chide neither will <u>19_PSA_103_09</u># He will not always chide: neither will he keep [his anger] for ever.

chide with him <u>07_JUD_08_01</u> # And the men of Ephraim said unto him, Why hast thou served us thus, that thou calledst us not, when thou wentest to fight with the Midianites? And they did chide with him sharply.

chide with Moses <u>02_EXO_17_02</u># Wherefore the people did chide with Moses, and said, Give us water that we may drink. And Moses said unto them, Why chide ye with me? wherefore do ye tempt the LORD?

chide ye with <u>02_EXO_17_02</u> # Wherefore the people did chide with Moses, and said, Give us water that we may drink. And Moses said unto them, Why chide ye with me? wherefore do ye tempt the LORD?

chided with Laban <u>01_GEN_31_36</u># And Jacob was wroth, and chided with Laban: and Jacob answered and said to Laban, What [is] my trespass? what [is] my sin, that thou hast so hotly pursued after me?

chided with Moses <u>04_NUM_20_03</u># And the people chided with Moses, and spake, saying, Would God that we had died when our brethren died before the LORD!

chiding of the <u>02_EXO_17_07</u># And he called the name of the place Massah, and Meribah, because of the chiding of the children of Israel, and because they tempted the LORD, saying, Is the LORD among us, or not?

Chidon Uzza put <u>13_1CH_13_09</u># And when they came unto the threshingfloor of Chidon, Uzza put forth his hand to hold the ark; for the oxen stumbled.

hid a snare <u>19_PSA_140_05</u># The proud have hid a snare for me, and cords; they have spread a net by the wayside; they have set gins for me. Selah.

hid all the <u>51_COL_02_03</u> # In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

hid an hundred <u>11_1KI_18_13</u># Was it not told my lord what I did when Jezebel slew the prophets of the LORD, how I hid an hundred men of the LORD's prophets by fifty in a cave, and fed them with bread and water?

hid and he <u>24_JER_43_10</u> # And say unto them, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will send and take Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, my servant, and will set his throne upon these stones that I have hid; and he shall spread his royal pavilion over them.

hid and I <u>01_GEN_04_14</u> # Behold, thou hast driven me out this day from the face of the earth; and from thy face shall I be hid; and I shall be a fugitive and a vagabond in the earth; and it shall come to pass, [that] every one that findeth me shall slay me.

hid and laid <u>06_JOS_10_27</u> # And it came to pass at the time of the going down of the sun, [that] Joshua commanded, and they took them down off the trees, and cast them into the cave wherein they had been hid, and laid great stones in the cave's mouth, [which remain] until this very day.

hid and whom <u>18_JOB_03_23</u> # [Why is light given] to a man whose way is hid, and whom God hath hedged in?

hid as it <u>23_ISA_53_03</u> # He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were [our] faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

hid as with <u>18_JOB_38_30</u> # The waters are hid as [with] a stone, and the face of the deep is frozen.

hid bringeth he <u>18_JOB_28_11</u># He bindeth the floods from overflowing; and [the thing that is] hid bringeth he forth to light.

hid bringeth he <u>18_JOB_28_11</u># He bindeth the floods from overflowing; and [the thing that is] hid bringeth he forth to light.

hid catch himself <u>19_PSA_35_08</u> # Let destruction come upon him at unawares; and let his net that he hath hid catch himself: into that very destruction let him fall.

hid for me <u>19_PSA_35_07</u># For without cause have they hid for me their net [in] a pit, [which] without cause they have digged for my soul.

hid from ages <u>51_COL_01_26</u># [Even] the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints:

hid from him <u>03_LEV_05_03</u> # Or if he touch the uncleanness of man, whatsoever uncleanness [it be] that a man shall be defiled withal, and it be hid from him; when he knoweth [of it], then he shall be guilty.

hid from him <u>03_LEV_05_04</u> # Or if a soul swear, pronouncing with [his] lips to do evil, or to do good, whatsoever [it be] that a man shall pronounce with an oath, and it be hid from him; when he knoweth [of it], then he shall be guilty in one of these.

hid from me <u>28_HOS_05_03</u> # I know Ephraim, and Israel is not hid from me: for now, O Ephraim, thou committest whoredom, [and] Israel is defiled.

hid from mine <u>28_HOS_13_14</u> # I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death: O death, I will be thy plagues; O grave, I will be thy destruction: repentance shall be hid from mine eyes.

hid from mine <u>23_ISA_65_16</u> # That he who blesseth himself in the earth shall bless himself in the God of truth; and he that sweareth in the earth shall swear by the God of truth; because the former troubles are forgotten, and because they are hid from mine eyes.

hid from mine <u>24_JER_16_17</u># For mine eyes [are] upon all their ways: they are not hid from my face, neither is their iniquity hid from mine eyes.

hid from my <u>30_AMO_09_03</u># And though they hide themselves in the top of Carmel, I will search and take them out thence; and though they be hid from my sight in the bottom of the sea, thence will I command the serpent, and he shall bite them:

hid from my <u>24_JER_16_17</u># For mine eyes [are] upon all their ways: they are not hid from my face, neither is their iniquity hid from mine eyes.

hid from Solomon <u>14_2CH_09_02</u># And Solomon told her all her questions: and there was nothing hid from Solomon which he told her not.

hid from the <u>10_2SA_18_13</u># Otherwise I should have wrought falsehood against mine own life: for there is no matter hid from the king, and thou thyself wouldest have set thyself against [me].

hid from the <u>23_ISA_40_27</u> # Why sayest thou, O Jacob, and speakest, O Israel, My way is hid from the LORD, and my judgment is passed over from my God?

hid from the <u>18_JOB_05_21</u># Thou shalt be hid from the scourge of the tongue: neither shalt thou be afraid of destruction when it cometh.

hid from the <u>18_JOB_28_21</u># Seeing it is hid from the eyes of all living, and kept close from the fowls of the air.

hid from the <u>03_LEV_04_13</u> # And if the whole congregation of Israel sin through ignorance, and the thing be hid from the eyes of the assembly, and they have done [somewhat against] any of the commandments of the LORD [concerning things] which should not be done, and are guilty;

hid from the <u>04_NUM_05_13</u># And a man lie with her carnally, and it be hid from the eyes of her husband, and be kept close, and she be defiled, and [there be] no witness against her, neither she be taken [with the manner];

hid from the <u>19_PSA_19_06</u># His going forth [is] from the end of the heaven, and his circuit unto the ends of it: and there is nothing hid from the heat thereof.

hid from thee <u>19_PSA_139_15</u> # My substance was not hid from thee, when I was made in secret, [and] curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth.

hid from thee <u>19_PSA_38_09</u># Lord, all my desire [is] before thee; and my groaning is not hid from thee.

hid from thee <u>19_PSA_69_05</u># O God, thou knowest my foolishness; and my sins are not hid from thee.

hid from them <u>42_LUK_09_45</u> # But they understood not this saying, and it was hid from them, that they perceived it not: and they feared to ask him of that saying.

hid from them <u>42_LUK_18_34</u> # And they understood none of these things: and this saying was hid from them, neither knew they the things which were spoken.

hid from thine <u>42_LUK_19_42</u> # Saying, If thou hadst known, even thou, at least in this thy day, the things [which belong] unto thy peace! but now they are hid from thine eyes.

hid her son <u>12_2KI_06_29</u> # So we boiled my son, and did eat him: and I said unto her on the next day, Give thy son, that we may eat him: and she hath hid her son.

hid herself five <u>42_LUK_01_24</u> # And after those days his wife Elisabeth conceived, and hid herself five months, saying,

hid him even <u>12_2KI_11_02</u># But Jehosheba, the daughter of king Joram, sister of Ahaziah, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons [which were] slain; and they hid him, [even] him and his nurse, in the bedchamber from Athaliah, so that he was not slain.

hid him from <u>14_2CH_22_11</u># But Jehoshabeath, the daughter of the king, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons that were slain, and put him and his nurse in a bedchamber. So Jehoshabeath, the daughter of king Jehoram, the wife of Jehoiada the priest, [for she was the sister of Ahaziah,] hid him from Athaliah, so that she slew him not.

hid him in <u>02_EXO_02_12</u> # And he looked this way and that way, and when he saw that [there was] no

man, he slew the Egyptian, and hid him in the sand.

hid him three <u>02_EXO_02_02</u> # And the woman conceived, and bare a son: and when she saw him that he [was a] goodly [child], she hid him three months.

hid himself among <u>09_1SA_10_22</u># Therefore they inquired of the LORD further, if the man should yet come thither. And the LORD answered, Behold, he hath hid himself among the stuff.

hid himself and <u>43_JOH_08_59</u> # Then took they up stones to cast at him: but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.

hid himself in <u>09_1SA_20_24</u># So David hid himself in the field: and when the new moon was come, the king sat him down to eat meat.

hid himself <u>07_JUD_09_05</u> # And he went unto his father's house at Ophrah, and slew his brethren the sons of Jerubbaal, [being] threescore and ten persons, upon one stone: notwithstanding yet Jotham the youngest son of Jerubbaal was left; for he hid himself.

hid his face <u>02_EXO_03_06</u># Moreover he said, I [am] the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God.

hid his face <u>23_ISA_59_02</u> # But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid [his] face from you, that he will not hear.

hid his face <u>19_PSA_22_24</u># For he hath not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; neither hath he hid his face from him; but when he cried unto him, he heard.

hid his lord's <u>40_MAT_25_18</u># But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money.

hid I my <u>26_EZE_39_23</u> # And the heathen shall know that the house of Israel went into captivity for their iniquity: because they trespassed against me, therefore hid I my face from them, and gave them into the hand of their enemies: so fell they all by the sword.

hid I said <u>19_PSA_32_05</u># I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin. Selah.

hid in a <u>06_JOS_10_17</u># And it was told Joshua, saying, The five kings are found hid in a cave at Makkedah.

hid in a <u>40_MAT_13_44</u># Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto treasure hid in a field; the which when a man hath found, he hideth, and for joy thereof goeth and selleth all that he hath, and buyeth that field.

hid in God <u>49_EPH_03_09</u># And to make all [men] see what [is] the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:

hid in his <u>18_JOB_20_26</u> # All darkness [shall be] hid in his secret places: a fire not blown shall consume him; it shall go ill with him that is left in his tabernacle.

hid in his <u>06_JOS_07_22</u># So Joshua sent messengers, and they ran unto the tent; and, behold, [it was] hid in his tent, and the silver under it.

hid in mine <u>19_PSA_119_11</u># Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.

hid in prison <u>23_ISA_42_22</u># But this [is] a people robbed and spoiled; [they are] all of them snared in

holes, and they are hid in prison houses: they are for a prey, and none delivereth; for a spoil, and none saith, Restore.

hid in Samaria <u>14_2CH_22_09</u> # And he sought Ahaziah: and they caught him, [for he was hid in Samaria,] and brought him to Jehu: and when they had slain him, they buried him: Because, said they, he [is] the son of Jehoshaphat, who sought the LORD with all his heart. So the house of Ahaziah had no power to keep still the kingdom.

hid in the <u>14_2CH_22_12</u> # And he was with them hid in the house of God six years: and Athaliah reigned over the land.

hid in the <u>12_2KI_11_03</u># And he was with her hid in the house of the LORD six years. And Athaliah did reign over the land.

hid in the <u>05_DEU_33_19</u># They shall call the people unto the mountain; there they shall offer sacrifices of righteousness: for they shall suck [of] the abundance of the seas, and [of] treasures hid in the sand.

hid in the <u>06_JOS_07_21</u># When I saw among the spoils a goodly Babylonish garment, and two hundred shekels of silver, and a wedge of gold of fifty shekels weight, then I coveted them, and took them; and, behold, they [are] hid in the earth in the midst of my tent, and the silver under it.

hid in the <u>36_ZEP_02_03</u> # Seek ye the LORD, all ye meek of the earth, which have wrought his judgment; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger.

hid in thine <u>18_JOB_10_13</u># And these [things] hast thou hid in thine heart: I know that this [is] with thee.

hid in three <u>42_LUK_13_21</u> # It is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three measures of meal, till the whole was leavened.

hid in three <u>40_MAT_13_33</u># Another parable spake he unto them; The kingdom of heaven is like unto leaven, which a woman took, and hid in three measures of meal, till the whole was leavened.

hid is their <u>19_PSA_09_15</u># The heathen are sunk down in the pit [that] they made: in the net which they hid is their own foot taken.

hid it and <u>12_2KI_07_08</u> # And when these lepers came to the uttermost part of the camp, they went into one tent, and did eat and drink, and carried thence silver, and gold, and raiment, and went and hid [it]; and came again, and entered into another tent, and carried thence [also], and went and hid [it].

hid it and <u>24_JER_13_07</u># Then I went to Euphrates, and digged, and took the girdle from the place where I had hid it: and, behold, the girdle was marred, it was profitable for nothing.

hid me and <u>23_ISA_57_17</u> # For the iniquity of his covetousness was I wroth, and smote him: I hid me, and was wroth, and he went on frowardly in the way of his heart.

hid me <u>23_ISA_49_02</u> # And he hath made my mouth like a sharp sword; in the shadow of his hand hath he hid me, and made me a polished shaft; in his quiver hath he hid me;

hid my face <u>26_EZE_39_24</u> # According to their uncleanness and according to their transgressions have I done unto them, and hid my face from them.

hid my face <u>23_ISA_54_08</u> # In a little wrath I hid my face from thee for a moment; but with everlasting kindness will I have mercy on thee, saith the LORD thy Redeemer.

hid my face <u>24_JER_33_05</u> # They come to fight with the Chaldeans, but [it is] to fill them with the dead bodies of men, whom I have slain in mine anger and in my fury, and for all whose wickedness I have hid my face from this city.

hid myself from <u>19_PSA_55_12</u> # For [it was] not an enemy [that] reproached me; then I could have borne [it]: neither [was it] he that hated me [that] did magnify [himself] against me; then I would have hid myself from him:

hid myself <u>01_GEN_03_10</u># And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I [was] naked; and I hid myself.

hid not my <u>23_ISA_50_06</u># I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from shame and spitting.

hid nothing from <u>09_1SA_03_18</u> # And Samuel told him every whit, and hid nothing from him. And he said, It [is] the LORD: let him do what seemeth him good.

hid now in <u>10_2SA_17_09</u># Behold, he is hid now in some pit, or in some [other] place: and it will come to pass, when some of them be overthrown at the first, that whosoever heareth it will say, There is a slaughter among the people that follow Absalom.

hid ourselves <u>23_ISA_28_15</u># Because ye have said, We have made a covenant with death, and with hell are we at agreement; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, it shall not come unto us: for we have made lies our refuge, and under falsehood have we hid ourselves:

hid she came <u>42_LUK_08_47</u> # And when the woman saw that she was not hid, she came trembling, and falling down before him, she declared unto him before all the people for what cause she had touched him, and how she was healed immediately.

hid snares for <u>24_JER_18_22</u> # Let a cry be heard from their houses, when thou shalt bring a troop suddenly upon them: for they have digged a pit to take me, and hid snares for my feet.

hid sorrow from <u>18_JOB_03_10</u> # Because it shut not up the doors of my [mother's] womb, nor hid sorrow from mine eyes.

hid that shall <u>42_LUK_08_17</u> # For nothing is secret, that shall not be made manifest; neither [any thing] hid, that shall not be known and come abroad.

hid that shall <u>42_LUK_12_02</u># For there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; neither hid, that

shall not be known.

hid the messengers <u>06_JOS_06_17</u> # And the city shall be accursed, [even] it, and all that [are] therein, to the LORD: only Rahab the harlot shall live, she and all that [are] with her in the house, because she hid the messengers that we sent.

hid the messengers <u>06_JOS_06_25</u> # And Joshua saved Rahab the harlot alive, and her father's household, and all that she had; and she dwelleth in Israel [even] unto this day; because she hid the messengers, which Joshua sent to spy out Jericho.

hid their eyes <u>26_EZE_22_26</u># Her priests have violated my law, and have profaned mine holy things: they have put no difference between the holy and profane, neither have they showed [difference] between the unclean and the clean, and have hid their eyes from my sabbaths, and I am profaned among them.

hid their heart <u>18_JOB_17_04</u># For thou hast hid their heart from understanding: therefore shalt thou not exalt [them].

hid them and <u>06_JOS_02_04</u> # And the woman took the two men, and hid them, and said thus, There came men unto me, but I wist not whence they [were]:

hid them by <u>11_1KI_18_04</u># For it was [so], when Jezebel cut off the prophets of the LORD, that Obadiah took an hundred prophets, and hid them by fifty in a cave, and fed them with bread and water.]

hid them under <u>01_GEN_35_04</u> # And they gave unto Jacob all the strange gods which [were] in their hand, and [all their] earrings which [were] in their ears; and Jacob hid them under the oak which [was] by Shechem.

hid them with <u>06_JOS_02_06</u># But she had brought them up to the roof of the house, and hid them with the stalks of flax, which she had laid in order upon the roof.

hid them <u>24_JER_36_26</u> # But the king commanded Jerahmeel the son of Hammelech, and Seraiah the son of Azriel, and Shelemiah the son of Abdeel, to take Baruch the scribe and Jeremiah the prophet: but the LORD hid them.

hid themselves and <u>18_JOB_29_08</u># The young men saw me, and hid themselves: and the aged arose, [and] stood up.

hid themselves from <u>01_GEN_03_08</u># And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.

hid themselves in <u>09_1SA_14_22</u> # Likewise all the men of Israel which had hid themselves in mount Ephraim, [when] they heard that the Philistines fled, even they also followed hard after them in the battle.

hid themselves in <u>06_JOS_10_16</u># But these five kings fled, and hid themselves in a cave at Makkedah.

hid themselves in <u>66_REV_06_15</u> # And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;

hid themselves Now <u>13_1CH_21_20</u> # And Ornan turned back, and saw the angel; and his four sons with him hid themselves. Now Ornan was threshing wheat.

hid themselves <u>09_1SA_14_11</u> # And both of them discovered themselves unto the garrison of the Philistines: and the Philistines said, Behold, the Hebrews come forth out of the holes where they had hid themselves.

hid these things <u>42_LUK_10_21</u> # In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight.

hid these things <u>40_MAT_11_25</u># At that time Jesus answered and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes.

hid thou also <u>34_NAH_03_11</u># Thou also shalt be drunken: thou shalt be hid, thou also shalt seek strength because of the enemy.

hid three months <u>58_HEB_11_23</u># By faith Moses, when he was born, was hid three months of his parents, because they saw [he was] a proper child; and they were not afraid of the king's commandment.

hid thy face <u>23_ISA_64_07</u> # And [there is] none that calleth upon thy name, that stirreth up himself to take hold of thee: for thou hast hid thy face from us, and hast consumed us, because of our iniquities.

hid thy righteousness <u>19_PSA_40_10</u># I have not hid thy righteousness within my heart; I have declared thy faithfulness and thy salvation: I have not concealed thy lovingkindness and thy truth from the great congregation.

hid thy talent <u>40_MAT_25_25</u># And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, [there] thou hast [that is] thine.

hid to them <u>47_2CO_04_03</u> # But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost:

hid treasure they <u>19_PSA_17_14</u> # From men [which are] thy hand, O LORD, from men of the world, [which have] their portion in [this] life, and whose belly thou fillest with thy hid [treasure]: they are full of children, and leave the rest of their [substance] to their babes.

hid treasures <u>18_JOB_03_21</u> # Which long for death, but it [cometh] not; and dig for it more than for hid treasures;

hid treasures <u>20_PRO_02_04</u># If thou seekest her as silver, and searchest for her as [for] hid treasures;

hid which shall <u>41_MAR_04_22</u> # For there is nothing hid, which shall not be manifested; neither was any thing kept secret, but that it should come abroad.

hid with Christ <u>51_COL_03_03</u> # For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.

hid <u>54_1TI_05_25</u> # Likewise also the good works [of some] are manifest beforehand; and they that are otherwise cannot be hid.

hid <u>28_HOS_13_12</u># The iniquity of Ephraim [is] bound up; his sin [is] hid.

hid <u>23_ISA_29_14</u># Therefore, behold, I will proceed to do a marvellous work among this people, [even] a marvellous work and a wonder: for the wisdom of their wise [men] shall perish, and the understanding of their prudent [men] shall be hid.

hid <u>18_JOB_06_16</u> # Which are blackish by reason of the ice, [and] wherein the snow is hid:

hid <u>41_MAR_07_24</u> # And from thence he arose, and went into the borders of Tyre and Sidon, and entered into an house, and would have no man know [it]: but he could not be hid.

hid <u>40_MAT_05_14</u># Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.

Hiddai of the 10_2SA_23_30 # Benaiah the Pirathonite, Hiddai of the brooks of Gaash,

hidden from him <u>03_LEV_05_02</u># Or if a soul touch any unclean thing, whether [it be] a carcase of an unclean beast, or a carcase of unclean cattle, or the carcase of unclean creeping things, and [if] it be hidden from him; he also shall be unclean, and guilty.

hidden from the <u>18_JOB_24_01</u># Why, seeing times are not hidden from the Almighty, do they that know him not see his days?

hidden from thee <u>05_DEU_30_11</u># For this commandment which I command thee this day, it [is] not hidden from thee, neither [is] it far off.

hidden man of <u>60_1PE_03_04</u> # But [let it be] the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, [even the ornament] of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.

hidden manna and <u>66_REV_02_17</u># He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth [it].

hidden ones <u>19_PSA_83_03</u># They have taken crafty counsel against thy people, and consulted against thy hidden ones.

hidden part thou <u>19_PSA_51_06</u># Behold, thou desirest truth in the inward parts: and in the hidden [part] thou shalt make me to know wisdom.

hidden riches of <u>23_ISA_45_03</u> # And I will give thee the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, that thou mayest know that I, the LORD, which call [thee] by thy name, [am] the God of Israel.

hidden things and 23_ISA_48_06 # Thou hast heard, see all this; and will not ye declare [it]? I have showed thee new things from this time, even hidden things, and thou didst not know them.

hidden things of <u>46_1CO_04_05</u> # Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise of God.

hidden things of <u>47_2CO_04_02</u> # But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.

hidden things sought <u>31_OBA_01_06</u># How are [the things] of Esau searched out! [how] are his hidden things sought up!

hidden to the <u>18_JOB_15_20</u># The wicked man travaileth with pain all [his] days, and the number of years is hidden to the oppressor.

hidden untimely birth <u>18_JOB_03_16</u># Or as an hidden untimely birth I had not been; as infants [which] never saw light.

hidden wisdom which <u>46_1CO_02_07</u> # But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, [even] the hidden [wisdom], which God ordained before the world unto our glory:

hidden <u>20_PRO_28_12</u># When righteous [men] do rejoice, [there is] great glory: but when the wicked rise, a man is hidden.

hide a multitude <u>59_JAM_05_20</u> # Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way shall save a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins.

hide any thing <u>09_1SA_03_17</u> # And he said, What [is] the thing that [the LORD] hath said unto thee? I pray thee hide [it] not from me: God do so to thee, and more also, if thou hide [any] thing from me of all the things that he said unto thee.

hide from Abraham <u>01_GEN_18_17</u># And the LORD said, Shall I hide from Abraham that thing which I do;

hide from thee <u>26_EZE_28_03</u># Behold, thou [art] wiser than Daniel; there is no secret that they can hide from thee:

hide he burnt <u>03_LEV_09_11</u># And the flesh and the hide he burnt with fire without the camp.

hide him she <u>02_EXO_02_03</u># And when she could not longer hide him, she took for him an ark of bulrushes, and daubed it with slime and with pitch, and put the child therein; and she laid [it] in the flags by the river's brink.

hide him the <u>26_EZE_31_08</u># The cedars in the garden of God could not hide him: the fir trees were not like his boughs, and the chestnut trees were not like his branches; nor any tree in the garden of God was like unto him in his beauty.

hide himself from <u>43_JOH_12_36</u> # While ye have light, believe in the light, that ye may be the children of light. These things spake Jesus, and departed, and did hide himself from them.

hide himself his <u>24_JER_49_10</u> # But I have made Esau bare, I have uncovered his secret places, and he shall not be able to hide himself: his seed is spoiled, and his brethren, and his neighbours, and he [is] not.

hide himself in <u>09_18A_26_01</u># And the Ziphites came unto Saul to Gibeah, saying, Doth not David hide himself in the hill of Hachilah, [which is] before Jeshimon?

hide himself in 24_JER_23_24 # Can any hide himself in secret places that I shall not see him? saith the LORD. Do not I fill heaven and earth? saith the LORD.

hide himself with <u>09_1SA_23_19</u> # Then came up the Ziphites to Saul to Gibeah, saying, Doth not David hide himself with us in strong holds in the wood, in the hill of Hachilah, which [is] on the south of Jeshimon?

hide himself with <u>19_PSA_54_01</u> # To the chief Musician on Neginoth, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when the Ziphims came and said to Saul, Doth not David hide himself with us? Save me, O God, by thy name, and judge me by thy strength.

hide his face <u>33_MIC_03_04</u> # Then shall they cry unto the LORD, but he will not hear them: he will even hide his face from them at that time, as they have behaved themselves ill in their doings.

hide his flesh <u>03_LEV_08_17</u> # But the bullock, and his hide, his flesh, and his dung, he burnt with fire without the camp; as the LORD commanded Moses.

hide it from <u>01_GEN_47_18</u># When that year was ended, they came unto him the second year, and said unto him, We will not hide [it] from my lord, how that our money is spent; my lord also hath our herds of cattle; there is not ought left in the sight of my lord, but our bodies, and our lands:

hide it from <u>07_JUD_06_11</u> # And there came an angel of the LORD, and sat under an oak which [was] in Ophrah, that [pertained] unto Joash the Abiezrite: and his son Gideon threshed wheat by the winepress, to hide [it] from the Midianites.

hide it not <u>09_1SA_03_17</u> # And he said, What [is] the thing that [the LORD] hath said unto thee? I pray thee hide [it] not from me: God do so to thee, and more also, if thou hide [any] thing from me of all the things that he said unto thee.

hide it not <u>23_ISA_03_09</u> # The show of their countenance doth witness against them; and they declare their sin as Sodom, they hide [it] not. Woe unto their soul! for they have rewarded evil unto themselves.

hide it not 24_JER_38_25 # But if the princes hear that I have talked with thee, and they come unto thee, and say unto thee, Declare unto us now what thou hast said unto the king, hide it not from us, and we will not put thee to death; also what the king said unto thee:

hide it not <u>06_JOS_07_19</u># And Joshua said unto Achan, My son, give, I pray thee, glory to the LORD God of Israel, and make confession unto him; and tell me now what thou hast done; hide [it] not from me.

hide it there <u>24_JER_13_04</u> # Take the girdle that thou hast got, which [is] upon thy loins, and arise, go to Euphrates, and hide it there in a hole of the rock.

hide it under <u>18_JOB_20_12</u># Though wickedness be sweet in his mouth, [though] he hide it under his tongue;

Hide me from <u>19_PSA_64_02</u> # Hide me from the secret counsel of the wicked; from the insurrection of the workers of iniquity:

hide me he <u>19_PSA_27_05</u> # For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.

hide me in <u>18_JOB_14_13</u> # O that thou wouldest hide me in the grave, that thou wouldest keep me secret, until thy wrath be past, that thou wouldest appoint me a set time, and remember me!

hide me in <u>19_PSA_27_05</u># For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.

hide me under <u>19_PSA_17_08</u># Keep me as the apple of the eye, hide me under the shadow of thy wings,

hide me <u>19_PSA_143_09</u> # Deliver me, O LORD, from mine enemies: I flee unto thee to hide me.

hide mine eyes 23_ISA_01_15 # And when ye spread forth your hands, I will hide mine eyes from you: yea,

when ye make many prayers, I will not hear: your hands are full of blood.

hide my commandments <u>20_PRO_02_01</u> # My son, if thou wilt receive my words, and hide my commandments with thee;

hide my face <u>05_DEU_31_17</u> # Then my anger shall be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and I will hide my face from them, and they shall be devoured, and many evils and troubles shall befall them; so that they will say in that day, Are not these evils come upon us, because our God [is] not among us?

hide my face <u>05_DEU_31_18</u># And I will surely hide my face in that day for all the evils which they shall have wrought, in that they are turned unto other gods.

hide my face <u>05_DEU_32_20</u> # And he said, I will hide my face from them, I will see what their end [shall be]: for they [are] a very froward generation, children in whom [is] no faith.

hide my face <u>26_EZE_39_29</u> # Neither will I hide my face any more from them: for I have poured out my spirit upon the house of Israel, saith the Lord GOD.

hide myself from <u>18_JOB_13_20</u> # Only do not two [things] unto me: then will I not hide myself from thee.

Hide not thy <u>19_PSA_102_02</u> # Hide not thy face from me in the day [when] I am in trouble; incline thine ear unto me: in the day [when] I call answer me speedily.

hide not thy <u>19_PSA_119_19</u># I [am] a stranger in the earth: hide not thy commandments from me.

hide not thy <u>19_PSA_143_07</u> # Hear me speedily, O LORD: my spirit faileth: hide not thy face from me, lest I be like unto them that go down into the pit.

Hide not thy <u>19_PSA_27_09</u># Hide not thy face [far] from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.

hide not thy <u>19_PSA_69_17</u> # And hide not thy face from thy servant; for I am in trouble: hear me speedily.

hide not thyself <u>23_ISA_58_07</u> # [Is it] not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? when thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh?

hide not thyself <u>19_PSA_55_01</u># To the chief Musician on Neginoth, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David. Give ear to my prayer, O God; and hide not thyself from my supplication.

hide nothing from <u>24_JER_38_14</u> # Then Zedekiah the king sent, and took Jeremiah the prophet unto him into the third entry that [is] in the house of the LORD: and the king said unto Jeremiah, I will ask thee a thing; hide nothing from me.

hide pride from <u>18_JOB_33_17</u> # That he may withdraw man [from his] purpose, and hide pride from

hide the outcasts <u>23_ISA_16_03</u> # Take counsel, execute judgment; make thy shadow as the night in the midst of the noonday; hide the outcasts; bewray not him that wandereth.

hide thee in 23_ISA_02_10 # Enter into the rock, and hide thee in the dust, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty.

hide thee thou <u>24_JER_36_19</u># Then said the princes unto Baruch, Go, hide thee, thou and Jeremiah; and let no man know where ye be.

hide their counsel <u>23_ISA_29_15</u> # Woe unto them that seek deep to hide their counsel from the LORD, and their works are in the dark, and they say, Who seeth us? and who knoweth us?

hide their eyes <u>03_LEV_20_04</u># And if the people of the land do any ways hide their eyes from the man, when he giveth of his seed unto Molech, and kill him not:

hide them from <u>19_PSA_78_04</u> # We will not hide [them] from their children, showing to the generation to come the praises of the LORD, and his strength, and his wonderful works that he hath done.

hide them in <u>24_JER_43_09</u># Take great stones in thine hand, and hide them in the clay in the brickkiln, which [is] at the entry of Pharaoh's house in Tahpanhes, in the sight of the men of Judah;

Hide them in <u>18_JOB_40_13</u># Hide them in the dust together; [and] bind their faces in secret.

hide themselves but <u>20_PRO_28_28</u># When the wicked rise, men hide themselves: but when they perish, the righteous increase.

hide themselves from <u>05_DEU_07_20</u> # Moreover the LORD thy God will send the hornet among them, until they that are left, and hide themselves from thee, be destroyed.

hide themselves in <u>09_1SA_13_06</u> # When the men of Israel saw that they were in a strait, [for the people were distressed,] then the people did hide themselves in caves, and in thickets, and in rocks, and in high places, and in pits.

hide themselves in <u>12_2KI_07_12</u> # And the king arose in the night, and said unto his servants, I will now show you what the Syrians have done to us. hide this thing <u>09_1SA_20_02</u># And he said unto him, God forbid; thou shalt not die: behold, my father will do nothing either great or small, but that he will show it me: and why should my father hide this thing from me? it [is] not [so].

hide thy face <u>19_PSA_13_01</u># To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. How long wilt thou forget me, O LORD? for ever? how long wilt thou hide thy face from me?

hide thy face <u>19_PSA_30_07</u> # LORD, by thy favour thou hast made my mountain to stand strong: thou didst hide thy face, [and] I was troubled.

Hide thy face <u>19_PSA_51_09</u># Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities.

hide thyself as <u>23_ISA_26_20</u> # Come, my people, enter thou into thy chambers, and shut thy doors about thee: hide thyself as it were for a little moment, until the indignation be overpast.

hide thyself by <u>11_1KI_17_03</u># Get thee hence, and turn thee eastward, and hide thyself by the brook Cherith, that [is] before Jordan.

hide thyself for <u>19_PSA_89_46</u># How long, LORD? wilt thou hide thyself for ever? shall thy wrath burn like fire?

hide thyself from <u>05_DEU_22_01</u> # Thou shalt not see thy brother's ox or his sheep go astray, and hide thyself from them: thou shalt in any case bring them again unto thy brother.

hide thyself from <u>05_DEU_22_04</u> # Thou shalt not see thy brother's ass or his ox fall down by the way, and hide thyself from them: thou shalt surely help him to lift [them] up again.

hide thyself <u>05_DEU_22_03</u># In like manner shalt thou do with his ass; and so shalt thou do with his raiment; and with all lost thing of thy brother's, which he hath lost, and thou hast found, shalt thou do likewise: thou mayest not hide thyself.

hide us from <u>66_REV_06_16</u> # And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

hidest thou thy <u>18_JOB_13_24</u> # Wherefore hidest thou thy face, and holdest me for thine enemy?

hidest thou thy <u>19_PSA_44_24</u> # Wherefore hidest thou thy face, [and] forgettest our affliction and our oppression?

hidest thou thy <u>19_PSA_88_14</u> # LORD, why castest thou off my soul? [why] hidest thou thy face from me?

hidest thou thyself <u>19_PSA_10_01</u># Why standest thou afar off, O LORD? [why] hidest thou [thyself] in times of trouble?

hidest thy face <u>19_PSA_104_29</u># Thou hidest thy face, they are troubled: thou takest away their breath, they die, and return to their dust.

hidest thyself O 23_ISA_45_15 # Verily thou [art] a God that hidest thyself, O God of Israel, the Saviour.

hideth and for <u>40_MAT_13_44</u># Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto treasure hid in a field; the which when a man hath found, he hideth, and for joy thereof goeth and selleth all that he hath, and buyeth that field.

hideth counsel without <u>18_JOB_42_03</u># Who [is] he that hideth counsel without knowledge? therefore have I uttered that I understood not; things too wonderful for me, which I knew not.

hideth hatred with <u>20_PRO_10_18</u># He that hideth hatred [with] lying lips, and he that uttereth a slander, [is] a fool.

hideth her hideth <u>20_PRO_27_16</u> # Whosoever hideth her hideth the wind, and the ointment of his right hand, [which] bewrayeth [itself].

hideth himself and <u>09_1SA_23_23</u># See therefore, and take knowledge of all the lurking places where he hideth himself, and come ye again to me with the certainty, and I will go with you: and it shall come to pass, if he be in the land, that I will search him out throughout all the thousands of Judah.

hideth himself but <u>20_PRO_22_03</u># A prudent [man] foreseeth the evil, and hideth himself: but the simple pass on, and are punished.

hideth himself but <u>20_PRO_27_12</u> # A prudent [man] foreseeth the evil, [and] hideth himself; [but] the simple pass on, [and] are punished.

hideth himself on <u>18_JOB_23_09</u># On the left hand, where he doth work, but I cannot behold [him]: he hideth himself on the right hand, that I cannot see [him]:

hideth his eyes <u>20_PRO_28_27</u> # He that giveth unto the poor shall not lack: but he that hideth his eyes shall have many a curse.

hideth his face 23_ISA_08_17 # And I will wait upon the LORD, that hideth his face from the house of Jacob, and I will look for him.

hideth his face <u>18_JOB_34_29</u> # When he giveth quietness, who then can make trouble? and when he hideth [his] face, who then can behold him? whether [it be done] against a nation, or against a man only:

hideth his face <u>19_PSA_10_11</u># He hath said in his heart, God hath forgotten: he hideth his face; he will

hideth his hand <u>20_PRO_19_24</u># A slothful [man] hideth his hand in [his] bosom, and will not so much as bring it to his mouth again.

hiding of his <u>35_HAB_03_04</u> # And [his] brightness was as the light; he had horns [coming] out of his hand: and there [was] the hiding of his power.

hiding place and <u>19_PSA_119_114</u># Thou [art] my hiding place and my shield: I hope in thy word.

hiding place from <u>23_ISA_32_02</u> # And a man shall be as an hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the tempest; as rivers of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land.

hiding place thou <u>19_PSA_32_07</u># Thou [art] my hiding place; thou shalt preserve me from trouble; thou shalt compass me about with songs of deliverance. Selah.

hiding place <u>23_ISA_28_17</u> # Judgment also will I lay to the line, and righteousness to the plummet: and the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the hiding place.

Mehida the children <u>15_EZR_02_52</u># The children of Bazluth, the children of Mehida, the children of Harsha,

Mehida the children <u>16_NEH_07_54</u># The children of Bazlith, the children of Mehida, the children of Harsha,

Rephidim and pitched <u>04_NUM_33_15</u># And they departed from Rephidim, and pitched in the wilderness of Sinai.

Rephidim and there <u>02_EXO_17_01</u> # And all the congregation of the children of Israel journeyed from the wilderness of Sin, after their journeys, according to the commandment of the LORD, and pitched in Rephidim: and [there was] no water for the people to drink.

Rephidim and were <u>02_EXO_19_02</u># For they were departed from Rephidim, and were come [to] the desert of Sinai, and had pitched in the wilderness; and there Israel camped before the mount.

Rephidim where was <u>04_NUM_33_14</u> # And they removed from Alush, and encamped at Rephidim, where was no water for the people to drink.

Rephidim <u>02_EXO_17_08</u> # Then came Amalek, and fought with Israel in Rephidim.
