hart and the <u>05_DEU_14_05</u># The hart, and the roebuck, and the fallow deer, and the wild goat, and the pygarg, and the wild ox, and the chamois.

hart and the <u>23_ISA_35_06</u># Then shall the lame [man] leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert.

hart behold he <u>22_SON_02_09</u> # My beloved is like a roe or a young hart: behold, he standeth behind our wall, he looketh forth at the windows, showing himself through the lattice.

hart is eaten <u>05_DEU_12_22</u># Even as the roebuck and the hart is eaten, so thou shalt eat them: the unclean and the clean shall eat [of] them alike.

hart panteth after 19_PSA_42_01# To the chief Musician, Maschil, for the sons of Korah. As the hart panteth after the water brooks, so panteth my soul after thee, O God.

hart upon the <u>22_SON_02_17</u> # Until the day break, and the shadows flee away, turn, my beloved, and be thou like a roe or a young hart upon the mountains of Bether.

hart upon the <u>22_SON_08_14</u> # Make haste, my beloved, and be thou like to a roe or to a young hart upon the mountains of spices.

hart <u>05_DEU_12_15</u> # Notwithstanding thou mayest kill and eat flesh in all thy gates, whatsoever thy soul lusteth after, according to the blessing of the LORD thy God which he hath given thee: the unclean and the clean may eat thereof, as of the roebuck, and as of the hart.

hart <u>05_DEU_15_22</u> # Thou shalt eat it within thy gates: the unclean and the clean [person shall eat it] alike, as the roebuck, and as the hart.

harts and roebucks <u>11_1KI_04_23</u># Ten fat oxen, and twenty oxen out of the pastures, and an hundred sheep, beside harts, and roebucks, and fallowdeer, and fatted fowl.

harts that find <u>25_LAM_01_06</u> # And from the daughter of Zion all her beauty is departed: her princes are become like harts [that] find no pasture, and they are gone without strength before the pursuer.
