chide neither will 19\_PSA\_103\_09 # He will not always chide: neither will he keep [his anger] for ever.

chide with him <u>07\_JUD\_08\_01</u># And the men of Ephraim said unto him, Why hast thou served us thus, that thou calledst us not, when thou wentest to fight with the Midianites? And they did chide with him sharply.

chide with Moses <u>02\_EXO\_17\_02</u># Wherefore the people did chide with Moses, and said, Give us water that we may drink. And Moses said unto them, Why chide ye with me? wherefore do ye tempt the LORD?

chide ye with <u>02\_EXO\_17\_02</u># Wherefore the people did chide with Moses, and said, Give us water that we may drink. And Moses said unto them, Why chide ye with me? wherefore do ye tempt the LORD?

chided with Laban <u>01\_GEN\_31\_36</u># And Jacob was wroth, and chided with Laban: and Jacob answered and said to Laban, What [is] my trespass? what [is] my sin, that thou hast so hotly pursued after me?

chided with Moses <u>04\_NUM\_20\_03</u> # And the people chided with Moses, and spake, saying, Would God that we had died when our brethren died before the LORD!

hide a multitude <u>59\_JAM\_05\_20</u> # Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way shall save a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins.

hide any thing <u>09\_1SA\_03\_17</u> # And he said, What [is] the thing that [the LORD] hath said unto thee? I pray thee hide [it] not from me: God do so to thee, and more also, if thou hide [any] thing from me of all the things that he said unto thee.

hide from Abraham <u>01\_GEN\_18\_17</u> # And the LORD said, Shall I hide from Abraham that thing which I do;

hide from thee <u>26\_EZE\_28\_03</u># Behold, thou [art] wiser than Daniel; there is no secret that they can hide from thee:

hide he burnt 03\_LEV\_09\_11 # And the flesh and the hide he burnt with fire without the camp.

hide him she <u>02\_EXO\_02\_03</u># And when she could not longer hide him, she took for him an ark of bulrushes, and daubed it with slime and with pitch, and put the child therein; and she laid [it] in the flags by the river's brink.

hide him the <u>26\_EZE\_31\_08</u># The cedars in the garden of God could not hide him: the fir trees were not like his boughs, and the chestnut trees were not like his branches; nor any tree in the garden of God was like unto him in his beauty.

hide himself from <u>43\_JOH\_12\_36</u> # While ye have light, believe in the light, that ye may be the children of light. These things spake Jesus, and departed, and did hide himself from them.

hide himself his <u>24\_JER\_49\_10</u> # But I have made Esau bare, I have uncovered his secret places, and he shall not be able to hide himself: his seed is spoiled, and his brethren, and his neighbours, and he [is] not.

hide himself in 09\_1SA\_26\_01 # And the Ziphites came unto Saul to Gibeah, saying, Doth not David hide

himself in the hill of Hachilah, [which is] before Jeshimon?

hide himself in <u>24\_JER\_23\_24</u> # Can any hide himself in secret places that I shall not see him? saith the LORD. Do not I fill heaven and earth? saith the LORD.

hide himself with <u>09\_1SA\_23\_19</u># Then came up the Ziphites to Saul to Gibeah, saying, Doth not David hide himself with us in strong holds in the wood, in the hill of Hachilah, which [is] on the south of Jeshimon?

hide himself with 19 PSA 54 01 # To the chief Musician on Neginoth, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when the Ziphims came and said to Saul, Doth not David hide himself with us? Save me, O God, by thy name, and judge me by thy strength.

hide his face 33\_MIC\_03\_04 # Then shall they cry unto the LORD, but he will not hear them: he will even hide his face from them at that time, as they have behaved themselves ill in their doings.

hide his flesh <u>03\_LEV\_08\_17</u> # But the bullock, and his hide, his flesh, and his dung, he burnt with fire without the camp; as the LORD commanded Moses.

hide it from <u>01\_GEN\_47\_18</u># When that year was ended, they came unto him the second year, and said unto him, We will not hide [it] from my lord, how that our money is spent; my lord also hath our herds of cattle; there is not ought left in the sight of my lord, but our bodies, and our lands:

hide it from <u>07\_JUD\_06\_11</u># And there came an angel of the LORD, and sat under an oak which [was] in Ophrah, that [pertained] unto Joash the Abiezrite: and his son Gideon threshed wheat by the winepress, to hide [it] from the Midianites.

hide it not 24\_JER\_38\_25 # But if the princes hear that I have talked with thee, and they come unto thee, and say unto thee, Declare unto us now what thou hast said unto the king, hide it not from us, and we will not put thee to death; also what the king said unto thee:

hide it not <u>06\_JOS\_07\_19</u> # And Joshua said unto Achan, My son, give, I pray thee, glory to the LORD God of Israel, and make confession unto him; and tell me now what thou hast done; hide [it] not from me.

Hide me from 19\_PSA\_64\_02 # Hide me from the secret counsel of the wicked; from the insurrection of the workers of iniquity:

hide me he <u>19\_PSA\_27\_05</u># For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.

hide me in <u>18\_JOB\_14\_13</u> # O that thou wouldest hide me in the grave, that thou wouldest keep me secret, until thy wrath be past, that thou wouldest appoint me a set time, and remember me!

hide me in 19\_PSA\_27\_05 # For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.

hide me under 19\_PSA\_17\_08 # Keep me as the apple of the eye, hide me under the shadow of thy wings,

hide me 19\_PSA\_143\_09 # Deliver me, O LORD, from mine enemies: I flee unto thee to hide me.

hide mine eyes 23\_ISA\_01\_15 # And when ye spread forth your hands, I will hide mine eyes from you: yea, when ye make many prayers, I will not hear: your hands are full of blood.

hide my commandments <u>20\_PRO\_02\_01</u> # My son, if thou wilt receive my words, and hide my commandments with thee;

hide my face <u>05\_DEU\_31\_17</u># Then my anger shall be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and I will hide my face from them, and they shall be devoured, and many evils and troubles shall befall them; so that they will say in that day, Are not these evils come upon us, because our God [is] not among us?

hide my face <u>05\_DEU\_31\_18</u># And I will surely hide my face in that day for all the evils which they shall have wrought, in that they are turned unto other gods.

hide my face <u>05\_DEU\_32\_20</u> # And he said, I will hide my face from them, I will see what their end [shall be]: for they [are] a very froward generation, children in whom [is] no faith.

hide my face 26\_EZE\_39\_29 # Neither will I hide my face any more from them: for I have poured out my spirit upon the house of Israel, saith the Lord GOD.

hide myself from 18\_JOB\_13\_20 # Only do not two [things] unto me: then will I not hide myself from thee.

hide myself in <u>09 1SA 20 05</u> # And David said unto Jonathan, Behold, to morrow [is] the new moon, and I should not fail to sit with the king at meat: but let me go, that I may hide myself in the field unto the third [day] at even.

Hide not from 10\_2SA\_14\_18 # Then the king answered and said unto the woman, Hide not from me, I pray thee, the thing that I shall ask thee. And the woman said, Let my lord the king now speak.

hide not thine 25\_LAM\_03\_56 # Thou hast heard my voice: hide not thine ear at my breathing, at my cry.

Hide not thy 19\_PSA\_102\_02 # Hide not thy face from me in the day [when] I am in trouble; incline thine ear unto me: in the day [when] I call answer me speedily.

hide not thy 19 PSA 119 19 # I [am] a stranger in the earth: hide not thy commandments from me.

hide not thy 19\_PSA\_143\_07 # Hear me speedily, O LORD: my spirit faileth: hide not thy face from me, lest I be like unto them that go down into the pit.

Hide not thy 19\_PSA\_27\_09 # Hide not thy face [far] from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.

hide not thy 19\_PSA\_69\_17 # And hide not thy face from thy servant; for I am in trouble: hear me speedily.

hide not thyself <u>23\_ISA\_58\_07</u> # [Is it] not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? when thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh?

hide not thyself 19\_PSA\_55\_01 # To the chief Musician on Neginoth, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David. Give ear to my prayer, O God; and hide not thyself from my supplication.

hide nothing from 24\_JER\_38\_14 # Then Zedekiah the king sent, and took Jeremiah the prophet unto him into the third entry that [is] in the house of the LORD: and the king said unto Jeremiah, I will ask thee a thing; hide nothing from me.

hide pride from 18\_JOB\_33\_17 # That he may withdraw man [from his] purpose, and hide pride from man.

hide the outcasts <u>23\_ISA\_16\_03</u> # Take counsel, execute judgment; make thy shadow as the night in the midst of the noonday; hide the outcasts; bewray not him that wandereth.

hide thee in 23\_ISA\_02\_10 # Enter into the rock, and hide thee in the dust, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty.

hide thee thou <u>24\_JER\_36\_19</u> # Then said the princes unto Baruch, Go, hide thee, thou and Jeremiah; and let no man know where ye be.

hide their counsel 23 ISA 29 15 # Woe unto them that seek deep to hide their counsel from the LORD, and their works are in the dark, and they say, Who seeth us? and who knoweth us?

hide their eyes <u>03\_LEV\_20\_04</u> # And if the people of the land do any ways hide their eyes from the man, when he giveth of his seed unto Molech, and kill him not:

hide them from 19\_PSA\_78\_04 # We will not hide [them] from their children, showing to the generation to come the praises of the LORD, and his strength, and his wonderful works that he hath done.

hide them in 24\_JER\_43\_09 # Take great stones in thine hand, and hide them in the clay in the brickkiln, which [is] at the entry of Pharaoh's house in Tahpanhes, in the sight of the men of Judah;

Hide them in 18\_JOB\_40\_13 # Hide them in the dust together; [and] bind their faces in secret.

hide them in 19\_PSA\_31\_20 # Thou shalt hide them in the secret of thy presence from the pride of man: thou shalt keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues.

hide themselves but <u>20\_PRO\_28\_28</u># When the wicked rise, men hide themselves: but when they perish, the righteous increase.

hide themselves from <u>05\_DEU\_07\_20</u> # Moreover the LORD thy God will send the hornet among them, until they that are left, and hide themselves from thee, be destroyed.

hide themselves in <u>09\_1SA\_13\_06</u># When the men of Israel saw that they were in a strait, [for the people were distressed,] then the people did hide themselves in caves, and in thickets, and in rocks, and in high places, and in pits.

hide themselves in 12\_2KI\_07\_12 # And the king arose in the night, and said unto his servants, I will now show you what the Syrians have done to us. They know that we [be] hungry; therefore are they gone out of the camp to hide themselves in the field, saying, When they come out of the city, we shall catch them alive, and get into the city.

hide themselves 18\_JOB\_34\_22\_# [There is] no darkness, nor shadow of death, where the workers of iniquity may hide themselves.

hide there 24\_JER\_13\_06 # And it came to pass after many days, that the LORD said unto me, Arise, go to Euphrates, and take the girdle from thence, which I commanded thee to hide there.

hide this thing <u>09\_1SA\_20\_02</u># And he said unto him, God forbid; thou shalt not die: behold, my father will do nothing either great or small, but that he will show it me: and why should my father hide this thing from me? it [is] not [so].

hide thy face 19 PSA 13 01 # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. How long wilt thou forget me, O LORD? for ever? how long wilt thou hide thy face from me?

hide thy face 19\_PSA\_30\_07 # LORD, by thy favour thou hast made my mountain to stand strong: thou didst hide thy face, [and] I was troubled.

Hide thy face 19\_PSA\_51\_09 # Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities.

hide thyself as <u>23\_ISA\_26\_20</u> # Come, my people, enter thou into thy chambers, and shut thy doors about thee: hide thyself as it were for a little moment, until the indignation be overpast.

hide thyself by <u>11\_1KI\_17\_03</u># Get thee hence, and turn thee eastward, and hide thyself by the brook Cherith, that [is] before Jordan.

hide thyself for 19\_PSA\_89\_46 # How long, LORD? wilt thou hide thyself for ever? shall thy wrath burn like fire?

hide thyself from <u>05\_DEU\_22\_01</u># Thou shalt not see thy brother's ox or his sheep go astray, and hide thyself from them: thou shalt in any case bring them again unto thy brother.

hide thyself from <u>05\_DEU\_22\_04</u># Thou shalt not see thy brother's ass or his ox fall down by the way, and hide thyself from them: thou shalt surely help him to lift [them] up again.

hide thyself when <u>09\_1SA\_20\_19</u># And [when] thou hast stayed three days, [then] thou shalt go down quickly, and come to the place where thou didst hide thyself when the business was [in hand], and shalt remain by the stone Ezel.

hide thyself 11\_1KI\_22\_25# And Micaiah said, Behold, thou shalt see in that day, when thou shalt go into an inner chamber to hide thyself.

hide thyself <u>09\_1SA\_19\_02</u> # But Jonathan Saul's son delighted much in David: and Jonathan told David, saying, Saul my father seeketh to kill thee: now therefore, I pray thee, take heed to thyself until the morning, and abide in a secret [place], and hide thyself:

hide thyself 14\_2CH\_18\_24 # And Micaiah said, Behold, thou shalt see on that day when thou shalt go into

an inner chamber to hide thyself.

hide thyself <u>05\_DEU\_22\_03</u># In like manner shalt thou do with his ass; and so shalt thou do with his raiment; and with all lost thing of thy brother's, which he hath lost, and thou hast found, shalt thou do likewise: thou mayest not hide thyself.

hide us from <u>66\_REV\_06\_16</u># And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

hide yourselves there <u>06\_JOS\_02\_16</u># And she said unto them, Get you to the mountain, lest the pursuers meet you; and hide yourselves there three days, until the pursuers be returned: and afterward may ye go your way.

hidest thou thy 18\_JOB\_13\_24 # Wherefore hidest thou thy face, and holdest me for thine enemy?

hidest thou thy 19 PSA 44 24 # Wherefore hidest thou thy face, [and] forgettest our affliction and our oppression?

hidest thou thy 19\_PSA\_88\_14 # LORD, why castest thou off my soul? [why] hidest thou thy face from me?

hidest thou thyself <u>19\_PSA\_10\_01</u> # Why standest thou afar off, O LORD? [why] hidest thou [thyself] in times of trouble?

hidest thy face 19\_PSA\_104\_29 # Thou hidest thy face, they are troubled: thou takest away their breath, they die, and return to their dust.

hidest thyself O 23\_ISA\_45\_15 # Verily thou [art] a God that hidest thyself, O God of Israel, the Saviour.

hideth and for <u>40\_MAT\_13\_44</u># Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto treasure hid in a field; the which when a man hath found, he hideth, and for joy thereof goeth and selleth all that he hath, and buyeth that field.

hideth counsel without <u>18\_JOB\_42\_03</u> # Who [is] he that hideth counsel without knowledge? therefore have I uttered that I understood not; things too wonderful for me, which I knew not.

hideth hatred with 20\_PRO\_10\_18 # He that hideth hatred [with] lying lips, and he that uttereth a slander, [is] a fool.

hideth her hideth <u>20\_PRO\_27\_16</u> # Whosoever hideth her hideth the wind, and the ointment of his right hand, [which] bewrayeth [itself].

hideth himself and <u>09\_1SA\_23\_23</u># See therefore, and take knowledge of all the lurking places where he hideth himself, and come ye again to me with the certainty, and I will go with you: and it shall come to pass, if he be in the land, that I will search him out throughout all the thousands of Judah.

hideth himself but 20\_PRO\_22\_03 # A prudent [man] foreseeth the evil, and hideth himself: but the simple pass on, and are punished.

hideth himself but 20\_PRO\_27\_12 # A prudent [man] foreseeth the evil, [and] hideth himself; [but] the simple pass on, [and] are punished.

hideth himself on <u>18\_JOB\_23\_09</u> # On the left hand, where he doth work, but I cannot behold [him]: he hideth himself on the right hand, that I cannot see [him]:

hideth his eyes 20\_PRO\_28\_27 # He that giveth unto the poor shall not lack: but he that hideth his eyes

shall have many a curse.

hideth his face 23\_ISA\_08\_17\_# And I will wait upon the LORD, that hideth his face from the house of Jacob, and I will look for him.

hideth his face 18\_JOB\_34\_29 # When he giveth quietness, who then can make trouble? and when he hideth [his] face, who then can behold him? whether [it be done] against a nation, or against a man only:

hideth his face 19\_PSA\_10\_11# He hath said in his heart, God hath forgotten: he hideth his face; he will never see [it].

hideth his hand 20\_PRO\_19\_24 # A slothful [man] hideth his hand in [his] bosom, and will not so much as bring it to his mouth again.

hideth his hand 20\_PRO\_26\_15 # The slothful hideth his hand in [his] bosom; it grieveth him to bring it again to his mouth.

hideth not from 19\_PSA\_139\_12 # Yea, the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day: the darkness and the light [are] both alike [to thee].

hideth the wind 20\_PRO\_27\_16 # Whosoever hideth her hideth the wind, and the ointment of his right hand, [which] bewrayeth [itself].
