beheld all the [21 ECC 08 17](#) # Then I beheld all the work of God, that a man cannot find out the work that is done under the sun: because though a man labour to seek [it] out, yet he shall not find [it]; yea farther; though a wise [man] think to know [it], yet shall he not be able to find [it].

beheld all the [01 GEN 13 10](#) # And Lot lifted up his eyes, and beheld all the plain of Jordan, that it [was] well watered every where, before the LORD destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah, [even] as the garden of the LORD, like the land of Egypt, as thou comest unto Zoar.

beheld among the [20 PRO 07 07](#) # And beheld among the simple ones, I discerned among the youths, a young man void of understanding,

beheld and drove [35 HAB 03 06](#) # He stood, and measured the earth: he beheld, and drove asunder the nations; and the everlasting mountains were scattered, the perpetual hills did bow: his ways [are] everlasting.

beheld and he [13 1CH 21 15](#) # And God sent an angel unto Jerusalem to destroy it: and as he was destroying, the LORD beheld, and he repented him of the evil, and said to the angel that destroyed, It is enough, stay now thine hand. And the angel of the LORD stood by the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.

beheld and heard [66 REV 08 13](#) # And I beheld, and heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, Woe, woe, woe, to the inhabitants of the earth by reason of the other voices of the trumpet of the three angels, which are yet to sound!

beheld and I [66 REV 05 11](#) # And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands;

beheld and lo [27 DAN 07 06](#) # After this I beheld, and lo another, like a leopard, which had upon the back of it four wings of a fowl; the beast had also four heads; and dominion was given to it.

beheld and lo [26 EZE 08 02](#) # Then I beheld, and lo a likeness as the appearance of fire: from the appearance of his loins even downward, fire; and from his loins even upward, as the appearance of brightness, as the colour of amber.

beheld and lo [01 GEN 19 28](#) # And he looked toward Sodom and Gomorrah, and toward all the land of the plain, and beheld, and, lo, the smoke of the country went up as the smoke of a furnace.

beheld and lo [24 JER 04 25](#) # I beheld, and, lo, [there was] no man, and all the birds of the heavens were fled.

beheld and lo [24 JER 04 26](#) # I beheld, and, lo, the fruitful place [was] a wilderness, and all the cities thereof were broken down at the presence of the LORD, [and] by his fierce anger.

beheld and lo [66 REV 05 06](#) # And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

beheld and lo [66 REV 06 05](#) # And when he had opened the third seal, I heard the third beast say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand.

beheld and lo [66 REV 07 09](#) # After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

beheld and my [24 JER 31 26](#) # Upon this I awaked, and beheld; and my sleep was sweet unto me.

beheld and the [27 DAN 07 21](#) # I beheld, and the same horn made war with the saints, and prevailed against them;

beheld and there [23 ISA 41 28](#) # For I beheld, and [there was] no man; even among them, and [there was] no counsellor, that, when I asked of them, could answer a word.

beheld another beast [66 REV 13 11](#) # And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon.

beheld but there [19 PSA 142 04](#) # I looked on [my] right hand, and beheld, but [there was] no man that would know me: refuge failed me; no man cared for my soul.

beheld even till [27 DAN 07 11](#) # I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spake: I beheld [even] till the beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame.

beheld he was [44 ACT 01 09](#) # And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight.

beheld him as [42 LUK 22 56](#) # But a certain maid beheld him as he sat by the fire, and earnestly looked upon him, and said, This man was also with him.

beheld him he [43 JOH 01 42](#) # And he brought him to Jesus. And when Jesus beheld him, he said, Thou art Simon the son of Jona: thou shalt be called Cephas, which is by interpretation, A stone.

beheld him were [41 MAR 09 15](#) # And straightway all the people, when they beheld him, were greatly amazed, and running to [him] saluted him.

beheld his glory [43 JOH 01 14](#) # And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, [and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,] full of grace and truth.

beheld how the [41 MAR 12 41](#) # And Jesus sat over against the treasury, and beheld how the people cast money into the treasury: and many that were rich cast in much.

beheld iniquity in [04 NUM 23 21](#) # He hath not beheld iniquity in Jacob, neither hath he seen perverseness in Israel: the LORD his God [is] with him, and the shout of a king [is] among them.

beheld Joseph's sons [01 GEN 48 08](#) # And Israel beheld Joseph's sons, and said, Who [are] these?

beheld lo the [26 EZE 37 08](#) # And when I beheld, lo, the sinews and the flesh came up upon them, and the skin covered them above: but [there was] no breath in them.

beheld Satan as [42 LUK 10 18](#) # And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.

beheld the city [42 LUK 19 41](#) # And when he was come near, he beheld the city, and wept over it,

beheld the countenance [01 GEN 31 02](#) # And Jacob beheld the countenance of Laban, and, behold, it

[was] not toward him as before.

beheld the earth [24 JER 04 23](#) # I beheld the earth, and, lo, [it was] without form, and void; and the heavens, and they [had] no light.

beheld the linen [42 LUK 24 12](#) # Then arose Peter, and ran unto the sepulchre; and stooping down, he beheld the linen clothes laid by themselves, and departed, wondering in himself at that which was come to pass.

beheld the living [26 EZE 01 15](#) # Now as I beheld the living creatures, behold one wheel upon the earth by the living creatures, with his four faces.

beheld the mountains [24 JER 04 24](#) # I beheld the mountains, and, lo, they trembled, and all the hills moved lightly.

beheld the place [09 ISA 26 05](#) # And David arose, and came to the place where Saul had pitched: and David beheld the place where Saul lay, and Abner the son of Ner, the captain of his host: and Saul lay in the trench, and the people pitched round about him.

beheld the sepulchre [42 LUK 23 55](#) # And the women also, which came with him from Galilee, followed after, and beheld the sepulchre, and how his body was laid.

beheld the serpent [04 NUM 21 09](#) # And Moses made a serpent of brass, and put it upon a pole, and it came to pass, that if a serpent had bitten any man, when he beheld the serpent of brass, he lived.

beheld the sun [18 JOB 31 26](#) # If I beheld the sun when it shined, or the moon walking [in] brightness;

beheld the transgressors [19 PSA 119 158](#) # I beheld the transgressors, and was grieved; because they kept not thy word.

beheld the woman [01 GEN 12 14](#) # And it came to pass, that, when Abram was come into Egypt, the Egyptians beheld the woman that she [was] very fair.

beheld them and [42 LUK 20 17](#) # And he beheld them, and said, What is this then that is written, The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner?

beheld them and [40 MAT 19 26](#) # But Jesus beheld [them], and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible.

beheld them [66 REV 11 12](#) # And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, Come up hither. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld them.

beheld then because [27 DAN 07 11](#) # I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spake: I beheld [even] till the beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame.

beheld till the [27 DAN 07 04](#) # The first [was] like a lion, and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it.

beheld till the [27 DAN 07 09](#) # I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment [was] white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne [was like] the fiery flame, [and] his wheels [as] burning fire.

beheld when he [66 REV 06 12](#) # And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood;

beheld where he [41 MAR 15 47](#) # And Mary Magdalene and Mary [the mother] of Joses beheld where he was laid.

beheld while Samson [07 JUD 16 27](#) # Now the house was full of men and women; and all the lords of the Philistines [were] there; and [there were] upon the roof about three thousand men and women, that beheld while Samson made sport.

beheld your devotions [44 ACT 17 23](#) # For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, him declare I unto you.

held a consultation [41 MAR 15 01](#) # And straightway in the morning the chief priests held a consultation with the elders and scribes and the whole council, and bound Jesus, and carried [him] away, and delivered [him] to Pilate.

held a council [40 MAT 12 14](#) # Then the Pharisees went out, and held a council against him, how they might destroy him.

held a feast [11 1KI 08 65](#) # And at that time Solomon held a feast, and all Israel with him, a great congregation, from the entering in of Hamath unto the river of Egypt, before the LORD our God, seven days and seven days, [even] fourteen days.

held a feast [09 ISA 25 36](#) # And Abigail came to Nabal; and, behold, he held a feast in his house, like the feast of a king; and Nabal's heart [was] merry within him, for he [was] very drunken: wherefore she told him nothing, less or more, until the morning light.

held a weapon [16 NEH 04 17](#) # They which builded on the wall, and they that bare burdens, with those that laded, [every one] with one of his hands wrought in the work, and with the other [hand] held a weapon.

held back the [10 2SA 18 16](#) # And Joab blew the trumpet, and the people returned from pursuing after Israel: for Joab held back the people.

held both the [16 NEH 04 16](#) # And it came to pass from that time forth, [that] the half of my servants wrought in the work, and the other half of them held both the spears, the shields, and the bows, and the habergeons; and the rulers [were] behind all the house of Judah.

held him and [22 SON 03 04](#) # [It was] but a little that I passed from them, but I found him whom my soul loveth: I held him, and would not let him go, until I had brought him into my mother's house, and into the chamber of her that conceived me.

held him by [07 JUD 16 26](#) # And Samson said unto the lad that held him by the hand, Suffer me that I may feel the pillars whereupon the house standeth, that I may lean upon them.

held him by [40 MAT 28 09](#) # And as they went to tell his disciples, behold, Jesus met them, saying, All hail. And they came and held him by the feet, and worshipped him.

held his peace [09 ISA 10 27](#) # But the children of Belial said, How shall this man save us? And they despised him, and brought him no presents. But he held his peace.

held his peace [01 GEN 24 21](#) # And the man wondering at her held his peace, to wit whether the LORD had made his journey prosperous or not.

held his peace [01 GEN 34 05](#) # And Jacob heard that he had defiled Dinah his daughter: now his sons were with his cattle in the field: and Jacob held his peace until they were come.

held his peace [03 LEV 10 03](#) # Then Moses said unto Aaron, This [is it] that the LORD spake, saying, I will be sanctified in them that come nigh me, and before all the people I will be glorified. And Aaron held his peace.

held his peace [41 MAR 14 61](#) # But he held his peace, and answered nothing. Again the high priest asked him, and said unto him, Art thou the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?

held his peace [40 MAT 26 63](#) # But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.

held his peace [04 NUM 30 07](#) # And her husband heard [it], and held his peace at her in the day that he heard [it]: then her vows shall stand, and her bonds wherewith she bound her soul shall stand.

held his peace [04 NUM 30 11](#) # And her husband heard [it], and held his peace at her, [and] disallowed her not: then all her vows shall stand, and every bond wherewith she bound her soul shall stand.

held his peace [04 NUM 30 14](#) # But if her husband altogether hold his peace at her from day to day; then he establisheth all her vows, or all her bonds, which [are] upon her: he confirmeth them, because he held his peace at her in the day that he heard [them].

held his steps [18 JOB 23 11](#) # My foot hath held his steps, his way have I kept, and not declined.

held in the [22 SON 07 05](#) # Thine head upon thee [is] like Carmel, and the hair of thine head like purple; the king [is] held in the galleries.

held in with [19 PSA 32 09](#) # Be ye not as the horse, [or] as the mule, [which] have no understanding: whose mouth must be held in with bit and bridle, lest they come near unto thee.

held it he [08 RUT 03 15](#) # Also he said, Bring the veil that [thou hast] upon thee, and hold it. And when she held it, he measured six [measures] of barley, and laid [it] on her: and she went into the city.

held Jesus mocked [42 LUK 22 63](#) # And the men that held Jesus mocked him, and smote [him].

held me up [19 PSA 94 18](#) # When I said, My foot slippeth; thy mercy, O LORD, held me up.

held my peace [23 ISA 57 11](#) # And of whom hast thou been afraid or feared, that thou hast lied, and hast not remembered me, nor laid [it] to thy heart? have not I held my peace even of old, and thou fearest me not?

held my peace [19 PSA 39 02](#) # I was dumb with silence, I held my peace, [even] from good; and my sorrow was stirred.

held my tongue [17 EST 07 04](#) # For we are sold, I and my people, to be destroyed, to be slain, and to perish. But if we had been sold for bondmen and bondwomen, I had held my tongue, although the enemy could not countervail the king's damage.

held one curtain [02 EXO 36 12](#) # Fifty loops made he in one curtain, and fifty loops made he in the edge of the curtain which [was] in the coupling of the second: the loops held one [curtain] to another.

held out the [17 EST 08 04](#) # Then the king held out the golden sceptre toward Esther. So Esther arose, and stood before the king,

held out to [17 EST 05 02](#) # And it was so, when the king saw Esther the queen standing in the court, [that] she obtained favour in his sight: and the king held out to Esther the golden sceptre that [was] in his hand.

So Esther drew near, and touched the top of the sceptre.

held Peter and [44 ACT 03 11](#) # And as the lame man which was healed held Peter and John, all the people ran together unto them in the porch that is called Solomon's, greatly wondering.

held that we [45 ROM 07 06](#) # But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of spirit, and not [in] the oldness of the letter.

held the lamps [07 JUD 07 20](#) # And the three companies blew the trumpets, and brake the pitchers, and held the lamps in their left hands, and the trumpets in their right hands to blow [withal]: and they cried, The sword of the LORD, and of Gideon.

held the spears [16 NEH 04 21](#) # So we laboured in the work: and half of them held the spears from the rising of the morning till the stars appeared.

held their peace [12 2KI 18 36](#) # But the people held their peace, and answered him not a word: for the king's commandment was, saying, Answer him not.

held their peace [44 ACT 11 18](#) # When they heard these things, they held their peace, and glorified God, saying, Then hath God also to the Gentiles granted repentance unto life.

held their peace [44 ACT 15 13](#) # And after they had held their peace, James answered, saying, Men [and] brethren, hearken unto me:

held their peace [23 ISA 36 21](#) # But they held their peace, and answered him not a word: for the king's commandment was, saying, Answer him not.

held their peace [18 JOB 29 10](#) # The nobles held their peace, and their tongue cleaved to the roof of their mouth.

held their peace [42 LUK 14 04](#) # And they held their peace. And he took [him], and healed him, and let him go;

held their peace [42 LUK 20 26](#) # And they could not take hold of his words before the people: and they marvelled at his answer, and held their peace.

held their peace [41 MAR 03 04](#) # And he saith unto them, Is it lawful to do good on the sabbath days, or to do evil? to save life, or to kill? But they held their peace.

held their peace [41 MAR 09 34](#) # But they held their peace: for by the way they had disputed among themselves, who [should be] the greatest.

held them fast [24 JER 50 33](#) # Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The children of Israel and the children of Judah [were] oppressed together: and all that took them captives held them fast; they refused to let them go.

held they their [16 NEH 05 08](#) # And I said unto them, We after our ability have redeemed our brethren the Jews, which were sold unto the heathen; and will ye even sell your brethren? or shall they be sold unto us? Then held they their peace, and found nothing [to answer].

held three thousand [14 2CH 04 05](#) # And the thickness of it [was] an handbreadth, and the brim of it like the work of the brim of a cup, with flowers of lilies; [and] it received and held three thousand baths.

held up his [27 DAN 12 07](#) # And I heard the man clothed in linen, which [was] upon the waters of the river, when he held up his right hand and his left hand unto heaven, and sware by him that liveth for ever

that [it shall be] for a time, times, and an half; and when he shall have accomplished to scatter the power of the holy people, all these [things] shall be finished.

held up his [02_EXO_17_11](#) # And it came to pass, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed.

held up his [01_GEN_48_17](#) # And when Joseph saw that his father laid his right hand upon the head of Ephraim, it displeased him: and he held up his father's hand, to remove it from Ephraim's head unto Manasseh's head.

held with the [44_ACT_14_04](#) # But the multitude of the city was divided: and part held with the Jews, and part with the apostles.

held [66_REV_06_09](#) # And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held:

Heldai of Tobijah [38_ZEC_06_10](#) # Take of [them of] the captivity, [even] of Heldai, of Tobijah, and of Jedaiah, which are come from Babylon, and come thou the same day, and go into the house of Josiah the son of Zephaniah;

Heldai the Netophathite [13_1CH_27_15](#) # The twelfth [captain] for the twelfth month [was] Heldai the Netophathite, of Othniel: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

upheld me [23_ISA_63_05](#) # And I looked, and [there was] none to help; and I wondered that [there was] none to uphold: therefore mine own arm brought salvation unto me; and my fury, it upheld me.

withheld from thee [01_GEN_30_02](#) # And Jacob's anger was kindled against Rachel: and he said, [Am] I in God's stead, who hath withheld from thee the fruit of the womb?

withheld not my [21_ECC_02_10](#) # And whatsoever mine eyes desired I kept not from them, I withheld not my heart from any joy; for my heart rejoiced in all my labour: and this was my portion of all my labour.

withheld the poor [18_JOB_31_16](#) # If I have withheld the poor from [their] desire, or have caused the eyes of the widow to fail;

withheld thee from [01_GEN_20_06](#) # And God said unto him in a dream, Yea, I know that thou didst this in the integrity of thy heart; for I also withheld thee from sinning against me: therefore suffered I thee not to touch her.

withheld thy son [01_GEN_22_12](#) # And he said, Lay not thine hand upon the lad, neither do thou any thing unto him: for now I know that thou fearest God, seeing thou hast not withheld thy son, thine only [son] from me.

withheld thy son [01_GEN_22_16](#) # And said, By myself have I sworn, saith the LORD, for because thou hast done this thing, and hast not withheld thy son, thine only [son]:

witheldest not thy [16_NEH_09_20](#) # Thou gavest also thy good spirit to instruct them, and witheldest not thy manna from their mouth, and gavest them water for their thirst.
