heavy and displeased <u>11_1KI_20_43</u># And the king of Israel went to his house heavy and displeased, and came to Samaria.

heavy and displeased <u>11_1KI_21_04</u># And Ahab came into his house heavy and displeased because of the word which Naboth the Jezreelite had spoken to him: for he had said, I will not give thee the inheritance of my fathers. And he laid him down upon his bed, and turned away his face, and would eat no bread.

heavy And he <u>09_1SA_04_18</u> # And it came to pass, when he made mention of the ark of God, that he fell from off the seat backward by the side of the gate, and his neck brake, and he died: for he was an old man, and heavy. And he had judged Israel forty years.

heavy and I <u>11_1KI_12_14</u># And spake to them after the counsel of the young men, saying, My father made your yoke heavy, and I will add to your yoke: my father [also] chastised you with whips, but I will chastise you with scorpions.

heavy and shut <u>23_ISA_06_10</u> # Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.

heavy and the <u>20_PRO_27_03</u># A stone [is] heavy, and the sand weighty; but a fool's wrath [is] heavier than them both.

heavy and they <u>02_EXO_17_12</u> # But Moses' hands [were] heavy; and they took a stone, and put [it] under him, and he sat thereon; and Aaron and Hur stayed up his hands, the one on the one side, and the other on the other side; and his hands were steady until the going down of the sun.

heavy burden they <u>19_PSA_38_04</u> # For mine iniquities are gone over mine head: as an heavy burden they are too heavy for me.

heavy burdens and <u>23_ISA_58_06</u># [Is] not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke?

heavy burdens and <u>40 MAT_23_04</u> # For they bind heavy burdens and grievous to be borne, and lay [them] on men's shoulders; but they [themselves] will not move them with one of their fingers.

heavy but I <u>14_2CH_10_14</u> # And answered them after the advice of the young men, saying, My father made your yoke heavy, but I will add thereto: my father chastised you with whips, but I [will chastise you] with scorpions.

heavy but make <u>11_1KI_12_10</u># And the young men that were grown up with him spake unto him, saying, Thus shalt thou speak unto this people that spake unto thee, saying, Thy father made our yoke heavy, but make thou [it] lighter unto us; thus shalt thou say unto them, My little [finger] shall be thicker than my father's loins.

heavy but make <u>14_2CH_10_10</u># And the young men that were brought up with him spake unto him, saying, Thus shalt thou answer the people that spake unto thee, saying, Thy father made our yoke heavy, but make thou [it] somewhat lighter for us; thus shalt thou say unto them, My little [finger] shall be thicker than my father's loins.

heavy for me 04_NUM_11_14 # I am not able to bear all this people alone, because [it is] too heavy for me.

heavy for me <u>19_PSA_38_04</u> # For mine iniquities are gone over mine head: as an heavy burden they are too heavy for me.

heavy for thee <u>02_EXO_18_18</u># Thou wilt surely wear away, both thou, and this people that [is] with thee: for this thing [is] too heavy for thee; thou art not able to perform it thyself alone.

heavy heart <u>20_PRO_25_20</u># [As] he that taketh away a garment in cold weather, [and as] vinegar upon nitre, so [is] he that singeth songs to an heavy heart.

heavy hearts <u>20_PRO_31_06</u># Give strong drink unto him that is ready to perish, and wine unto those that be of heavy hearts.

heavy his lips <u>23_ISA_30_27</u> # Behold, the name of the LORD cometh from far, burning [with] his anger, and the burden [thereof is] heavy: his lips are full of indignation, and his tongue as a devouring fire:

heavy laden and <u>40_MAT_11_28</u># Come unto me, all [ye] that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

heavy loaden they <u>23_ISA_46_01</u> # Bel boweth down, Nebo stoopeth, their idols were upon the beasts, and upon the cattle: your carriages [were] heavy loaden; [they are] a burden to the weary [beast].

heavy neither wist <u>41_MAR_14_40</u> # And when he returned, he found them asleep again, [for their eyes were heavy,] neither wist they what to answer him.

heavy on him <u>10_2SA_14_26</u> # And when he polled his head, [for it was at every year's end that he polled [it]: because [the hair] was heavy on him, therefore he polled it:] he weighed the hair of his head at two hundred shekels after the king's weight.

heavy that it <u>23_ISA_59_01</u> # Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear:

heavy there <u>09_1SA_05_11</u># So they sent and gathered together all the lords of the Philistines, and said, Send away the ark of the God of Israel, and let it go again to his own place, that it slay us not, and our people: for there was a deadly destruction throughout all the city; the hand of God was very heavy there.

heavy tidings <u>11_1KI_14_06</u># And it was [so], when Ahijah heard the sound of her feet, as she came in at the door, that he said, Come in, thou wife of Jeroboam; why feignest thou thyself [to be] another? for I [am] sent to thee [with] heavy [tidings].

heavy upon it <u>23_ISA_24_20</u> # The earth shall reel to and fro like a drunkard, and shall be removed like a cottage; and the transgression thereof shall be heavy upon it; and it shall fall, and not rise again.

heavy upon me <u>19_PSA_32_04</u># For day and night thy hand was heavy upon me: my moisture is turned into the drought of summer. Selah.

heavy upon thee <u>18_JOB_33_07</u># Behold, my terror shall not make thee afraid, neither shall my hand be heavy upon thee.

heavy upon them <u>09_1SA_05_06</u> # But the hand of the LORD was heavy upon them of Ashdod, and he destroyed them, and smote them with emerods, [even] Ashdod and the coasts thereof.

heavy upon this <u>16_NEH_05_18</u># Now [that] which was prepared [for me] daily [was] one ox [and] six

choice sheep; also fowls were prepared for me, and once in ten days store of all sorts of wine: yet for all this required not I the bread of the governor, because the bondage was heavy upon this people.

heavy with sleep <u>42_LUK_09_32</u> # But Peter and they that were with him were heavy with sleep: and when they were awake, they saw his glory, and the two men that stood with him.

heavy yoke I <u>11_1KI_12_11</u># And now whereas my father did lade you with a heavy yoke, I will add to your yoke: my father hath chastised you with whips, but I will chastise you with scorpions.

heavy yoke that <u>14_2CH_10_04</u> # Thy father made our yoke grievous: now therefore ease thou somewhat the grievous servitude of thy father, and his heavy yoke that he put upon us, and we will serve thee.

heavy yoke upon <u>14_2CH_10_11</u># For whereas my father put a heavy yoke upon you, I will put more to your yoke: my father chastised you with whips, but I [will chastise you] with scorpions.

heavy yoke which <u>11_1KI_12_04</u># Thy father made our yoke grievous: now therefore make thou the grievous service of thy father, and his heavy yoke which he put upon us, lighter, and we will serve thee.

heavy <u>25_LAM_03_07</u> # He hath hedged me about, that I cannot get out: he hath made my chain heavy.

heavy <u>41_MAR_14_33</u> # And he taketh with him Peter and James and John, and began to be sore amazed, and to be very heavy;

heavy <u>40_MAT_26_37</u># And he took with him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and began to be sorrowful and very heavy.

heavy <u>40_MAT_26_43</u># And he came and found them asleep again: for their eyes were heavy.
