herb and as <u>05_DEU_32_02</u># My doctrine shall drop as the rain, my speech shall distil as the dew, as the small rain upon the tender herb, and as the showers upon the grass:

herb and the <u>23_ISA_66_14</u># And when ye see [this], your heart shall rejoice, and your bones shall flourish like an herb: and the hand of the LORD shall be known toward his servants, and [his] indignation toward his enemies.

herb as the <u>12_2KI_19_26</u># Therefore their inhabitants were of small power, they were dismayed and confounded; they were [as] the grass of the field, and [as] the green herb, [as] the grass on the house tops, and [as corn] blasted before it be grown up.

herb bearing seed <u>01_GEN_01_29</u># And God said, Behold, I have given you every herb bearing seed, which [is] upon the face of all the earth, and every tree, in the which [is] the fruit of a tree yielding seed; to you it shall be for meat.

herb for meat <u>01_GEN_01_30</u># And to every beast of the earth, and to every fowl of the air, and to every thing that creepeth upon the earth, wherein [there is] life, [I have given] every green herb for meat: and it was so.

herb for the <u>19_PSA_104_14</u># He causeth the grass to grow for the cattle, and herb for the service of man: that he may bring forth food out of the earth;

herb have I <u>01_GEN_09_03</u># Every moving thing that liveth shall be meat for you; even as the green herb have I given you all things.

herb of the <u>02_EXO_10_15</u> # For they covered the face of the whole earth, so that the land was darkened; and they did eat every herb of the land, and all the fruit of the trees which the hail had left: and there remained not any green thing in the trees, or in the herbs of the field, through all the land of Egypt.

herb of the <u>01_GEN_02_05</u> # And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for the LORD God had not caused it to rain upon the earth, and [there was] not a man to till the ground.

herb <u>19_PSA_37_02</u> # For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, and wither as the green herb.

herbs and becometh <u>40_MAT_13_32</u># Which indeed is the least of all seeds: but when it is grown, it is the greatest among herbs, and becometh a tree, so that the birds of the air come and lodge in the branches thereof.

herbs and found <u>12_2KI_04_39</u> # And one went out into the field to gather herbs, and found a wild vine, and gathered thereof wild gourds his lap full, and came and shred [them] into the pot of pottage: for they knew [them] not.

herbs and I <u>23_ISA_42_15</u> # I will make waste mountains and hills, and dry up all their herbs; and I will make the rivers islands, and I will dry up the pools.

herbs and shooteth <u>41_MAR_04_32</u> # But when it is sown, it groweth up, and becometh greater than all herbs, and shooteth out great branches; so that the fowls of the air may lodge under the shadow of it.

herbs and the <u>23_ISA_26_19</u> # Thy dead [men] shall live, [together with] my dead body shall they arise. Awake and sing, ye that dwell in dust: for thy dew [is as] the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead.

herbs because it <u>11_1KI_21_02</u># And Ahab spake unto Naboth, saying, Give me thy vineyard, that I may have it for a garden of herbs, because it [is] near unto my house: and I will give thee for it a better vineyard than it; [or], if it seem good to thee, I will give thee the worth of it in money.

herbs in their <u>19_PSA_105_35</u> # And did eat up all the herbs in their land, and devoured the fruit of their ground.

herbs meet for <u>58_HEB_06_07</u> # For the earth which drinketh in the rain that cometh oft upon it, and bringeth forth herbs meet for them by whom it is dressed, receiveth blessing from God:

herbs of every <u>24_JER_12_04</u> # How long shall the land mourn, and the herbs of every field wither, for the wickedness of them that dwell therein? the beasts are consumed, and the birds; because they said, He shall not see our last end.

herbs <u>05_DEU_11_10</u># For the land, whither thou goest in to possess it, [is] not as the land of Egypt, from whence ye came out, where thou sowedst thy seed, and wateredst [it] with thy foot, as a garden of herbs:

herbs <u>04_NUM_09_11</u># The fourteenth day of the second month at even they shall keep it, [and] eat it with unleavened bread and bitter [herbs].

herbs <u>45_ROM_14_02</u> # For one believeth that he may eat all things: another, who is weak, eateth herbs.
