Beerlahairoi behold it <u>01_GEN_16_14</u># Wherefore the well was called Beerlahairoi; behold, [it is] between Kadesh and Bered.

hair and a <u>40_MAT_03_04</u># And the same John had his raiment of camel's hair, and a leathern girdle about his loins; and his meat was locusts and wild honey.

hair and all <u>04_NUM_31_20</u> # And purify all [your] raiment, and all that is made of skins, and all work of goats' [hair], and all things made of wood.

hair and made <u>16_NEH_13_25</u># And I contended with them, and cursed them, and smote certain of them, and plucked off their hair, and made them swear by God, [saying], Ye shall not give your daughters unto their sons, nor take their daughters unto your sons, or for yourselves.

hair and of 60_1PE_03_03 # Whose adorning let it not be that outward [adorning] of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel;

hair and red <u>02_EXO_35_23</u> # And every man, with whom was found blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine linen, and goats' [hair], and red skins of rams, and badgers' skins, brought [them].

hair and the <u>43_JOH_12_03</u># Then took Mary a pound of ointment of spikenard, very costly, and anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped his feet with her hair: and the house was filled with the odour of the ointment.

hair breadth and <u>07_JUD_20_16</u> # Among all this people [there were] seven hundred chosen men lefthanded; every one could sling stones at an hair [breadth], and not miss.

hair fall from 44_ACT_27_34 # Wherefore I pray you to take [some] meat: for this is for your health: for there shall not an hair fall from the head of any of you.

hair fallen off <u>03_LEV_13_41</u> # And he that hath his hair fallen off from the part of his head toward his face, he [is] forehead bald: [yet is] he clean.

hair is fallen 03_LEV_13_40 # And the man whose hair is fallen off his head, he [is] bald; [yet is] he clean.

hair is given 46_1CO_11_15# But if a woman have long hair, it is a glory to her: for [her] hair is given her for a covering.

hair is grown <u>26_EZE_16_07</u> # I have caused thee to multiply as the bud of the field, and thou hast increased and waxen great, and thou art come to excellent ornaments: [thy] breasts are fashioned, and thine hair is grown, whereas thou [wast] naked and bare.

hair it is <u>46_1CO_11_14</u># Doth not even nature itself teach you, that, if a man have long hair, it is a shame unto him?

hair it is <u>46_1CO_11_15</u># But if a woman have long hair, it is a glory to her: for [her] hair is given her for a covering.

hair O Jerusalem 24_JER_07_29 # Cut off thine hair, [O Jerusalem], and cast [it] away, and take up a lamentation on high places; for the LORD hath rejected and forsaken the generation of his wrath.

hair of him 11_1KI_01_52# And Solomon said, If he will show himself a worthy man, there shall not an hair of him fall to the earth: but if wickedness shall be found in him, he shall die.

hair of his <u>09_1SA_14_45</u># And the people said unto Saul, Shall Jonathan die, who hath wrought this great salvation in Israel? God forbid: [as] the LORD liveth, there shall not one hair of his head fall to the ground; for he hath wrought with God this day. So the people rescued Jonathan, that he died not.

hair of his <u>10_2SA_14_26</u># And when he polled his head, [for it was at every year's end that he polled [it]: because [the hair] was heavy on him, therefore he polled it:] he weighed the hair of his head at two hundred shekels after the king's weight.

hair of his <u>27_DAN_07_09</u> # I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment [was] white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne [was like] the fiery flame, [and] his wheels [as] burning fire.

hair of his <u>04_NUM_06_19</u># And the priest shall take the sodden shoulder of the ram, and one unleavened cake out of the basket, and one unleavened wafer, and shall put [them] upon the hands of the Nazarite, after [the hair of] his separation is shaven:

hair of thine 22_SON_07_05 # Thine head upon thee [is] like Carmel, and the hair of thine head like purple; the king [is] held in the galleries.

hair of women 66_REV_09_08 # And they had hair as the hair of women, and their teeth were as [the teeth] of lions.

hair of your 42_LUK_21_18# But there shall not an hair of your head perish.

hair off his <u>03 LEV 14_09</u># But it shall be on the seventh day, that he shall shave all his hair off his head and his beard and his eyebrows, even all his hair he shall shave off: and he shall wash his clothes, also he shall wash his flesh in water, and he shall be clean.

hair or gold <u>54_1TI_02_09</u># In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array;

hair then the <u>03_LEV_13_30</u># Then the priest shall see the plague: and, behold, if it [be] in sight deeper than the skin; [and there be] in it a yellow thin hair; then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a dry scall, [even] a leprosy upon the head or beard.

hair to be <u>02_EXO_26_07</u> # And thou shalt make curtains [of] goats' [hair] to be a covering upon the tabernacle: eleven curtains shalt thou make.

hair was heavy 10_2SA_14_26# And when he polled his head, [for it was at every year's end that he polled [it]: because [the hair] was heavy on him, therefore he polled it:] he weighed the hair of his head at two hundred shekels after the king's weight.

hair white and <u>03_LEV_13_10</u># And the priest shall see [him]: and, behold, [if] the rising [be] white in the skin, and it have turned the hair white, and [there be] quick raw flesh in the rising;

hair white or 40_MAT_05_36# Neither shalt thou swear by thy head, because thou canst not make one hair white or black.

hair whose brother 43_JOH_11_02# [It was [that] Mary which anointed the Lord with ointment, and wiped his feet with her hair, whose brother Lazarus was sick.]

hair 02_EXO_25_04 # And blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine linen, and goats' [hair],

hair 02_EXO_35_06 # And blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine linen, and goats' [hair],

hair <u>02_EXO_35_26</u> # And all the women whose heart stirred them up in wisdom spun goats' [hair].

hair <u>26_EZE_05_01</u># And thou, son of man, take thee a sharp knife, take thee a barber's razor, and cause [it] to pass upon thine head and upon thy beard: then take thee balances to weigh, and divide the [hair].

hairs are here <u>28_HOS_07_09</u> # Strangers have devoured his strength, and he knoweth [it] not: yea, gray hairs are here and there upon him, yet he knoweth not.

hairs of her <u>42_LUK_07_38</u># And stood at his feet behind [him] weeping, and began to wash his feet with tears, and did wipe [them] with the hairs of her head, and kissed his feet, and anointed [them] with the ointment.

hairs of her <u>42_LUK_07_44</u># And he turned to the woman, and said unto Simon, Seest thou this woman? I entered into thine house, thou gavest me no water for my feet: but she hath washed my feet with tears, and wiped [them] with the hairs of her head.

hairs of mine 19 PSA 40 12 # For innumerable evils have compassed me about: mine iniquities have taken hold upon me, so that I am not able to look up; they are more than the hairs of mine head: therefore my heart faileth me.

hairs of mine 19 PSA 69 04 # They that hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of mine head: they that would destroy me, [being] mine enemies wrongfully, are mighty: then I restored [that] which I took not away.

hairs of thy <u>01_GEN_44_31</u># It shall come to pass, when he seeth that the lad [is] not [with us], that he will die: and thy servants shall bring down the gray hairs of thy servant our father with sorrow to the grave.

hairs of your <u>42_LUK_12_07</u># But even the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear not therefore: ye are of more value than many sparrows.

hairs of your 40_MAT_10_30# But the very hairs of your head are all numbered.

hairs therein and <u>03_LEV_13_21</u># But if the priest look on it, and, behold, [there be] no white hairs therein, and [if] it [be] not lower than the skin, but [be] somewhat dark; then the priest shall shut him up seven days:

hairs were grown 27_DAN_04_33 # The same hour was the thing fulfilled upon Nebuchadnezzar: and he was driven from men, and did eat grass as oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven, till his hairs were grown like eagles' [feathers], and his nails like birds' [claws].

hairs were white <u>66_REV_01_14</u> # His head and [his] hairs [were] white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes [were] as a flame of fire;

hairs will I <u>23_ISA_46_04</u> # And [even] to [your] old age I [am] he; and [even] to hoar hairs will I carry [you]: I have made, and I will bear; even I will carry, and will deliver [you].

hairs with sorrow <u>01_GEN_42_38</u> # And he said, My son shall not go down with you; for his brother is dead, and he is left alone: if mischief befall him by the way in the which ye go, then shall ye bring down my gray hairs with sorrow to the grave.

hairs with sorrow <u>01_GEN_44_29</u> # And if ye take this also from me, and mischief befall him, ye shall bring down my gray hairs with sorrow to the grave.

hairs <u>05_DEU_32_25</u> # The sword without, and terror within, shall destroy both the young man and the virgin, the suckling [also] with the man of gray hairs.

hairy as his <u>01_GEN_27_23</u># And he discerned him not, because his hands were hairy, as his brother Esau's hands: so he blessed him.

hairy garment and <u>01_GEN_25_25</u># And the first came out red, all over like an hairy garment; and they called his name Esau.

hairy man and 12 2KI 01 08 # And they answered him, [He was] an hairy man, and girt with a girdle of leather about his loins. And he said, It [is] Elijah the Tishbite.

hairy man and <u>01_GEN_27_11</u># And Jacob said to Rebekah his mother, Behold, Esau my brother [is] a hairy man, and I [am] a smooth man:

hairy scalp of 19_PSA_68_21 # But God shall wound the head of his enemies, [and] the hairy scalp of such an one as goeth on still in his trespasses.

Lahairoi for he <u>01_GEN_24_62</u> # And Isaac came from the way of the well Lahairoi; for he dwelt in the south country.

Lahairoi <u>01_GEN_25_11</u># And it came to pass after the death of Abraham, that God blessed his son Isaac; and Isaac dwelt by the well Lahairoi.
