

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

harp also is <u>18\_JOB\_30\_31</u> # My harp also is [turned] to mourning, and my organ into the voice of them that weep.

harp and it <u>09\_1SA\_16\_16</u> # Let our lord now command thy servants, [which are] before thee, to seek out a man, [who is] a cunning player on an harp: and it shall come to pass, when the evil spirit from God is upon thee, that he shall play with his hand, and thou shalt be well.

harp and organ <u>01\_GEN\_04\_21</u># And his brother's name [was] Jubal: he was the father of all such as handle the harp and organ.

harp and played <u>09\_1SA\_16\_23</u> # And it came to pass, when the [evil] spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.

harp and rejoice 18\_JOB\_21\_12 # They take the timbrel and harp, and rejoice at the sound of the organ.

harp and the <u>23\_ISA\_05\_12</u># And the harp, and the viol, the tabret, and pipe, and wine, are in their feasts: but they regard not the work of the LORD, neither consider the operation of his hands.

harp and the 19\_PSA\_98\_05 # Sing unto the LORD with the harp; with the harp, and the voice of a psalm.

harp before them <u>09\_1SA\_10\_05</u> # After that thou shalt come to the hill of God, where [is] the garrison of the Philistines: and it shall come to pass, when thou art come thither to the city, that thou shalt meet a company of prophets coming down from the high place with a psaltery, and a tabret, and a pipe, and a harp, before them; and they shall prophesy:

harp O thou 19\_PSA\_71\_22 # I will also praise thee with the psaltery, [even] thy truth, O my God: unto thee will I sing with the harp, O thou Holy One of Israel.

harp sackbut psaltery <u>27\_DAN\_03\_05</u> # [That] at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, dulcimer, and all kinds of music, ye fall down and worship the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king hath set up:

harp sing unto 19\_PSA\_33\_02 # Praise the LORD with harp: sing unto him with the psaltery [and] an instrument of ten strings.

harp to give 13 1CH 25 03 # Of Jeduthun: the sons of Jeduthun; Gedaliah, and Zeri, and Jeshaiah, Hashabiah, and Mattithiah, six, under the hands of their father Jeduthun, who prophesied with a harp, to give thanks and to praise the LORD.

harp unto our 19\_PSA\_147\_07 # Sing unto the LORD with thanksgiving; sing praise upon the harp unto our God:

sharply that they <u>56\_TIT\_01\_13</u># This witness is true. Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith;

sharply <u>07\_JUD\_08\_01</u># And the men of Ephraim said unto him, Why hast thou served us thus, that thou calledst us not, when thou wentest to fight with the Midianites? And they did chide with him sharply.
