT\_18\_17</u># And if he shall neglect to hear them, tell [it] unto the church: but if he neglect to hear the church, let him be unto thee as a heathen man and a publican.

church by Christ 49 EPH 03 21 # Unto him [be] glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen.

church communicated with <u>50\_PHP\_04\_15</u># Now ye Philippians know also, that in the beginning of the gospel, when I departed from Macedonia, no church communicated with me as concerning giving and receiving, but ye only.

church daily such <u>44\_ACT\_02\_47</u> # Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.

church entering into <u>44\_ACT\_08\_03</u> # As for Saul, he made havock of the church, entering into every house, and haling men and women committed [them] to prison.

church first apostles <u>46\_1CO\_12\_28</u># And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues.

church he went <u>44\_ACT\_18\_22</u> # And when he had landed at Caesarea, and gone up, and saluted the church, he went down to Antioch.

church I had <u>46\_1CO\_14\_19</u># Yet in the church I had rather speak five words with my understanding, that [by my voice] I might teach others also, than ten thousand words in an [unknown] tongue.

church I hear <u>46\_1CO\_11\_18</u># For first of all, when ye come together in the church, I hear that there be divisions among you; and I partly believe it.

church in Pergamos <u>66\_REV\_02\_12</u># And to the angel of the church in Pergamos write; These things saith he which hath the sharp sword with two edges;

church in Philadelphia <u>66\_REV\_03\_07</u># And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;

church in Sardis <u>66\_REV\_03\_01</u># And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; These things saith he that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; I know thy works, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead.

church in Smyrna <u>66\_REV\_02\_08</u># And unto the angel of the church in Smyrna write; These things saith the first and the last, which was dead, and is alive;

church in the <u>44\_ACT\_07\_38</u># This is he, that was in the church in the wilderness with the angel which spake to him in the mount Sina, and [with] our fathers: who received the lively oracles to give unto us:

church in thy <u>57\_PHM\_01\_02</u># And to [our] beloved Apphia, and Archippus our fellowsoldier, and to the church in thy house:

church in Thyatira 66\_REV\_02\_18 # And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write; These things saith the Son of God, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet [are] like fine brass;

church is subject 49\_EPH\_05\_24 # Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so [let] the wives [be] to their own husbands in every thing.

church let him <u>40\_MAT\_18\_17</u># And if he shall neglect to hear them, tell [it] unto the church: but if he neglect to hear the church, let him be unto thee as a heathen man and a publican.

church may receive <u>46\_1CO\_14\_05</u> # I would that ye all spake with tongues, but rather that ye prophesied: for greater [is] he that prophesieth than he that speaketh with tongues, except he interpret, that the church may receive edifying.

church not having 49\_EPH\_05\_27 # That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

church of Ephesus <u>66\_REV\_02\_01</u> # Unto the angel of the church of Ephesus write; These things saith he that holdeth the seven stars in his right hand, who walketh in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks;

church of God <u>46\_1CO\_01\_02</u> # Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called [to be] saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:

church of God <u>46\_1CO\_10\_32</u># Give none offence, neither to the Jews, nor to the Gentiles, nor to the church of God:

church of God <u>46\_1CO\_11\_22</u># What? have ye not houses to eat and to drink in? or despise ye the church of God, and shame them that have not? What shall I say to you? shall I praise you in this? I praise [you] not.

church of God <u>46\_1CO\_15\_09</u> # For I am the least of the apostles, that am not meet to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.

church of God <u>54\_1TI\_03\_05</u># [For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the church of God?]

church of God <u>47\_2CO\_01\_01</u> # Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Timothy [our] brother, unto the church of God which is at Corinth, with all the saints which are in all Achaia:

church of God <u>44\_ACT\_20\_28</u># Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.

church of God <u>48\_GAL\_01\_13</u># For ye have heard of my conversation in time past in the Jews' religion, how that beyond measure I persecuted the church of God, and wasted it:

church of the <u>52\_1TH\_01\_01</u># Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessalonians [which is] in God the Father and [in] the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace [be] unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.

church of the <u>54\_1TI\_03\_15</u> # But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth.

church of the <u>53\_2TH\_01\_01</u> # Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessalonians in God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ:

church of the <u>51\_COL\_04\_16</u># And when this epistle is read among you, cause that it be read also in the church of the Laodiceans; and that ye likewise read the [epistle] from Laodicea.

church of the <u>58\_HEB\_12\_23</u># To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect,

church of the 66\_REV\_03\_14 # And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things

saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God;

church saluteth you <u>45\_ROM\_16\_23</u> # Gaius mine host, and of the whole church, saluteth you. Erastus the chamberlain of the city saluteth you, and Quartus a brother.

church that is <u>46\_1CO\_16\_19</u> # The churches of Asia salute you. Aquila and Priscilla salute you much in the Lord, with the church that is in their house.

church that is <u>60\_1PE\_05\_13</u> # The [church that is] at Babylon, elected together with [you], saluteth you; and [so doth] Marcus my son.

church that is <u>45\_ROM\_16\_05</u> # Likewise [greet] the church that is in their house. Salute my wellbeloved Epaenetus, who is the firstfruits of Achaia unto Christ.

church that was 44 ACT 13\_01 # Now there were in the church that was at Antioch certain prophets and teachers; as Barnabas, and Simeon that was called Niger, and Lucius of Cyrene, and Manaen, which had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul.

church the manifold <u>49\_EPH\_03\_10</u> # To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly [places] might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God,

church they passed <u>44\_ACT\_15\_03</u># And being brought on their way by the church, they passed through Phenice and Samaria, declaring the conversion of the Gentiles: and they caused great joy unto all the brethren.

church to send <u>44\_ACT\_15\_22</u># Then pleased it the apostles and elders, with the whole church, to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; [namely], Judas surnamed Barsabas, and Silas, chief men among the brethren:

church together they <u>44\_ACT\_14\_27</u># And when they were come, and had gathered the church together, they rehearsed all that God had done with them, and how he had opened the door of faith unto the Gentiles.

church touching the <u>50\_PHP\_03\_06</u># Concerning zeal, persecuting the church; touching the righteousness which is in the law, blameless.

church unto God <u>44\_ACT\_12\_05</u># Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him.

church which is <u>51\_COL\_04\_15</u># Salute the brethren which are in Laodicea, and Nymphas, and the church which is in his house.

church which is <u>45\_ROM\_16\_01</u> # I commend unto you Phebe our sister, which is a servant of the church which is at Cenchrea:

church which was 44\_ACT\_08\_01 # And Saul was consenting unto his death. And at that time there was a great persecution against the church which was at Jerusalem; and they were all scattered abroad throughout the regions of Judaea and Samaria, except the apostles.

church which was 44\_ACT\_11\_22 # Then tidings of these things came unto the ears of the church which was in Jerusalem: and they sent forth Barnabas, that he should go as far as Antioch.

church who is <u>51\_COL\_01\_18</u># And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all [things] he might have the preeminence.

church whom if 64\_3JO\_01\_06 # Which have borne witness of thy charity before the church: whom if thou

bring forward on their journey after a godly sort, thou shalt do well:

church will I <u>58\_HEB\_02\_12</u># Saying, I will declare thy name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto thee.

church <u>46\_1CO\_04\_17</u> # For this cause have I sent unto you Timotheus, who is my beloved son, and faithful in the Lord, who shall bring you into remembrance of my ways which be in Christ, as I teach every where in every church.

church <u>46\_1CO\_06\_04</u> # If then ye have judgments of things pertaining to this life, set them to judge who are least esteemed in the church.

church 46\_1CO\_14\_04 # He that speaketh in an [unknown] tongue edifieth himself; but he that prophesieth edifieth the church.

church 46\_1CO\_14\_12 # Even so ye, for a smuch as ye are zealous of spiritual [gifts], seek that ye may excel to the edifying of the church.

church <u>46\_1CO\_14\_35</u># And if they will learn any thing, let them ask their husbands at home: for it is a shame for women to speak in the church.

church <u>64\_3JO\_01\_10</u> # Wherefore, if I come, I will remember his deeds which he doeth, prating against us with malicious words: and not content therewith, neither doth he himself receive the brethren, and forbiddeth them that would, and casteth [them] out of the church.

church <u>44\_ACT\_12\_01</u># Now about that time Herod the king stretched forth [his] hands to vex certain of the church.

church 44\_ACT\_20\_17 # And from Miletus he sent to Ephesus, and called the elders of the church.

church <u>51\_COL\_01\_24</u># Who now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Christ in my flesh for his body's sake, which is the church:

church 49\_EPH\_01\_22 # And hath put all [things] under his feet, and gave him [to be] the head over all [things] to the church,

churches established in <u>44\_ACT\_16\_05</u># And so were the churches established in the faith, and increased in number daily.

churches except it <u>47\_2CO\_12\_13</u> # For what is it wherein ye were inferior to other churches, except [it be] that I myself was not burdensome to you? forgive me this wrong.

churches for it <u>46\_1CO\_14\_34</u> # Let your women keep silence in the churches: for it is not permitted unto them to speak; but [they are commanded] to be under obedience, as also saith the law.

churches He that <u>66\_REV\_02\_11</u># He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death.

churches I am <u>66\_REV\_22\_16</u># I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, [and] the bright and morning star.

churches nor yet <u>44\_ACT\_19\_37</u> # For ye have brought hither these men, which are neither robbers of churches, nor yet blasphemers of your goddess.

churches of Asia 46\_1CO\_16\_19 # The churches of Asia salute you. Aquila and Priscilla salute you much in the Lord, with the church that is in their house.

churches of Christ <u>45\_ROM\_16\_16</u> # Salute one another with an holy kiss. The churches of Christ salute you.

churches of Galatia 46\_1CO\_16\_01 # Now concerning the collection for the saints, as I have given order to the churches of Galatia, even so do ye.

churches of Galatia <u>48\_GAL\_01\_02</u># And all the brethren which are with me, unto the churches of Galatia:

churches of God <u>46\_1CO\_11\_16</u># But if any man seem to be contentious, we have no such custom, neither the churches of God.

churches of God <u>52\_1TH\_02\_14</u># For ye, brethren, became followers of the churches of God which in Judaea are in Christ Jesus: for ye also have suffered like things of your own countrymen, even as they [have] of the Jews:

churches of God <u>53\_2TH\_01\_04</u> # So that we ourselves glory in you in the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that ye endure:

churches of Judaea <u>48\_GAL\_01\_22</u> # And was unknown by face unto the churches of Judaea which were in Christ:

churches of Macedonia <u>47\_2CO\_08\_01</u> # Moreover, brethren, we do you to wit of the grace of God bestowed on the churches of Macedonia;

churches of the <u>46\_1CO\_14\_33</u># For God is not [the author] of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.

churches of the <u>45\_ROM\_16\_04</u> # Who have for my life laid down their own necks: unto whom not only I give thanks, but also all the churches of the Gentiles.

churches rest throughout <u>44\_ACT\_09\_31</u># Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.

churches shall know <u>66\_REV\_02\_23</u># And I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.

churches taking wages 47\_2CO\_11\_08# I robbed other churches, taking wages [of them], to do you service.

churches the proof <u>47\_2CO\_08\_24</u> # Wherefore show ye to them, and before the churches, the proof of your love, and of our boasting on your behalf.

churches To him <u>66\_REV\_02\_07</u># He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.

churches To him <u>66\_REV\_02\_17</u># He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth [it].

churches to travel <u>47\_2CO\_08\_19</u> # And not [that] only, but who was also chosen of the churches to travel with us with this grace, which is administered by us to the glory of the same Lord, and [declaration of] your ready mind:

churches which are <u>66\_REV\_01\_04</u># John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace [be] unto you, and peace, from him which is, and which was, and which is to come; and from the seven Spirits which are before his throne;

churches which are <u>66\_REV\_01\_11</u># Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send [it] unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.

churches <u>46\_1CO\_07\_17</u> # But as God hath distributed to every man, as the Lord hath called every one, so let him walk. And so ordain I in all churches.

churches <u>47\_2CO\_08\_18</u> # And we have sent with him the brother, whose praise [is] in the gospel throughout all the churches;

churches <u>47\_2CO\_11\_28</u># Beside those things that are without, that which cometh upon me daily, the care of all the churches.

churches 44\_ACT\_15\_41 # And he went through Syria and Cilicia, confirming the churches.

churches <u>66\_REV\_01\_20</u># The mystery of the seven stars which thou sawest in my right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the seven candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches.

churl are evil <u>23\_ISA\_32\_07</u> # The instruments also of the churl [are] evil: he deviseth wicked devices to destroy the poor with lying words, even when the needy speaketh right.

churl said to <u>23\_ISA\_32\_05</u># The vile person shall be no more called liberal, nor the churl said [to be] bountiful.

churlish and evil <u>09\_1SA\_25\_03</u> # Now the name of the man [was] Nabal; and the name of his wife Abigail:

and [she was] a woman of good understanding, and of a beautiful countenance: but the man [was] churlish and evil in his doings; and he [was] of the house of Caleb.

churning of milk <u>20\_PRO\_30\_33</u> # Surely the churning of milk bringeth forth butter, and the wringing of the nose bringeth forth blood: so the forcing of wrath bringeth forth strife.

Geshur and Aram 13\_1CH\_02\_23 # And he took Geshur, and Aram, with the towns of Jair, from them, with Kenath, and the towns thereof, [even] threescore cities. All these [belonged to] the sons of Machir, the father of Gilead.

Geshur and brought <u>10\_2SA\_14\_23</u># So Joab arose and went to Geshur, and brought Absalom to Jerusalem.

Geshur And David 10\_2SA\_13\_37 # But Absalom fled, and went to Talmai, the son of Ammihud, king of Geshur. And [David] mourned for his son every day.

Geshur and was 10\_2SA\_13\_38 # So Absalom fled, and went to Geshur, and was there three years.

Geshur in Syria 10\_2SA\_15\_08 # For thy servant vowed a vow while I abode at Geshur in Syria, saying, If the LORD shall bring me again indeed to Jerusalem, then I will serve the LORD.

Geshur it had 10\_2SA\_14\_32 # And Absalom answered Joab, Behold, I sent unto thee, saying, Come hither, that I may send thee to the king, to say, Wherefore am I come from Geshur? [it had been] good for me [to have been] there still: now therefore let me see the king's face; and if there be [any] iniquity in me, let him kill me.

Geshur the fourth <u>13\_1CH\_03\_02</u> # The third, Absalom the son of Maachah the daughter of Talmai king of Geshur: the fourth, Adonijah the son of Haggith:

Geshur <u>10\_2SA\_03\_03</u># And his second, Chileab, of Abigail the wife of Nabal the Carmelite; and the third, Absalom the son of Maacah the daughter of Talmai king of Geshur;

Shur that is <u>09\_1SA\_15\_07</u> # And Saul smote the Amalekites from Havilah [until] thou comest to Shur, that [is] over against Egypt.

Shur that is <u>01\_GEN\_25\_18</u># And they dwelt from Havilah unto Shur, that [is] before Egypt, as thou goest toward Assyria: [and] he died in the presence of all his brethren.

Shur <u>01\_GEN\_16\_07</u> # And the angel of the LORD found her by a fountain of water in the wilderness, by the fountain in the way to Shur.

Zacchur his son <u>13\_1CH\_04\_26</u># And the sons of Mishma; Hamuel his son, Zacchur his son, Shimei his son.
