harvest and as <u>23\_ISA\_09\_03</u># Thou hast multiplied the nation, [and] not increased the joy: they joy before thee according to the joy in harvest, [and] as [men] rejoice when they divide the spoil.

harvest and cold <u>01\_GEN\_08\_22</u> # While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease.

harvest and dwelt <u>08\_RUT\_02\_23</u># So she kept fast by the maidens of Boaz to glean unto the end of barley harvest and of wheat harvest; and dwelt with her mother in law.
