changed according to <u>27_DAN_06_08</u># Now, O king, establish the decree, and sign the writing, that it be not changed, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not.

changed against Shadrach <u>27_DAN_03_19</u> # Then was Nebuchadnezzar full of fury, and the form of his visage was changed against Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego: [therefore] he spake, and commanded that they should heat the furnace one seven times more than it was wont to be heated.

changed and his <u>27_DAN_05_06</u># Then the king's countenance was changed, and his thoughts troubled him, so that the joints of his loins were loosed, and his knees smote one against another.

changed and Shibmah <u>04_NUM_32_38</u> # And Nebo, and Baalmeon, [their names being changed,] and Shibmah: and gave other names unto the cities which they builded.

changed but thou <u>58_HEB_01_12</u># And as a vesture shalt thou fold them up, and they shall be changed: but thou art the same, and thy years shall not fail.

changed concerning Daniel <u>27_DAN_06_17</u># And a stone was brought, and laid upon the mouth of the den; and the king sealed it with his own signet, and with the signet of his lords; that the purpose might not be changed concerning Daniel.

changed from man's <u>27_DAN_04_16</u> # Let his heart be changed from man's, and let a beast's heart be given unto him: and let seven times pass over him.

changed his apparel 10_2SA_12_20# Then David arose from the earth, and washed, and anointed [himself], and changed his apparel, and came into the house of the LORD, and worshipped: then he came to his own house; and when he required, they set bread before him, and he did eat.

changed his behaviour <u>09_1SA_21_13</u> # And he changed his behaviour before them, and feigned himself mad in their hands, and scrabbled on the doors of the gate, and let his spittle fall down upon his beard.

changed his behaviour <u>19_PSA_34_01</u> # [A Psalm] of David, when he changed his behaviour before Abimelech; who drove him away, and he departed. I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise [shall] continually [be] in my mouth.

changed his colour <u>03_LEV_13_55</u># And the priest shall look on the plague, after that it is washed: and, behold, [if] the plague have not changed his colour, and the plague be not spread; it [is] unclean; thou shalt burn it in the fire; it [is] fret inward, [whether] it [be] bare within or without.

changed his name 12_2KI_24_17 # And the king of Babylon made Mattaniah his father's brother king in his stead, and changed his name to Zedekiah.

changed his prison 12_2KI_25_29 # And changed his prison garments: and he did eat bread continually before him all the days of his life.

changed his prison 24_JER_52_33 # And changed his prison garments: and he did continually eat bread before him all the days of his life.

changed his raiment 01_GEN_41_14 # Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him hastily

out of the dungeon: and he shaved [himself], and changed his raiment, and came in unto Pharaoh.

changed in him <u>27_DAN_05_09</u> # Then was king Belshazzar greatly troubled, and his countenance was changed in him, and his lords were astonied.

changed in me <u>27_DAN_07_28</u> # Hitherto [is] the end of the matter. As for me Daniel, my cogitations much troubled me, and my countenance changed in me: but I kept the matter in my heart.

changed into the <u>47_2CO_03_18</u> # But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, [even] as by the Spirit of the Lord.

changed it bindeth <u>18_JOB_30_18</u> # By the great force [of my disease] is my garment changed: it bindeth me about as the collar of my coat.

changed my judgments <u>26_EZE_05_06</u># And she hath changed my judgments into wickedness more than the nations, and my statutes more than the countries that [are] round about her: for they have refused my judgments and my statutes, they have not walked in them.

changed my wages <u>01_GEN_31_07</u># And your father hath deceived me, and changed my wages ten times; but God suffered him not to hurt me.

changed my wages <u>01_GEN_31_41</u> # Thus have I been twenty years in thy house; I served thee fourteen years for thy two daughters, and six years for thy cattle: and thou hast changed my wages ten times.

changed nor the <u>27_DAN_03_27</u># And the princes, governors, and captains, and the king's counsellors, being gathered together, saw these men, upon whose bodies the fire had no power, nor was an hair of their head singed, neither were their coats changed, nor the smell of fire had passed on them.

changed the glory <u>45_ROM_01_23</u> # And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things.

changed the king's <u>27_DAN_03_28</u> # [Then] Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, Blessed [be] the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, who hath sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and have changed the king's word, and yielded their bodies, that they might not serve nor worship any god, except their own God.

changed the ordinance <u>23_ISA_24_05</u> # The earth also is defiled under the inhabitants thereof; because they have transgressed the laws, changed the ordinance, broken the everlasting covenant.

changed the portion 33 MIC_02_04 # In that day shall [one] take up a parable against you, and lament with a doleful lamentation, [and] say, We be utterly spoiled: he hath changed the portion of my people: how hath he removed [it] from me! turning away he hath divided our fields.

changed the stones <u>25_LAM_04_01</u># How is the gold become dim! [how] is the most fine gold changed! the stones of the sanctuary are poured out in the top of every street.

changed the truth <u>45_ROM_01_25</u> # Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.

changed their glory 24_JER_02_11 # Hath a nation changed [their] gods, which [are] yet no gods? but my people have changed their glory for [that which] doth not profit.

changed their glory <u>19_PSA_106_20</u> # Thus they changed their glory into the similitude of an ox that eateth grass.

changed their gods 24_JER_02_11# Hath a nation changed [their] gods, which [are] yet no gods? but my people have changed their glory for [that which] doth not profit.

changed their minds <u>44_ACT_28_06</u># Howbeit they looked when he should have swollen, or fallen down dead suddenly: but after they had looked a great while, and saw no harm come to him, they changed their minds, and said that he was a god.

changed there is <u>58_HEB_07_12</u># For the priesthood being changed, there is made of necessity a change also of the law.

changed therefore tell <u>27_DAN_02_09</u> # But if ye will not make known unto me the dream, [there is but] one decree for you: for ye have prepared lying and corrupt words to speak before me, till the time be changed: therefore tell me the dream, and I shall know that ye can show me the interpretation thereof.

changed unto white <u>03_LEV_13_16</u># Or if the raw flesh turn again, and be changed unto white, he shall come unto the priest;

changed 46_1CO_15_51 # Behold, I show you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,

changed <u>46_1CO_15_52</u># In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

changed <u>27_DAN_05_10</u> # [Now] the queen by reason of the words of the king and his lords came into the banquet house: [and] the queen spake and said, O king, live for ever: let not thy thoughts trouble thee, nor let thy countenance be changed:

changed <u>27_DAN_06_15</u># Then these men assembled unto the king, and said unto the king, Know, O king, that the law of the Medes and Persians [is], That no decree nor statute which the king establisheth may be changed.

changed **21_ECC_08_01** # Who [is] as the wise [man]? and who knoweth the interpretation of a thing? a man's wisdom maketh his face to shine, and the boldness of his face shall be changed.

changed <u>24_JER_48_11</u># Moab hath been at ease from his youth, and he hath settled on his lees, and hath not been emptied from vessel to vessel, neither hath he gone into captivity: therefore his taste remained in him, and his scent is not changed.

changed 19_PSA_102_26 # They shall perish, but thou shalt endure: yea, all of them shall wax old like a garment; as a vesture shalt thou change them, and they shall be changed:

hanged about his <u>42_LUK_17_02</u> # It were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he cast into the sea, than that he should offend one of these little ones.

hanged about his <u>41_MAR_09_42</u> # And whosoever shall offend one of [these] little ones that believe in me, it is better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he were cast into the sea.

hanged about his <u>40_MAT_18_06</u># But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and [that] he were drowned in the depth of the sea.

hanged Haman on <u>17_EST_07_10</u># So they hanged Haman on the gallows that he had prepared for Mordecai. Then was the king's wrath pacified.

hanged Haman's ten <u>17_EST_09_14</u># And the king commanded it so to be done: and the decree was given at Shushan; and they hanged Haman's ten sons.

hanged himself and <u>10_2SA_17_23</u># And when Ahithophel saw that his counsel was not followed, he saddled [his] ass, and arose, and gat him home to his house, to his city, and put his household in order, and hanged himself, and died, and was buried in the sepulchre of his father.

hanged himself <u>40_MAT_27_05</u># And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself.

hanged in an <u>10_2SA_18_10</u># And a certain man saw [it], and told Joab, and said, Behold, I saw Absalom hanged in an oak.

hanged is accursed <u>05_DEU_21_23</u># His body shall not remain all night upon the tree, but thou shalt in any wise bury him that day; [for he that is hanged [is] accursed of God;] that thy land be not defiled, which the LORD thy God giveth thee [for] an inheritance.

hanged on a 44_ACT_05_30 # The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree.

hanged on a <u>44_ACT_10_39</u> # And we are witnesses of all things which he did both in the land of the Jews, and in Jerusalem; whom they slew and hanged on a tree:

hanged on a <u>17_EST_02_23</u> # And when inquisition was made of the matter, it was found out; therefore they were both hanged on a tree: and it was written in the book of the chronicles before the king.

hanged on a <u>06_JOS_08_29</u># And the king of Ai he hanged on a tree until eventide: and as soon as the sun was down, Joshua commanded that they should take his carcase down from the tree, and cast it at the entering of the gate of the city, and raise thereon a great heap of stones, [that remaineth] unto this day.

hanged on the <u>17_EST_09_25</u> # But when [Esther] came before the king, he commanded by letters that his wicked device, which he devised against the Jews, should return upon his own head, and that he and his sons should be hanged on the gallows.

hanged our harps 19_PSA_137_02 # We hanged our harps upon the willows in the midst thereof.

hanged railed on <u>42_LUK_23_39</u> # And one of the malefactors which were hanged railed on him, saying, If thou be Christ, save thyself and us.

hanged the chief 01_GEN_40_22 # But he hanged the chief baker: as Joseph had interpreted to them.

hanged the shield <u>26_EZE_27_10</u> # They of Persia and of Lud and of Phut were in thine army, thy men of war: they hanged the shield and helmet in thee; they set forth thy comeliness.

hanged their shields <u>26_EZE_27_11</u># The men of Arvad with thine army [were] upon thy walls round about, and the Gammadims were in thy towers: they hanged their shields upon thy walls round about; they have made thy beauty perfect.

hanged them in 10_2SA_21_09 # And he delivered them into the hands of the Gibeonites, and they hanged them in the hill before the LORD: and they fell [all] seven together, and were put to death in the days of harvest, in the first [days], in the beginning of barley harvest.

hanged them on <u>06_JOS_10_26</u> # And afterward Joshua smote them, and slew them, and hanged them on five trees: and they were hanging upon the trees until the evening.

hanged them up <u>10_2SA_04_12</u># And David commanded his young men, and they slew them, and cut off their hands and their feet, and hanged [them] up over the pool in Hebron. But they took the head of Ishbosheth, and buried [it] in the sepulchre of Abner in Hebron.

hanged them when 10 2SA 21 12 # And David went and took the bones of Saul and the bones of Jonathan his son from the men of Jabeshgilead, which had stolen them from the street of Bethshan, where the Philistines had hanged them, when the Philistines had slain Saul in Gilboa:

hanged thereon and <u>15 EZR_06_11</u># Also I have made a decree, that whosoever shall alter this word, let timber be pulled down from his house, and being set up, let him be hanged thereon; and let his house be made a dunghill for this.

hanged thereon then <u>17_EST_05_14</u># Then said Zeresh his wife and all his friends unto him, Let a gallows be made of fifty cubits high, and to morrow speak thou unto the king that Mordecai may be hanged thereon: then go thou in merrily with the king unto the banquet. And the thing pleased Haman; and he caused the gallows to be made.

hanged up by <u>25_LAM_05_12</u># Princes are hanged up by their hand: the faces of elders were not honoured.

hanged upon the <u>17_EST_08_07</u># Then the king Ahasuerus said unto Esther the queen and to Mordecai the Jew, Behold, I have given Esther the house of Haman, and him they have hanged upon the gallows, because he laid his hand upon the Jews.

hanged upon the <u>17_EST_09_13</u> # Then said Esther, If it please the king, let it be granted to the Jews which [are] in Shushan to do to morrow also according unto this day's decree, and let Haman's ten sons be hanged upon the gallows.

hanged <u>10_2SA_21_13</u> # And he brought up from thence the bones of Saul and the bones of Jonathan his son; and they gathered the bones of them that were hanged.

hanged <u>01_GEN_41_13</u> # And it came to pass, as he interpreted to us, so it was; me he restored unto mine office, and him he hanged.
